#GoLobos Matches at a Glance

The Week Ahead:

The University of New Mexico Lobos (1-11) continues its six-match home stand with a couple of regional rivals. On Friday morning at 11 a.m., the Lobos will host regional rival UTEP at the McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium. Then on Saturday, the Lobos will host Rio Grande Rival New Mexico State, also at 11 a.m. and also at McKinnon.

After this weekend, the Lobos will have another weekend off before opening Mountain West play with a pair of home matches against Utah State and Boise State.

The Coaches:

The University of New Mexico Lobos are coached by Stephanie Wooten-Quijada, who is in her first season with New Mexico. She came to UNM from UT-Rio Grande Valley where she led the Vaqueros to a WAC Tournament title. Her coaching career also includes one season stints at UTRGV and Stephen F. Austin. UTEP is coached by Roberto Aspillaga, who is in his second season with the Miners. Aspillaga previously spent two seasons at Stephen F. Austin as the head coach. New Mexico State is coached by Ivan Fernandez, who is in his ninth season as the head coach of NM State and director of the Aggie Tennis Center.

Series History:

New Mexico has dominated the series with both UTEP and New Mexico. The Lobos lead the series with UTEP 30-1, winning 24 in a row before losing in 2010. Since then, UNM has won six in a row. The Lobos lead the series with New Mexico State 34-6, having won the last four in the series.

Rio Grande Rivalry:

Saturday's match is worth 1.5 points in the Rio Grande Rivalry, the annual series that encompasses all sports between New Mexico and New Mexico State. The Lobos have already clinched the series for the 2016-17 year as they lead 17-6.5. New Mexico has won the Rio Grande Rivalry all 10 seasons it has been contested in its current format.

About UTFP

UTEP is 4-10 on the season, having lost its last three. The Lobos and Miners have three opponents in common, with both teams losing to Northern Arizona and Arizona, and UTEP beating Colorado, while UNM lost. Vivienne Kulicke is 8-3 at No. 1 singles and has won five in a row, while Raven Bennett has a fourmatch winning streak. Kulicke has teamed up with Milou Pietersz in doubles to go 9-2 at No. 1 doubles.

About New Mexico State

New Mexico State is 6-8 on the season and takes on Wyoming in Laramie on Thursday afternoon. While UNM and NM State have no common opponents, New Mexico State just played UTRGV, which is the former school of Stephanie Wooten-Quijada.

What A-Bhat Rachana?

Rachana Bhat picked up another singles win, grabbing a 6-2, 7-6 (7-3) win over Northern Arizona, which was singles win No. 86. Bhat is now two wins away from moving up into a tie for seventh place with Tjasa Suvakm who played from 2000-04. Assuming she gets to complete every match, Bhat has at least nine matches left this season (eight regular season plus one conference tournament match). Bhat's 12 singles wins lead the team, as does her 12-5 record.

Only Her Game is Dirty

Diana Wong continued her hot play, picking up two more wins over the previous weekend, running her winning streak to four. Wong has wins over Cincinnati, Cal State Northridge, Minnesota and Northern Arizona. Her four wins improved her record to 8-5 on the season.

Dulski Starting to Dom-inate

Dominique Dulski is starting to look like the Dom of old, having one her last two matches. Dulski, who has played despite a bad toe injury, improved to 2-3 on the season at No. 3 singles.

We Got a Schedule to Keep Cha-Cha

The New Mexico women's tennis team has an overall program record of 493-368, meaning UNM is seven wins away from No. 500. Of those 493 wins, most were earned over 24 seasons by Kathy Kolankeiwicz, who went 354-212. Of UNM's five head coaches (not counting first year coach Stephanie Wooten-Quijada), four have had winning overall records, including the last two, Erica Perkins Jasper (40-33) and Kelcy McKenna (15-7).

Olivier Getting Closer to Top 15

Emily Olivier teamed up with Diana Wong to get a 7-5 win at No. 2 doubles over Minnesota. That win gave Olivier 56 doubles wins over her career, and now she is two doubles wins away from moving into 15th on the all-time list. Sitting in 15th is her former teammate, Michaela Bezdickova, who won 58 doubles matches from 2010-14

Kate McKinnon isn't the Only Awesome McKinnon These Days

The Linda Estes Tennis Center served as a wonderful home for UNM Tennis, and even though UNM doesn't play outdoor matches there, UNM's tennis offices, locker room and the Randy Briggs Indoor Tennis Dome are all still located there. The Briggs Indoor Dome covers three courts. It is 40 feet tall, 196 feet long and 128 feet wide, and was at one time the widest indoor tennis bubble in the world. There is a lobby area and the bleachers that seat close to 1 000 fans

Now, UNM calls the McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium home for it's outdoor matches. The McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium is located directly across the street from Linda Estes, behind The Pit basketball arena and next to the Lobo baseball field.

The stadium features stadium lights, electronic scoreboards and six sunken outdoor courts that include stadium seating for approximately 1,000 fans. Fans can keep up with all the action via a large electronic scoreboard located between the two central courts as well as smaller boards at each individual court.

The McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium comes courtesy of a \$1.2 million donation that was part of a \$7.5 million gift to UNM that Ian and Sonnet McKinnon made in 2011. Another \$500,000 was raised privately for the project and the stadium lights were donated by the City of Albuquerque. The McKinnon family also contributed \$300,000 to an endowed scholarship in the name of Loren Dils, a former director of the Lobo Tennis Club and an ex-UNM assistant tennis coach. Who has been diagnosed with ALS. Ed and Shirley Corley donated the scoreboards.

The McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium has also served as the host site of numerous events including the 2014 USTA/ITA Regional Championships and 2015 Mountain West Conference Championships

In summer 2015, the McKinnon Family Tennis Stadium was recognized as one of 13 winners in its 34th annual USTA Facility Awards Program, which recognizes excellence in the construction and/or renovation of tennis facilities throughout the country.
