

2/6 Boise State vs. UNM Post-Game Quotes

Head Coach Paul Weir:

“What happened at the end of the game was completely unacceptable. I apologize to the fans, the Mountain West, Boise State University, their whole staff and their program. I didn’t see everything that happened, but it was completely unacceptable behavior.”

“I am sick about it. As sick as I am about the game. That’s not how a game like this should end.”

“...Just a really bad half of offensive basketball, and, unfortunately, a really poor night on the glass.”

“Their offensive rebounding really hurt us, and our offensive ineptitude really got us in the second half. It’s an unbelievable way to finish a game, obviously makes you sick in a lot of ways, and the way the game ended on top of that, just made things worse. Not a great feeling. That’s really about it.”

“We, unfortunately, turned the ball over at some really inopportune times, on some really basic plays.”

“(This game is) ironic because our defense really stepped up tonight and had a pretty good game, and our offense really let us down. That hasn’t happened in a while. We have to get better offensively. It was a rough night.”

“They got more offensive rebounds. You turn over the ball, give them breakaway layups, and it’s hard to ever get back and set-up your defense.”

“We had some really poor offensive possessions down the stretch.”

“Boise did a really good job defending when they had to, and then, obviously scoring at the other end.”

“Our decision making, our ball handling, and our passing, down the stretch, was awful.”

“Our rebounding is half technical, half toughness and they just out-toughed us on the glass.”
