## LAST TIME OUT FOR THE LOBOS ...

New Mexico swept a home weekend with relative ease, taking down the Pacific Tigers 4-2 on Friday and then the Idaho State Bengals on Sunday by a 5-0 score. The Lobos got their nine goals from seven players, with Jessie Hix and Alesia Garcia scoring in each game, and Madi Hirschman picking up a goal and two assists against Idaho State.

### UNM VS. UC DAVIS

**ALL-TIME RECORD VS. UC DAVIS: 1-0-1**

The Lobos owns a 1-0-1 record against UC Davis, with the matches coming in 2012 and 2013. In 2012, UNM played UC Davis as a part of the UC Riverside Tournament, winning 2-0 to go 2-0 in that tourney, and the following year at the UNM Jack in the Box Classic, the two teams tied 0-0 in double OT.

### UNM VS. SAN FRANCISCO

**ALL-TIME RECORD VS. USF: 1-2-0**

The Lobos are 1-2-0 vs. San Francisco and this will be the first meeting at USF. The last meeting was the 2017 season opener, a 2-1 win at the UNM Soccer Complex for the Dons. The two teams also played in 1994 (3-2 USF win in Albuquerque in overtime) and 1997 (a 2-0 Lobo win at Stanford).

## THING TO WATCH FOR...

\*Alesia Garcia scored the game-winning goal in both games last weekend, giving her two for the season. She would need just three over the remainder of career to break into the top-10 list at UNM for career game-winning goals. She is a freshman.

\*UNM started two different keepers in goal, marking the first time UNM has started two different keepers since 2015, when Cassie Ulrich started 19 and midfielder/defender Victoria Archuleta started against New Mexico State in net due to an equipment/injury issue with Ulrich. Archuleta ended up playing the first 32:53 of that game.

\*New Mexico's 2-1 start is its best under Heather Dyche and its best since 2010, when the team opened 2-0-1. That squad actually started out 4-0-3 and eventually went 12-1-5 before losing its final two matches.

## NEW MEXICO NOTES

### THE BATTLE OF ALESIA

The Battle of Alesia was a military conflict that occurred in 52 B.C. (so like, NOT yesterday). That conflict was centered around the city of Alesia, and it marked the end of Gallic independence in France and Belgium. That has zero to do with Alesia Garcia, but she certainly claimed a bit of independence as a freshman, winning Mountain West Offensive Player of the Week honors as a freshman after scoring the game-winning goal in both wins over the weekend.

Garcia is tied with three other players in the league for the lead in game-winning goals with two.

### THE SONS OF CHAMPLIN PLAY ON THE SEPTEMBER 3..WE SHOULD STAY OVER!

One of the greatest bands to come out of San Francisco is the Sons of Champlin. They never hit it huge, but were sort of the Phish of their time frame, and they are still playing today. As to why they never hit it big, founder Bill Champlin, owner of two Grammys and the former lead singer of Chicago, likes to say, "every time opportunity knocked, we answered the phone." The Sons play near San Francisco on September 3, too late for the Lobo soccer team which will finally play a game in San Francisco for the first time ever, coming in their 25th anniversary season. UNM has played San Francisco three times, including two in Albuquerque. UNM is 0-2 in those games, but 1-0 vs. the Dons away from ABQ.

### POINT TAKEN

When you are a freshman playing at goalkeeper in your first career game, your thoughts are organize the defense, and stop the ball. Somewhere in the heart of every goalkeeper is a forward trying to get out, but in a first game, a keeper probably isn't thinking about say, assisting on the game winning goal. Enter Malia Vanisi.

With a 2-0 lead, Vanisi boomed a punt that went well beyond midfield. Jenna Killman raced onto the ball and flicked it into an open space to the running Alesia Garcia, who one-touched that home for what turned out to be the game-winning goal.

### MULTIPLE GOALS = LOBO WINS

Under Heather Dyche, the Lobos are 23-1-2 when scoring multiple goals in a game. The odd part of that stat is at one time UNM was 21-0-0. Then the oddities occurred. First, UNM lost on a free kick with seven seconds left in overtime in which the clock was stopped to allow the free kick to happen ... that was a 4-3 loss. That was followed by a pair of come-from-behind 2-2 ties, one while playing with 10 players, the other without leading scorer Claire Lynch in the Mountain West Tournament.

### RECORD IN THE CLASSROOM

Along with the success on the field, the UNM women's soccer program is proving to be one of the top teams off of it as well as the Lobos put together a 3.77 GPA in the 2018 spring semester. It's the 16th-consecutive semester UNM women's soccer has put together a 3.4 GPA or better, and the 3.77 GPA tied with the spring semester of 2017 for the highest team GPA.

### KEEPING IT GOING

The Lobos have turned in winning records in 12 of the last 13 seasons, and in all three under Heather Dyche. UNM also has an all-time home record of 112-70-25 at the UNM Soccer Complex.
