

# ***POSTGAME NOTES: BOISE STATE 73, NEW MEXICO 71***

- UNM continues to lead the all-time series against Boise State, now 10-5

## In-Game Notes

- Joe Furstinger set a new career-high in blocks with five.
- Two Lobos scored in double-digits in the first half including Dane Kuiper and Anthony Mathis (both had 10).
  - Kuiper, Mathis and Antino Jackson finished in double-digits (11, 17 and 10, respectively).
  - Mathis finished the game 4-for-6 from three.
- UNM shot 55.2% from the field in the first half (16-29) while holding Boise State to 39.3% (11-28).
  - New Mexico also held the Broncos to 14.3% shooting from the three-point line in the first half (1-7).
- The Lobos shot 47.8% from the three-point line on the night (11-23).
  - Tuesday night marks the 6<sup>th</sup> straight game the Lobos have scored 10 or more 3-pointers.
  - UNM has scored 10 or more 3-pointers in 17 games this season.
- The Lobos finished the game with 15 assists, compared to the Broncos' six.
- UNM scored its final seven points on free throws, not hitting a field goal in the final 7:33 of the game.
- UNM's bench outscored Boise State's 24 to 14.
- Boise State grabbed 41 rebounds to UNM's 26, including 14 offensive rebounds.
- The Broncos' outscored the Lobos in the paint 46-24.
