## Game Notes:

- Starters: Cherise Beynon, Tesha Buck, N'Dea Flye, Alex Lapeyrolerie, Jaisa Nunn
- The Lobos are coming off of the first loss of the season against Oklahoma. Previously, the Lobos were 11-0, tying an all-time win streak.
- This marks only the second time UNM and Lamar have met, with the last time Dec 3, 2010 where the Lobos beat the Cardinals 64-58.

## Game Notes:

- Leading scorer for the Lobos was Tesha Buck, who posted 40 points. This surpassed her previous season-high of 22 (versus W. Michigan, November 10).
  - This also surpasses a program record set by Jaisa Nunn (on Nov. 13, 2017 against Marquette).
- Going 10-for-16 from 3-point range, Buck surpasses the program for threes made (previous record was set by Miranda Sanchez on Feb. 12, 2000 against Air Force)
  - This also surpasses a Mountain West record for three-pointers made.
  - This also ties a record for most three-pointers attempted in a single game (last time was Amy Beggin on Nov. 28, 2008 against William and Mary).
- Jaisa Nunn had 17 rebounds, which was one rebound off her season and high (Nov. 25, 2017 against UC Irvine).
- Cherise Beynon earned her first double-double of the season with 11 points and 14 assists.
  - This is the first double-double of the season with points and assists.
    The last was Beynon on Dec. 6, 2016 with 11 points and 14 assists.
  - o This was one off of the program record for assists in a game.
- The Lobos outrebounded the Cardinals 49-46 for the game. This is the first time the Lobos have outrebounded their opponents since NMSU on Dec. 2, 2017.
- The Cardinals scored the same amount of points this game as they did the last time they met the Lobos (58).
