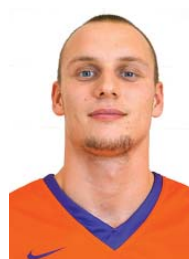

All scheduled interviews will take place in the arena prior to practice. Please see the schedule in game notes for a full schedule of that week. Please contact Bob Pristash on the day of your scheduled interview to confirm location. With schedules at the Ford Center possibly changing last minute, we want to make sure you end up at the correct place. There will also be no availability on game day prior to the contest and on scheduled off days.

Photographers (including TV and other video) are permitted to shoot during the first 10 minutes of practice. All photographers must notify Pristash in advance in order to attend practice. Coach Simmons and selected players will be available following each home game in the media room of the Ford Center following a ten-minute cooling off period. Quotes from road games will be included in the post-game release.

The Opening Tip

- Standing at 5-1 following a successful trip to the Cancun Challenge, the University of Evansville men's basketball team heads to New Mexico for a match-up against the Lobos on Wednesday evening
- UE has started the season with a 5-1 mark for the fourth time in five years
- Ryan Taylor and Blake Simons each earned spots on the Cancun Challenge All-Tournament Team
- It was announced on Monday that Taylor would be sidelined for the next six weeks after suffering a fractured foot against Fresno State

How about that D!

- Fresno State entered last Tuesday's contest averaging 86.7 points per game while shooting 53.5% from the field; Evansville held them to 57 points, 29 under their average, and just 38.6% shooting
- Louisiana Tech went into the Nov. 22 contest posting 89 points per game while shooting 50% and the UE defense was at it again, holding them to just 63 points on 37.7% shooting
- For the season, the Aces allow just 58.2 points per game, a tally that ranks 10th in the country

He is Automatic

- In the win over Fresno State, Ryan Taylor scored 21 points and hit the game-winner before totaling 11 against Louisiana Tech
- Taylor suffered a fractured foot in the opener against Fresno and could miss up to six weeks of play
- With 21.3 points per game, Taylor is third in the MVC and 36th in the country
- He connected on seven 3-pointers against Binghamton, the most for a UE player since Colt Ryan had 8 triples against Bradley in 2012
- Taylor hit all six free throw attempts against the Redhawks and is shooting 88.0% (22/25) from the line this season
- Last year, Taylor got to the line 92 times in 33 games
- Taylor had six 20-point games last season and already has four in six games this year

- Wednesday's game will mark the sixth for UE in the MVC/Mountain West Challenge
- Evansville is 2-3 in the series, but has won the last two games

- Evansville has enjoyed nice early season success and is currently 5-1 for the fourth time in five years
- Between 1999 and 2012, the team has just two 5-1 starts in 14 seasons

A Helping Hand

- In a 3-game stretch entering the trip to Cancun, Dru Smith dished out a total of 29 assists
- His average of 6.0 leads the MVC and is 26th in the nation
- He is also shooting a slick 62.9% through the opening six outings
- Smith has tallied double figures in four games this season after doing so just four times in his whole freshman campaign
- In the win over SEMO, Smith had a season-high 17 points on 5-of-6 shooting; it was just two points shy of his career mark of 19 points, set last season at Wichita State
- As a freshman, Smith averaged 5.3 points per game, but has upped that to 11.2 through the first six games of the season
- Last season, Smith had an impressive assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.45 and has picked right up where he left off in 2017-18, notching 36 assists against just 17 turnovers

Getting it done

- Dainius Chatkevicius averaged 7.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in the two games played in Mexico
- After registering four points and seven rebounds against Fresno State, Chavkevicius had 10 points, all in the second half, against La. Tech while grabbing 8 boards
- In his first contest at Evansville, Chatkevicius posted 10 points, 6 rebounds and 3 blocks; his block total led the team

It's Over!

- Entering Tuesday's game against Fresno State, the Aces lost 14 in a row when failing to score 60 points
- That all changed as the squad hung on for a 59-57 win
- Prior to the win, the last time the team won when failing to reach that mark came at Missouri State, a 56-54 win, in January of 2015
- Another streak also came to an end for the Aces; prior to the triumph over the Bulldogs, the Aces lost 12 in a row when failing to record 10 or more assists
- UE had just eight helpers against FSU; the last time prior to that UE won without reaching double digits in that stat was on 1/1/15 versus UNI when Evansville was credited with eight assists

Traveling Abroad

- UE's trip to the Cancun Challenge marked the first trip outside of the United States since December of 2000 when the team played in the San Juan Shootout
- That year, the Aces beat Puerto Rico Mayaguez before falling to Northwestern
- Evansville also played in the San Juan Shootout in 1997

Taking Advantage

- Part of UE's start to the season has been its solid performance from the line
- The Aces are hitting 77.5% of their free throws, second in the Missouri Valley Conference
- By comparison, Evansville's opponents have hit just 59.5% of their attempts

Home Streak

- Evansville has won 25 non-conference home games in a row, dating back to December of 2014 and includes a 3-0 mark in the 2015 CollegeInsider.com Tournament
- That streak is the longest for any current Missouri Valley Conference team

Better than ever?

- It has been an impressive return to the floor for Blake Simmons after missing last season due to injury
- Simmons has played an average of 35.8 minutes per game while chipping in 9.5 points
- He scored a season-high 15 points against Louisiana Tech and has connected on 13 3-pointers this season
- The sharpshooter has connected on at least three triples in four out of six games
- Simmons is tied for 6th in the MVC in 3-point percentage and seventh in 3-point makes
- Over the first six games, Simmons is 13-of-26 (50.0%) from long range and just 7-21 from inside the arc

Marty's Milestone

- The November 13 contest against the Eagles marked the 500th in the head coaching career of Marty Simmons

One More Year

- Duane Gibson is back for his 5th season at UE and had an efficient 6 points and 3 assists against Arkansas State
- Gibson had an efficient 10 points in 33 minutes of action against NCCU
- Going back to last season, Gibson has recorded double figures in 5 of the last 14 games; he hit 10 or more points in just 17 of his first 93 contests with the Aces
- He led UE in 2016-17 with 114 assists

In the Lineup

- Dalen Traore has made the start at center in each game thus far and has gotten better each time out
- Against NCCU, Traore finished with 8 points and 7 rebounds while being on the floor for 24 minutes
- Traore is a solid 9-10 from the free throw line on the season

Triples

- UE has attempted at least 12 3-pointers in all six games this year
- Last year, UE took 12 or more 3-pointers in just 13 out of 33 games

Another W

- In front of 6,048 fans on Nov. 13 at the Ford Center, the Aces took down North Carolina Central by a final of 68-55
- UE's defense made the difference, forcing 26 turnovers and turning them into 26 points
- Evansville had at least three players hit double digits in scoring for the second game in a row

Evansville's Opener

- Taking on a 20-win team from a year ago, the Aces led by as many as 26 points against Arkansas State before winning by a final of 77-63
- Four Aces hit double figures, a feat the team accomplished eight times last season
- UE registered nine steals in the game, a number they hit in 2016-17 just five times

What a Debut

- Sophomore K.J. Riley made an immediate impact with UE in his first game, playing 16 minutes while getting to the line seven times, hitting six of those attempts
- Riley finished with 10 points in the game; it was the top total for a UE player in their debut since Mislav Brzoja had 21 against Earlham in first game in an Aces uniform
- He has hit 14 out of 17 free throw tries (82.4%) this season

- The Aces are 66-33 in their first 99 season openers and have won four of their last five following the win over Arkansas State

Veteran's Day

- Air Force veteran Solomon Hainna is in his second season with the Aces and each season-opener has seen him play around Veteran's Day
- He impressed in the 2017 opener, scoring five points and hauling in four boards
- Hainna went 7-10 from the free throw line in the Nov. 16 win over SEMO

The 2017-18 Season

- Ryan Taylor, a 2-time MVC New-comer of the Week in 2016-17 is the top returning scorer. Taylor was seventh in the MVC last season with 14.1 points per game. Against Norfolk State last season, he set his career mark with 38 points. Taylor was a Preseason All-Conference Second Team player.

- Dru Smith earned a nod on the All-Freshman Team in 2017. Smith played in 28 games and made eight starts for UE. He had a stellar effort at Wichita State, posting 19 points while draining five 3-pointers.

- After missing last season due to a knee injury, Blake Simmons makes his return to the squad. A redshirt senior, Simmons has started all 103 games that he has participated in at the collegiate level. For his career, Simmons has averaged 7.4 points per contest.

- Fellow redshirt senior Duane Gibson brings a wealth of experience. As a junior in 2016-17, Gibson notched 7.1 PPG while dishing out a team-high 114 assists. His 3.8 assists per game was 5th in the MVC and he is the top returner in the league in that statistic.

- Senior Dalen Traore will get extended time at the center position. Playing in 21 games in his first season with the Aces, Traore notched 2.3 points and 2.7 rebounds per contest. Traore missed the majority of February due to injury.

The New Guys in Town

1-Marty Hill-JR-G-Brooklyn Park, Minn.

- Heads to Evansville from Northeast Community College in Nebraska and is a native of Champlin, MN where he played at Champlin Park High School...last season at Northeast CC, scored 14.8 points per game while recording 4.0 rebounds and 1.7 assists...brings a solid shot from outside, shooting 42.7% from 3-point range.

10-Evan Kuhlman-FR-F-Liberty Twp, Ohio

- Makes his way to Evansville from Ohio where he played for Lakota East High School...finished senior season with 16.0 points and 6.6 rebounds per game...posted 12.2 points and 5.3 rebounds per contest in his junior campaign... has nice touch from outside for a forward, knocking down 34 triples as a junior and 41 as a senior.

14-Dainius Chatkevicius-JR-F-Klaipeda, Lith.

- Chatkevicius spent the last two seasons playing at Vincennes University, helping the Trailblazers to a 58-11 record, including a 32-3 mark last season...set his career mark with 13 caroms in a win over John A. Logan on February 13 of this year... Vincennes advanced to the final eight in the NJCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament, falling by just two points in the quarterfinals to South Plains....prior to his time at Vincennes, he played at the prestigious West Oaks Academy in Orlando, Florida.

2018 Jersey Retirement

On November 7, 2017, it was announced that the jerseys of eight of the all-time greats from the Purple Aces program would be retired. The list includes six players and two head coaches. Below is a capsule on each one who will be recognized. A celebration of the group will take place on Saturday, January 27, 2018 when the men's basketball team faces Drake.



AHLERING

#20 Hugh Ahlering

Hugh Ahlering played at UE from 1957-59. A 1973 UE Hall of Fame inductee, Ahlering was a 1959 First Team AP All-American. Ahlering was a pivotal member of UE's first national championship team, averaging 15.3 points per game.



ELKINS

#31 Andy Elkins

The #6 scoring in Purple Aces history (1,761 points), Andy Elkins led UE to two NCAA Tournaments and one NIT in four seasons. Elkins, a native of Evansville, was a 1st Team MCC player in 1994 before earning the accolade from the Missouri Valley Conference in 1995.



LEAF

#15 Brad Leaf

Brad Leaf lettered at UE from 1979 through 1982 and played an instrumental role in 1981-82, scoring 17.6 points per game in leading UE to its first Division I tournament. Leaf is 8th in UE history with 1,605 points and was a 3-time All-MCC First Teamer.



WILSON

#5 Marcus Wilson

Marcus Wilson was the 1999 Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Year and led UE to the regular season league championship that year and an NCAA Tournament berth. A member of the MVC All-Centennial Team that was announced in 2007, Wilson ranks 4th on the UE list with 2,053 career points.



SIMMONS

#50 Marty Simmons

In just two years, Marty Simmons put his imprint on the Aces program. Scoring 1,265 points, Simmons finished the 1987-88 season 6th in the nation with 25.9 PPG while finishing 9th in AP Player of the Year voting. Simmons led UE to a 21-8 mark as a senior including an NIT win over Utah, the Aces first Division I postseason win.



Coach Arad McCutchan

Arad McCutchan served as the UE head coach from 1946 until 1977 and led the Purple Aces to five National Championships. He was enshrined into the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame in 1973 before earning the nod from the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1981. McCutchan was a 2-time NCAA College Division Coach of the Year.



SHREFFLER

#20 Scott Shreffler

Scott Shreffler was the glue on a team that advanced to three NCAA Tournaments in his four years as a starter. Shreffler remains second in UE history with 521 assists and is 13th on the scoring list with 1,454 in his career. He is the only player in the Aces' Division I history to make three NCAA Tournaments.



Coach Jim Crews

Jim Crews coached the Purple Aces for 17 seasons (1985-2002) and won a total of 294 games. He led Evansville to four NCAA Tournament appearances and a pair of NIT berths. Crews was a 4-time conference Coach of the Year, winning it three times in the MCC and once in the Missouri Valley Conference - that coming in 1999. UE was .500 or better in 13 of his 17 seasons at the helm.

The Ford Center

In the fall of 2011, the Ford Center opened as the new home of the University of Evansville men's basketball team. The Aces made the move to the brand new downtown venue after playing at Roberts Stadium for 55 years.

Construction of the \$127.5 million arena began in 2010. In August of 2011, Tri-State Ford Dealers acquired the naming rights to the 290,000 square foot facility, dubbing it the Ford Center.

Located on the corner of Main Street and MLK Jr. Boulevard, the Ford Center seats around 10,000 and is fully accessible to wheelchairs and patrons with limited mobility. In addition to cushioned chair backs, the Ford Center features numerous amenities, including six concession stands and one bar, 18 restrooms, and 178 televisions on and around the concourse level.

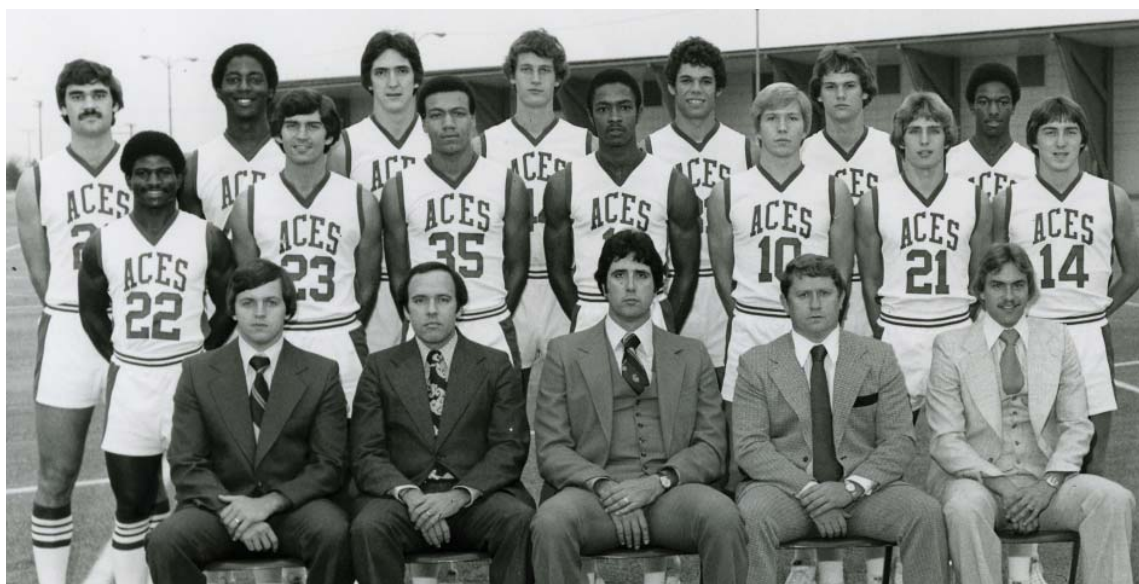

Nobody personifies just what it means to be a Purple Ace more than head coach Marty Simmons. One of the top players in program history enters his 11th season at the helm of his alma mater.

He did an admirable job in the 2016-17 campaign. Directing a team that lost the all-time leading scorer and rebounder in program history, the Purple Aces finished the season winning six of their final nine games to finish the year at 16-17.

That came a season after Simmons led the Purple Aces to a 25-9 mark and its second berth in the Missouri Valley Conference Championship game. UE finished second in the MVC in the regular season. During the 2015-16 season, D.J. Balentine became the program's all-time leading scorer, finishing his career with 2,464 points. Egidijus Mockevicius finished his time at UE with the most rebounds in Aces history.

In 2015, Simmons coached the Aces to a record of 24-12 and the CIT Championship. Evansville went 5-0 in the tournament en route to the championship. The record was the best for the program since the 1991-92 season. For the first time since joining the Missouri Valley Conference, the team had two players on the All-MVC First Team as D.J. Balentine and Egidijus Mockevicius garnered the accolade. With a win over #23 Northern Iowa on January 1, 2015, Simmons earned his fifth triumph over a ranked opponent.

The 2012-13 season brought about milestones that had not been achieved in over a decade as University of Evansville men's basketball coach Marty Simmons led his Purple Aces to a 21-15 record. That mark included a 3-1 record in the CollegiateInsider.com Tournament as the Aces won more postseason games in a season since taking home the 1971 National Championship. A banner season saw Colt Ryan break the UE career scoring mark with 2,279 points (6th in MVC history), Troy Taylor record the second triple-double in program history, another top four seed for the MVC Tournament and a sweep of eventual Final Four participant Wichita State. Simmons has led the Aces to the postseason in five of the last seven years while going .500 or better in five out of those seasons; he helped UE to its best two MVC records (2012 and 2013) since the 1999 championship and has led the Purple Aces to three victories over ranked opponents, including a 2012 victory over No. 15 and eventual MVC champion Creighton at the Ford Center.

Prior to that, the 2011-12 season was full of memories as Simmons squad advanced to the postseason for the third time in four seasons, facing Princeton in the CBI. The Aces finished in third place in the Valley, their top finish since 1999 and picked up victories over defending national runner-up Butler in the season opener before downing Creighton, who was ranked 15th in the nation at the time.

Prior to his return to Evansville in 2007, Simmons served as head coach for five years at Division II Southern Illinois University-Edwardsville, where he took over a program that had not won 10 games since 1999 and led the Cougars to 23 wins in 2005 and 25 in 2006. SIUE reached the NCAA Tournament in 2005 for the first time in 15 years, and Simmons was chosen as Great Lakes Valley Coach of the Year. His 2006 squad did even better, winning three games in the NCAA Division II Great Lakes Regional Championships and advancing to the Elite Eight. SIUE appeared in the national rankings 16 weeks.

A native of Lawrenceville, Ill., Simmons led Lawrenceville High School to back to back Class A state championships and became one of the most celebrated players in Illinois prep history. Affectionately known as 'Mule,' his 2,986 career points were the third most in Illinois history when he graduated in 1983. Simmons played at Lawrenceville for Ron Felling, who went on to become an assistant coach at Indiana University. Simmons immediately helped turn around the UE program when he became eligible in 1986-87. He averaged 22.4 points as a junior and led Evansville to a first place tie in the Midwestern Collegiate Conference. As a senior, he finished sixth in the nation in scoring at 25.9, and finished ninth in balloting for the Associated Press College Basketball Player of the Year. He led the Aces to a 21-8 record in 1988 and a first-round win over Utah in the NIT. It was Evansville's first post-season appearance since 1982, and UE's first post-season win at the Division I level. A first team all-MCC player in both of his seasons at UE, Simmons scored 750 points as a senior, the fourth most in school history.

Marty and his wife, Angie, who grew up in nearby Newburgh, have four children: Brittany, Kelsey, Blake, and Cole.
