

## **Post-Game Notes: UNM 90 vs. Texas Tech 56**

### **Match-Up Notes:**

- Starting Line-Up: Cherise Beynon, Tesha Buck, N'Dea Flye, Alex Lapeyrolerie, Jaisa Nunn
- Lobos are 10-0, the best start in program history
- The Lobos are now 4-15 all-time against Texas Tech, including a loss of 69-58 last season at the Red Raiders home turf in Lubbock, Texas. This is the first time the Red Raiders have played in Albuquerque since November 2012.
- Attendance: 5,663

### **In-Game Notes:**

- Lobos shot 37.2% FG in the first half and improved their shot percentage by 43.4% for the entire game.
- Lobos led a 13-0 run for 2:37 in the second quarter
- Jaisa Nunn earned her sixth double-double of the season with 15 points and 10 rebounds
- Lobos finished the night with 7 turnovers which is their sixth single-digit turnover game for the season.
- Best season start in program history (10-0)
- For the season, this is the fewest free throws the Lobos have allowed
- 7<sup>th</sup> time that the opposing team shot less than 40% from field goal range
- In the second half, Lobos went 15-for-16 on free throws, which is their second-best free throw percentage of the season
- UNM scored 28 points off turnovers in comparison to Texas Tech's 2 points
- Lobos increased points every quarter (14 in 1<sup>st</sup>, 23 in 2<sup>nd</sup>, 24 in 3<sup>rd</sup>, 29 in 4<sup>th</sup>)
