SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos are 7-3 overall against Nevada including a four-win streak over the last four meetings. The Lobos claimed a 69-63 victory on the road at Nevada earlier this season on Saturday, Jan. 7 to improve their road record to 4-2 while UNM holds a 3-1 advantage over the Wolf Pack at home in WisePies Arena - The Pit.

The last meeting between the two squads marked UNM's fourth straight win to open Mountain West play 4-0 and Nevada's fourth straight loss making them 0-4 in the league. Freshman Mykiel Burleson got the Lobos out to a strong start, scoring an outstanding 16 points in just the first quarter. Junior Cherise Beynon scored 25 points to go along with five rebounds, three assists and two steals en route to the win. The Lobos were missing heavy-shooting Alex Lapeyrolerie to injury in the last meeting. Lapeyrolerie is expected to be ready for action Saturday.

Leading the way for Nevada in the match was sophomore Terae Briggs who scored 16 points going 7-for-12 from the field and sophomore Riana Everidge who posted 13 points going 5-for-7 from the floor and 1-of-3 from three.

ABOUT THE MATCHUP

The Lobos enter Saturday's game 2-1 in their last three contests including a 10-point victory over Utah State on the road.

Utah State is also 2-1 in its last three games after suffering a five-loss streak to open Mountain West play. The Wolf Pack topped Air Force and Boise State by a combined 12-point margin for their two Mountain West wins.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES**SCOUTING NEVADA**

The Wolf Pack enters Saturday's game with an 8-11 record including a 2-6 conference mark to rank them 10th in the Mountain West standings. Nevada most recently pulled off the upset victory over fifth-place Boise State on Wednesday at home by a score of 69-62. Boise State is now 4-4 in conference play after the loss, 14-5 overall.

The squad is led by two players scoring in double figures including sophomore Riana Everidge and Stephanie Schmid who average 12.3 and 12.1 points per game, respectively. Sophomore AJ Cephas leads the squad with 8.0 rebounds per game.

In Nevada's game vs. Boise State Wednesday, four players scored in double figures including Everidge (16), Cephas (13), Terae Briggs (11) and T Moe (10). In addition, two players hit double-double status as Everidge and Cephas each collected 10 rebounds apiece.

6 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

The countdown continues as Cherise Beynon closes in on 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. Beynon now has 994 career points and 494 career rebounds, meaning she needs just six of each. Hitting both marks would add her to the elite list of players to reach the 1,000 point and 500 rebound threshold in their careers. Only 14 Lobos have accomplished the feat in the history of the program.

The Lobos have now reached the halfway mark in the 2016-17 Mountain West schedule and are currently 6-3 through their first nine league matches.

STARTING LAP

After proving her offensive abilities throughout the season, redshirt-junior Alex Lapeyrolerie has started the last three games for the Lobos. Lapeyrolerie has battled injuries this season but has earned a starting spot as the Lobos enter the second half of conference play. She has accumulated 167 points this season which is 48 more than her previous two seasons combined despite missing four games.

Lapeyrolerie averages 11.1 points per game on the season but posted 13.5 points per game over her four starts this season. In the Lobos' most recent game at Utah State, Lapeyrolerie was a member of the starting five and finished just one point shy of her career high (22) while also tying her career-high minutes (36).

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

IT'S ALL ABOUT THE REBOUND

A key focus of Coach Bradbury's game plan is the ability to get the rebound, and it's clear why. UNM is 0-7 this season (0-2 MW) when they are outrebounded by their opponent. Conversely, the Lobos are 10-2 (6-1 MW) when they secure the most boards. Currently the Lobos rank No. 1 in the NCAA in defensive rebounds per game and third in rebounds per game.

So far this season, UNM has pulled in over 45 rebounds in 13 of its 19 games - 57 vs. FDU, 57 vs. NMSU (11/15), 46 at Texas Tech, 57 vs. Tulsa, 47 vs. SMU, 47 vs. Minnesota, 46 vs. UTEP, 49 at Fresno State, 51 vs. SDSU, 52 at Nevada, 49 at UNLV, 52 vs. Colorado State and 52 vs. Boise State.

LOBOS IN THE NATION

As a team, the Lobos currently rank **first** in the country in defensive rebounds per game (34) and **third** in rebounds per game (46.89). In addition, UNM is ranked **11th** in the country in personal fouls per game and **17th** in defensive field goal percentage. Individually, junior **Cherise Beynon** ranks 12th in the nation in assists per game (6.8). Beynon also ranks 15th in total assists (129).

THE MOUNTAIN WEST STACK UP

The Lobos remain first in the league in five team categories including defensive rebounds per game, fewest fouls, personal fouls per game, total rebounds and rebounds per game.

Individually, **Cherise Beynon** leads the league in assists and assists per game while **Richelle van der Keijl** remains the Mountain West leader in field goal percentage (57.8) and is second in rebounds (184) and rebounds per game (9.7).

DOUBLE-FIGURE LOBO UPDATE

Five Lobos are averaging in double figures heading into Saturday's game including **Cherise Beynon** (15.7), **Richelle van der Keijl** (13.4), **Alex Lapeyrolerie** (11.1) **Jaisa Nunn** (10.6) and **Mykiel Burleson** (10.0).

MW PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Senior **Richelle van der Keijl** earned the Lobos' first Mountain West Player of the Week honor on Dec. 12 after her outstanding performances against Minnesota and UTEP. She averaged 17.0 points, 10.5 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game while shooting 53.3 percent from the field for the week. She also registered her third double-double of the season against UTEP when she scored 18 points and grabbed 12 rebounds while shooting 72.7 percent from the field.

BEYNON RECORDS AND MILESTONES

Junior **Cherise Beynon** tied the all-time New Mexico record for assists in a single game with 15 on Nov. 15 against NM State. Beynon tied former Lobo player - and current Lobo administrator - Janice Ruggiero (Branch) who set the record on Jan. 23, 1987 against Adams State.

In the Lobos' contest vs. SMU at home on December 3, **Beynon** racked up an outstanding 32 points. Her 32 points ranks her fourth all-time in UNM history for points in a single game. The last time a Lobo scored 30 points was on Dec. 15, 2002 when Jordan Adams scored 30 vs. Memphis. Beynon is one of just four players in the Mountain West to score 30+ points this season.

20-POINT CLUB

The Lobos have had at least one player rack up 20 points in 13 of their first 19 games of the 2016-17 season. This season's Lobo 20-point club consists of, **Richelle van der Keijl**, **Alex Lapeyrolerie**, **Mykiel Burleson**, **Cherise Beynon** and **Jaisa Nunn**.

ABOUT THE 2016-17 LOBOS

The 2016-17 edition of the New Mexico women's basketball team is going to have a much different look as the Lobos are under new direction with new head coach Mike Bradbury. The Lobos will show off a new style of play, speeding the game up with the dribble drive and shooting those outside threes.

ADDITION BY ADDITION

The Lobos welcome in six new faces to the program -- all coming from experienced backgrounds of basketball. The three freshman were rated as the top recruiting class in the Mountain West. Three transfers come in to the program. Only one will be eligible to play this season.

PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST HONORS

Junior **Cherise Beynon** was named to the 2016-17 Mountain West Preseason All-Conference Team following her stellar sophomore campaign while freshman **Mykiel Burleson** was named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year. As a team, the Lobos were selected to finish sixth in the league.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Two years ago, "The Pit" went under construction with the name of the arena. It is still identified as "The Pit" but has a few more letters added to it, as the name of the arena is now WisePies Arena aka The Pit. "The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years.

STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic

rankings as well. For six of the last eight seasons, and eight of the last 11 seasons, UNM has finished in the WBCA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

The Lobo women's basketball roster has a mixture of athletes from near and far on its 2016-17 roster. The Lobos have players from nine different states and one from another country. The Lobos are combined with players from Texas, Florida, Utah, Nevada, New Mexico, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Washington. The Lobos have one player from overseas in senior transfer Richelle van der Kiejl from The Netherlands.

Lobos make it 4-0 with 69-63 Win at Nevada

RENO, NEV. --- After a dominating performance that resulted in a 27-11 first-quarter lead, The University of New Mexico women's basketball team (8-6, 4-0 MW) won an eventual nail-biter over the Nevada Wolf Pack (6-9, 0-4 MW) on Saturday evening by a score of 69-63 to claim its first 4-0 conference start since the 1998-99 season when the Lobos were a member of the WAC. The win marks the first time in the 17 seasons that the Lobos have been a part of the Mountain West that they have started 4-0.

Freshman Mykiel Bursleson got the Lobos out to a strong start scoring an outstanding 16 points in just the first quarter. Prior to Saturday's game, Bursleson had only scored over 16 points in a game once when she netted 22 at Texas Tech on Nov. 20.

"I think that this was one of those games we just had to gut out," head coach Mike Bradbury said. "Nevada was tremendous in taking us out of everything that we wanted to do. We had no inside game today and we had to gut it out. We were good defensively in the second half and Cherise was Cherise. We're fortunate to have her and fortunate that she played as well as she did today."

The New Mexico bench was limited on Saturday as UNM was missing junior guard Alex Lapeyrolerie and sophomore guard Emily Lines, both exceptional perimeter shooters. The remaining Lobos stood up to the challenge and were led by junior Cherise Beynon with her seventh game of the season scoring 20 or more points, her fourth straight. Beynon scored 25 points to go along with five rebounds, three assists and two steals while going 6-of-10 from behind the 3-point line. Six 3-pointers in a single game ties Beynon's career high which she last achieved on Feb. 10, 2016 vs. Utah State.

Beynon was followed by Bursleson who finished with 18 points, her second-highest total of her career, to go along with seven rebounds and a steal. She went 7-of-17 from the floor and 3-of-7 from 3-point range. Powering through her own adverse conditions, junior Jayda Bovero was a last-minute decision to play and notched her third game in double digits this season scoring 10 points to help lead the squad.

Bursleson got the Lobos started with a three less than 15 seconds into the game, followed by two more as she went 3-of-4 from behind the arc and 6-of-7 from the floor in the first quarter. The freshman couldn't miss and was joined in the 3-pointer party by Beynon who went 3-of-3 from deep to account for a combined 25 of UNM's 27 opening points.

"I thought Mykiel was really good defensively tonight," Bradbury said. "She made some shots in the first quarter but defensively, this was her best game. She did not miss a defensive assignment."

With a lofty 16-point lead after the first frame, the Lobos looked to lose the momentum as they gave up three turnovers in a span of 1:14 to open the second quarter and allowed a three by the Wolf Pack's Desirae Gonzalez to make it 27-14 UNM. The Lobo offense seemed to stall out as Nevada whittled the 16-point lead down to 10 and eventually to eight as Nevada closed the half on a 6-0 run over the final 1:51 to make it 40-32 UNM. Nevada outscored UNM 21-13 in the second quarter and outshot the Lobos 45 percent to 25.

As if the reduced bench wasn't enough pressure on the Lobos, Beynon picked up her third foul on a questionable call that laid the junior out at half court with just 24 seconds left in the first half to put her starting the second half in foul trouble.

UNM was outshooting Nevada 40.0 to 32.4 percent and outrebounding 27-19 at the half. Nevada improved from behind the arc, going 0-for-5 in the first quarter to 3-of-6 in the second. Conversely, the Lobos went from 6-of-9 (66.7 percent) in the first to 2-of-6 (33.3 percent) in the second.

Beynon came out with back-to-back 3-pointers to open scoring in the third quarter and put UNM back up by a comfortable 14-point margin, 46-32 but in similar fashion to the second quarter, scoring droughts for UNM allowed Nevada to cut the Lobo lead back to single digits when the Wolf Pack closed the quarter on a 4-0 run to make it 55-46.

The Lobos were once again daunted by foul trouble when senior standout Richelle van der Keijl collected three straight fouls in the third quarter, bringing her game total to four. van der Keijl, who averages 14.3 points per game, fouled out with 1:45 left in the fourth quarter after scoring just six. The finale of the game was a close one as UNM got its lead out to as many as nine, 64-55, before Nevada cut it to just three, 66-63 with exactly one minute to go. A free throw by sophomore Jaisa Nunn made it a four-point two-possession game, 67-63, with 52 seconds left followed by another free throw by senior Kianna Keller at 30 seconds (68-63) and yet another by Beynon with just 18 left on the clock for the 69-63 final.

Overall the Lobos outshot Nevada 35.4 percent to 32.9 and posted 14 fast-break points to just eight for the Wolf Pack. Nevada did however outscore the Lobos in the paint (30-26) and off of turnovers (13-11). The Lobos grabbed 52 boards to just 37 for the Wolf Pack, led by Keller and Nunn (12 apiece) to make UNM 8-1 this season when outrebounding its opponent.

The Lobos return to action at UNLV on Wednesday, Jan. 11 at 7 p.m. MT and UNM returns to WisePies Arena - The Pit on Saturday, Jan. 14 as they host Colorado State in a 3 p.m. contest. The Colorado State game marks Pack the Pit night with just \$2 tickets!
