

## ***POST-GAME NOTES: NEW MEXICO 79, NEW MEXICO STATE 61***

### **Streaks, Trends and In-Game Notes**

- The Lobos had a balanced scoring attack with four players in double digits, lead by Elijah Brown with 20. The three other Lobos scoring in double-digits were Tim Williams (18) Cullen Neal (13) and Sam Logwood (10).
- Lobos now hold a 120-96 advantage in the Rio Grande Rivalry, claiming four straight wins and 15 of the last 17 matchups.
- The Lobos now have a 73-38 advantage when playing at home against the Aggies.
- This is the first time that a Lobo opponent has failed to make a 3FG since 11/22/03.

### **RS-Junior Forward Tim Williams**

- Scored 18 points off of 9-for-15 shooting.
- This was his seventh double-digit scoring effort this season; the Lobos are 6-1 when Williams scores more than 10 points.

### **RS-Sophomore Guard Elijah Brown**

- Tied a season-high in assists with six.
- Scored a team-high 20 points, his fourth 20 point effort this season.
- This is Brown's eighth double-digit scoring effort this season, the Lobos have a 6-2 record when Brown scores more than 10 points.
- This is the fifth time this season that the Lobos were lead in scoring by Brown, the team is 4-1 in that span.

### **Sophomore Guard/Forward Sam Logwood**

- This is Logwood's second double-digit scoring effort of the season, the Lobos are 2-0 when he scores 10 or more.

### **RS-Sophomore Guard Cullen Neal**

- Had a career high in assists with 9, breaking his previous record of 7.

### **NMSU Sophomore Forward Pascal Siakam**

- This is only the second time this season that Siakam has not recorded a double-double, both of those times were against the Lobos.
