UTAH STATE TRAVELING TO ALBUQUERQUE ON SATURDAY

• Utah State returns to the road on Saturday afternoon, facing New Mexico in Albuquerque at 4. Fans can listen to the game on KVNU with Al Lewis providing play-by-play or watch the game live online on ESPN3 (watchespn.com).

• Utah State and New Mexico will meet for the 28th time on Saturday, with the Aggies holding an all-time series lead of 20-7. The Aggies are 6-2 on the road, including a 63-60 victory in Albuquerque last season.

• Utah State's 63-60 victory in Albuquerque was the first for the Aggies since the 1979 season.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR AGAINST THE LOBOS

• New Mexico and Utah State are two of the top shooting teams in the league, ranking first and fourth in field goal percentage, shooting 47.2 percent (406-of-860) and 44.6 percent (360-of-807), respectively.

• The shooting prowess extends beyond the 3-point line where the teams ranks third and fourth behind the line, shooting 35.7 percent (92-of-258) and 35.3 percent (106-of-300), respectively.

• Both teams are also among the best in assists per game, ranking third and fourth and averaging 15.3 and 15.0 assists per game, respectively.

• New Mexico is the only team in the conference with three different players in the top-10 of the league in scoring in Elijah Brown (19.4 ppg, second), Tim Williams (16.2 ppg, fifth) and Cullen Neal (14.7 ppg, 10th). Additionally, Williams leads the league in field goal percentage, shooting 59.4 percent (104-of-175) from the floor this season.

• Jalen Moore is the player to watch for Utah State, ranking eighth in the league with 14.9 points per game, 19th with 5.6 rebounds per game, eighth in field goal percentage (.425), sixth with 33.2 minutes per game and having scored in double digits in each of the Aggies' last nine games.

BASKETBALL COACH'S LUNCHEON

Utah State men's basketball will host eight coach's luncheons this season, hosted by the Big Blue Scholarship Fund. The next luncheon is scheduled for Monday, Jan. 11, at the Homewood Suites located at 423 W. 300 S., in Salt Lake City.

LOOKING AT UTAH STATE

Utah State is 9-5 on the year, including a 1-2 mark in Mountain West play. The Aggies have dropped each of their last two games, falling at home to San Diego State (70-67) and Boise State (76-61).

Utah State is averaging 72.1 points per game, while shooting 44.6 percent (360-of-807) from the floor, 35.3 percent (106-of-300) from behind the 3-point line and 68.8 percent (183-of-266) from the free throw line. Individually, USU is paced by junior wing **Jalen Moore** with a team-best 14.9 points per game, including double-digit points in each of his last nine games. He is followed by senior guard **Chris Smith** with 12.9 points per game and redshirt

junior forward **Lew Evans** with 9.9 points per game. The trio also leads the team on the boards with Evans first with 6.3 rebounds per game, followed by Smith with 5.9 and Moore with 5.6 rebounds per game, respectively. Junior guard **Shane Rector** leads the team with 50 assists on the year and has recorded five or more in five games this year.

Defensively, Utah State has allowed opponents score 68.1 points per game, fourth-best in the Mountain West, and shoot 43.7 percent (353-of-807) from the floor, 35.4 percent (99-of-280) from behind the 3-point line and 66.2 percent (149-of-225) from the free throw line. **Rector** leads the team with 17 steals on the year, while Smith leads the team with nine blocks on the year.

UTAH STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL

Overall, Utah State returns 10 players from a team that finished 18-13 in 2014-15, including an 11-7 mark in the Mountain West. The 11 wins were the most by any second-year program in the history of the conference. The Aggies return four starters in **Smith, J. Moore, Julion Pearre** and senior guard **Darius Perkins**.

Head Coach **Tim Duryea** is in his first year at the helm of the Aggies, but has been a member of the staff for the previous 14 years under Stew Morrill. Duryea became one of just 12 head coaches in the history of Utah State basketball to post a win in their debuts, with the 73-70 victory at Weber State.

AGGIES PICKED THIRD IN MOUNTAIN WEST

Utah State men's basketball was selected third in the annual preseason Mountain West men's basketball poll. The prediction is the highest for the Aggies since joining the Mountain West and highest since USU was selected to win the Western Athletic Conference in its final season in the league during the 2012-13 season.

LAST TIME OUT

LOGAN, Utah - For the second time in as many home games, Utah State's men's basketball team struggled in the second half and Boise State took advantage in a 76-61 victory over the Aggies on Tuesday night at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum. The Broncos (11-4, 2-0 Mountain West) shot 59.6 percent from the field (28-of-47) and outscored Utah State 45-32 after halftime to pull away. The last time a team shot that well against the Aggies was during the 2010-11 campaign, when Hawai'i shot 63.2 in a 74-66 loss to Utah State. Junior wing Jalen Moore scored in double figures for the ninth consecutive game for the Aggies as he led all scorers in the game with 18 points on 8-of-19 shooting from the field. However, he was the lone Utah State player to reach double-digit scoring. Utah State (9-5, 1-2), which lost back-to-back home games for the first time since the 2013-14 season, shot 43.9 percent from the field (25-of-57), including 27.3 percent from 3-point range (6-of-22). The Aggies struggled at the charity stripe, making just 5-of-13 free throw attempts (38.5 percent). In Utah State's 70-67 home loss to San Diego State last Saturday night, the Aztecs started the second half on a 10-0 run. Redshirt senior guard Mikey Thompson paced four Broncos in double-figure scoring with 17 points on 5-of-8 shooting from the field and 7-of-8 from the free-throw line. Sophomore guard Chandler Hutchison and junior forward Nick Duncan each added 15 points, while redshirt junior forward James Webb III chipped in 12. Defensively, the Aggies shut down Anthony Drmic, the Broncos' second-leading scorer at 14.9 points per game coming in. However, the redshirt senior guard/forward was held to zero points on 0-for-4 shooting from the field. He did grab a game-best nine boards, however, helping Boise State outrebound Utah State 32-27. The Aggies couldn't have asked for a better start to the game as they scored the first six points courtesy of baskets by redshirt junior forward Lew Evans, senior guard Chris Smith and Moore. In fact, Moore and Smith combined to score 18 of Utah State's first 20 points of the night. Boise State didn't take its first lead of the night until redshirt senior guard Montigo Alford scored on a layup to make it 16-15 with 11:01 remaining in the first half. The Broncos led 31-29 at the break. The Aggies took their final lead of the night on a 3-pointer by Evans to begin the second half, making it 32-31. However, Utah State did not score for the next 2:27 and Boise State took advantage with an 8-0 run. The Aggies missed two shots and turned it over twice during that game-changing spurt. This was the Broncos' second straight win at the Spectrum. However, Utah State still leads the all-time series 30-11.

BOISE STATE AT UTAH STATE NOTABLES

- Utah State has lost back-to-back home games for the first time since the 2013-14 season when it dropped consecutive home games to San Diego State and New Mexico.
- Utah State is now 0-5 on the season when trailing at the half and 2-5 when scoring less than 70 points. Furthermore, USU is now 2-5 on the season when allowing 70 or more points in a game.
- Boise State shot 59.6 percent from the field (28-of-47), which is a season-high for an Aggie opponent and the highest shooting percentage against USU since Hawai'i shot 63.2 percent during the 2010-11 season. Overall, it is the second time this year that a USU opponent has shot 50 percent from the field (Duke, 55.6%).
- Junior wing **Jalen Moore** scored in double-figures for the ninth-straight game, 12th time this year and 45th time in his career with his 18 points. It is also the 13th-straight conference game that he has scored in double-figures. Moore's 19 field goal attempts are the most by an Aggie since Jarred Shaw attempted 20 shots against Nevada during the 2013-14 season. Moore also tied his season-high with 39 minutes played and had five rebounds, marking the 10th time this year and 39th time in his career he has grabbed at least five rebounds in a game.

SCOUTING NEW MEXICO

New Mexico is 9-6 on the year and 2-0 in the Mountain West, having opened their league slate with victories over Nevada (88-76) and on the road at Fresno State (77-62). The Lobos are 7-1 at home this season.

UNM averages 77.5 points per game while shooting a Mountain West-best 47.2 percent (406-of-860) from the floor, 35.7 percent (92-of-258) from behind the 3-point line and 73.7 percent (258-of-350) from the free throw line. The Lobos are led by a trio of double-digit scorers in redshirt sophomore Elijah Brown (19.4 ppg), redshirt junior forward Tim Williams (16.2 ppg) and redshirt sophomore guard Cullen Neal (14.7 ppg). Williams also leads the team on the glass, averaging 7.3 rebounds per game. Neal leads the team in assists, totaling 66 on the year.

Defensively, opponents have averaged 72.5 points per game while shooting 42.3 percent (379-of-896) from the floor, 31.8 percent (104-of-327) from behind the 3-point line and 67.2 percent (225-of-335) from the free throw line. Brown leads the team in steals (16), while junior center Obij Agete paces the team with 24 blocks.

Head coach Craig Neal is in his third season at the helm in Albuquerque, compiling an overall mark of 51-29 over that span, including a 3-1 mark against the Aggies.

SERIES HISTORY AGAINST NEW MEXICO

Utah State and New Mexico will meet for the 28th time on Saturday, with the Aggies holding an all-time series lead of 20-7. The Aggies are 6-2 on the road, including a 63-60 victory in Albuquerque last season.

LAST TIME AGAINST NEW MEXICO

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. - Utah State led for the entire second half and captured a 63-60 victory at New Mexico on Saturday afternoon, posting its first win in the Pit since the 1979 season. The result puts the Aggies at 13-10 on the year and 6-5 in the Mountain West and gives the Lobos an overall mark of 14-9 and a league mark of 6-5. New Mexico had the largest lead of the first half after using a 7-0 run over the span of a minute-and-a-half to take a 15-6 advantage with 13:02 on the clock. Utah State battled back late in the half to tie the contest at 22-22 with 4:56 to play, but back-to-back baskets put the Aggies back down four, 26-22, with just under four minutes. USU recorded back-to-back baskets of its own over the final two possessions as junior guard Chris Smith hit a pair of 3-pointers, including a buzzer beater to give the Aggies a 33-30 lead going into the break. Utah State's lead grew to six after halftime as sophomore wing Jalen Moore converted a 3-point play, putting the Aggies up 36-30. The Lobos only got to within two as the second half wore on, and Utah State took its largest lead of 10, 56-46, on a jumper by junior guard Darius Perkins with 7:51 to play. UNM came back to within three, 63-60, with 1:56 to play, but neither team was able to score down the stretch, leading to the final score. Moore led all scorers with 19 points and added a career high three blocks. He was followed by Smith with 13 points and a career-high two steals, and Collette and Perkins with 10 points apiece. Collette recorded his second double-double of the year after leading the team with 12 rebounds and adding four blocks to move to No. 3 all-time in a single season with 48 on the year. New Mexico was led by Obij Agete with 10 points and 11 rebounds as the Lobos finished the game shooting 43.4 percent (23-of-53) from the floor, 20.0 percent (3-of-15) from behind the 3-point line and 64.7 percent (11-of-17) from the free throw line. Utah State wrapped up its night shooting 47.2 percent (25-of-53) from the floor, 30.4 percent (7-of-23) from long range and 60.0 percent (6-of-10) from the charity stripe.

UTAH STATE MEN'S BASKETBALL

COACHING DEBUTS

Head coach **Tim Duryea** is the 12th Aggie coach in school history to win his first-ever game as head coach joining **E. Lowell Romney, Robert Burnett, D.D. Young, H.B. Lee, Joe Whitesides, H. Cecil Baker, Ladell Andersen, T.L. Plain, Dutch Belnap, Rod Tueller** and **Stew Morrill**. In all, USU has had 18 head coaches in this its 111th season of basketball.

Furthermore, Duryea is the sixth head coach in school history to start his career with four consecutive wins.

HOME SWEET HOME

Utah State will call the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum home for the 46th season, amassing a 548-128 (.811) record on its home court.

ALL-TIME RESULTS

Utah State has an overall record of 1,545-1,064 (.592) in its 2,609 games played.

LONG RANGE BOMBERS

Utah State has hit at least one 3-point basket in 309 games, stretching back to Dec. 16, 2006.

MAKING A SPLASH

Utah State used four bench players in its season-opening victory at Weber State and each made their respective debuts against the Wildcats. The quartet of junior guard **Shane Rector**, redshirt junior forward **Lew Evans**, redshirt senior forward **Grayson Moore** and redshirt freshman forward **Quinn Taylor** combined to score 34 points, the most by the bench since the USU bench scored 34 against San José State on January 4, 2014.

The Utah State reserves followed up that performance with 39 against Utah Valley, the most bench points since the Aggies scored 45 against Troy on Dec. 21, 2013.

The Aggies' bench has recorded eight outings with 20 or more points and three outings with 30 or more points.

BACKUP BRIGADE

Utah State's bench has recorded more points than the opposition's reserves in nine of 14 games this season. The Aggies have outscored opponents' benches 310 to 210.

QUICK STARTERS

Utah State has posted 500 first-half points to the opposition's 435 so far this season. The Aggies have outscored their opponent by an average of 4.6 points in the first half this season. USU is a perfect 9-0 this season when leading at the break.

REBOUNDING BATTLE

Utah State outrebounded nine of its 14 opponents this season and is 7-0 on the year when winning the battle of the boards. The Aggies currently hold a plus-2.1 advantage on the glass.

BOXING OUT

Utah State is strong in limiting opponents' second-chance points this season, collecting a defensive rebound close to 75 percent of the time (.732) on an errant shot by its foe.

DROPPING DIMES

Junior guard **Shane Rector** made the most in the first two starts of his career, recording double-digit points at both Missouri State (12) and BYU (12) and recording matching career-highs of six assists in each contest.

SHARING MEANS CARING

Utah State is strong as a team when it comes to assists, ranking fourth in the Mountain West with 15.0 helpers per game.

LEADERS AT THE BREAK

Utah State has picked up all nine of its victories this season when leading at halftime.

BETTER SHOOTING LEADS TO BETTER RESULTS

Utah State has not lost this season (7-0) when shooting better from the field than its opponent.

LOCK DOWN DEFENSE

Utah State is among the best in the Mountain West in scoring defense, holding opponents to 68.1 points per game, fourth-best in the league. The Aggies are 7-0 this season when holding opponents to less than 69 points per game.

STARTING MIX

Utah State has used the same starting line-up in each of the last six games: Shane Rector, Darius Perkins, Chris Smith, Jalen Moore, Lew Evans. That starting five is currently 5-2 on the year.

START-TO-FINISH

Utah State has led start-to-finish in two games this season, a 73-49 victory over Union (Tenn.) and Mountain West-opening 80-71 victory at San José State.

SMALL SCREEN STARS

Utah State will appear on national television 18 times during the 2015-16 season. The Aggies will appear on the ESPN family of networks nine times, ROOT Sports seven times and the CBS Sports Network three times.

HOME GROWN

Utah State's 2015-16 roster includes four from the state of Utah in redshirt senior forward **Grayson Moore** (North Logan/Sky View HS), redshirt junior forward **Lew Evans** (Salt Lake City, Utah/Highland HS), junior wing **Jalen Moore** (North Logan/Sky View HS), and freshman guard **Jake Miles** (Morgan/Morgan HS).

DIALED IN FROM DEEP

Utah State returns four of its top-five 3-point shooters that helped Utah State set a school record with 591 attempts from behind the arc, converting the second most in school history with 233, in 2014-15. Senior guard **Chris Smith** is the top returner for the Aggies, shooting 47.4 percent (63-of-133), fifth best in a single season in USU men's basketball history.

WE'RE GOING TO OVERTIME

Utah State is 55-45 all-time in overtime contests.

3-POINT RECORD BOOK BARRAGE

Utah State's 233 3-point field goals and 591 3-point field goal attempts in 2014-15 are both among the most in school history, ranking second and first on the all-time record books at USU.

RECORD-SETTING SWATS

Utah State's 142 blocks in 2014-15 were a new school record, eclipsing the previous total of 139 set during the 1989-90 season.

BALL SECURITY

Utah State was in the top-20 nationally in taking care of the ball in 2014-15, committing just 10.4 turnovers per game, which ranked No. 18 in the nation.

SUPER SOPHOMORE YEAR

Jalen Moore finished in some elite company among USU history as he led the team in scoring with 15.2 points per game in 2014-15. Moore joined All-Americans **Cornell Green** (20.4 ppg), **Wayne Estes** (28.3 ppg), **Marvin Roberts** (22.4), three-time all-Big West honoree **Greg Grant** (17.4 ppg), two-time all-Big West honoree **Kendall Youngblood** (18.8 ppg) and first-team all-WAC honoree **Preston Medlin** (17.0), who each led the team in scoring as a sophomore.

Moore's 470 points are the most by a sophomore since All-American **Jaycee Carroll** scored 521 during his sophomore campaign in 2005-06.

SCORING THREATS

Utah State was the only team in the Mountain West in 2014-15 with three players in the top 10 of the league in scoring last season and return two in junior wing **Jalen Moore** (sixth, 15.2) and senior guard **Chris Smith** (10th, 12.6).

RETURN AND SHARE

Utah State returns four of its top-five assist leaders, with the group recording a Mountain West-best 15.5 assists per outing in league play. Senior guard **Darius Perkins** led the team with 101 assists during the 2014-15 campaign.

SOMETHING OLD, SOMETHING NEW

Head coach **Tim Duryea** will be entering his 15th year with the program, but just his first year at the helm at Utah State in 2015-16. Duryea has served as an assistant coach for the past 14 seasons.

ALL-CONFERENCE RETURNERS

Utah State returns two of its all-conference honorees from last season in junior wing **Jalen Moore** (second team all-MW) and senior guard **Chris Smith** (honorable mention all-MW).

BEST AMONG THE MOUNTAIN WEST

In the Mountain West, Utah State finished among the top five in 11 categories, including 3-point field goal percentage (first, .394), defensive 3-point field goal percentage (first, .297), 3-point field goals made (second, 8.7), assist/turnover ratio (second, 1.4), blocks (third, 4.6 bpg), assists (third, 14.4 apg), defensive rebounds (fourth, 24.6 drpg), field goal percentage (fourth, .452), scoring offense (fourth, 66.6 ppg), scoring defense (fifth, 63.6 ppg) and defensive field goal percentage (fifth, .403).

TEAM OF THE MILLENNIUM

Utah State has one of the top winning percentages since the turn of the Millennium in 2000, ranking No. 6 with a mark of .730 (387-143) going into the 2015-16 season.

HEAD COACH TIM DURYEA

North Texas, 1988
First Year (15th Overall)

Head coach Tim Duryea (pronounced Dur-yea) will enter his first season at the helm of Utah State men's basketball in 2015-16 after having served as a member of the coaching staff for the past 14 seasons. Duryea had been the longest tenured assistant coach in program history before taking over in April of 2015 and becoming the 18th head coach for USU men's basketball.

In his 14 seasons at Utah State, Duryea has been part of an Aggie program that has averaged 23.6 wins per season, advanced to the NCAA Tournament six times (2003, 2005, 2006, 2009, 2010, 2011), and won five conference championships in the Big West (2003) and Western Athletic Conferences (2008, 2009, 2010, 2011) while winning four conference tournament titles in the Big West (2003, 2005) and WAC (2009, 2011).

In seven seasons leading up to his appointment as head coach, Duryea was in charge of an Aggie offense that traditionally was one of the best in the nation. The 2014-15 season was no different as Utah State led the Mountain West and ranked No. 14 nationally in 3-point shooting (.394), while also ranking second in the conference and No. 17 in the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.38), and second in the conference and No. 19 nationally in fewest turnovers per game (10.4). Individually, USU had the best field goal shooter in the Mountain West in redshirt freshman forward David Collette, who was No. 14 in the nation at 59.1 percent (163-of-276).

In 2013-14, Utah State ranked second in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage (.406), as well as No. 12 in assists per game (15.9) and No. 19 in assist-to-ratio (1.44). During the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons, USU ranked No. 24 nationally in field goal percentage at 47.5 and 46.9 percent, respectively, while ranking No. 28 nationally in field goal percentage (.470) during the 2010-11 campaign.

During the 2009-10 season, Utah State ranked third nationally in 3-point field goal percentage (.414), ninth in overall shooting (.488) and 10th in free throw shooting (.758), and was the only team in the nation to rank among the top-10 in all three shooting categories. During the 2008-09 season, USU finished the year as the nation's best shooting team (.496) and ranked No. 17 in 3-point field goal percentage (.394).

Duryea spent his first seven seasons at Utah State in charge of an Aggie defense that traditionally ranked among the top in the nation in points allowed, including No. 4 in 2002 (58.1), No. 8 in 2005 (57.8) and No. 9 in 2003 (60.0).

During his time as an assistant at Utah State, the Aggies recorded a dozen 20-win seasons, including setting the school record for wins with a 30-5 mark during the 2008-09 season and a 30-4 mark during the 2010-11 campaign. USU also had 18 players earn a total of 30 all-conference honors during the past 14 years, including three WAC Players of the Year in Jaycee Carroll (2008), Gary Wilkinson (2009) and Tai Wesley (2011). Furthermore, USU had three players earn All-American citations a total of four times with Duryea on staff in Carroll (2007, 2008), Wilkinson (2009) and Wesley (2011).

Along with his on-the-court responsibilities, Duryea also oversaw academic progress while as an assistant at Utah State, which resulted in 22 Aggies earning academic all-conference honors a total of 40 times over the last 14 years, while nearly 90 percent of USU's players during that time graduated.

Prior to joining the Aggies, Duryea was the head coach at Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College from 2000-01. During his two years at the helm, his teams produced a 40-25 record and back-to-back trips to the Region Six Championships.

A 1988 graduate of North Texas, Duryea began his coaching career in 1988 at Colorado State before moving on to North Texas in 1993. Duryea then went to Hutchinson (Kan.) Community College as an assistant coach for two seasons before becoming the head coach there prior to the 1999-2000 season.

Duryea played basketball at Denton (Texas) High School and Texas Pan-American before transferring to North Texas. At UNT, Duryea was a co-captain in 1988 for one of only three teams in school history to advance to the NCAA Tournament.

Duryea and his wife Angie have 20-year-old twins, Tanner (son) and Taylor (daughter), and a 13-year-old daughter (Kaylee). Tanner is a sophomore lacrosse player at Westminster (Utah), while Taylor is a sophomore volleyball player at Dixie State (Utah).


