ABOUT THE MATCHUP: The Lobos will face Houston Baptist in their season opener Friday. The last time the two teams met, the Lobos claimed a dominating 63-46 victory on Nov. 18, 2012 over the Huskies. The Lobos own a 2-0 all-time record over the Huskies, both contests under head coach Yvonne Sanchez. The Lobos are 2-2 in season openers under Sanchez.

Houston Baptist is coming off a 90-56 exhibition victory over Southwestern. The Huskies return six lettermen from last year's squad including three starters. Senior guard Rachel Arthur is the highest scoring Huskie to return for the team. Last year, she averaged 11.0 points per game. The Huskies finished 15-18 overall last year with a 6-12 record in the Southland Conference. The Huskies made it to the finals in SLC tournament but fell 58-50 to Northwestern State.

New Mexico comes off two exhibition victories last week, a 78-41 win over Western New Mexico and a 80-39 win over New Mexico Highlands. Freshman Jaisa Nunn led the way with a combined 32 points and 14 rebounds.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

DOUBLEHEADER ON ROOT SPORTS

The Lobos will be televised on ROOT Sports Friday with Houston Baptist. The Lobo men will be taking on Texas Southern before the women take the floor against the Huskies. The women's game will start 30 minutes after the men's game. The last time the women's team was featured on TV was last season on ESPN2 at New Mexico State.

NLI SHOW ON ROOT SPORTS

ROOT Sports will also be featuring the women's basketball NLI show. That will take place during the 30-minute break between the men's and women's games. Coach Sanchez and Lobo play-by-play announcer Josh Suchon will talk about the four signees and preview the 2015-16 season.

LOBOS START STRONG WITH TWO EXHIBITION WINS

The Lobos started off preseason with two dominating exhibition wins. The Lobos put together a 78-41 win over Western New Mexico and a 80-39 win over New Mexico Highlands last week.

FRESHMAN NUNN LEADS THE WAY

The Lobos were led the freshman Jaisa Nunn in both games, combining for 32 points and 14 rebounds. Against Western New Mexico she tallied 18 points and seven rebounds. New Mexico Highlands couldn't stop her as she put up 14 points and seven rebounds.

ABOUT THE 2015-16 LOBOS

The 2015-16 edition of the New Mexico women's basketball team is an experienced group that adds three exciting freshmen to the mix. The Lobos return 11 letterwinners to the squad which includes the return of Whitney Johnson, who has been away from the team on a Mormon Mission in Mexico. With the loss of Antiesha Brown, the Lobos will look to four returning starters with the leadership of three seniors, Alexa Chavez, Bryce Owens and Khadijah Shumpert.

The Lobos have a nonconference schedule that starts out with seven of their first eight games at home. The nonconference schedule is highlighted by games with SMU, Minnesota, Nicholls State, Sacramento State, UTEP, Pepperdine, Houston Baptist and our home Thanksgiving tournament, welcoming in North Carolina A&T, Southern Utah and Duquesne.

ONE FOR THE BOOKS

Last year's season was one for the books, as the 2014-15 Lobos finished with a school-record 14 conference wins, winning 13 straight at home for the first time since 2004-05 and went undefeated at home in conference play for the first time since 2005-06. Sanchez earned Mountain West Coach of the Year honors. The Lobos advanced to the finals of the Mountain West Tournament for the second time in four years and hosted two games in the WBI, the team's first postseason appearance since 2009-10.

ADDITION BY ADDITION

The Lobos welcome three freshmen — all coming from experienced backgrounds of basketball. The three freshmen gave the Lobos their BlueStar Top 50 recruiting class honorable mention, making them the only program in the Mountain West to earn that distinction.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Last year, "The Pit" went underconstruction with the name of the arena. It is still identified as "The Pit" but has a few more letters added to it, as the name of the arena is now WisePies Arena aka The Pit. "The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years.

ALBUQUERQUE'S OWN

When head coach Yvonne Sanchez calls Albuquerque her home, she really means it. Sanchez enters her fifth season at the helm of the Lobo program after spending the previous 11 seasons as an assistant on staff under coach Don Flanagan. However, Yvonne Sanchez and basketball in Albuquerque go back over a quarter of a century. Sanchez was a prep stand-out for Flanagan at Eldorado High School in Albuquerque in the 1980s. Sanchez earned Mountain West Coach of the Year after finishing second in the MW with a 14-4 record.

STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For six of the last eight seasons, and eight of the last 11 seasons, UNM has finished in the WBCA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

The Lobo women's basketball roster has a mixture of athletes from near and far on its 2015-16 roster. The Lobos have players from nine different states and one other country. The Lobos are combined with players from Texas, Florida, Utah, Nevada, New Mexico, Minnesota, California, Wisconsin and Washington. Junior Josie Greenwood is the only international player on the team, coming from Australia.

MOUNTAIN WEST MEDIA POLL

The Lobos were picked to finish second in the 11-team Mountain West preseason poll released in October. 2014-15 regular-season champion Colorado State grabbed the top spot in the poll, which is listed below:

Khadijah Shumpert made the preseason All-Mountain West team while newcomer Jannon Otto garnered MW Freshman of the Year honors. Shumpert earned College Sports Madness preseason first-team all-conference recognition.

RIO GRANDE RIVALRY

The Rio Grande rivalry is a series between UNM and NMSU that encompasses athletic teams for both programs. It began with the 2007-08 school year. The teams' will match up this season on November 17 in La Cruces and December 20 in Albuquerque.

STAFF OF ENCHANTMENT

In addition to coach Yvonne Sanchez's New Mexico roots, the UNM staff has several other connections to the Land of Enchantment.

Assistant coach Amy Beggin is a 2010 graduate of UNM and just one of 17 Lobo players to score 1,000 points during her collegiate career. She became the program's video coordinator in 2011 and worked her way up to director of operations and now assistant coach, where she is in her second season.

Jourdan Erskine replaced Beggin as the team's director of operations. Erskine played for the Lobos from 2009-13 and was a team captain her senior year. Erskine was the team's video coordinator

before she was promoted to director of operations.

Vera Jo Bustos took over the video coordinator position, who was a standout New Mexico prep player at West Las Vegas High School. She is the school's all-time leader in points, rebounds, assists, steals and games started.

Former All-America and Olympic athlete Carla Garrett became the program's strength coach in the summer of 2015. She is originally from Santa Fe, New Mexico and played high school basketball against head coach Yvonne Sanchez.
