

### KICKING OFF

After a second lengthy stretch of road games, the University of New Mexico women's soccer team is back at home this coming weekend as they will play host to Nevada on Friday and UNLV on Sunday. The pair of games are a part of the second week of Mountain West play and the Lobos will enter with a 1-1-0 record in the MW after losing 1-0 in overtime to Colorado State and then shutting out Wyoming 3-0. They will also be just the third and fourth home games for the Lobos this season as seven of their first nine have been on the road.

The shutout of Wyoming was the Lobos' fourth of the season and the three goals tied a season-high set in the Lobos' last home game against Northern Arizona back on September 15.

Nevada enters the game on Friday at 2-7-0 overall and 1-1-0 in MW play. The Wolf Pack are looking to carry the momentum from their opening weekend of MW games as they dropped a one-goal game to league-leading Boise State and then bounced back for a double overtime win at home against Utah State this past Sunday.

Prior to playing the Lobos on Sunday, UNLV will take on San Diego State on Friday night. Heading into that matchup, the Rebels are 3-7-0 overall and 0-2-0 in MW play after being shutout in both of their league games last weekend. In fact, the shutout streak against UNLV stretches back three games. Perhaps an anomaly, but the Rebels have won each game that they have scored in and have been shutout in each defeat.

A pair of promos highlight the weekend as Friday night's game against Nevada is Pack the Pitch Night and all tickets will be just \$2! There will also be a post-game autograph session with 2019 commemorative schedule posters. On Sunday, the team will host AYSO Club Day.

# HEATHER DYCHE | @HEATHERDYCHE RECORD AT UNM: 49-33-9 (5TH SEASON) CAREER RECORD: SAME

### NOTEWORTHY :

- » Named the fourth head coach in program history on January 29, 2015
- » Ranks second in program history in wins with 49
- » Led team to consecutive Mountain West Tournament Championship Games

**HEATHER DYCHE** enters into her fifth season as the head women's soccer coach at The University of New Mexico.

The Albuquerque native owns a 44-29-9 overall record and a 26-14-4 mark in Mountain West play. This past season, Dyche guided the Lobos to a share of the program's third regular season title while also making a second-straight appearance in the MW Tournament Championship Game.

Additionally, Dyche's 2018 Lobo team set a program record for goals scored with 45 and posted second-best program marks in assists (33) and points (123). In terms of individual player accolades, three standouts received All-Pacific Region honors from the United Soccer Coaches, which was a program record. From the Mountain West, the 2018 team had five honorees, three of which were first team selections.

All told, Coach Dyche has coached 10 All-MW selections while at UNM. Success has also come

under Dyche's leadership in the classroom. In each semester since Dyche's arrival, the UNM women's soccer team has posted a team GPA of 3.46 or higher and three times have posted GPA's above 3.7. For three-straight years, the team has received the Team Academic Award from the United Soccer Coaches.

In her first season, Dyche became the third coach in Lobo women's soccer history to begin her career with double-digit victories by going 10-8-2 in 2015. That record included a 7-3-1 record in Mountain West play and a run to MW Tournament semifinals.

Along with leading the Lobos, Dyche traveled to Brazil to assist the U.S. Women's National Team during the 2016 Summer Olympic Games - assisting with scouting and analyzing opponents. She also served as an assistant coach for the U-18 U.S. Women's National Team's trip to Australia in the summer of 2017.

Dyche is also a coach, instructor and scout with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF). Dyche is an assistant coach for the US Youth National Team U14 and U15 Girls. There, Dyche is granted the opportunity to identify and work with the most talented U15 soccer players in the country and the core of the US team that competed in the 2018 FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup. She also serves on the USSF instructional staff, instructing USSF B- and USSF C-licensed national coaching schools across the country.

Dyche's footprint at the elite level spans past the national stage, as she has also assisted for national teams from Antigua, St. Kitts and Nevis and Grenada.

Dyche serves on the instructional staff for The Confederation of North, Central American and

Caribbean Association Football (CONCACAF). As the only female of the CONCACAF educational board, Dyche teaches C, D and grassroots courses in order while developing and writing content for all women's grassroots programs.

Dyche is a US Youth Region IV ODP head coach. There, she coaches the team at Olympic Development Interregional events and identifies top players in the region to participate in the Olympic Development Program Regional

Finally, she is also the co-founder and head coach of LEAD Academy (Leadership and Empowerment through Athletic Development Soccer) - an all-girls soccer leadership training school







located here in Albuquerque.

Dyche's New Mexico soccer roots are as extensive as her résumé is.

Prior to joining the University of New Mexico, Dyche was a presenter at the National Soccer Coaches Association of America/U.S. Youth National Conference in 2013 and at the U.S. Soccer National Symposium in 2011.

She has coached more than 60 players who have gone on to collegiate soccer programs. She has coached multiple state and regional champion club teams in New Mexico. Dyche was also the NMYSA Coach of the Year in 2008 with the Rio 95G Magic. Additionally, she served as the associate head coach and team captain of the now-defunct Albuquerque Asylum of the Women's Premier Soccer League from 2006-07.

Dyche is a 1997 graduate of Eldorado High School and was a four-year all-state defender, a two-time district Player of the Year and the 1996 Defensive Player of the Year. She also played basketball for the Eagles and was a first-team all-state performer 2 years.

Dyche accepted a soccer scholarship to the University of Nebraska out of high school and was

a participant on the No. 4-ranked women's soccer program in the nation.

Dyche then transferred to Florida State and played there from 1998-2001, serving as the team captain her senior year. The Seminoles participated in the NCAA Tournament in 2000 and 2001 and were ranked as high as No. 9 in the country during her time there. She was on the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) All-Tournament Team in 2001 and was an on the ACC Academic Honor Roll all four of her years there.

Dyche got her bachelor's degree in Family and Consumer Sciences, with an emphasis in Child Development, accumulating a 3.8 grade-point average. She then earned a master's degree in Athletic Administration, achieving a 3.84 grade-point average.

She went on to play with ROA Norway - a semiprofessional soccer team in 2004-05 - helping the squad win the Norwegian League Championship in '04.

Dyche holds an impressive list of licensing credentials. She earned a USSF National A License in 2010, a National Soccer Coaches Association of America Premier Diploma in 2013, a CONCACAF D License in 2013 and a U.S. Youth Soccer Association National Youth License in 2010.

### BALANCED SCORING

Last season, the Lobos set a new program record for goals with 45. An impressive note to that record was the fact that the team had 13 different goal scorers. This season, the Lobos have put forth another balanced scoring attack. With 11 goals to this point of the season, there have been six different goal scorers and five of those are tied for the team lead with two goals.

### **BETWEEN THE PIPES**

Going back to last season, the Lobos have had quality options of goalkeeper with **EMILY JOHNSON** and **MALIA UANISI** equally as capable. Last year, Johnson received a majority of the time in goal for the Lobos and started the first two games this season, which included an impressive 1-0 shutout of then-ranked No. 22 Texas Tech, but an injury has sidelined Johnson opening the door for Vanisi to step in.

In the seven games that Vanisi has played, she has allowed five goals and posted 27 saves while registering a trio of shutouts.

Combined, Johnson and Vanisi have turned in four clean sheets. Last season, the Lobos had just one defensive shutout.

### OFFENSE GAINING MOMENTUM

After scoring two goals through their first four games, the Lobos offense has began to pick up steam as they have scored nine goals over their last five games. The Lobos have won four of those five games.

#### ONE-GOAL DIFFERENCE

Thus far, seven of the nine games played by the Lobos this season have been one-goal games. In those games, the Lobos are 3-4. Last season, the Lobos played 12 one-goal games and posted a 7-5 record.

#### EJ NAMED MW DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior goalkeeper **EMILY JOHNSON** earned the first MW Defensive Player of the Week award for the 2019 season after she withstood an unrelenting offensive attack by the No.22-ranked Texas Tech Red Raiders for the entirety of the 90-minute match en route to a clean sheet.





In the first half, Johnson faced 10 shots and made three saves. In the second half, with the Lobos holding a 1-0 lead, Johnson was forced to face 12 shots and made four more saves. The individual shutout posted by Johnson was her eighth as the Lobo goalkeeper and the weekly conference plaudit was the second in her career as well.

### Knocking off nationally-ranked foe

Historically, the Lobos have played 33 matches against a ranked opponent coming into the 2019 season. All-time the Lobos' record vs. ranked opponents was 4-25-5. Coming off of their NCAA Second Round run a year ago, UNM's first opponent, the Texas Tech Red Raiders, were ranked No. 22 in the United Soccer Coaches Preseason Poll.

This year's meeting marked the fourth time that the Lobos would play the Red Raiders when they were ranked. In those games, the Lobos were 0-3-0, but a "1" was added to the win column for the Lobos after they pulled off a 1-0 upset win of the Red Raiders.

The win snapped what was a five-game losing streak to the Red Raiders and was the first win for the Lobos over a ranked opponent since 2010 when they beat No. 8-ranked BYU.

### GARCIA AND GAME-WINNERS

Sophomore forward **ALESIA GARCIA** wasted little time in establishing herself as one of the top scoring threats in the MW as she ranked in a tie for second with seven goals. While any goal is important, all but two of Garcia's were extremely important as they ended up being gamewinning goals. Her five game-winners as a freshman were tied for the second-most by a Lobo in a season and already place her in a tie for sixth on the career list.

Garcia has wasted no time in adding to her total as her penalty kick goal in the waining seconds of the first half against No. 22-ranked Texas Tech stood up as the gamewinner. Garcia, now with six career game-winners to her credit is tied for fifth all-time.
