THE OPENING TIP

Nicholls will hit the road for the first time in the 2015-16 campaign as they travel over 1,000 miles west to take on the New Mexico Lobos. The Colonels and Lobos have matched up two times previously, with New Mexico posting a 2-0 record over Nicholls. The last contest between Nicholls and New Mexico came in 2007 with the Lobos cruising to a 79-49 victory. The Colonels will be looking for their first road-opening win under head coach DoBee Plaisance, who is currently 0-7 in her first game on the road.

THE STARTING FIVE

- Last Time Out
 After a sloppy start which put Nicholls behind Prairie View A&M by 17 points in the first half, the Colonels stormed back to pull within two; however, an early 10-2 run in the fourth quarter helped hand Nicholls a rare loss in Stopher Gym as the Lady Panthers left with a 81-70 victory. Junior Hope Pawlowski scored a career-high 17 points for the second consecutive game for the Colonels, and senior Jovana Mandic chipped in with 13 points off the bench.
- Injuries Galore
 The Colonels had a bit of a new look in their first two games as four players who have been starters throughout their careers are sidelined due to injuries. Most notable is the absence of guard Emani White, who set the program's single-season scoring record in 2013-14 after averaging 19.6 points per game. Point guard Tia Charles, who earned honorable mention All-Southland as a freshman last season, has also missed the first two contests.
- Fresh Princesses of Stoph-Air
 With a significant amount of injuries hampering the Colonels' veterans, Nicholls has trotted out a total of six freshmen in their first two games at Stopher Gym. Logging starts as freshmen for DoBee Plaisance's squad have been guards Sammi Deakin-Sharpe, Cassidy Barrios and Airi Hamilton.
- Chasing History
 Head coach DoBee Plaisance has led her teams to nearly every single program record since she arrived in Thibodaux in 2008, and she's nearing a personal mark as she is seven victories from becoming the program's all-time leader in wins. Ben Abadie currently holds the record with 89 career victories.
- 3-Point Streak
 Nicholls has made at least one 3-pointer in 194 consecutive games, dating back to the 2008-09 season. The last time the Colonels failed to make one from downtown was on Valentine's Day in 2009 at Southeastern Louisiana where Nicholls was 0-for-8 behind the arc.

ALBUQUERQUE, NM - The Colonels went into the locker room at halftime only down five points, but the Lobos went on a 28-0 run in the second half to defeat Nicholls, 79-49.

The Colonels (1-2) lost their second straight game away from Stopher Gym as true freshman Shelly West was the only Nicholls player to score in double digits in the loss with 10. West also had a game high tie in rebounds with nine and was perfect from the free throw line by going 4-of-4.

As a team, Nicholls shot 26.8 percent (15-of-56) from the floor, and 26.1 percent (6-of-23) from three-point range. Three of the six three pointers that the Colonels made came from senior Kelli Johnson. New Mexico (4-1) out shot the Colonels from field goal range with a 51.9 percent (28-of-54) mark, and from three point land with a 53.8 percentage (7-of-13).

However, Nicholls did have a better percentage at the free throw line, 86.7 to 84.2, but only took 15 trips to the Lobos 19.

Rough Road

While Coach Plaisance is searching for her first career road-opening win since coming to Nicholls, no one can be too critical of her drought considering the opposition. The Colonels' last five opponents to open the road slate have been Ole Miss', Alabama, No. 25 DePaul, No. 9 Baylor and Arkansas.

Glimmer of Hope

Primarily a high-energy defender in her first two seasons, junior guard Hope Pawlowski has taken charge on the offensive end by netting back-to-back 17 point games to start the season. Pawlowski, who had 6 career 3-pointers heading into this campaign, has already knocked down four, which included a 3 for 3 day in the opener.

Yo

After seeing limited minutes as a junior, 6-foot-4 Jovana Mandic has made her presence known in the first two games as she's averaging 12 points on 9 of 15 from the field, and 5.5 rebounds in under 20 minutes per game. Mandic has also proved to be an asset at the free throw line, knocking down 71 percent at the line for her career (17-24)

The Heist

For the third straight season, Nicholls led the Southland in steals, averaging 11.4 per contest, which ranked 9th in the NCAA. Tia Charles was 55th in the NCAA with 2.4 steals, Hope Pawlowski averaged 2.1. After two games, Nicholls is averaging 16 steals, led by Pawlowski's nine total.

Putting The D In Thibodaux

The main reason for the Colonels' recent success has been their dedication to playing defense. During last season's seven-game winning streak, Nicholls held opponents to less than 60 points five times, and three of those games included 40 or less points. In their win over Northwestern State, the Colonels limited the visitors to 26 percent shooting and 1 of 16 from behind the arc.

Steady Progress

DoBee Plaisance has completely turned around the program since taking over in 2008 with the Colonels' win total increasing each season to 2013, which started a string of three consecutive winning campaigns. Coach Plaisance had a pattern in her first four seasons as Nicholls basically doubled its win total each year, going from two, to four, to eight, to 15. The 15 wins in 2011-12 was the program record before 2012-13 season's 19 set the new mark.

Stop-Her Gym

Nicholls has been stellar at home over the past few seasons, posting a 31-7 record at Stopher Gym. Nicholls went 11-2 in front of its home crowd in 2013-14 after posting a 9-2 record in 2012-13. In 12 home games last year, Nicholls finished at 10-2.

DoBee Plaisance is in her eighth season as head coach for the Nicholls State University women's basketball program, and is the ninth head coach in the school's history. She came to Nicholls after 13 seasons at Loyola University New Orleans where she successfully built a dominant NAIA program.

Since arriving, Plaisance has guided Nicholls to uncharted territory, leading the Colonels to three consecutive winning seasons for the first time in program history, as well as a program-record fourth consecutive appearance in the Southland Conference Tournament. In the last four campaigns, Plaisance has led Nicholls to an astonishing 68 victories, including two wins in the

postseason.

Nicholls finished last season with a 17-13 overall record and a program-best 13 wins in the Southland to claim a three-seed, which was the Colonels' highest seeding ever. Plaisance's hard work and dedication did not go unnoticed as she took home two coaching awards in 2015. Plaisance was named Southland Conference Women's Basketball co-Head Coach of the Year, becoming only the second coach in program history to earn the award, and went on to the garner Louisiana Sports Writers Association (LSWA) Women's Basketball Head Coach of the Year. It marked the third season in her career as a collegiate head coach where she has been named coach of the year.

In seven seasons, Plaisance has an 82-124 record and ranks second on the Colonels' all-time coaching victories list, trailing Ben Abadie's 89. After winning two games in her first campaign, Plaisance doubled her wins in the next two seasons. In 2011-12, she nearly completed the feat for a third time as Nicholls won 15 games. That year was the first of four consecutive seasons with at least 15 wins as she followed up with a program-record 19 wins in 2012-13. Before Plaisance arrived to Thibodaux, the Colonels had never won 15 games in a season, nor had they had three consecutive campaigns with double-digit victories.

In 2013-14, Plaisance coached the program's first-ever All-Southland First Team honoree, sophomore and New Orleans native Emani White. The Colonels also landed a player on second team, giving Plaisance two All-Southland honorees for the third straight year, another program record.

Last season, senior guard Jenny Nash made the All-Southland Second Team and went on to cap her remarkable academic career by being named Southland Conference Women's Basketball Student-Athlete of the Year. Nash also received first-team academic honors for the third time in her career and was placed on the Capital One Academic All-District team for the second time.

In Plaisance's first season at Nicholls, the Colonels suffered through a number of growing pains, winning only two games. But over the next two seasons, Plaisance doubled her victories, claiming four wins in her second year, and eight in her fourth. She has since followed up with 15-, 19- and two 17-win campaigns.

Along with her own success, Plaisance has also guided her players to numerous individual accolades. Since the start of her tenure, Nicholls has had nine All-Southland selections, which doubles the amount the program had in the previous 17 seasons.

At Loyola, after the arrival of scholarships in 2004, Plaisance posted an impressive 81-33 record that included back-to-back Gulf Coast Athletic Conference (GCAC) Regular Season Championships in 2006-07 and 2007-08.

Her 2006-07 squad finished 25-9, while her 2007-08 team notched a school best 28-7 mark, resulting in Plaisance winning consecutive GCAC Coach of the Year honors. In the 2007-08 season, she led the Wolfpack to the Elite Eight of the NAIA Women's Basketball National Championship Tournament.

The appearance in the Elite 8 was the furthest that Loyola has ever advanced in the NAIA National Tournament in the program's history. Loyola also eclipsed program records for wins and highest ranking as the Wolfpack won 28 games and were ranked 15th in the final NAIA poll. As the pioneer for the Wolfpack program, Plaisance was inducted into the Loyola Athletics Hall of Fame in January of 2015.

Plaisance, a New Orleans native, was a four-year starter throughout her college career, playing two years at the University of New Orleans and two years at Southeastern Louisiana University.

She later graduated from the University of Southern Mississippi and worked as a student assistant coach for the Lady Eagles. Following her stint with Southern Miss, she joined the Tulane University staff as assistant coach where she spent three seasons.

Plaisance landed her first job as head coach at St. Martin Episcopal High School in Metairie, La. In seven of her eight years at St. Martin's, Plaisance successfully guided her squad to the state playoffs before capturing back-to-back state championships in 1993 and 1994. Her teams compiled a 70-4 record over that span that included a perfect 36-0 mark in 1993. In 2015, Plaisance was enshired into St. Martin's Hall of Fame for her outstanding coaching career.

Mary 'DoBee' Ronquillo Plaisance is married to Scott Plaisance and the couple has two children - Theresa and Scott Jr.

The oldest, Theresa, was a standout player at Louisiana State where she garnered All-SEC honors as well as WBCA All-America Honorable Mention. Following her career at LSU, she was drafted 27th overall in the 2014 WNBA Draft by the Tulsa Shock. For the offseason, Theresa plays overseas in Turkey for Botasspor Adana. Plaisance also gained international experience by making the USA Basketball U18 Women's National Team and then helped the squad earn a gold medal at the FIBA Americas 18 Championship in the summer of 2010.

Scott Jr. is in his second season as a member of the Louisiana-Lafayette basketball team. Before joining ULL, he led Country Day to back-to-back 1A state championships. Along with being named First Team All-State in his last two seasons, he was named Louisiana Class 1A Player of the Year as a junior.


