PREGAME REPORT

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. – The HBU men's basketball team will look to bounce back for their first win of the 2016-17 campaign against New Mexico on Monday with tip-off set for 8:00 p.m. The game will be televised on the Root Sports Network with Drew Goodman providing the play-by-play call and Dave Bollwinkel as the color commentator. Additionally, fans can listen to Lonnie King on the Legacy Sports Network audio broadcast available at HBUHuskies.com.

HBU (0-1) dropped its opener to Texas Tech on Friday in Lubbock, Texas by a score of 93-67. Senior graduate transfer Atif Russell led the way with 16 points on 6-12 shooting in his HBU debut. Junior Josh Ibarra ended the night with nine points and tied for the team lead in rebounds with five while freshman Jalon Gates ended his collegiate debut with nine points off the bench. Senior Colter Lasher led HBU with three assists to go along with eight points and five boards.

New Mexico (1-0) are coming off a season-opening home victory over Idaho State on Friday. The Lobos trailed by six at the half but outscored the Bengals 49-32 in the second half en route to an 81-70 final. UNM was led by senior forward Tim Williams who posted a double-double (18 points, 11 rebounds) and junior forward Sam Logwood who netted a team-high 20 points. New Mexico struggled from three, connecting on just 19 percent from behind the arc, but made up for it by score more than half their points in the paint.

This meeting marks the third meeting between the two programs. The most recent meeting was January 3, 2012 in Albuquerque with the Huskies falling 98-61.

After Monday's game, HBU will return to Sharp Gym for its home opener against Dallas Christian on Friday, November 18 at 7:00 p.m.

RUSSELL'S IMPRESSIVE HUSKY DEBUT

Senior Atif Russell, a senior graduate transfer from Pepperdine, made a splash in his debut with the Huskies. Russell was the lone HBU player to reach double-digits in scoring in the season opener at Texas Tech. He finished 6-12 from the floor, 1-4 from beyond the arc and 3-5 from the charity stripe to net 16 points on the night.

SENIOR NUCLEUS

HBU has four three-year letterwinners together on the roster in forwards Colter Lasher and Alex Fountain, guard/forward Reveal Chukwujekwu and center Cody Stetler. The Huskies have not had four four-year seniors together since 1995, when head coach Ron Cottrell's first full recruiting class of Tony DiCamillo, Bobby Sanders, Shannon Holmes and Jamie Lynn were finishing out their careers.

LASHER CHASING 1,000 CAREER POINTS

Senior Colter Lasher is currently at 787 points for his career, leaving him 213 shy of 1,000. The forward finished the 2015-16 season with 335 points and totaled 297 points as a sophomore. Between those two seasons, his scoring average per game comes out to 10.5.

HUSKIES IN THE PROS

HBU has five active former players in professional basketball. Anthony Odunsi ('16) was recently selected by the Canton Charge in the NBA Developmental League Draft. Caleb Crayton ('16) is playing for Mgzavrebi-Armia in the Georgian Superleague while Ricmonds Vilde ('15) is in France playing for ALM Evreux. Rod Nealy ('03) is playing in Angola and Emanuel Willis ('09) is playing in China.

BROTHERS IN THE BACKCOURT

The Huskies' roster features a pair of brothers in junior guard Will Gates Jr. and freshman guard Jalon Gates, who have never played together on an organized team until coming to HBU. They are the sons of Will Gates Sr., who starred in the 1994 critically acclaimed documentary *Hoop Dreams*. Gates Sr. went on to play collegiately at Marquette, which HBU will face on Nov. 26.

MAN IN THE MIDDLE

With center Josh Ibarra in the lineup, HBU got off to a 14-7 record overall and 8-0 start in Southland Conference play last season, but finished 3-8 as he missed the final 11 games with an injury. Ibarra averaged 10.3 points and 5.0 rebounds, shot 63.1 percent from the field and blocked 30 shots in 22 games. Through two seasons, Ibarra already ranks seventh all-time in school history with 85 blocked shots and posted the third-highest field goal percentage in school history in 2015-16.

SHOES TO FILL

With the graduation of first-team all-conference guard Anthony Odunsi, the Huskies will have to step up to fill the void of last season's leading scorer and assister. Odunsi averaged 17.5 points, 3.7 assists (123 total) and 4.5 rebounds per game. He ranked third nationally in free throws made and attempted (255-for-304).

FRESH FACES

Nine newcomers were added to the Huskies' roster, including two redshirts, three transfers and four true freshmen. Will Gates Jr. appeared in three games last year, but received a medical redshirt to play two more full seasons, while Kyren Block did not see action and redshirted his first year at HBU. Atif Russell is a graduate transfer from Pepperdine, while Braxton Bonds is a transfer from Columbia State, who began his career at Tennessee. Tyquon Jordan redshirted his freshman year at Eastfield. Jalon Gates and Jalen Webber signed with HBU early, then were joined by other true freshmen, Colin Just and Michael Saladin.
