- **We really are New Mexico ...** The 2016 New Mexico baseball team has 12 players from the state of New Mexico. It is no secret coach Ray Birmingham wants to take local kids all the way to Omaha. Ever since he got to UNM, he has been a big advocate of recruiting the best local talent New Mexico has to offer. In fact his rosters have had more players from New Mexico than any other state in each of his nine years at UNM.
- **He Just Keeps Winning ...** Ray Birmingham has been around for nine years at UNM and 29 years overall as a college head coach. He picked up his 1,110th career victory over Grand Canyon and in his 29-year career he is now up to 1,107 wins ... really it's only been 28 1/2 years, but the get to 1,100 wins in 29 years, Birmingham has had to average an astounding 38 wins per season.
- **Bullpen Dominance ...** The UNM bullpen has been outstanding at protecting leads during the last several seasons. If UNM is leading after eight innings? Forget it. The Lobos haven't lost when leading after eight in 97 straight games, a streak that dates back to March 24, 2013.

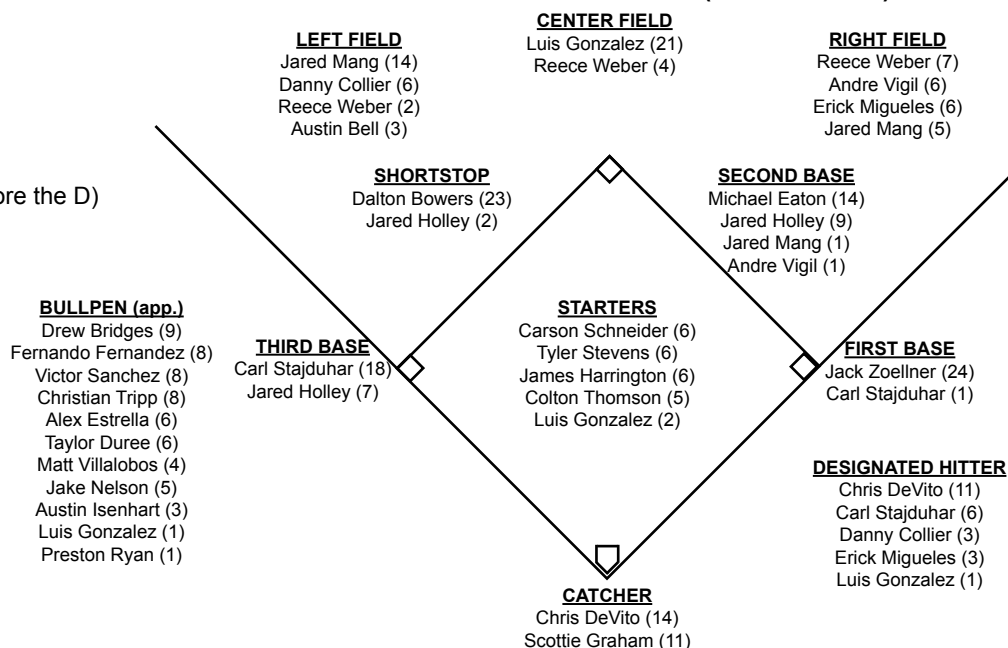

### Career Notes

- Four straight NCAA regionals appearances (2010-13), first postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

## HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

**SCOUTING UNLV ...** The UNLV Rebels enter the weekend with a 9-15 record. They are 3-6 in the Mountain West after series with San Jose State (2-1), Fresno State (1-2) and Nevada (0-3). The Rebels have had more success on the road (4-4) than they have at home (5-11).

Sophomore Payton Squier leads the Rebels offensively, batting .366 while starting in every game this season. He's scored a team-best 17 runs while chipping in 10 RBI.

On the mound, D.J. Myers has carried a heavy load, with six starts and 35.2 innings pitched. He has a team-high 38 strikeouts and has held opposing batters to a .238 batting average.

**ALL AMERICAN WATCH ...** Chris DeVito has been on a tear over the last week and has set himself up for possible national honors if he can keep it up. He is currently batting .404 on the season, ranking in the national top-50. He is one of the nation's leading run producers at 1.36 RBI per game, ranking 12th in the NCAA. With a .717 slugging percentage, he leads his team and ranks in the national top-30.

At DeVito's current pace, his numbers were last matched by DJ Peterson, who was a three-time All-American, two-time Mountain West Player of the Year and the program's highest ever draft pick.

**BIRMINGHAM MILESTONE ...** Friday night's game against UNLV will serve as head coach Ray Birmingham's 500th game as the leader of the Lobos. In his time guiding the Lobos to Mountain West powerhouse status, Birmingham has amassed a .580 winning percentage.

After the series on Sunday night, New Mexico's all-time leader in collegiate coaching wins will be inducted into the New Mexico Athletics Hall of Fame.

**NO STING ...** The Lobos were dominant in their most recent two-game midweek series against the Sacramento State Hornets. In that series, the Lobos shut them out in game one, 1-0, before earning another win, 12-3. The Lobos held the Hornets scoreless in 16 of 18 innings this past week. Sacramento State's combined batting average against New

**WINNING 1-0 ...** The Lobos' 1-0 win over Sacramento State on Monday was the first 1-0 win for Ray Birmingham as head coach of New Mexico and the program's first since defeating San Diego State in the Mountain West Conference Tournament on May 23, 2007. The last regular season win by a score of 1-0 came in 2004.

**STARTING WITH A W ...** The Lobos earned a 5-3 series opening win last Thursday at San Diego State, making them 3-0 on the season when starting a Mountain West Conference series. This is the third time in the last four seasons in which the Lobos have started 3-0 in MW series openers. The bar was set high last year, when the Lobos won on opening night in their first seven MW series'.

**PITCHING THIS WEEK ...** Head coach Ray Birmingham has stated that in order for this team to be successful, the pitching has to be on point. Based on the last five games, the message seems to have been received. the Lobos' ERA over the last five games, all of which have been on the road, is at 3.27. The team has 32 strikeouts during that time to just 11 walks and has held opposing batters to a .258 average.

**CHAMPIONSHIP PEDIGREE ...** At 7-2, the Lobos are the fastest team in the Mountain West to reach seven wins, and are on pace to compete for another conference championship.

That is to be expected of Birmingham's Lobos. Since Birmingham took over the program in 2008, New Mexico has been the champions or runners up in either the regular season or conference tournament. That includes five regular season or tournament titles during a four year span from 2011-2014.

**WINNING ON THE ROAD ...** New Mexico is currently on a run of nine wins in 11 games, with eight of the last 11 games played away from Santa Ana Star Field. Prior to the team's back-to-back wins over Grand Canyon, the Lobos held an RPI of 189. The Lobos recent success has bumped them up 114 spots to 75th.

Fresno State has the league's best RPI at 64. UNM ranks second, ahead of Air Force at 84. Air Force is followed by Nevada at 144, UNLV at 185, San Jose State at 189 and San Diego State at 203.

**FOLLOW MY LEAD ...** The Lobos have been starting rallies early in innings this season, with an inning-starting OBP of .426. They are hitting .321 as a team in leadoff situations.

**ATTENDANCE UPDATE ...** Through six home games the Lobos are averaging 960 fans, which is 63rd in the country.

**DUREE-ABLE...** Taylor Duree pitched in relief against both San Diego State and Sacramento State this week, the latter marking his 72nd career appearance. He is the second pitcher

to reach 70 appearances at New Mexico and is now in second place all alone on the UNM career appearances list.

He is now four spots ahead of David Steinberg (not the Canadian comedian, but that would have been amazing) with 68 appearances (Steinberg played from 1979-82). He is now three appearances away from tying Joe Coleman for first on the UNM career list. Here is the top 10:

**BULLPEN DOMINANCE** ... The UNM bullpen has been outstanding at protecting leads during the last several seasons. If UNM is leading after eight innings? Forget it. The Lobos haven't lost when leading after eight in 97 straight games, a streak that dates back to March 24, 2013.

**PLEASE, COME BACK SOON** ... UNM's sweep of San Jose State was the first home conference sweep of an opponent since last May, when UNM swept...San Jose State.

**THE MANGHATTAN PROJECT** ... It didn't take long for Lobo freshman Jared Mang to receive a nickname. Half a game, maybe? During UNM's opener on Feb. 19 at Hawai'i, TV broadcaster Sam Spangler, himself an Albuquerque native, coined the nickname "Manghattan Project" for the Los Alamos, N.M. native. Los Alamos of course was home of the laboratory for the Manhattan Project, and Mang, a two-time Gatorade State Player of the Year, has prodigious power. Mang lived up to the nickname in his first collegiate series by smashing two home runs against the Rainbow Warriors.

**HIT ME BABY ONE MORE TIME** ... Despite standing just 5-foot-8 and being the shortest player in each of his four years on the Lobos, Jared Holley has become a baseball magnet. He was hit once during UNM's series with San Jose State, which moved his career total to 32. That is the second most in UNM history, just six behind the leader, Joe Salas.

**LOBOS TABBED CO-FAVORITES BY MW COACHES** ... The University of New Mexico baseball team was picked as co-favorites in the Mountain West by the conference's coaches. The Lobos

where we're going," UNM head coach Ray Birmingham said. "In the end, though, it's meaningless. You still have to play the games."

Air Force and Fresno State finished tied for third with 24 points, and the Bulldogs received the final first-place vote. UNLV (15) was picked fifth, just ahead of last year's regular season champion, Nevada (14). San José State finished seventh with six points.

Collier is one of just three players to repeat on the Preseason All-Conference Team, joined by junior outfielder Tyler Jones of Air Force and junior utility player Trenton Brooks of Nevada. Collier, who was the MW 2014 Freshman of the Year and a First Team All-MW performer last season, is a career .349 hitter.

Stajduhar is one of just two sophomores on the preseason team. A 2015 Second Team All-MW player, he set a new UNM freshman record for RBIs with 53 on his way to a pair of Freshman All-America honors. He led the Lobos in hits (75), doubles (21), home runs (nine) and total bases (127). This year he has already been named a Preseason All-American by both College Sports Madness and Collegiate Baseball Newspaper.

Zoellner is UNM's leading returning hitter after posting a .352 average last season en route to Second Team All-MW honors. A career .330/.434/.492 hitter, he was also named to the Mountain West All-Tournament Team last year after hitting .450 (9-for-20) with nine runs, eight RBIs, four doubles and two home runs in the conference tournament in May.

**PRESEASON HONORS ...** Coming off a Freshman All-America season, sophomore infielder Carl Stajduhar has been named a Preseason All-American by both Louisville Slugger and College Sports Madness.

Junior left-hander Carson Schneider, meanwhile, was named the 260th best college prospect for the 2016 MLB Draft by D1Baseball.com.

**BIRMINGHAM ELECTED TO NM SPORTS HALL OF FAME ...** UNM head coach Ray Birmingham was elected to his third Hall of Fame this offseason when the New Mexico Sports Hall of Fame opened its doors for him. The official induction ceremony is April 3. He was previously elected to the NJCAA Hall of Fame in 2011 and the Lea County (N.M.) Hall of Fame in 2012.

**NEXT FRESHMAN UP ...** Five years running now the Lobos have produced a Freshman All-American, including a record three in 2015. It started with DJ Peterson and his NCAA-freshman record 32 doubles in 2011. Then Ryan Padilla hit .353 and helped UNM to Mountain West regular-season and tournament titles in 2012. In 2013 Sam Haggerty was honored after being named Co-MW Freshman of the Year and leading UNM with 49 walks. Last season Danny Collier followed in Haggerty's footsteps in earning MW Freshman of the Year honors and hitting .353 despite being limited by hamstring and heel problems. Last season Carl Stajduhar, Cory Voss and Tyler Stevens all earned the honor, with Stevens becoming the first pitcher in program history to be named a Freshman All-American.

So who's next up for the Lobos? UNM has several intriguing possibilities

including two-time New Mexico Gatorade High School Player of the Year Jared Mang. Austin Bell, Andrew Pratt and Austin Treadwell, each of whom hails from Albuquerque, should all receive ample playing time to make their case.

The opportunities will be there for all 12 of the Lobos' freshmen, and one thing is for sure: whoever is playing well will get his chance to be a Freshman All-American.

**LOBOS DRAFTED ...** The New Mexico baseball program has had 91 student-athletes in its history drafted by Major League Baseball including a school-record seven in the 2013 draft. DJ Peterson led the way by becoming the highest draft pick in school history when the Seattle Mariners selected him with the 12th overall pick. Sam Wolff (sixth round - Texas Rangers) and Mitch Garver (ninth round - Minnesota Twins) gave UNM a trio of picks in the first 10 rounds. Alex Allbritton (21st round - Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim), Will Mathis (25th round - Seattle Mariners), Jake McCasland (26th round - San Francisco Giants) and Josh Melendez (37th round - Houston Astros) completed the record-setting draft for UNM. Last season left-handed pitcher Toller Boardman and second baseman Sam Haggerty were selected in the MLB Draft.

During Birmingham's tenure at UNM, New Mexico has had 23 players drafted and 26 have played professional baseball.

**30-WIN SEASONS ...** The Lobos are averaging 34 wins per year in the eight years under Ray Birmingham. UNM only reached that number eight times before the Birmingham era. The Lobos' run from 2012-14 (three straight 37-win seasons) was the most wins UNM has recorded in a three-year period. In 2010, New Mexico had the third most wins in program history. The Lobos are currently in the midst of the most successful eight-year stretch in program history (272 wins).
