Last Time Out: Behind a season-high effort from senior Liv Roberts, the Wyoming basketball team (9-5 overall, 2-1 MW) held the Boise State Broncos (8-7 overall, 2-2) almost 20 points under its scoring average on its way to a 66-51 victory on Saturday afternoon. It's the first time since Jan. 10, 2015 that the Cowgirls earned a win in Boise.

"We talked about that if Liv (Roberts) can get off to the start like she did today, it really relaxes everyone," head coach Joe Legerski said. "Now as a group we need to continue to grow, because you can't expect her to do that night in and night out especially going 9-of-9 from the field. I don't think I've ever seen that. What an effort from a player to come up 25 points, six rebounds and 35 minutes of defense. Boise State puts tremendous pressure on you, pressing and doing different things. They made their run at the end and got it down with around 2 and a half minutes to go. The way Boise State shoots the ball, you have to come up with some big plays and Taylor (Rusk) hit two big threes that really gave us the cushion."

Roberts followed up her 20-plus point effort from Wednesday with a season-high 25 points along with six rebounds in 35 minutes of action. She was 9-of-9 (1.00) from the field, 2-of-2 (1.00) from beyond the arc and 5-of-7 (.714) from the charity stripe. Sophomore Taylor Rusk followed with a 12 point, five rebound and five assist effort, while junior Marta Gomez chipped in 11. The Cowgirls shot 23-of-48 (.479) from the field and a season-high 10-of-16 (.625) from beyond the arc. They out rebounded Boise State 32-26, had 10 assists on 17 made baskets and 26 points in the paint.

"We keep talking about having to rest Taylor. She's been playing around 38 minutes. Tonight she played 36 so I guess we accomplished that. When you are 4-of-5 from three, have five defensive rebounds, five assists and the most difficult match-up. She continues to impress, play well and it was exactly what we needed. We had so many good efforts tonight."

Junior Marta Hermida and sophomore Riley Lupfer led the way for the Broncos with 11 points and two assists each. Redshirt sophomore Ellie Woerner followed with seven points while senior Shalen Shaw recorded a team-high seven rebounds and six points. Boise State shot 17-of-55 (.309) from the field and 11-of-12 (.917) from the free throw line.

The teams traded early baskets to begin the game until four straight points by Hermida gave the Broncos and 8-5 advantage. A three by Roberts followed by a Baker layup gave the Cowgirls a 10-8 advantage through the media timeout. Wyoming would stretch that lead to eight, 16-8, with a Gomez three to cap an 11-0 run. Coleman hit a jumper for Boise State to end a five minute scoring drought to close out the quarter. UW shot 6-of-12 (.500) from the field and 3-of-3 (1.00) from beyond the arc. The Cowgirls kept that momentum going and opened up the second period with ten straight points to extend the lead to 16, 26-10. Amundsen hit a three to stop the Boise State scoreless stretch and would start and 8-2 run to close the gap to ten, 28-18. Wyoming scored the final four points of the half to take a 32-18 advantage in to the locker room.

Roberts led all scorers in the first half with 14 points plus three rebounds. Gomez followed with 11 points with nine of those coming from beyond the arc, along with four rebounds. UW shot 10-of-22 (.455) from the field and 5-of-6 (.833) from beyond the arc. They out rebounded the Broncos, 16-15, and had 15 points off the bench. Boise State was led by Hermida with nine points, while two others had three. Junior Joyce Harrell and Shaw each brought down three rebounds. BSU was 8-of-30 (.267) from the field and 2-of-6 (.333) from beyond the arc.

Boise State scored the first five of six points to begin the third to pull within ten, 33-23. Six unanswered by the Cowgirls pushed it back to a 16-point advantage, 39-23, forcing a Bronco timeout. A basket by Woerner ended a three-minute scoring drought, but Rusk hit back to back three point field goals to push the lead to 18, 45-27. Boise State scored six of the final eight to finish out the third making it 47-33 in favor of the Cowgirls headed in to the final quarter. After a three by junior Sladjana Rakovic, the Broncos scored five straight to make it 50-35, which was answered with five points from junior Clara Tapia extending it back to a 17-point lead, 55-38, with 6:05 left on the clock. Boise State wouldn't go away and scored 11 of the next 14 over the next three minutes to pull to within single digits, 58-49. A basket by Roberts slowed it down, but Amundsen hit a pair of free throws to get it under ten, 60-51, with under three to go. Rusk stepped up again with two from beyond the arc as the Cowgirls held Boise State scoreless the remainder of the way and on to the 66-51 victory.

Scouting the Lobos: Wyoming returns home on Wednesday to host the league-leading New Mexico Lobos. UNM enters the contest with a 15-2 overall mark and a 3-1 mark in the league. Redshirt senior Tesha Buck leads the way with 15.9 points and 4.4 rebounds, while senior Cherise Beynon follows with 15.0 points. Junior Jaisa Nunn is averaging a team high 10.4 boards along with 15.0 points. As a squad, the Lobos are outscoring opponents 86.4-72.6. They return three starters and five letterwinners to a team that went 15-15 overall and 10-8. This will be the 74th meeting between the two schools. New Mexico leads the series 39-34. The last time the two teams met was February 25, 2017 with the Cowgirls holding on to a 60-58 victory. The Lobos are coached by Mike Bradbury who is in his second season with the program.

2017-18 Cowgirl Basketball Conference Information

Three Cowgirl Basketball Players Garner Postseason Honors, Legerski named Coach of the Year: Three members of the Wyoming Cowgirl basketball team, Liv Roberts, Marta Gomez and Taylor Rusk, were recognized as the Mountain West announced the 2017 All-Conference Team. Head Coach Joe Legerski was selected the 2017 Coach of the Year by his peers. Roberts was named to the All-MW and All-Defensive Teams for the first time in her career while Gomez was selected the Sixth Player of the Year. Rusk earned a spot on the league's All-Freshman Team. Roberts, a junior from Missoula, Mont., played in 25 contests along with 14 conference games before suffering a season-ending knee injury. She led the team in nine statistical categories overall including points and rebounds, plus leading the way in ten conference categories. In league games, she ranked among the Top 15 in eight statistical categories. Roberts scored in double-digits in all but one contest she played, reached double-figures in rebounding five times which included four double-doubles. She led the team in rebounding ten times, nine times in scoring and six times in assists. Gomez played in all 18 games during conference action. She averaged 8.9 points and 2.6 rebounds in 25.1 minutes per play. She led the team in three-point field goals made and attempts while being ranked among the top 15 in those two categories in league games. Gomez recorded nine double-figure scoring games which included an 18-point performance against UNLV. A freshman from Highlands Ranch, Colo., Rusk played in all 18 league games including her first career start against Boise State. She averaged 7.2 points and 2.8 rebounds in league play. Rusk led the league in three-point field goal percentage for all games and was second overall in league games. She finished with four double-figure scoring games including a career-high 14 points against San Jose State. Legerski earned Coach of the Year honors for the second time in his career. The 14th-year head coach also received the award following the 2003-04 season. He helped lead the Cowgirls to a 20-plus win season for the eighth time in his career and a program best 13 conference victories. The all-time winningest head coach in school history he has amassed 266 overall wins and an MW best 133 conference victories.

Cowgirls For Three: The Wyoming Cowgirl basketball team has made it a habit from shooting from beyond the arc. Through the Drake game (11/21/17), UW had made a three-point field goal in every game during the season and 50 consecutive games. The streak ended on Nov. 25, 2017 against Northern Iowa when the Cowgirls went 0-8 (.000) from beyond the arc..

Legerski for 275: Head coach Joe Legerski reached another milestone in his stellar career. With the 66-60 win over the Nevada Wolf Pack (1/3/18), he reached 275 wins for his career. Already the winningest coach in school history, he recorded that mark with a 72-50 win over Waves on Nov. 24, 2012. His current record stands at 276-171 (.619), while his conference mark is 135-94 (.590). He overtook Chad Lavin who completed his coaching career at Wyoming with 175 wins.

Bringing In The Crowd: The Cowgirls are averaging 2,502 fans for the 2017-18 campaign with a total of 15,010. Their largest regular season crowd of the year was 2,608 against Adams State (11/11/17).

Cowgirls Ink Four: University of Wyoming Cowgirl head basketball coach Joe Legerski announced the signing of four student-athletes to attend the University of Wyoming beginning in the fall of 2018.

Karla Erjavec (Air Yah Vets), 5-10, Guard, Zagreb, Croatia (Sport Gymnasium): A member of the U18 National Team in Croatia. This past summer, she averaged 15.1 points, three rebounds and 1.6 assists in the U18 FIBA Women's European Championships. Her U18 team won four gold medals in the U18 State Championships and was a finalist in the U16 Championships three times. She was a two-time MVP and Best Five selection during her career. She is the daughter of Mladen and Ivana Erjavec. She has one sibling, David.

Maria Torreblanca (Tor ee blank uh), 5-10, Guard, Melilla Spain (IES Joaquin Blume): A member of Segle XXI for the past two seasons and Adalucia Promesas prior to that. She was a member of the U16 National Team that finished first at the 2016 FIBA European Championships. JOE LEGERSKI

(WYOMING, 1979)

University of Wyoming, Head Women's Basketball Coach

Joe Legerski will be entering his 15th season in 2017-18 as the head women's basketball coach at the University of Wyoming. He was named head coach on May 1, 2003 and became the sixth head coach in Cowgirl history.

In 2016-17, it proved to be an extremely successful stint for Legerski and the Cowgirls. The team improved nine games from the previous year going 22-10 overall along with a 13-5 record in league action. The 20-plus wins marked the eighth time in Legerski's career that mark has been reached and the 22 wins were seventh most all-time in school history. The 13 conference wins were the most wins in conference play in program history. The team had a nine game winning streak during the season which was the longest since the 2007-08 season when they won 12 in a row. Legerski would notch his 250th career victory with a 68-48 win over Southern Utah (12/2/16). His overall record stands at 267-166 while he holds a 133-93 mark in league play. Three individuals were selected for postseason honors. Junior Liv Roberts was named to the All-Conference and All-Defensive Teams, sophomore Marta Gomez was named the Sixth Player of the Year and newcomer Taylor Rusk was selected to the All-Freshman Team. For the accomplishments on the season, Legerski was named the MW Coach of the Year for the second time in his career.

He recorded his first career coaching victory on Dec. 13, 2003, as Wyoming defeated Montana State Billings, 62-51. His first conference win came on Jan. 17, 2004 against rival BYU.

In his first season, he guided the Cowgirls to an 11-18 record overall and a 6-8 mark in the Mountain West including their first ever Mountain West Tournament victory in school history. Two Cowgirls also garnered All-Conference awards as he earned MW Coach of the Year honors in his first year with the program.

In 2004-05, he helped the Cowgirls to a 16-12 overall mark, along with a 7-7 record and a fourth place finish in the MW. It was the highest they'd finished in conference play since 1996-97. They swept BYU for the first time since 1994-95 and earned a 72-67 win over the Colorado Buffaloes which snapped a 13-game losing streak. Three Cowgirls earned All-MW awards including Ashley Elliott who earned First Team All-MW honors for the second year in a row.

For the 2005-06 season, the Cowgirls completed the year 21-9 overall, while finishing 10-6 overall in the Mountain West Conference. They made an appearance in the WNIT for only the third time in school history. The 21-wins were at the time the most since the 1989-90 season when they went 24-8 and the ten conference victories at the time tied an all-time school record which was set in 1978-79. Three Cowgirls garnered All-Conference honors, including Hanna Zavec who earned First Team All-MW and Defensive Player of the Year honors along with Megan McGuffey who took home the MW Newcomer of the Year award.

During the 2006-07 campaign, it was a magical year for Legerski and the Cowgirls as they won the WNIT Postseason Championship over the Wisconsin Badgers. Wyoming went 6-0 enroute to the championship. They completed the season with a program best 27-9 record, which eclipsed the 24-8 mark set in 1989-90, and the 11-5 record and second place finish in the league standings were the second most wins in both the MW and school history. It was the also the first time in school history that a Cowgirl team had won at least 20 games in back-to-back seasons, along with being invited to post season play. For the second year in a row, Hanna Zavec was named First Team All-MW and Justyna Podziemska was named MW Newcomer of the Year along with earning Second Team All-MW honors.

In 2007-08, the Cowgirls continued where they left off from the previous season as further marks were broken. They started off with an 18-1 record, which was the best start in school history, and tied for the best in the MW as well. With 24 wins, they recorded their third straight 20-win season, which had never been done in the programs' history, and with a 12-4 mark in conference play it also was the most conference wins breaking the 11 wins set the year before. Their play helped them earn the Cowgirl programs' first ever bid to the NCAA Tournament. For the first time in school history, they were also ranked among the Top 25 teams in the country by both the Associated

Press and USA Today/ESPN Division I Coaches' Poll. Their highest ranking was 15th in the AP (1/28/08) and 16th in the Coaches' Poll (1/29/08). As a team, they were ranked in either poll for 13 weeks during the season and received votes for the other six polls. Wyoming was also honored with several individual awards. Hanna Zavec was named First Team All-Mountain West for the third straight year, while being named the MW Defensive Player of the Year, Justyna Podziemska earned Second Team All-MW honors for the second straight year, and Aubrey Vandiver was awarded Third Team All-MW honors. Zavec also garnered Honorable Mention All-America accolades by the Associated Press and for the second year in a row was named to the State Farm Coaches' Honorable Mention All-America Team.

In his sixth season with the Cowgirls, they wrapped up the year with a 16-14 record overall and an 8-8 mark in MWC. With a victory over Denver (11/14/08), he would reach his 100th career victory, the fastest head coach to achieve that mark in school history. Four Cowgirls earned conference honors as Hillary Carlson was named Second Team All-MW, Megan McGuffey was Third Team All-MW, Kristen Scheffler was Honorable Mention All-MW and Emma Langford was named the Sixth Player of the Year.

Under his guidance in 2009-10, the Cowgirls recorded a 20-win or more season finishing with a 21-12 overall record and a 9-7 mark in the MWC. It was the fourth time out of the five seasons that a Wyoming team had recorded 20-wins or more, along with their sixth consecutive winning season. His teams have played in postseason a record number of times as well. They had played beyond the regular season in four of his seven years, which included the last four of five. Three Cowgirls garnered conference honors for the seventh straight year under Legerski as Hillary Carlson and Aubrey Vandiver were each named to the Second Team All-MW, while Emma Langford earned Third Team All-MW honors.

It was another record setting year for the Cowgirls during the 2010-11 basketball campaign. Wyoming posted their fifth 20-win season out of the previous six years by going 24-9 overall and 12-4 in the Mountain West. The 12 conference victories tied for the most wins set by the 2007-08 team and the 24 wins tied for the third most wins in school history. It also marked the Cowgirls seventh consecutive winning season and the second time in the last eight years they recorded back-to-back 20-win seasons. Wyoming continued their latest run through the post-season under Legerski. They were selected to participate in the WNIT for the second year in a row and the fourth time in the Legerski era. With a win over Air Force (1/22/11), he reached 150 wins for his career. The awards followed as well for UW. For the first time in MW history and only the second time in school history, a Cowgirl player earned Player of the Year honors. Aubrey Vandiver was named the Mountain West Player of the Year for her performance during the MW season. She and fellow senior Hillary Carlson were both named First Team All-MW, while Jade Kennedy and Chaundra Sewell each earned Honorable Mention All-MW.

It was a rebuilding year in 2011-12 with the program having to replace four graduating seniors including MW Player of the Year Aubrey Vandiver and First Team All-MW selection Hillary Carlson. Despite finishing the non-conference schedule 4-9, they would rally in Mountain West play to go 7-7 on their way to a fifth place finish. The Cowgirls finished the season 12-17 overall and 1-1 at the MW championships. They won their opener against the TCU Frogs but lost to the eventual conference champion and number one seed San Diego State Aztecs. Three players garnered postseason honors for the ninth straight year. Chaundra Sewell was selected Second Team All-Conference and to the All-Defensive Team. Freshman Kayla Woodward earned Third Team All-Conference honors followed by junior Ashley Sickles who was an Honorable Mention All-MW selection.

It was quite a turnaround in 2012-13 after a previous year that saw the Cowgirls win just 12 games. Wyoming started off the season going 12-4 overall in non-conference action which equaled their win total from the previous season. During that time, Legerski would become the all-time winningest coach with a 72-50 victory over Pepperdine (11/24/12). They finished the year off with a 24-8 overall record. The 24-wins tied for the third most in school history.

Wyoming has also reached 20-plus wins for the sixth time under Legerski. In league action, the Cowgirls improved their record by five games going 12-4 and finishing third. The 12-wins tied the most conference wins with the 2007-08 and 2010-11 teams. They reached the postseason for the sixth time in ten seasons as well. Four Cowgirls earned postseason honors for the tenth straight year led by senior Chaundra Sewell. She earned First Team All-Conference and All-Defensive Team honors. Sophomore Kayla Woodward was selected Second Team while senior Ashley Sickles and sophomore Kaitlyn Mileto were named Third Team All-Mountain West. Sewell also garnered WBCA Honorable Mention All-America honors and All-Region VII honors, while being named Capital One Third Team Academic All-American.

In 2013-14, several more records and marks were achieved within the program. Wyoming finished with a 20-11 overall mark and a 10-8 record in MW. The 20-wins marked the seventh time in the last nine years that a Cowgirl team has reached that mark. The program also reached its 600th win in school history with an 87-76 win over Fresno State (1/29/14). With a victory over Pepperdine (11/23/13), Legerski earned his 200th career victory. Two Cowgirls earned postseason honors led by junior Kayla Woodward. She was selected First Team All-MW and to the MW Championships All-Tournament Team. Woodward also garnered WBCA Honorable Mention All-America honors and All-Region VII honors. Senior Fallon Lewis was also selected Honorable Mention All-Mountain West.

In his 12th season with the Cowgirls, UW went 16-14 overall and 10-8 in league play for a fifth place finish. Two Cowgirls earned conference honors as Kayla Woodward and Marquelle Dent were each selected All-Mountain West. Dent also garnered WBCA Honorable Mention All-America and All-Region VII honors. Woodward was named CoSIDA First Team Academic All-District.

During the 2015-16 campaign, the Cowgirls finished with a 13-16 overall record and 6-12 in MW play. Two individuals were selected for postseason honors. Senior Marquelle Dent was named to the All-Conference and All-Defensive teams for the second straight year while newcomer Marta Gomez was selected to the MW All-Freshman team.

In his 14 years, the Cowgirls have been successful in the classroom as well. Including players that earned honors multiple times 79 Academic All-MW student-athletes while 49 have been MW Scholar Athlete.

Legerski came to Wyoming following a highly-successful stint at the University of Utah. As an assistant (1991-1998), and later associate head coach (1998-2003) for Elaine Elliott, he was part of the most successful women's program in the history of both the Western Athletic and Mountain West Conferences. The Utes compiled a 254-96 record while he was there, including seven league titles. They were 135-35 in conference play.

Legerski earned a bachelor of science degree in business education from UW in 1979. He was an assistant with the Cowgirls from 1987 through 1991, before taking the Utah position. He was the head women's basketball coach at Western Wyoming College (Rock Springs) for one season, finishing second in the region. Prior to that he was the head women's basketball coach at Rock Springs High from 1984 to 1986.

Legerski, and his wife, Jamie, are parents of three children, stepson Zane Beadles, daughter Madison and son Joseph III.

Gerald Mattinson

Associate Head Basketball Coach, Weber State '81

Gerald Mattinson will be entering his 15th season on the Cowgirl coaching staff and his 11th as an associate head coach.

He began his college basketball career as a student-athlete at Casper College for head coach Oscar "Swede" Ericson. While there, he was a First Team All-American and All-Region selection in 1978. Mattinson then moved onto a three-year career at Weber State University in Ogden, Utah. He earned All-Conference honors twice during his career for head coach Neil McCarthy. A two-time Academic All-American selection, he graduated from Weber State with a bachelor's of science degree in business education in 1981. He completed a master's of sports science degree from the United States Sports Academy in 1988 and earned his principal endorsement from the University of Wyoming.

Mattinson's professional coaching career began at Weber State as a graduate assistant coach with the men's basketball program during the 1981-82 season. From 1982-1987, he was the head boy's basketball coach at Rock Springs High School. He earned Wyoming State Coach of the Year honors and was named Conference Coach of the Year twice. From 1987-90, Mattinson was an assistant men's coach at Western Wyoming Community College. He was elevated to an Assistant Athletics Director and the Head Men's Basketball Coach in 1991 and held the position until 1998. For the 1998-99 season, he became an assistant with the women's program for one year. Mattinson had been a business education teacher at Rock Springs High School since 1982 before taking the position of Principal at East Junior High School in June of 2001.

Mattinson, and his wife, Carey are the parents of three children, stepson Morgan Splichal, stepdaughter Tiffany Paradis and son Ashton.

Bojan Jankovic

Assistant Basketball Coach, University of the Ozarks, '06

Bojan Jankovic joined the Cowgirl basketball program in the summer of 2015. Jankovic came to Wyoming after a five-year stint at Oral Roberts University in Tulsa, Okla. He joined the ORU staff in 2010, and helped guide the Golden Eagles to the Southland Conference Championship in 2013. At ORU, Jankovic was responsible for international recruiting and scheduling, working with the post player's and game day preparation. He coached Sarah Shelton to All-Southland Conference honors in 2013 while in 2015 coached Vicky McIntyre to leading the nation in rebounds and blocks per game. She was drafted 20th by the Seattle Storm, the first player in Oral Roberts history. Also in his time at ORU, the Golden Eagles won 88 games and made four postseason appearances, including a 2013 trip to the NCAA Tournament and a pair of WNIT bids.

He also has experience coaching at the highest levels of international basketball. He currently serves as an assistant coach on the Serbian senior national team. The team won the gold medal during the 2015 European Championship which helped them qualify for the 2016 Rio Olympics. The team mounted an upset of the Australian's 73-71 in the quarterfinals before falling to Spain in the semifinals. The team would respond with a 70-63 win over France in the Bronze medal game. During the summer of 2013, the squad finished fourth at the European Championship which was at the time the highest in the nation's history. In 2014, the Serbian national team reached its best ever finish at the FIBA World Championships in Turkey finishing eighth. All-together, he has helped coach four players who have reached the WNBA, Ana Dabovic, Vicky McIntyre, Jelena Milovanovic and Sonja Petrovic.

Prior to that, Jankovic spent four seasons at Centenary College in Shreveport, La., serving as assistant coach for three years before taking over the head coaching duties for the 2009-10 season. He also assisted at the University of the Ozarks for one year, where he helped the men's basketball team achieve the most conference wins in team history.

He spent five years with Radnicki, a Division I Professional team in Serbia, where he served as the head coach for the U18 team. In 2004, he helped lead Radnicki's U18 team to a win in one of the largest tournaments on the European circuit in Goteborg, Sweden.

Jankovic started his playing career with Radnicki, and he also played at Belgrade Basketball Club before coming to the United States. Collegiately, he played at Mount Senario College in Ladysmith, Wis., leading the team to the National Small College National Championship in 1996. He received his degree from the University of the Ozarks in 2006. Jankovic and his wife Bojana have a daughter Anja and son Vuk.

Heather Ezell

Assistant Basketball Coach, Iowa State, '09

Heather Ezell is entering her third season as an assistant coach with the Wyoming basketball program in 2017-18. She came to Wyoming after spending the previous four seasons at Southeast Missouri State. She joined the staff in 2011 and was responsible for working with the guards along with organizing practices, game day preparation and running summer camps. In 2012-13, she helped mentor Kara Wright to an Ohio Valley Conference All-Newcomer selection, marking the first Redhawk to earn postseason honors since the 2008-09 season.

Ezell spent the 2010-11 season as an assistant coach at Fairfield University, where the Stags posted a 17-13 overall record and a 10-8 mark in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference. She worked primarily with perimeter players while assisting in the day-to-day operations of the program, including practice and game planning, recruiting and coordinating the team's community service efforts.

She had a highly decorated career both collegiately and professionally which began as a four-year letterwinner at Iowa State University (2005-09). She finished her career tied for the Cyclones' career record with 287 made three-point field goals and finished 10th in program history with 1,339 points. In her senior season, Ezell earned Second Team All-Big 12 honors. She ranked 27th nationally with 2.5 three-point field goals made per game and eighth in the Big 12 with 3.5 assists per contest. Ezell also earned a spot on the 2008 Big 12 All-Tournament Team and helped the Cyclones to three NCAA appearances including the Elite Eight in 2009.

Ezell moved onto the professional level in 2009-10, playing in Iceland for Haukar where she was named Best Player in the Iceland Express League. She led the league in points and steals while finishing second in assists and rebounds. She also earned Most Valuable Player recognition in the league's All-Star Game.

A native of Springfield, Mo., Ezell led her Kickapoo High School team to two state championships and a 113-7 record during her prep years. She was named Miss Show Me Basketball as Missouri's top player in 2005. Ezell graduated from Iowa State in 2009 with bachelor's degrees in management and marketing.

Fallon Lewis

Assistant Director of Player Development, Wyoming'14

Fallon Lewis joined the Cowgirl staff as the Director of Recruiting beginning in September 2015. She was named the Assistant Director of Player Development during the 2016-17 season. Lewis returned to her alma mater after spending eight months playing for CB Arxil in Pontevedra, Spain. In 24 games, she averaged 11.9 points and 6.5 rebounds in 27.8 minutes per contest. She also spent time over the summer as a private basketball trainer.

Lewis had a highly successful two-year career (2013-14) with the Cowgirls. An Honorable Mention All-Conference selection during her senior campaign, she played in 62 games with 31 starts. In her final season with Wyoming, she averaged 14.3 points and a team-leading 8.9 rebounds. Lewis also recorded 20 points and 21 rebounds in a game becoming only the second player in school history to achieve that. As a junior, she came off the bench and averaged 6.1 points and 3.6 boards in 31 contests. Prior to UW, she spent two seasons at Sheridan College from 2011-12. Lewis was an Honorable Mention NJCAA All-American selection in 2012 and a two-time Region IX All-Conference selection. She helped the Lady Generals to a 45-21 mark and a NJCAA North Sub-Region IX title over her two years.

A Dayton, Wyoming native, Lewis graduated with her degree in business administration from the UW in May of 2014 and was a two-time Academic All-Mountain West selection.

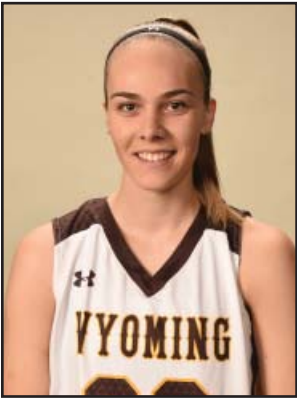
