- Coming off of its first conference series win of the 2017 campaign, the Nevada softball team will continue its road trip with a threegame stint in Albequerque, N.M.
- The three-game set against the New Mexico Lobos will take place April 7-9 and each game will be streamed on the Mountain West Network, free of charge.
- New Mexico enters the series in sole possession of second place in conference play, after notching off two wins against Colorado State this past weekend.
- Last year, the Wolf Pack won the season series, 2-1, and improved its all-time record against the Lobos to 11-3.

LAST TIME OUT

- Nevada won its first conference series of the season over Fresno State, 2-1. The series win also marked the first time the Pack has won a season series against the Bulldogs since 2014.
- In the Pack's two wins over the Bulldogs, Nevada combined to score 15 runs while connecting on 18 hits and batting .300 (18-for-60) in the process.
- Both of Nevada's wins came as a result of the Pack striking first, where the team is now 14-2 when scoring before its opponent.
- Over the course of the weekend, senior McKenna Isenberg struck out a total of 16 batters, including eight in Sunday's series-clinching win.

- New Mexico's offense boasts a .316 team batting average, which is led by Shelbie Franc, who leads the conference with a .476 average this season. She is followed by Jasmine Casados (.431), who ranks second in the MW with 44 hits on the year.
- In the circle, the Bulldogs are paced by a variety of players as three different pitchers have already made 14 or more appearances this season. Tess McPherson guides the pitching staff with an 8-6 record as Krissy Fortner has been a steady rock in the bullpen with her 2.90 ERA and 4-2 record.
- The Lobos are led by their head coach Erica Beach, who is in her seventh season at the helm of the program.

STATS OF THE WEEK

- Nevada is seeking to start its first 12 games of conference play with a .500 win percentage for the second
- season in a row.
 After starting her career batting .182 (2-for-11) in her first six appearances, freshmen **Kenzi** her past 22 games.

FANTASTIC FRESHMEN

- The Pack welcomes seven freshmen to its 2017 roster, including a pitcher, two catchers, three infielders and an outfielder, many of whom have already made important contributions to Nevada's season.
- Head coach Josh Taylor has shown his confidence in his newcomers as all seven freshmen have made an appearance in a game this season. In the Pack's first 33 games of the year, at least two freshmen have started for Nevada, including five freshmen against San Jose State (March 18).
- During a three week stretch from Feb. 24 March 12, the Pack's rookies collectively hit an astonishing .325 (52-for-160).
- With 31 career games already underneath her belt, **Kenzi Goins** is batting a teamhigh .333 on the season, leading the Pack with seven doubles and 31 hits. Goins is also tied for first on the Pack with nine multiple hit games this season and leads the team with a .357 batting average during conference play.
- Sierra Mello began her Wolf Pack career hitting safely in her first five games and holds a team-high streak of reaching base in 18 straight games. She also leads the Wolf Pack with 20 runs scored on the year and has drawn a team-high 13 walks.

LATE-INNING MAGIC

- Nevada has had a characteristic of scoring in the final inning of its games this season. The Pack has touched the plate in the final inning 14 times this year, five of which have resulted in wins.
- Against Binghamton (March 3), the Pack scored three runs in the bottom of the fifth inning to seal an 8-0 win over the Bearcats. Junior Aaliyah Gibson stepped up to the plate with the bases loaded and doubled in all three runners to cement the team's win.
- With the Pack trailing by as many as six runs, Nevada used a seven-run bottom of the seventh to storm back and take down No. 17 Utah (March 3), 7-6. The Wolf Pack slowly chipped away at the Utes' lead to set the table again for Gibson, who was credited with the game-winning RBI after drawing a bases loaded walk.
- In Nevada's matchup versus Iowa State (March 4), the Pack held a steady 3-1 lead for most of the game but used an explosive sixth inning to score six runs and beat the Cyclones, 9-1.
- Against Southern Utah (March 5), Nevada led for the first six innings but the Thunderbirds tied the game in the bottom of the sixth inning at three a piece. The Pack responded in the top of the seventh, with a run of its own and took home the victory, 4-3.
- Nevada won in walk off fashion again against Utah Valley (March 11) as the Pack trailed by three runs in the bottom of the seventh inning, before junior **Erika Hansen** hit a grand slam with two outs to give the Pack a 7-6 win over the Wolverines.

SETTING THE TONE EARLY

- The Pack has had a trend of jumping out to early leads, scoring in the first inning 11 times this season and holding an 9-2 record in such games.
- So far this season, Nevada has outscored its opponents in the first inning 23-18, with the latest coming against Fresno State (April 1), where the Pack score six runs in the opening frame.
- Scoring first has been an important characteristic of the Wolf Pack this year as Nevada is 14-2 on the season when it comes out with the first lead of its games.

HOLY HANSEN

- Entering the GCU Tournament (Feb. 24-26), junior Erika Hansen was batting just .250 on the season, but has raised her season average to .302 after hitting .319 since the beginning of that weekend. She enters this series against New Mexico ranking fifth the MW with 32 RBIs on the year.
- In the Pack's game against Rhode Island (Feb. 24), Hansen began the fourth inning with her first two-bagger of the season, sparking a seven-run inning for Nevada, in which she came around to record two doubles in the inning.
- Against Portland State (Feb. 25), Hansen connected on her first home run of the season, a three-run shot over the right-center field fence, to cap off a four-run first inning for Nevada.
- Against Utah Valley (March 11), Hansen launched a ball over the left field fence with the bases loaded and hit a grand slam to lead the Pack to a 7-6 victory of the Wolverines. It marked her second long ball of the game, the first being a solo shot that came in the sixth inning.
- Her home runs against Portland State, Iowa State (March 4), Utah Valley, San Jose State (March 19) and Utah State (March 25) marked a streak of five weekends in a row where she hit a home run.

McKKKKKKKKKKKKKKKENNA

- Senior McKenna Isenberg is making herself known as one of the most feared pitchers in the Mountain West as she ranks second in the conference with 122 strikeouts on the season.
- At the Red Desert Classic (March 3-5), Isenberg's performances earned her MW
 Pitcher of the Week honors for just the second time in her career. In the Pack's five
 games, she posted a 3-0 record with a 1.40 ERA and struck out 24 batters.
- Earlier in the year, she recorded what turned out to be a career-night against Southerneastern Louisiana (Feb. 11), where she posted a career-high 14 strikeouts in the Pack's 3-1 win over the Lions.
- Against San Jose State, Isenberg went head-to-head with one of the conference's best pitchers in Katelyn Lindford. The two split their battles against each other, where Isenberg notched off a win in the series finale to finish the weekend with a total of 12 strikeouts and just three earned runs.
- When matching up against one of the most prolific offenses in the MW, Isenberg struck out nine Aggies and allowed just five hits in the Nevada's first contest vs. Utah State (March 24).

KALI SWAG

- In her first appearance as a member of the Wolf Pack, sophomore **Kali Sargent** went the distance, pitching all eight innings in Nevada's first win of the season over Southern Illinois (Feb. 10), 3-2.
- Sargent followed that performance with another dominating outing against Nicholls State (Feb. 11), where she threw a complete game, 1-0, shutout, allowing just five hits and no walks in the process.
- Against BYU (Feb. 17), Sargent kept the Cougars scoreless through the first four innings, where she had allowed just two hits entering the fifth inning.
- In her last start again Fresno State (April 1), Sargent tossed her fourth complete game of the season, helping lead the Pack to an 8-4 win over the Bulldogs.

GREATNESS BEING RECOGNIZED

- As a team, Nevada collected a total of four preseason accolades, including a preseason All-American honoree.
- After conducting one of the greatest offensive seasons in Nevada history, junior Jennifer Purcell saw her name appear on three preseason lists from two different outlets.
- Fast Pitch News (FPN) gave her a 2017 Second Team All-American nod and named her one of the top 50 hitters in NCAA softball, entering this season. DI Softball News also named Purcell to its Player of the Year Watchlist.
- Junior **Aaliyah Gibson** joined Purcell as the only Pack players to receive preseason honors. FPN named Gibson as one of the top juniors to watch in 2017.

A PROMINENT RETURN

- Nevada returns all but two players from its powerful hitting lineup that boasted a .312 team batting average in 2016.
- Along with Purcell and Gibson, seniors Raquel "Rocky" Martinez and Melissa Arriaga will play an important role for the Pack as Martinez and Arriaga combined for 74 RBIs a year ago.
- After missing the entire 2016 season due to injury, redshirt sophomore Alyssa Mendez returns to the Pack, where she posted a .304 batting average in her rookie campaign.

QUICK FACTS

Josh Taylor enters his first season at the helm of Wolf Pack softball. After a brief two-month stint in charge of the softball program at the College of Southern Nevada, Taylor was named the head coach at Nevada in August 2016. He joins a softball program that he is very familiar with, as Taylor has been part of the Wolf Pack coaching staff

since the 2012 season.

HEAD COACH JOSH TAYLOR

Before accepting the position at the College of Southern Nevada, Taylor served as the assistant softball coach at Nevada for four seasons, where the team saw three winning seasons and over 100 wins. During his time under previous head coach Matt Meuchel, Taylor was responsible for all aspects of team and individual defense while also overseeing camps and clinics, recruiting visits and recruiting databases.

Last year with the Pack, Taylor helped lead the team to one of its most successful seasons since joining the Mountain West. The 32 wins Nevada collected marked a 19-win improvement from the 2015 campaign and earned Nevada a third place tie in the 2016 MW standings, which is the team's highest finish as a member of the conference.

In his first season leading the defense, the Wolf Pack set a school record with a .965 fielding percentage that also ranked second in the Mountain West. Nevada also committed just 52 errors as a team that season, the second-lowest total in the conference.

Prior to joining the Wolf Pack, Taylor served as the head coach at Feather River College in Quincy, Calif. Taylor, who was an assistant coach and recruiting cordinator for the Feather River baseball team in his first stint from 2004-07, led the Golden Eagle softball program to three-consecutive Super Regional appearances from 2010 to 2012. His overall record in his four years at Feather River was 113-59.

The 2012 season was highlighted by Taylor's third-consecutive 30-win season and his 10th playoff victory in the regional playoff. In 2011, Feather River reached its second-straight Super Regional in a season that also saw Taylor receive the Gatorade Coach of the Year award.

In 2010, Taylor was named Golden Valley Conference Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Eagles to their first GVC title since 2006. The Taylor-led offense topped the GVC in team batting average, runs, RBI, doubles and triples.

While at Feather River, Taylor oversaw all major aspects of the program including travel and budget, academic progress of student-athletes, recruiting efforts, facility and maintenance upkeep and weight training. Taylor also developed and implemented fundraising efforts for the program. Feather River also put Taylor to the task of serving as the fitness center director and an advisor for the Associated Students of Feather River College.

Taylor previously served as associate head coach for the Marysville Gold Sox, a collegiate summer league team, from 2008-11. On top of running all aspects of hitting and fielding instruction, Taylor coached multiple players who went on to earn Division I scholarships and two big leaguers in Cody Anderson and Max Stassi. Prior to joining the Gold Sox, Taylor spent a season as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator at San Joaquin College in Stockton, Calif. from 2007-08.

A former Wolf Pack baseball player, Taylor had an impressive

senior season in 1994 where he appeared in 41 games, starting in 25, hit .284 with a home run and 12 RBIss. That year, the Pack compiled a season record of 41-15 while going 16-5 in the Big West Conference, en route to capturing its first Division I conference championship and appearing in the program's first NCAA Regional.

Nevada was ranked as high as No. 6 in the nation that season and finished the season ranked No. 17. Taylor was inducted into the Nevada Athletics Hall of Fame in 2015 as part of the 1994 baseball squad.

Taylor and his wife, Michelle, have one daughter, Madyson.
