NEW MEXICO NOTES

THE LAST TIME OUT

The Lobos are coming off a 2-1 loss at No. 19 Texas Tech in their season opener on Friday, Aug. 19, in Lubbock, Texas. The match was scoreless until the Red Raiders scored a pair of goals six minutes apart starting at the 58th minute to build a 2-0 advantage. UNM bounced back and cut its deficit to one when Maddie Irwin found the back of the net in the 69th minute, but the Lobos never found the equalizer and dropped their fourth straight to Texas Tech.

A MATCHUP 17 YEARS IN THE MAKING

It's been a long time since UNM and Cal faced one another in their one and only matchup. The Lobos dropped a 2-1 contest to the Golden Bears on Sept. 24, 1999, at a tournament in Greensboro, N.C. UNM fell behind 2-0 in the first half of that contest before Lara Melendres cut the lead to 2-1 with a goal for the Lobos in the 50th minute. However, the Lobos fell short and dropped to 3-5-1 on the year - a season in which UNM finished 6-13-1.

Meeting no. 2 between lobos and tigers

Like in its Friday matchup with Cal, UNM has faced Pacific only one other time in the program's history - but that contest was played much more recently. The Lobos fell to the Tigers 2-1 on Sept. 15, 2013, at the Saint Mary's Classic in Moraga, Calif. The Lobos took a 1-0 advantage in the first half of that contest when Madisyn Olguin scored on a corner from Alyssa Coonrod in the 15th minute before two goals by Pacific in the final 22 minutes handed UNM the heartbreaking loss.

LOBOS US. RANKED OPPONENTS

UNM has dropped 12 straight matchups against ranked opponents, last beating a ranked team Oct. 16, 2010, when the Lobos defeated No. 8 BYU 1-0 in double overtime in Albuquerque. The Lobos' last win over a ranked opponent on the road came at No. 6 BYU on Oct. 6, 2005 (1-0). Since 2005, UNM is 3-20-5 against ranked teams.

LOOKING BACK AT 2015

The 2015 Lobos under first-year coach Heather Dyche won 10 games for the second consecutive season, going 10-8-2 and reaching the Mountain West Tournament semifinals (falling in penalty kicks). Of those eight losses, five were by one goal. New Mexico went 7-3-1 in the Mountain West to finish third in the conference.

LOCAL TALENT A STRONG INFLUENCE ON 2016 ROSTER

The 2016 Lobos will have plenty of home-grown talent on the roster as 14 players are from New Mexico. Ten of those players are from the Albuquerque area while two are from Farmington and one each are from Carlsbad and Tucumcari. It's not only the players that have New Mexico ties as head coach Heather Dyche is an Albuquerque Eldorado High School graduate and assistant coach Paul Maestas is a Lobo grad and a former high school, state-title winning coach at Eldorado High School.

CHAVEZ NAMED 2015-16 LOBO CLUB STUDENT-ATHLETE OF YEAR

Defender Emily Chavez earned the prestigious honor of being named the Lobo Club Student-Athlete of the Year for 2015-16. Chavez, who earned All-Mountain West honorable mention and Mountain West All-Academic honors last season, became the third player in MW history to win both an offensive and defensive player of the week honors in her career. The junior from La Cueva High School in Albuquerque has started 38 games in her two-plus years for the Lobos and has three goals and three assists.

Another Stellar Year in the classroom

The University of New Mexico women's soccer program maintained a strong academic record during the 2015-16 school year, posting a spring GPA of 3.46. The program has posted an astounding 12 straight semesters of having a team GPA of 3.4 or higher. In the fall, the Lobos reached a GPA of 3.59. The high standard for the women's soccer program has been recognized over the years, with the 2015 season marking the 10th straight year in which the Lobos earned Academic All-District honors. In 2015, a pair of seniors, Cassie Ulrich from Rio Rancho, N.M. and Alyssa Coonrod from Albuquerque, N.M., were named to the 2015 CoSIDA/Academic All-District VII Team.

DYCHE ASSISTS U.S. SOCCER DURING OLYMPICS

Head coach Heather Dyche traveled to Brazil this summer to assist the U.S. Women's National team during the 2016 Summer Olympics. Dyche scouted and analyzed opponents for the USWNT. Dyche has a history of working with U.S. Soccer, helping with youth national teams, and is a national instructor on the U.S. Soccer educational staff.

unm racks up another double digit win season

For the sixth time in seven years, UNM put together a 10-plus win season in 2015 by going 10-8-2. Also for the 10th time in 11 seasons, the Lobos finished above .500 on the season. In Mountain West play, UNM has had eight consecutive .500-or-better seasons and own a 40-16-10 mark over that stretch (.681).

Lobos' muñoz plays for mexico u20 team

UNM sophomore Jennifer Muñoz spent this past summer trying out, making and eventually starting for Mexico's U20 Women's National Team. Muñoz started 19 games last season for the Lobos, tallying one assist in 1,566 minutes of play.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

The UNM Soccer Complex is a great home field advantage, and the records support that. New Mexico is 101-64-24 all-time in home matches, good for a .598 home winning percentage. A large factor is the Lobos' success at home is the dedicated crowds of Lobo fans at matches. New Mexico is the perennial leader in the Mountain West in attendance while consistently ranking in the top 25 nationally.
