TAKING ON THE BEARCATS

The Lobos head into their season opener 6-0 against Binghamton, last playing the Bearcats March 22-23, 2011, in Albuquerque - taking both games, 16-2 and 5-4. In fact, all six meetings versus Binghamton have occurred in the Duke City with the Lobos winning by an average of 8.7 runs. Binghamton comes from the America East Conference, a conference the Lobos are a perfect 15-0 against (6-0 vs. Binghamton, 4-0 vs. Hartford, 4-0 vs. Vermont, 1-0 vs. Maine).

ABOUT BINGHAMTON

Binghamton, like the Lobos, are no stranger to the NCAA postseason - having qualified for the NCAA Regionals four times since 2009, including last season where they went 30-25 and lost to Texas A&M and Minnesota in at the College Station Regionals. The Bearcats returns six all-conference players from that squad.



Career Notes

- Five NCAA regionals appearances in the last season seasons (2010-13, '16), first NCAA postseason berths for UNM since 1962
- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first three MW Tournament Championships in 2011-12 and 2016. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- Guided New Mexico Junior College to the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runner-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ... Well, the last time the University of New Mexico baseball team was on the field was at the 2016 NCAA Lubbock Regional where the Lobos won their opener over No. 17 Dallas Baptist 12-6 before falling to eventual College World Series participant and seventh-ranked Texas Tech 4-3 and being eliminated by Dallas Baptist 5-3. The Mountain West Tournament champion Lobos finished the season 39-23 overall - including a fifth trip to the NCAA postseason in the last seven seasons.

The Lobos' 39 wins was the third most in program history and the most for UNM since 1985. The Lobos, while very good at home, proved they can take care of business on the road as well - winning a program-record 20 games away from the sweet confines of Santa Ana Star Field.

UNM finished with two All-America honorees in Chris DeVito and Carl Stajduhar as well as a Freshman All-American honor for Andrew Pratt. The Lobos now have 36 All-Americans in their program's history dating back to Sam Suplizio in 1953. Fourteen of those All-Americans have come during Birmingham's nine seasons at the helm.

UNM finished in the top 10 in the nation in doubles (150 - first), slugging percentage (.492 - fifth), on-base percentage (.410 - sixth) and hits (692 - ninth) while finishing 12th in the country in batting average (.316).

Helping the Lobos lead the nation in doubles was a trio of players who finished in the top 50 individually in Luis Gonzalez (21), Jared Holley (21) and DeVito (20).

UNM had two players selected in the 2016 MLB Draft with DeVito going in the eighth round to the Kansas City Royals while Alex Estrella was selected in the 35th round by the Tampa Bay Rays. Colton Thomson signed a free agent contract with the St. Louis Cardinals as well for the Lobos.

UNM Vice President for Athletics Paul Krebs, UNM Board of Regents President Rob Doughty, UNM baseball coach Ray Birmingham and R.D. Hubbard spoke in front of a crowd of more than 200 people that filled the east parking lot of the \$2.3-million, 6,000-square foot facility.

“How about us? How about New Mexico!?” Birmingham led off his speech to the cheers of those in attendance. “Today is a historical day for not only the Lobo baseball team, but also the University of New Mexico and our great state. ... Thank you R.D. and Joan Dale for caring about us and caring about the young people of New Mexico as I have seen you do for parts of the last four decades.”

R.D. Hubbard, who donated the lead gift of \$500,000 to the project, had a fun-loving message for Birmingham.

“I just want to say to coach, if he can win the tournaments and the championships he’s won working out of that little old building with no showers and no dressing rooms, if he can’t win a national championship out of this building – I’m going to be very disappointed!” Hubbard said with a grin. “Here’s to Omaha!”

The Hubbard’s donation was one of many to help make the R.D. & Joan Dale Hubbard

Clubhouse, which is located down the right field line at Santa Ana Star Field, the first privately funded building on UNM’s campus.

Following the ceremony, supporters and fans toured the R.D. & Joan Dale Hubbard Clubhouse - which features locker rooms, coaching offices, restrooms, showers, a training room, storage and a player’s lounge. The building also provides a second-floor deck that overlooks the field. Previously, the UNM baseball team used a locker room in WisePies Arena – The Pit, but had to vacate it during certain events at the arena.

LOBOS HELPING LOBOS ... The University of New Mexico baseball student-athletes, some holding cell phones to record the moment, walked into the Dennis Family Locker Room for the first time Jan. 12 with the lights from their new lockers and a cherry light shining down onto the Lobo logo on the carpet guiding the way in front of the Dennis family and numerous others who support the program.

Coach Ray Birmingham and UNM dedicated the locker room to Dee Dennis Jr. and his family, a family who donated \$300,000 to the project while also assisting in the installation of lights on Santa Ana Star Field in 2013.

“Today as Lobos, we celebrate a man that

has made us better,” Birmingham said of Dennis. “He has knocked it out of the park. We win because of Dee Dennis. We grow as Lobos and as men because of Dee Dennis. ... Thank you, Dee.”

Dennis’ son, Dee Dennis III, is a Lobo baseball alum that graduated in 2000 and helped UNM to a 35-21 record his senior season, including a 22-8 mark in Mountain West play to win the regular-season title. Dennis III, who with his father made the donation, is honored with a plaque in the locker room.

MOUNTAIN WEST FAVORITES ... The Lobos are the favorites in the Mountain West according to the conference’s preseason coaches’ poll.

The defending Mountain West Tournament champion Lobos, who went 39-23 and reached the NCAA postseason for the fifth time in seven seasons in 2016, picked up four first-place votes and edged Fresno State (which had three first-place votes) by a point for the top spot in the preseason poll (each program voted, but could not vote for themselves). Following UNM and Fresno State was Nevada and San Diego State in third and fourth, respectively, Air Force and UNLV tied for fifth and San Jose State seventh.






