### SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos are 1-1 all-time against Marquette with the two teams meeting for the first time in 21 years last season in Milwaukee with UNM falling, 62-52. The other meeting came Dec. 31, 1995, again at Marquette with UNM winning, 73-71. This will be the first time Marquette has played against the Lobos in Albuquerque.

### HEADING INTO THE MATCHUP

The Lobos enter Monday's contest with Marquette 1-0 after defeating Western Michigan 88-76 on Friday at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit in their season opener. It's the most points the Lobos have scored in a regular-season game since defeating New Mexico State 92-85 in 2009.

UNM never trailed in its opener as it jumped out to a 25-12 advantage after the first quarter. The Broncos cut the Lobo lead to as little as one, but UNM found an answer each time to win their third consecutive season opener (the Lobos are 26-14 overall in season openers). The Lobos were led by senior guard Cherise Beynon as she had 24 points (18 in the first half), nine assists and eight rebounds. Senior transfer Tesha Buck in her first game as a Lobo had 22 points thanks to going 5-for-8 from 3-point range while adding five assists. Jaisa Nunn had 18 points to go along with six rebounds in 23 minutes of play.

This will be Marquette's season opener with the Golden Eagles coming off a 2016-17 campaign that saw them go 25-8 and win the Big East Tournament (first time in program history) and claim their first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2011.

**NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES****SCOUTING MARQUETTE**

The Golden Eagles return four starters from last season's Big East Tournament champion team, including Big East Preseason Player of the Year Allazia Blockton.

Blockton, who was an honorable mention All-American and unanimous first-team all-conference player, averaged 17.1 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.2 assists last season. Joining the junior in returning to the starting lineup are fellow juniors Danielle King (11.1 ppg), Natisha Hiedeman (13.9 ppg) and Erika Davenport (13.2 ppg, 9.2 rpg) along with key reserve Amani Wilborn (9.8 ppg).

The Golden Eagles also didn't fear the big games as they were 6-0 against ranked opponents last season - beating Arizona State, Oregon State and Creighton as well as DePaul three times. MU's 78.8 points per game ranked 14th in the NCAA as the Golden Eagles are going to look to run.

**BRADBURY CLOSING IN ON WIN NO. 200**

UNM coach Mike Bradbury has had a successful 10-plus seasons as a head coach and now he's closing in on win No. 200 in just his 11th season. The second-year Lobo coach sits at 194 victories and averaged 19.3 victories per season in his first 10 years as a head coach.

**NICE DEBUT BY BUCK**

Senior transfer shined her Lobo debut during an 88-76 win over Western Michigan on Friday, Nov. 10. The Wisconsin-Green Bay transfer racked up 22 points and added five assists in the victory. She was, not surprisingly, deadly accurate from beyond the arc - going 5-for-8 from long distance.

**LOBOS PICKED FOURTH IN MOUNTAIN WEST**

The Lobos has been selected to finish in the top third of the Mountain West Conference by the coaches and media as UNM was picked to finish fourth in the conference. The Lobos collected four first-place votes (there were 25 votes total) and 186 points - only behind Boise State (221 points, seven first-place votes), Wyoming (216 points, six first-place votes) and Colorado State (211 points, six first-place votes).

**UNM SWEEPS PRESEASON CONFERENCE AWARDS**

The Lobos swept the three preseason Mountain West individual awards with Cherise Beynon named the MW Preseason Player of the Year (as well as to the All-MW Preseason Team), Tesha Buck selected the MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year and N'Dea Flye voted the MW Preseason Freshman of the Year.

**BEYNON CLIMBING CAREER UNM CHARTS IN ... ALMOST EVERYTHING**

Cherise Beynon's first three seasons as a Lobo have been spectacular to say the least and the do-it-all guard will continue to climb the Lobo all-time lists this season. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native is in the career top 15 in points (1,193 - 10th), field goals made (449 - seventh), field goals attempted (1,284 - sixth), 3-pointers made (133 - eighth), 3-pointers attempted (458 - sixth), assists (381 - seventh) and steals (177 - fifth). She's also nearing the top 15 in rebounding (585 - No. 15 is 603) and the top 10 in minutes

played (2,827 - No. 10 is at 3,406). She can also become the second UNM basketball player - male or female - to reach the 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 500-assist mark (Mandi Moore finished with 1,057 points, 603 rebounds and 651 assists for the Lobos from 2002-05).

### BEYNON 2016-17 ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

Cherise Beynon was named the second Academic All-American in program history last season as she is one of just five players in the nation to make the CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team list.

### ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 University of New Mexico women's basketball team returns key pieces from head coach Mike Bradbury's first season and the additions of several others have the Lobos in a position to play the up-tempo style Bradbury hopes for and improve from their 15-15 campaign in 2016-17.

UNM returns All-Mountain West and Mountain West All-Defensive Team member Cherise Beynon as well as fellow starters Alex Lapeyrolerie and All-Mountain West Freshman team member Mykiel Bureson. UNM also returns Jaisa Nunn in the post and guards Laneah Bryan and Emily Lines. Add to it with two talented transfers and five freshmen that all will likely see action and UNM is excited to see what 2017-18 has in store.

### ADDITION BY ADDITION

Of the 13 players that will dress for the Lobos (Kansas transfer Aisia Robertson must sit for a season per NCAA rules), seven will be new to UNM fans this season, including a pair of transfers who sat last season for UNM in Tesha Buck and Erica Moore.

### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

The Pit is still there, but it will be going by a new name starting this season as the nationally famous facility will now be known as Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The arena is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years. The UNM women's basketball team is an impressive 386-202 at home all-time, a winning percentage of .656 heading into the 2017-18 season.

### MESSED AROUND & GOT A TRIPLE-DOUBLE ... TWICE

Senior guard Cherise Beynon put together one of the more impressive seasons in recent Lobo history in 2016-17 - averaging 15.8 points, 7.5 rebounds, 6.6 assists and 1.9 steals. Along with posting those well-rounded numbers - the Las Vegas native also had not one, but two triple-doubles last season, becoming the first Lobo since 1979 to have a triple-double. Beynon posted 15 points, 15 rebounds and 10 assists on Feb. 18 against Fresno State after notching her first on Feb. 8 against Air Force. In that game, Beynon put up 20 points, 12 assists and 12 rebounds. Beynon also finished just three assists short of her third triple-double on Feb. 22 at Colorado State.

Beynon is one of just 24 players to record a triple-double this season and is tied for second in the nation with most triple-doubles at two. Just one player has tallied more, Sabrina Ionescu of Oregon (4). Only three players have registered multiple triple-doubles this season in Division I.

### THE BUCK STOPPED HERE - IN NEW MEXICO

The Lobos will get a boost this season in Wisconsin-Green Bay transfer Tesha Buck. The Minnesota native, who sat out last season due to NCAA transfer rules, scored 1,003 points and hit 183 3-pointers in her three seasons with WGB along with averaging 4.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game. The 6-foot guard hit

57 or more 3-pointers in each of her three seasons - and she's a winner as the team went a combined 78-20 during her time there.

## STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For seven of the last nine seasons, and nine of the last 12 seasons, UNM has finished in the WB-CA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

## LETTING IT FLY FROM 3 - MW EDITION

The Lobos set a program record for 3-pointers made (115) and attempted (413) during a conference season in 2016-17. Cherise Beynon paced the Lobos by taking a program-record 118 3-pointers during conference play.

## LAPEYROLERIE ENTERS 3-PT SINGLE-SEASON TOP 10

Redshirt senior Alex Lapeyrolerie made her way into the UNM single-season top 10 in 3-pointers made and attempted in 2016-17 as she made 55 (10th in UNM single-season history) on 182 attempts (fifth). Cherise Beynon also found her way into the 3-pointers attempted single-season UNM list with 205 in 2016-17.

## DEFENSE AND REBOUNDING IN 2016-17

UNM was one of the toughest teams to shoot against last season as the Lobos ranked eighth in the country in field-goal percentage allowed at 34.8 percent. All those forced misses - along with the Lobos' up-tempo pace - helped UNM rank second in the NCAA in defensive rebounding at 33.0 boards per game. The Lobos finished the season ranked third in the nation in rebounding at 45.5 per contest.

## LOBOS LEAD ATTENDANCE

The Lobos again led the Mountain West and finished in the top 30 in attendance during the 2016-17 campaign. UNM drew 80,230 during the season, an average of 4,719 per game for 16th in the country and second among non-Power 5 schools (Gonzaga averaged 5,618).

## TWO TOP-25 FOES FOR LOBOS IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY

The Lobos will face a pair of teams ranked in the preseason top 25 in their non-conference slate this season. UNM hosts No. 19 Marquette on Nov. 13 (7 p.m.) and travels to take on No. 21 Oklahoma on Dec. 16.

# Lobos fall to Marquette on the road, 62-52

## UNM ATHLETICS

**MILWAUKEE, Wis.** --- The University of New Mexico women's basketball team went cold for a stretch in the third quarter and a late fourth-quarter rally came up short as the Lobos fell to Marquette 62-52 Wednesday at the Al McGuire Center in their final contest before Mountain West play.

New Mexico (4-6) trailed the Golden Eagles (9-2) 38-37 after an Alex Lapeyrolerie basket with 7:16 remaining in the third quarter. However, the Lobos went scoreless for a 5-minute, 48-second stretch to see their deficit grow to 47-37 on a trio of Marquette 3-pointers before Cherise Beynon ended the UNM drought with a bucket with 1:28 remaining to make it 47-39 – which was the score heading into the fourth.

The Golden Eagles increased their lead to 60-43 before Lapeyrolerie – who paced UNM with 14 points – scored with 4:07 remaining to ignite a 9-0 Lobo run capped by a Mykiel Burleson layup with 2:08 left in the contest to cut the Marquette advantage to 60-52.

But that's as close as the Lobos got before falling in their first game in 10 days (defeated UTEP 79-66 on Dec. 11) since inclement weather didn't allow Eastern Illinois to travel to play UNM in Albuquerque on Sunday, Dec. 18.

UNM trailed 22-17 after the opening quarter and were down 25-19 before an 8-0 Lobos run that was ignited by a Jaisa Nunn basket and capped with a Richelle van der Keijl turnaround jumper gave UNM its first lead of the contest at 27-25.

A Marquette 3-pointer put the Golden Eagles back in the lead briefly before Lapeyrolerie answered on the Lobos' next possession with her own 3-pointer to give the Lobos a 30-28 advantage with 3:29 remaining in the second.

The Lobos led 33-32 with less than a minute to play before Marquette scored to take a 34-33 halftime lead – and UNM wouldn't lead again in the contest.

To go along with Lapeyrolerie's team-high 14 points for the Lobos, Nunn had 12 points and six rebounds, Beynon had nine points and a team-high four assists, van der Keijl had eight points, a team-high nine rebounds and two blocks and Kianna Keller led the Lobos with three blocks to go along with two steals and four rebounds.

The Lobos shot 34.4 percent from the field (21-for-61), 23.5 percent from 3-point range (4-for-17) and 46.2 percent from the free-throw line (6-for-13). UNM's defense held Marquette to 32.4 percent shooting from the field (23-for-71). Marquette outrebounded the Lobos 53-39, including grabbing 16 offensive rebounds leading to 12 second-chance points (the Lobos had one second-chance point).
