### KICKING OFF

The University of New Mexico women's soccer team is looking to get back on track as they embark on the back half of their four-game road trip in the Pacific Northwest starting with a Thursday night game at Oregon State. The non-conference tilt will be another tough challenge for the Lobos as the Beavers will enter play 3-0-0 on the season. Under the direction of first-year head coach Matt Kagan, the Beavers have out-scored their opponents 8-1.

Through the Lobos' first three games of the season, their potentially potent offense has been tempered some as the Lobos have found the back of the net just twice. Despite that, the Lobos have countered with a solid defensive effort that has yielded just three

goals on the season and lays claim to a shutout effort versus then No. 22-ranked Texas Tech.

Thursday's game will be the fourth meeting all-time between the Lobos and the Beavers with Oregon State having won all three previous meetings. This will also be the third time that the two will meet in Corvallis. It will also be the first meeting between the two teams since 2011.

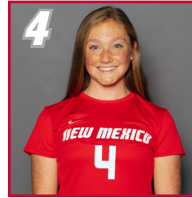

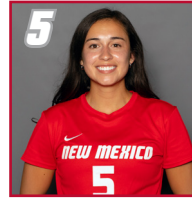

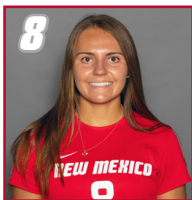

### **NOTEWORTHY :**

- » Named the fourth head coach in program history on January 29, 2015
- » Ranks second in program history in wins with 45
- » Led team to consecutive Mountain West Tournament Championship Games

**HEATHER DYCHE** enters into her fifth season as the head women's soccer coach at The University of New Mexico.

The Albuquerque native owns a 44-29-9 overall record and a 26-14-4 mark in Mountain West play. This past season, Dyche guided the Lobos to a share of the program's third regular season title while also making a second-straight appearance in the MW Tournament Championship Game.

Additionally, Dyche's 2018 Lobo team set a program record for goals scored with 45 and posted second-best program marks in assists (33) and points (123). In terms of individual player accolades, three standouts received All-Pacific Region honors from the United Soccer Coaches, which was a program record. From the Mountain West, the 2018 team had five honorees, three of which were first team selections.

All told, Coach Dyche has coached 10 All-MW selections while at UNM. Success has also come under Dyche's leadership in the classroom. In each semester since Dyche's arrival, the UNM women's soccer team has posted a team GPA of 3.46 or higher and three times have posted GPA's above 3.7. For three-straight years, the team has received the Team Academic Award from the United Soccer Coaches.

In her first season, Dyche became the third coach in Lobo women's soccer history to begin her career with double-digit victories by going 10-8-2 in 2015. That record included a 7-3-1 record in Mountain West play and a run to MW Tournament semifinals.

Along with leading the Lobos, Dyche traveled to Brazil to assist

the U.S. Women's National Team during the 2016 Summer Olympic Games - assisting with scouting and analyzing opponents. She also served as an assistant coach for the U-18 U.S. Women's National Team's trip to Australia in the summer of 2017.

Dyche is also a coach, instructor and scout with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF). Dyche is an assistant coach for the US Youth National Team U14 and U15 Girls. There, Dyche is granted the opportunity to identify and work with the most talented U15 soccer players in the country and the core of the US team that competed in the 2018 FIFA U-17 Women's World Cup. She also serves on the USSF instructional staff, instructing USSF B- and USSF C-licensed national coaching schools across the country.

Dyche's footprint at the elite level spans past the national stage, as she has also assisted for national teams from Antigua, St. Kitts and Nevis and Grenada.

Dyche serves on the instructional staff for The Confederation of North, Central American and

Caribbean Association Football (CONCACAF). As the only female of the CONCACAF educational board, Dyche teaches C, D and grassroots courses in order while developing and writing content for all women's grassroots programs.

Dyche is a US Youth Region IV ODP head coach. There, she coaches the team at Olympic Development Interregional events and identifies top players in the region to participate in the Olympic Development Program Regional Team.

Finally, she is also the co-founder and head coach of LEAD Academy (Leadership and Empowerment through Athletic Development Soccer) - an all-girls soccer leadership training school

located here in Albuquerque.

Dyche's New Mexico soccer roots are as extensive as her résumé is.

Prior to joining the University of New Mexico, Dyche was a presenter at the National Soccer Coaches Association of America/U.S. Youth National Conference in 2013 and at the U.S. Soccer National Symposium in 2011.

She has coached more than 60 players who have gone on to collegiate soccer programs. She has coached multiple state and regional champion club teams in New Mexico. Dyche was also the NMYSA Coach of the Year in 2008 with the Rio 95G Magic. Additionally, she served as the associate head coach and team captain of the now-defunct Albuquerque Asylum of the Women's Premier Soccer League from 2006-07.

Dyche is a 1997 graduate of Eldorado High School and was a four-year all-state defender, a two-time district Player of the Year and the 1996 Defensive Player of the Year. She also played basketball for the Eagles and was a first-team all-state performer 2 years.

Dyche accepted a soccer scholarship to the University of Nebraska out of high school and was

a participant on the No. 4-ranked women's soccer program in the nation.

Dyche then transferred to Florida State and played there from 1998-2001, serving as the team captain her senior year. The Seminoles participated in the NCAA Tournament in 2000 and 2001 and were ranked as high as No. 9 in the country during her time there. She was on the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) All-Tournament Team in 2001 and was an on the ACC Academic Honor Roll all four of her years there.

Dyche got her bachelor's degree in Family and Consumer Sciences, with an emphasis in Child Development, accumulating a 3.8 grade-point average. She then earned a master's degree in Athletic Administration, achieving a 3.84 grade-point average.

She went on to play with ROA Norway - a semi-professional soccer team in 2004-05 - helping the squad win the Norwegian League Championship in '04.

Dyche holds an impressive list of licensing credentials. She earned a USSF National A License in 2010, a National Soccer Coaches Association of America Premier Diploma in 2013, a CONCACAF D License in 2013 and a U.S. Youth Soccer Association National Youth License in 2010.

### ONE-GOAL DIFFERENCE

The Lobos continued to play close and competitive games this past week at the Husky Invitational as both games (Portland, 0-1 & Washington 1-2) were decided by one goal each. Unfortunately, the Lobos were on the short end of both games. Thus far, all three games played by the Lobos have been one-goal games and they are 1-2. Last season, the Lobos played 12 such games and posted a 7-5 record.

### EJ NAMED MW DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior goalkeeper **EMILY JOHNSON** earned the first MW Defensive Player of the Week award for the 2019 season after she withstood an unrelenting offensive attack by the No.22-ranked Texas Tech Red Raiders for the entirety of the 90-minute match en route to a clean sheet.

In the first half, Johnson faced 10 shots and made three saves. In the second half, with the Lobos holding a 1-0 lead, Johnson was forced to face 12 shots and made four more saves. The individual shutout posted by Johnson was her eighth as the Lobo goalkeeper and the weekly conference plaudit was the second in her career as well.

### KNOCKING OFF NATIONALLY-RANKED FOE

Historically, the Lobos have played 33 matches against a ranked opponent coming into the 2019 season. All-time the Lobos' record vs. ranked opponents was 4-25-5. Coming off of their NCAA Second Round run a year ago, UNM's first opponent, the Texas Tech Red Raiders, were ranked No. 22 in the United Soccer Coaches Preseason Poll.

This year's meeting marked the fourth time that the Lobos would play the Red Raiders when they were ranked. In those games, the Lobos were 0-3-0, but a "1" was added to the win column for the Lobos after they pulled off a 1-0 upset win of the Red Raiders.

The win snapped what was a five-game losing streak to the Red Raiders and was the first win for the Lobos over a ranked opponent since 2010 when they beat No. 8-ranked BYU.

### LOOKING TO BUILD OFF LAST SEASON

Last season was a banner year for the UNM women's soccer team. In the fourth season under head coach **HEATHER DYCHE**, the Lobos posted their most wins since 2009 with 13. The 2018 squad also posted a 7-2-2 record in the Mountain West to claim a share of the regular season title. Additionally, the Lobos appeared in the MW Tournament title game for the second-straight season, narrowly missing out on the NCAA Tournament.

### NINE NEWCOMERS TO THE FOLD

The Lobos did not lose much from their team a year ago as the 2018 iteration boasted just three seniors. Despite that, the Lobos have bolstered their roster with depth and talent thanks to the addition of nine newcomers to the fold. Listed among those newcomers are **ALLISON AREND**, **ALEXIS CHRISTIANSEN**, **ALIX HAILEY**, **MYAH ISAIS**, **JULIANA KOTSIOS**, **PARIS MCKENZIE**, **DANI MOSHER**, **AKANE TAKADA** and **MAYSA WALTERS**. Takada is the lone newcomer not entering as a true freshman as she is transferring from junior college power Tyler JC.

### POTENT TOP-25 OFFENSE PACES THE MW

Last season, UNM women's soccer possessed one of the most potent offenses in the country. Having scored multiple goals in 15 of their 21 games, the Lobos ended the year with 45 goals. Those 45 goals established a new single-season program record, led the Mountain West and ranked 25th in all of Division I.

### GARCIA AND GAME-WINNERS

Sophomore forward **ALESIA GARCIA** wasted little time in establishing herself as one of the top scoring threats in the MW as she ranked in a tie for second with seven goals. While any goal is important, all but two of Garcia's were extremely important as they ended up being game-winning goals. Her five game-winners as a freshman were tied for the second-most by a Lobo in a season and already place her in a tie for sixth on the career list.

### HIX KNOCKING ON DOOR OF TOP-5 IN GOALS

A two-time All-Mountain West First Team selection, **JESSIE HIX** has turned in a stellar career thus far for her hometown team. Her prowess on the pitch is most evident offensively. For her career, Hix has found the back of the net 14 times to place her currently in a tie for sixth all-time at UNM. Entering her senior campaign, Hix is just four goals away from moving into the top-five in program history.

### ROAD WARRIORS

Home games were kind to the Lobos last season as they went 8-1-1 while playing at the UNM Soccer Complex, but this year, the Lobos will be forced to be road warriors as 11 of their 18 scheduled regular season games will take place away from the Duke City. Last season, the Lobos had a mixed results on the road going 3-4-1.

### AWARDS AND ACCOLADES

The 2018 season was one of the most successful in program history with 13 wins (tied for second-most) and an overall .686 winning percentage (highest since 2009 and third-best). That team success also yielded a bevy of individual awards.

At the conference level, the 2018 Lobos had the second-most all-conference honorees all-time with five. Of those, **JESSIE HIX**, **GWEN MALY** and **JENNIFER MUÑOZ** were named to the first team; matching the program standard of three first team honorees set in 2010.

Those three first team selections also went on to earn All-Pacific Region honors from the United Soccer Coaches. It was the first time since 2011 that the program had an all-region performer.
