Post-Game

- Five Lobos scored in double digits including:
 - Makuach Maluach (16), Carlton Bragg (13), Zane Martin (13), Corey Manigault (13) and Keith McGee (11)
 - The last time the Lobos had five double-digit scorers was against Iona on Nov. 13, 2018.
- Redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle posted a near double-double with nine points and 11 assists.
 - Last time a Lobo registered 10+ assists was on Dec. 20, 2018 when Drue Drinnon tallied 12 against University of the Southwest. Prior to that it was former Lobo Antino Jackson on Feb. 10, 2018 at Air Force.
 - Last time a Lobo registered a double-double with points and assists was Antino Jackson on Feb. 10, 2018 at Air Force.
- Redshirt-junior Zane Martin scored 11 points while registering a team-high six defensive rebounds.
 - Two other Lobos also collected six boards including Bragg and Caldwell.
- Junior Makuach Maluach shot 5-for-7 from the field to lead UNM with 16 points.
- Redshirt-junior Keith McGee also went 5-for-7 from the field en route to his 13 points.
- The Lobos registered 22 assists to just 12 for the Greyhounds. The last time the Lobos posted 20 assists in a game was against Wyoming on Jan. 19, 2019 (20).
- The Lobos outscored ENMU in the paint (52-30), in fast-break points (31-17) and off the bench (42-36).
- UNM shot 60.0 percent (33-55) from the field compared to 37.3 percent (25-67) for ENMU.
