The Lobos are 29-38 against BYU in program history with the teams' last meeting resulting in a 65-49 Lobo loss at home on March 1, 2011. UNM is 6-2 in their last eight meetings.

A meeting between St. Joseph's and the Lobos would be the first in program history.

ABOUT THE MATCHUP - UNM US TULSA: The Lobos enter the 2016 Lobo Thanksgiving Tournament coming off of a close loss at Texas Tech on Sunday, Nov. 20. The contest was the closest the Lobos have had all season as the lead changed seven times. The Lobos were down by just two points heading into the fourth quarter before the Lady Raiders ran away with the game in a 22-point final frame.

new mexico game notes

SCOUTING TULSA

Tulsa is entering Friday's contest coming off of three-straight losses in six days to Kansas State (82-62), Oral Roberts (76-68) and South Dakota (71-68).

The Golden Hurricane is led by junior Erika Wakefield who is averaging 14.8 points per game to go along with 3.5 rebounds per game and a 59.0 field goal percentage. She leads the squad that was chosen to finish ninth in the American Athletic Conference Preseason Coaches Poll behind UConn, Temple and South Florida as the top three spots.

THE LOBO BIG D

The Lobos have boasted strong defensive numbers so far this season, holding all three regular-season opponents to under 35 percent shooting from the floor (30.5 percentage average), including the sharp-shooting Texas Tech Lady Raiders. The Lady Raiders were led by Recee' Caldwell who entered the contest on Nov. 20 averaging 33.0 points, but the Lobo defense kept her scoreless throughout three periods to keep the game close until the fourth.

VAN DER KEIJL'S BIG DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Senior **Richelle van der Keijl** notched 19 points and an outstanding 20 rebounds vs. NMSU. The last time a Lobo brought down 20 boards was on Dec. 13, 2008 vs Texas Tech.

Lobos Starting Strong

The Lobos are out to a steady 2-1 start including a strong performance at Texas Tech on Sunday, Nov. 20. Head coach Mike Bradbury has now earned his first two wins and his first loss at the Helm of the Lobos. The last time UNM won its first two regular-season games was during the 2012-13 season when the squad went on a five-win streak to open the season.

DOUBLE-FIGURE LOBOS

Three Lobos are leading the squad averaging double figures in scoring including redshirt-junior **Alex Lapeyrolerie** (15.3), senior **Richelle van der Keijl** (15.0) and freshman **Mykiel Burleson** (14.7). In addition, van der Keijl is averaging double figures in rebounds with 12.7 per game. She has posted 10 offensive and 28 defensive rebounds this season for a team-high total of 38.

RECORD FOR BEYNON

Junior **Cherise Beynon** tied the all-time New Mexico record for assists in a single game with 15 on Nov. 15 against NM State. Beynon tied former Lobo player - and current Lobo administrator - Janice Ruggiero (Branch) who set the record on Jan. 23, 1987 against Adams State.

Career first

Sophomore **Jaisa Nunn** assured the press after the Lobos' victory over NM State on Nov. 15 that her first career three-point shot would not be her last - she followed through on that promise. Nunn scored her second career three-pointer against Texas Tech in the very next game. Last season, the center did not attempt a single three-pointer, so far this season she has shot five under Bradbury's new, fast-paced style that includes unexpected shooters from the outside.

LAST TIME IS NOW

In their first three games under head coach Mike Bradbury, the Lobos have blasted through our "Last time it happened section" (see page 28). UNM scored over 80 points, won by more than 20, made 10 three-pointers, had 50 rebounds, posted over 20 assists and turned the ball over less than 10 times this season. In addition, the Lobos regis-

tered two 20-point scorers in their season opener, but were just short of two more against NMSU with their top two scorers netting 22 and 19 points. In the Lobos' game against NMSU, the team also posted 11 blocks. Last time the Lobos posted over 10 blocks was on Jan. 4 2012 vs. Wyoming.

REGULAR 20s

The Lobos have had at least one player rack up 20 points in each of their three games this season. In the season opener vs. Fairleigh Dickinson, it was **Richelle van der Keijl** (20) and **Alex Lapeyrolerie** (21), in the second game against NM State it was **Lapeyrolerie** (22) and in the Lobos' last outing at Texas Tech it was **Mykiel Burleson** (22).

In addition to its 20-point scorers, UNM has posted eight scorers over 10 points in its last three games.

ABOUT THE 2016-17 LOBOS

The 2016-17 edition of the New Mexico women's basketball team is going to have a much different look as the Lobos are under new direction with new head coach Mike Bradbury. The Lobos will show off a new style of play, speeding the game up with the dribble drive and shooting those outside threes.

The Lobos return seven lettermen from last year's squad including First Team All-Mountain West selection Cherise Beynon and All-Freshman Team selection Jaisa Nunn. The Lobos will add in six new faces, including three freshmen and three transfers (only one transfer will play this season).

-- all coming from experienced backgrounds of basketball. The three freshman were rated as the top recruiting class in the Mountain West. Three transfers come in to the program. Only one will be eligible to play this season.

Preseason mountain west honors

Junior **Cherise Beynon** was named to the 2016-17 Mountain West Preseason All-Conference Team following her stellar sophomore campaign while freshman **Mykiel Burleson** was named Mountain West Preseason Freshman of the Year. As a team, the Lobos were selected to finish sixth in the league.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Two years ago, "The Pit" went underconstruction with the name of the arena. It is still identified as "The Pit" but has a few more letters added to it, as the name of the arena is now WisePies Arena aka The Pit. "The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years.

STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For six of the last eight seasons, and eight of the last 11 seasons, UNM has finished in the WBCA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

Lobos from near and far

The Lobo women's basketball roster has a mixture of athletes from near and far on its 2016-17 roster. The Lobos have players from nine different states and one from another country. The Lobos are combined with players from Texas, Florida, Utah, Nevada, New Mexico, Minnesota, Wisconsin and Washington. The Lobos have one player from overseas in senior transfer Richelle van der Kiejl from The Netherlands.
