The Idaho State men's basketball team opens the 2016-17 season on Friday, November 11 at 8 p.m. at the University of New Mexico. The game will be heard live on 102.5 KMGJ with the pregame show starting at 7:30 p.m. Live stats and audio will also be available online at isubengals.com. The game will be televised on Root Sports.

ABOUT NEW MEXICO

New Mexico finished the 2015-16 season 17-15 and 10-8 in Mountain West play. Tim Williams returns to lead New Mexico. Last year he averaged 16.8 points and 7.4 rebounds. In a 113-57 exhibition win over Western New Mexico on Nov. 2 he had 13 points and five rebounds. In an 88-66 exhibition win over Eastern New Mexico, Williams had 20 points and 14 rebounds.

SERIES VS. NEW MEXICO

New Mexico leads the series 6-2. The Lobos have won the last five meetings with the most recent game being a 79-55 loss at New Mexico on Nov. 14, 2014. The Bengals lost 65-41 at UNM on Nov. 30, 2011. ISU's only two wins came in 1978 and 1966.

EXHIBITION WIN OVER SOUTHERN VIRGINIA

The Idaho State men's basketball team opened the 2016-17 season with an 89-55 exhibition victory over Southern Virginia on Wednesday night in Reed Gym.

Ethan Telfair and Geno Luzcando each had 20 points to lead the Bengals offensive attack. Luzcando was 7-9 from the field, had five rebounds, three assists and three steals. Telfair was 5-12 from the field with six assists and five steals.

Hayes Garrity had 12 points, Balint Mocsan nine, Stephen Lennox eight and Gary Chivichyan eight. Every Bengal that dressed saw action on the floor. Lennox and Novak Topalovic each had a team-best six rebounds.

Idaho State shot 45.5 percent from the floor while Southern Virginia shot 37.7 percent. The Bengals out rebounded Southern Virginia 40-38 and forced 22 turnovers while turning it over only nine times on their end.

Bill Evans FILE

Bill Evans was named the head coach of the Idaho State men's basketball program on March 8, 2012 and he quickly has put his stamp on the program on the court and academically. The 2015-16 Big Sky Conference and NABC All-District Coach of the Year guided the Bengals to a 16-15 record and a fourth place finish in the Big Sky.

The 16-15 record was the sixth best start since the 1976-77 season and the 11-7 conference record was the best winning percentage since the 2000-01 team finished 10-6.

Evans is only the fourth ISU coach to be named Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year. Evans coached a Bengal offense in 2015-16 that set a school record for 3-pointers made in a season and ISU had its first first-team all-conference player since 2008-09 in Ethan Telfair.

Evans has been one of the top defensive coaches in the game. Since being head coach in Pocatello, The Bengal defense has ranked in the top half of the league in scoring defense and over the last three seasons the ISU defense has ranked in the top half in field goal percentage defense.

In the 2012-13 season, the Bengals finished the year second overall in scoring defense, giving up only 64.3 points a game. That mark was the best by a Bengal team since before the shot clock era.

A year later, the Bengals held opponents to 69.4 points a game in Big Sky Conference games.

In the classroom, the Bengals recorded a perfect 1,000 APR for the 2012-13 school year along with a team GPA of 3.0 for 2014 spring semester. The Bengals boasted over a 3.0 GPA for the 2014-15 academic year.

In the last two years Evans has had eight student-athletes recognized by the NABC for academic excellence and the 2015-16 season saw a record six players earn Big Sky All-Academic honors. The team also received the team academic excellence award by the NABC for the 2014-15 season.

During Evans four years in Pocatello he has coached four all-conference players in Ethan Telfair, Chris Hansen, Geno Luzcando and Jeffrey Solarin. Hansen left ISU as the school's all-time leader for 3-pointers made and attempted. He also left ISU as the ninth leading scorer in program history. Solarin finished his career ranked in the Top 10 for total career rebounds.

Telfair put together one of the best single-seasons in Bengal history in 2015-16. He averaged 20.2 points overall and 23.9 in conference play. He also tallied 5.7 assists and 4.5 rebounds in league. For the year he made 205 free throws.

SCORING THREATS

This year's Bengal basketball team returns 75.6 percent of its scoring from the 2015-16 season. The team scored 2,297 points and 1,738 of those points return. Four starters return to the Bengal lineup. All four combined to average 48.2 points. Geno Luzcando scored 14.4 points, Gary Chivichyan scored 7.6 and Kyle Ingram six a game.

RECAPING 2015-16

Last year's ISU team finished 16-15 and 11-7 in Big Sky play. The .611 winning percentage in league was the best since the 2000-01 team finished 10-6 (.625). Bill Evans was named the Big Sky Conference Coach of the Year while Ethan Telfair earned first-team honors and the Big Sky Newcomer of the Year award. Idaho State was picked last in the league and finished fourth.
