

Utah hasn't played much tennis yet in the Spring, as they are just 0-1 on the season, losing 5-2 to Fresno State on the road. Junior Alexia Petrovic and Freshman Whitney Turley each picked up a singles victory for Utah. Petrovic came back from a first-set loss to defeat Emma Wilson, 2-6, 7-6, 10-5. Turley defeated Olivia Noble in two sets, 6-3, 6-4. Petrovic played at No. 3 singles and Wilson at No. 6 singles. Utah lost the doubles point despite getting a win at No. 1 doubles from Margo Pletcher and Brianna Turley.

About Wisconsin

Wisconsin is 3-3 on the season with wins over Colorado State (7-0), Marquette (4-3) and Xavier (5-2) and losses to Marshall (7-0), North Texas (4-3) and Oklahoma (4-0). Wisconsin has lost two in a row and is 3-0 at home and 0-3 outside of Madison. Junior Kelsey Grambeau and Christina Zordani were the only two Badgers to post singles wins last weekend. Grambeau is now 3-2 playing primarily at the No. 2 spot, while Zordani is now 3-3 in the dual season.

For New Mexico head coach Stephanie Wooten-Quijada, this week might be a little more interesting than any other. Sure her team has played a great schedule so far, but this weekend is like a reunion of sorts. It starts on Friday when UNM plays Utah. With the Lobos and the Utes go way back (it's the 35th meeting), Wooten-Quijada will be facing off against her former collegiate coach. Matt landolo, prior to Utah, was the head coach at Purdue, where Wooten-Quijada (she was just Wooten back then) played.

Then on Saturday, Wooten-Quijada and her team face off against the coach who had a head in recruiting many of the current team, as Wisconsin is coached by Kelcy McKenna. McKenna was an assistant coach from 2013 through 2015, and then was the head coach for the 2015-16 season before taking over Wisconsin on July 1. McKenna's exit made it possible for Wooten-Quijada to take over at New Mexico from UTRGV (that's The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley, which used to be The University of Texas Pan American).

Getting the Gang Back Together

Finally, everyone is back and has played. Kinda.

All eight players on the squad have now been in the lineup in the Spring, although UNM has still been slowed by the injury/illness bug to exactly half the team. Also hurting New Mexico is where they have been playing. So far, the Lobos haven't been able to play matches all the way through (except at Colorado) due to the lack of indoor courts at Georgia and Denver. It's hurt UNM a bit as Cassie Chung would probably be 2-0 already in the Spring, as she was leading in both of her matches that were stopped.

Two of New Mexico's 4-0 losses would have either ended 5-2 or 4-3 with full courts available. That shouldn't be an issue for this weekend as Utah has eight courts available indoors.

We Got a Schedule to Keep Cha-Cha

The New Mexico women's tennis team has an overall program record of 491-364, meaning that sometime this season, UNM should get win No. 500. Of those 491 wins, most were earned over 24 seasons by Kathy Kolankeiwicz, who went 354-212. Of UNM's five head coaches (not counting first year coach Stephanie Wooten-Quijada), four have had winning overall records, including the last two, Erica Perkins Jasper (40-33) and Kelcy McKenna (15-7).

Kate McKinnon isn't the Only Awesome McKinnon These Days

The Linda Estes Tennis Center served as a wonderful home for UNM Tennis, and even though UNM doesn't play outdoor matches there, UNM's tennis offices, locker room and the Randy Briggs Indoor Tennis Dome are all still located there. The Briggs Indoor Dome covers three courts. It is 40 feet tall, 196 feet long and 128 feet wide, and was at one time the widest indoor tennis bubble in the world. There is a lobby area and the bleachers that seat close to 1000 fans.

Now, UNM calls the McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium home for it's outdoor matches. The McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium is located directly across the street from Linda Estes, behind The Pit basketball arena and next to the Lobo baseball field.

The stadium features stadium lights, electronic scoreboards and six sunken outdoor courts that include stadium seating for approximately 1,000 fans. Fans can keep up with all the action via a large electronic scoreboard located between the two central courts as well as smaller boards at each individual court.

The McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium comes courtesy of a \$1.2 million donation that was part of a \$7.5 million gift to UNM that Ian and Sonnet McKinnon made in 2011. Another \$500,000 was raised privately for the project and the stadium lights were donated by the City of Albuqueque. The McKinnon family also contributed \$300,000 to an endowed scholarship in the name of Loren Dils, a former director of the Lobo Tennis Club and an ex-UNM assistant tennis coach, who has been diagnosed with ALS. Ed and Shirley Corley donated the scoreboards.

The McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium has also served as the host site of numerous events including the 2014 USTA/ITA Regional Championships and 2015 Mountain West Conference Championships.

In summer 2015, the McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium was recognized as one of 13 winners in its 34th annual USTA Facility Awards Program, which recognizes excellence in the construction and/or renovation of tennis facilities throughout the country.
