SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos are 13-6 overall against the Utah State Aggies including a 7-2 record at home in WisePies Arena - The Pit. In the squads' history, the Lobos lost the first two matches (1975 and 1976) but went on a 10-win streak from Jan. 1977-Feb. 1987. The teams went 26 seasons before facing off again on Jan. 29 2014. Since the teams' reconnecting, the Lobos are 3-4 against the Aggies including a 2-1 record at home.

Last time the teams met resulted in a close home victory for the Lobos, 73-70 in The Pit on February 10, 2016. Last season, the teams split their meetings with UNM falling on the road in January, 72-59, before powering back for the win in Albuquerque a month later.

ABOUT THE MATCHUP

The Lobos are entering Wednesday night's game coming off of their first 2-0 start in Mountain West play since the 2008-09 season. UNM knocked off its last two opponents, Fresno State and San Diego State, by 26 and 43 points, respectively. The Lobos have won their last two games by a combined 69 points and currently rank in the top 10 in the nation in three categories.

The Aggies are coming off of a split Mountain West opening, falling at Boise State, 76-56, on Thursday before claiming their first win in four games against Air Force at home on Saturday, 65-62.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES**SCOUTING UTAH STATE**

The Aggies are looking for their second Mountain West victory of the season on Wednesday night after splitting their first two league contests. The Aggies' offense is led by sophomore Rachel Brewster who averages 12.3 points per game followed by freshman Shannon Dufficy (9.9 ppg) and freshman Eliza West (7.0 ppg). As a unit, the squad averages 61.6 points per game while limiting its opponents to 57.3 points per game.

Utah State's starting five includes three freshmen and two sophomores, ranking as the youngest starting lineup in the country. USU is one of just four NCAA teams that has three freshmen in its starting lineup including Air Force, Maine and UAB.

LAST TIME OUT

The Lobos are one of just three teams left undefeated in the Mountain West and have claimed their first two league wins by outstanding margins. UNM's last game against the visiting San Diego State Aztecs resulted in the Lobos' largest victory margin this season of 43 points.

Leading the way for the Lobos vs. SDSU was junior Cherise Beynon who scored a game-high 23 points as the only player on the floor to score over 15. She was just one rebound and two assists away from UNM's first triple-double since 1978. She was followed by freshman Mykiel Burleson and sophomore Jaisa Nunn who each posted 12 points to round out UNM's three double-digit scorers. Junior Jayda Bovero also had an outstanding game, posting eight points and grabbing nine boards nearly notching her first career double-double.

DUELING FRESHMEN

Lobo freshman Mykiel Burleson was named the 2016-17 Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year, but she will have some competition on Wednesday. Burleson currently boasts 9.8 points and 4.1 rebounds per game to go along with 11 steals and 28 assists on the season while Aggie freshman Shannon Dufficy is also having a standout freshman campaign averaging 9.9 points and 9.5 rebounds per game. The pair ranks among the top freshmen in the conference.

80+

Saturday night's game was the fourth time this season that the Lobos have broken the 80-point threshold and the second time in as many games. The first two times UNM passed 80 points were in the first two games of the season when the Lobos claimed an 83-56 win over Fairleigh Dickinson in the season opener and an 84-55 victory over New Mexico State. WisePies Arena - The Pit. Last season the Lobos went over 80 just twice including early wins over Sacramento State and Nicholls State in November.

THE LOBO BIG D

The Lobos continue to post strong defensive numbers this season, holding regular-season opponents to an average of 34.3 percent shooting from the floor. Not only can the Lobos stop the shot, UNM is also outrebounding its opponents 47.8-43.8. The Lobos are currently outscoring their opponents 70.9-62.1 points per game.

IT'S ALL ABOUT THE REBOUND

A key focus of Coach Bradbury's game plan is the ability to get the rebound, and it's clear why. UNM is 0-5 this season when they are outrebounded by their opponent. Conversely, the Lobos are 6-1 when they secure the most boards. So far this season, UNM has pulled in over 45 rebounds in nine of its 12 games - 57 vs. FDU, 57 vs. NMSU (11/15), 46 at Texas Tech, 57 vs. Tulsa, 47 vs. SMU, 47 vs. Minnesota, 46 vs. UTEP, 49 at Fresno State and 51 vs. SDSU.

LOBOS IN THE NATION

As a team, the Lobos currently rank **second** in the country in defensive rebounds per game (34) and **fourth** in rebounds per game (47.75). In addition, UNM is ranked **eighth** in the country in fewest fouls. Individually, junior **Cherise Beynon** ranks fourth in the nation in assists per game (7.5). Beynon also ranks 15th in total assists (90) while **Richelle van der Keijl** ranks 14th nationally in field goal percentage (61.6).

THE MOUNTAIN WEST STACK UP

The Lobos remain first in the league in four team categories including defensive rebounds per game, fewest fouls, personal fouls per game and rebounds per game. The squad is also second in assist/turnover ratio, fewest turnovers, defensive field goal percentage and rebounds.

Individually, three Lobos combine for 15 top-five con-

ference rankings to include four league leaders. **Cherise Beynon** is first in the Mountain West in assists per game (7.5) and three-pointers attempted, **Richelle van der Keijl** is first in field goal percentage (61.6) and redshirt-junior **Alex Lapeyrolerie** is first in three-point field goals per game (2.60).

ONE LAP DOWN

Speaking of Alex Lapeyrolerie, the Lobos' leading perimeter shooter (26 threes this season) will miss Wednesday's game due to injury sustained in UNM's win over San Diego State on New Year's Eve.

VAN DER KEIJL CONTINUES TO RACK EM UP

Senior **Richelle van der Keijl** is averaging 14.7 points per game and a team-high 9.8 rebounds per contest this season. She also leads the team in shooting percentage, 61.6. In eight of this season's 12 games, van der Keijl has registered double figures including 20-, 19-, 21-, 15-, 21-, 16-, 18- and 16-point games, respectively.

DOUBLE-FIGURE LOBO UPDATE

Four Lobos are averaging in double figures heading into Saturday's game including **Cherise Beynon** (15.4), **Richelle van der Keijl** (14.7), **Alex Lapeyrolerie** (11.9) and **Jaisa Nunn** (10.0).

MW PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Senior **Richelle van der Keijl** earned the Lobos' first Mountain West Player of the Week honor on Dec. 12 after her outstanding performances against Minnesota and UTEP. She averaged 17.0 points, 10.5 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game while shooting 53.3 percent from the field for the week. She also registered her third double-double of the season against UTEP when she scored 18 points and grabbed 12 rebounds while shooting 72.7 percent from the field.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

BEYNON RECORDS AND MILESTONES

Junior **Cherise Beynon** tied the all-time New Mexico record for assists in a single game with 15 on Nov. 15 against NM State. Beynon tied former Lobo player - and current Lobo administrator - Janice Ruggiero (Branch) who set the record on Jan. 23, 1987 against Adams State.

In the Lobos' contest vs. SMU at home on December 3, **Beynon** racked up an outstanding 32 points. Her 32 points ranks her fourth all-time in UNM history for points in a single game. The last time a Lobo scored 30 points was on Dec. 15, 2002 when Jordan Adams scored 30 vs. Memphis. Beynon is one of just four players in the Mountain West to score 30+ points this season.

REGULAR 20s

The Lobos have had at least one player rack up 20 points in nine of their first 12 games of the 2016-17 season. This season's Lobo 20-point club consists of, **Richelle van der Keijl**, **Alex Lapeyrolerie**, **Mykiel Burleson** and **Cherise Beynon**.

ABOUT THE 2016-17 LOBOS

The 2016-17 edition of the New Mexico women's basketball team is going to have a much different look as the Lobos are under new direction with new head coach Mike Bradbury. The Lobos will show off a new style of play, speeding the game up with the dribble drive and shooting those outside threes.

The Lobos return seven lettermen from last year's squad including First Team All-Mountain West selection Cherise Beynon and All-Freshman Team selection Jaisa Nunn. The Lobos will add in six new faces, including three freshmen and three transfers (only one transfer will play this season).

ADDITION BY ADDITION

The Lobos welcome in six new faces to the program -- all coming from experienced backgrounds of basketball. The

three freshman were rated as the top recruiting class in the Mountain West. Three transfers come in to the program. Only one will be eligible to play this season.

PRESEASON MOUNTAIN WEST HONORS

Junior **Cherise Beynon** was named to the 2016-17 Mountain West Preseason All-Conference Team following her stellar sophomore campaign while freshman **Mykiel Burleson** was named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year. As a team, the Lobos were selected to finish sixth in the league.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Two years ago, "The Pit" went underconstruction with the name of the arena. It is still identified as "The Pit" but has a few more letters added to it, as the name of the arena is now WisePies Arena aka The Pit. "The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years.

STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For six of the last eight seasons, and eight of the last 11 seasons, UNM has finished in the WBCA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

The Lobo women's basketball roster has a mixture of athletes from near and far on its 2016-17 roster. The Lobos have players from nine different states and one from another country. The Lobos are combined with players from Texas, Florida, Utah, Nevada, New Mexico, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Washington. The Lobos have one player from overseas in senior transfer Richelle van der Kiejl from The Netherlands.

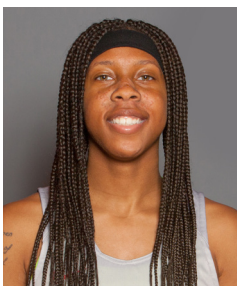
