ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Saturday's game coming off of a close 65-62 loss against New Mexico State at home on Saturday, Dec. 9.
- The three-point margin loss came after UNM fell by 19 points to the Aggies in the teams' first meeting of the season on the road.
- This will be the first ranked team the Lobos have faced this season.
- Arizona enters the game riding a four-win streak after dropping three straight to NC State, SMU and No. 18/16 Purdue earlier in the season.
- Arizona's last four wins came over Long Beach State, UNLV, No. 7/9 Texas A&M and, most recently, Alabama.
- The Wildcats topped Alabama 88-82 at home on Saturday, Dec. 9 so both teams have had a week to rest.
- Last time the two teams met, the then-ranked No. 18 Wildcats claimed a 77-46 victory in Tucson on Dec. 20, 2016.
- The last time the two teams faced off in Albuquerque was on Jan. 16, 1999 in which UNM claimed a 79-78 victory over Arizona.
- The Lobos have a trio of players on the roster scoring in double digits on the season including Chris McNeal (13.3) and Anthony Mathis (10.6). Senior Sam Logwood, who could be out Saturday, leads the team with 14.9.
- Arizona is led by two players averaging over 20 ppg including Allonzo Trier (22.3) and Deandre Ayton (20.5).

SCOUTING ARIZONA

The Wildcats enter Saturday's game 7-3 on the season, their three losses coming back-to-back-to-back between Nov. 22 and Nov. 24. Over the Thanksgiving holiday, Arizona dropped contests to NC State, SMU and then-ranked No. 18/16 Purdue. Most recently however, the Wildcats are on a four-win streak that includes victories over Long Beach State, UNLV (in overtime), Texas A&M and Alabama.

The Wildcats average scoring 84.0 points per game and post a +10.1 scoring margin, allowing opponents to score 73.9 points per game. The squad also averages 12.7 turnovers per game and forces the same.

Leading Arizona on the season is a pair of players averaging in double figures - both of which are averaging scoring over 20 points per game. Junior Allonzo Trier posts 22.3 points per game while 7'1" freshman Deandre Ayton is averaging 20.5. Ayton also leads the team in rebounds per game with 11.9.

SERIES HISTORY

History between the Lobos and the Wildcats dates back to February 1, 1917 when the Lobos earned a 28-19 victory in Albuquerque. UNM suffered a 77-46 loss last season under previous head coach Craig Neal on the road in Tucson on Dec. 20, 2016. Prior to that meeting, the Lobos and the Wildcats had not faced off since Dec. 21, 1999 on the road when UNM won 70-68.

The last time Arizona made the trip The Pit was on Jan. 16, 1999 when the Lobos handed the Wildcats a one-point loss, 79-78.

Overall, Arizona leads the series 84-42. At home, UNM is 31-34 against the Wildcats, but the Lobos are 14-5 against Arizona in The Pit.

Arizona is one of UNM's oldest rivals, ranking sixth in most-games played at 126 since the 1916-17 season.

SENIOR STATUS

Two of UNM's four senior leaders are questionable for Saturday's game including Connor MacDougall, who has yet to play a game this season after suffering an injury in UNM's exhibition game against BYU. Also tentative for playing time is leading-scorer Sam Logwood who Coach Weir announced last week is taking a leave of absence to contemplate his future plans.

WHAT'S IN A HALF?

While the halftime score is not always indicative of the final outcome, UNM seems to

be playing that way. The Lobos are 0-6 when trailing at the half this season. Conversely, the Lobos are 3-1 when leading. The one loss came against Tennessee Tech when UNM was leading 55-51 at the half.

In the last two games, UNM has been right on the cusp at halftime, suffering a 35-33 deficit at the break against two of their toughest foes this season, NMSU and Colorado.

RISE TO THE CHALLENGE

The Lobo record may be 3-7 but those who look at the stats will tell you that UNM is improving tremendously as the season progresses. UNM has a history this season of rising to the challenge, having nearly upset TCU in Florida over the Thanksgiving holiday and also nearly earning a win over 2017 NCAA Tournament team NMSU at home Saturday. In addition, the Lobo defense stepped up against Colorado, performing well until the final minutes of a close game on the road in Boulder.

MAGIC 40%

The Lobos are 3-1 when shooting over 40% this season, but 0-6 when when shooting below the mark.

The Lobos have featured five different lineups this season over 10 games searching for that perfect starting-five combo.

Top returners for the Lobos include lone regular starter Sam Logwood who averaged 7.3 points per game for a .449 field goal percentage and a .671 percentage from the free throw line. All four other Lobos to return to UNM this season played in at least 10 games, including junior Dane Kuiper who started 13 games, averaging 6.0 points per game.

NEW COACH, NEW ERA

At the helm of the Lobos in the 2016-17 season will be head coach Paul Weir, officially named the 21st head coach in UNM men's basketball history on April 11, 2017. Weir spent the last season with New Mexico State where he finished 28-6 and led NMSU to a WAC Tournament Championship and an NCAA appearance. Weir is the first basketball coach to serve as the head coach for both New Mexico DI institutions.

LOBO TRANSFERS

Of the nine fresh faces to the UNM squad, the Lobos welcome in six new transfers, four of which will be eligible to compete in the 2017-18 season. Those that are eligible and will don the Lobo Cherry & Silver this season include junior Chris McNeal (Indian Hills), senior Antino Jackson (Akron), junior Jachai Simmons (Midland College) and junior Troy Simons (Polk State). The pair of transfers that will not see action this season is JaQuan Lyle (Ohio State) and Vance Jackson (UCONN) due to NCAA transfer rules.

LOBOS ON TV

The 2017-18 schedule includes many national and regional broadcasts of New Mexico basketball. The Lobos are currently slated for TV 22 times, including 13 of 16 Mountain West games. UNM had 22 of 26 UNM and MW controlled games selected for TV while three non-conference road games, at New Mexico State, at UTEP and at Colorado are expected to be broadcast as well. The Lobos will be on ATT SportsNet/ROOT eight times, on CBS Sports Network five times, ESPN3 five times, and ESPNU and the Mountain West Network on Stadium once. Additionally, two games (at UNLV on January 17 and January 27 at home against Colorado State) are flex games that will be either on ESPNU or ESPN3.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

After two years as WisePies Arena - The Pit, the famous home of Lobo basketball has been given a new name. While it will still be referred to as "The Pit," this season will be the first that the Lobos will compete in "Dreamstyle Arena" as part of an exciting \$10 million agreement for naming rights by Dreamstyle Remodeling of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues. In addition to the official renaming of the Lobo basketball arena, the UNM football stadium, formerly referred to as "University Stadium" is now officially named "Dreamstyle Stadium."

“The Pit” is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men’s basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

Just one Lobo on the 2017-18 roster hails from near as a New Mexico native, freshman Matt Vail. Of the remaining 13 players on the roster, two are from California (Joe Furstinger and Vance Jackson) and two more are from Indiana (Sam Logwood and JaQuan Lyle). That leaves nine players all from different states or countries.

The Lobo melting pot includes players from as close as Arizona (Connor McDougall) and Texas (Antino Jackson) and as far as Alaska (Dane Kuiper), New Jersey (Jachai Simons), Oregon (Anthony Mathis), Pennsylvania (Troy Simons) and Tennessee (Chris McNeal).

Not only are the Lobos’ home towns spread across the United States, but two come from overseas including freshmen Makuach Maluach from Sydney, Australia, and Vladimir Pinchuk from Schwelm, Germany.

Lobos Fall to NMSU in Last-Minute Heartbreaker

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- With 6:40 to go in one of the biggest and most intense rivalries in The University of New Mexico history, the Lobos led the New Mexico State Aggies by eight, 56-48, on Saturday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit before dropping a heartbreaker by a final score of 65-62. The Lobos missed a tough, last-second three-pointer that would have tied the game.

The Lobos (3-7) outshot the Aggies (7-2) from 3-point range 28.6 percent to 20.0 percent and from the free throw line (70.6-50.0) in the outstanding defensive effort while scoring 14 points off of 17 NMSU turnovers.

UNM was led by senior Antino Jackson who compiled 14 points, his second-highest total of the season, including three from behind the arc. Junior Troy Simons posted 13 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

"I think this was just a newer team trying to find its way against a veteran team that's won a lot of games," head coach Paul Weir said. "I think that NMSU knows how to win those (close) games and has the experience to do it, and we're still trying to figure that out."

"These guys are fighting and I can't say anything negative about them ... they are giving it all they've got, we just have to find a way to improve and find a way to win games like this before the season is over."

Despite being down their leading scorer in arguably one of the biggest games of the year, the Lobos battled and went up on the Aggies, who reached the NCAA Tournament last season as the WAC Champions, by as much as nine points with 10 minutes left in the game. Nine points was the largest lead of the game by either team.

Freshman Makuach Maluach earned his first career start on the night. At the 10-minute mark, Maluach slammed a crowd-pleasing, one-handed dunk with unmatched enthusiasm from an excited Lobo crowd.

NMSU responded with three points from the game's leading scorer Zach Lofton, who tallied a game-high 22 points on the night, to cut the Lobo lead to six and eventually whittle UNM's advantage to three, 56-53 with 5:21 left.

The Aggies cut the deficit to one, 57-58 on a Lofton jumper and overtook the Lobos at the 2:34 mark on a Lofton layup, holding on for the win.

Lobo junior Anthony Mathis, who has been hot from behind the arc as of late, got a good look with the seconds winding down, but was forced to shoot from deep at the last second and missed. Mathis is 48.2 percent (27-56) on the season from three. Senior Joe Furstinger nearly got the putback before time expired.

As a team, UNM shot 39.9 percent compared to 42.6 percent for NMSU. The game marked just the second time this season that UNM committed more turnovers than its opponent (19-17). NMUS outscored the Lobos in the paint, 36-20, but UNM collected more points on the fast break, 11-8. Both teams tallied 13 second-chance points on the night.

The Lobos will have seven days to recuperate from Saturday's game vs. NMSU before taking on Arizona on Saturday, Dec. 16 at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on CBS Sports Network at 6 p.m.

New Mexico Falls at No. 18 Arizona, 77-46

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. – The University of New Mexico men's basketball team fell to No. 18 ranked Arizona 77-46 on Tuesday night at the McKale Center in Tucson, Ariz. The Lobos are now 7-5 on the season and begin Mountain West action on Dec. 28 against Fresno State inside WisePies Arena – The Pit.

Elijah Brown led all scorers with 17 points. He was 5-for-13 from the field, including 1-for-4 from the three. He finished 6-for-9 from the foul line to along with two assists and a steal. Tim Williams finished with 14 points, shooting 7-for-16 from the field. Williams and Joe Furstinger led the team in rebounds with eight each.

The game didn't start out on a high note for the Lobos as they were down 9-0 to the Wildcats going into the first media timeout. They ended up shooting 22.6 percent from the field in the first half and did not make a three in six attempts.

The Lobos didn't get on the scoreboard until the 14:11 mark after a Williams two. Williams scored the next two within the next two minutes, but the Lobos could never get in an offensive rhythm, trailing at halftime 37-16.

The second half was filled with more energy from the Lobos as they held the Wildcats to four points within the first five minutes of the half. But fouls put the Wildcats at the line, extending their lead to 47-24. The Lobos came within 24 points with 6:14 left to play but couldn't stop the Wildcats at the line as they made eight in the final six minutes.

The Lobos did outscore the Wildcats off the bench 24-21. They also beat the Wildcats on the offensive rebound column 14-12. The Lobos finished the game shooting 26.2 percent from the field, 14.3 percent from the three and 62.5 percent from the foul line.

New Mexico will begin Mountain West play after the holiday on Dec. 28, facing Fresno State inside WisePies Arena – The Pit at 7 p.m. MT. The game will be available on ESPN3.

Arizona Battles Past Alabama 88-82

TUCSON, Ariz. (AP) — Deandre Ayton had 29 points and 18 rebounds, Allonzo Trier scored 20 of his 25 points in the second half and Arizona outlasted Alabama 88-82 Saturday night.

This was Arizona's first real home test and the fans were ready, making McKale Center louder than it's been all season.

The Wildcats (7-3) responded with their second quality win of the week, backing up a victory over No. 7 Texas A&M with a strong all-around performance to win their 45th straight nonconference home game.

Alabama (7-3) matched Arizona nearly shot for shot in one of college basketball's toughest road environments, pulling within 84-80 on Riley Norris' 3-pointer with 38 seconds left.

Trier, who took just six shots, hit three free throws in the final 34 seconds to seal it for Arizona.

Freshman Collin Sexton scored 21 of his 30 points in the second half to keep the Crimson Tide close.

For their first big home test, the Wildcats got back sophomore guard Rawle Alkins, a tough, emotional player who Miller hoped would give them a lift.

Arizona had a spark before Alkins even entered the game, efficiently working its offense during a 10-0 run that put the Wildcats up 24-13. The Crimson Tide fought back behind their defense, using a 13-2 run to tie it at 26-all.

Alabama had no one who could stop Ayton in the first half — 15 points and nine rebounds — but Sexton banked in a 3-pointer at the buzzer to put the Tide up 40-38.

The Crimson Tide went on a quick run to start the second half, but Arizona rallied and the teams traded athletic plays, neither to gain much separation.

Alabama closed in around Ayton to limit his shots, but Trier got free multiple times to keep the Wildcats around the lead.

Sexton was Alabama's go-to player, confidently stroking in long 3-pointers and driving to the basket.

BIG PICTURE

Alabama came up short, but handling a hostile environment at McKale Center and keeping it close against a good team should only help the Crimson Tide later in the season.

Arizona could find itself back in the AP Top 25 next week after two quality wins.

UP NEXT

Alabama hosts Mercer on Dec. 19.

Arizona plays at New Mexico next Saturday.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

Five score in double figures, Lobos claim 78-56 win

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- Paced by five Lobos in double figures, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team rebounded from a four-game losing skid on Wednesday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit, topping Evansville by a score of 78-59 while shooting 49 percent from the floor (30-61).

Senior Sam Logwood and junior Troy Simons led the Lobos (3-4) with 14 points each, with Logwood adding five rebounds. Junior Chris McNeal added 13 points while junior Anthony Mathis and freshman Makuach Maluach chipped in 10 points apiece. The Lobos also posted 23 assists on 30 made baskets, 10 of which came from senior Antino Jackson.

"Obviously it was really good to get a win," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought we played a lot better tonight. We had a little lull there in the middle of the second half... but you've got to give Evansville credit. I've coached against and scouted against a lot of teams, and Marty Simmons is as good of a basketball coach as I've ever had to scout against. He eats basketball for breakfast. The guy is just awesome."

Jackson's 10 assists marks the second time this season that a Lobo has posted 10 or more assists, despite scoring just two points on the night compared to his usual 9.3 average.

"We've talked about it all week: your shots can't dictate your effect on the game," Weir said. "Antino's ability to push the ball and transition in the second half really helped us win the game."

After entering Wednesday's game ranked fourth in the nation in forced turnovers (21.33) and eighth in turnover margin (6.5), New Mexico forced over 20 turnovers (21) for the fourth time this season while only committing 11, including just three in the second half.

Evansville (5-2) entered the matchup second in the country in three-point percentage (47.8) and the Lobos held the Purple Aces to just 3-of-13 from behind the arc, including 0-for-6 in the first half. Wednesday marked the first time this season that Evansville has been completely denied from the arc in a half.

In addition, the Purple Aces entered the game ranked eighth nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 58.2 points per game. Prior to the Lobos' 78 points, the most Evansville had allowed in a game this season was 63.

The Lobos got off to a quick start as Simons opened the game with an early three-pointer, and UNM followed with an 11-0 run four minutes into the game to take a 16-5 lead, highlighted by back-to-back threes from junior Dane Kuiper. Evansville answered with a 9-0 run to close the gap to 16-14 with six minutes left in the first half.

The Lobos extended the lead back to nine at 25-16 on a pair of Logwood free throws three minutes later, and held a similar margin the rest of the half to enter the break leading 35-27.

New Mexico shot 40 percent from the floor, including 6-of-15 from behind the arc and a perfect 5-for-5 from the charity stripe, compared to Evansville's 33.3 field goal percentage, no three-pointers and 77.8 from the free throw line.

The Lobos opened up a 52-40 lead eight minutes into the second half with threes from McNeal, Simons and Mathis to fire up the crowd and claim the momentum. Four minutes later, another three from Mathis extended the Lobo lead to 19, 62-43.

Senior Joe Furstinger followed with a dunk 30 seconds later and the Lobos continued to run away with the game. An eight-point run fueled by a pair of Logwood layups, a McNeal jumper and a swift jumper from freshman Vladimir Pinchuk increased the lead to 24 with 1:43 left before the final 78-59 score.

The Lobos were able to capitalize on Evansville turnovers, scoring 20 points, while also outscoring the Purple Aces 20-2 on the fast break.

"It feels great (to get the win)," Maluach said. "There's not a better feeling than winning in front of your home crowd. We're a resilient group and we like each other a lot. When we win, we win together, and when we lose, we lose together. Hopefully we win more games than we lose."

New Mexico travels to face UTEP in El Paso, Texas on Saturday, Dec. 2 at 7 p.m.

Logwood Scores 22, Lobos Falter at UTEP

EL PASO, TEXAS --- Senior Sam Logwood of The University of New Mexico men's basketball team led the Lobos with 22 points on Saturday night for his third game this season registering 20+, but it wasn't enough to earn UNM the win as the Lobos fell to UTEP 88-76 in Don Haskins Center.

Midway through the second half, the Lobos (3-5) got a 14-point Miner lead down to five (61-56) on a 13-4 run before UTEP (2-6) rallied back with an 8-0 run of its own to reclaim the double-digit lead, push it to 15 (71-56) and hold out for the win.

The Lobos knocked down a pair of 3-pointers from juniors Dane Kuiper and Anthony Mathis in the final 45 seconds to reduce the Miner lead to nine (84-75), but UNM was forced to foul and UTEP's free throws sealed the Lobos' fate.

After discussing the Lobos' lackluster play in the first half, head coach Paul Weir spoke about the second-half spark that led UNM to outscore the Miners 45-43 over the final 20 minutes.

"Unfortunately, it was a halftime speech that got us to where we needed to be," coach Weir said. "But just like the Maryland game, it was just too late to come back from 15 on the road, it just doesn't happen every time. We'd like it to, but it just doesn't."

"I don't think I'll think offense was the problem... I think our inability to play defense is getting very troubling. Tonight we just couldn't stop those guys, it's concerning and we just need to improve."

As a team, UNM shot 37.5 percent from the floor compared to 53.7 percent for the Miners however, despite the lopsided overall percentages both teams fired at nearly the same rate from three. UNM went 11-of-31 from behind the arc (35.5 percent) while UTEP was 9-of-24 (37.5 percent). UNM has registered at least 10 3-pointers in five of its seven games.

The Lobos entered the game ranked third in the nation in free throw percentage, but had their lowest performance of the season from the stripe, going 23-for-35 (65.7 percent).

Defensively, the Lobos outscored UTEP 37-33 and turned them over 14 times, while committing 14 turnovers of their own. The Miners tallied 16 points off of UNM's turnovers compared to 11 for the Lobos.

Not only did Logwood register his fifth game scoring in double figures this season, but Mathis tallied 13 points for his sixth double-digit game and senior Antino Jackson scored 10 points for his third.

Logwood also added seven rebounds to go along with junior Troy Simons' eight and freshman Vladimir Pinchuk's seven.

The Lobos will return to action on Wednesday, Dec. 6 when they travel to take on Colorado at 7 p.m. MT on the Pac-12 Network.

Lobos Defeated at Colorado in Second Half

BOULDER, COLO. --- Despite a strong first-half performance, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team suffered a 75-57 loss on the road at Colorado on Wednesday night, letting a two-point halftime margin slip away over the final 10 minutes of the game.

Junior Anthony Mathis led the Lobos (3-6) with 15 points, just one shy of his career-high, as the only Lobo to score in double figures. Mathis went for 5-for-9 from the field including 3-for-6 from three and 2-for-3 from the free throw line.

The Lobos started out strong, turning the Buffalos (7-1) over three times in just the first three minutes, exhibiting an outstanding defense that burst on the scene with arguably the most energy and intensity it has had all season. UNM held the Buffs scoreless for the first two minutes of the game and eventually forced 23 turnovers.

"I think defensively, it was a little bit of a step forward for us tonight, particularly the first 28-29, actually 31-32 minutes," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought our defensive energy was really good and man if we could just find a way to convert some layups and some free throws I really think it would put us over the top."

The Lobos struggled from the floor going 21-for-71 for a season-low 29.6 percent field-goal percentage while shooting 29.0 percent from three (9-31) on the night.

"We got a lot of really good looks I thought around the rim, (Colorado) just did a really good job of protecting the glass," Weir said. "When you get 20 more shots than your opponent, you usually feel really good about what you did, but we just weren't able to convert a lot of shots around the rim."

The Buffalos shot 50 percent from the floor (26-52) and 60 percent (9-15) from three, taking advantage of their opportunities. CU slowly gained an 11-point lead midway through the first half, but the resilient Lobos went on an 11-2 run to erase the advantage, cutting the Buffalo lead to one, 29-28 with 1:58 left in the first half. The run was capped by a Mathis three and a dunk by freshman Makuach Maluach.

A 3-pointer from junior Troy Simons tied it up at 33 apiece with 43 seconds on the clock and the Buffs put in one more to make it 3

Lobos Fall to NMSU in Last-Minute Heartbreaker

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- With 6:40 to go in one of the biggest and most intense rivalries in The University of New Mexico history, the Lobos led the New Mexico State Aggies by eight, 56-48, on Saturday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit before dropping a heartbreaker by a final score of 65-62. The Lobos missed a tough, last-second three-pointer that would have tied the game.

The Lobos (3-7) outshot the Aggies (7-2) from 3-point range 28.6 percent to 20.0 percent and from the free throw line (70.6-50.0) in the outstanding defensive effort while scoring 14 points off of 17 NMSU turnovers.

UNM was led by senior Antino Jackson who compiled 14 points, his second-highest total of the season, including three from behind the arc. Junior Troy Simons posted 13 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

"I think this was just a newer team trying to find its way against a veteran team that's won a lot of games," head coach Paul Weir said. "I think that NMSU knows how to win those (close) games and has the experience to do it, and we're still trying to figure that out.

"These guys are fighting and I can't say anything negative about them ... they are giving it all they've got, we just have to find a way to improve and find a way to win games like this before the season is over."

Despite being down their leading scorer in arguably one of the biggest games of the year, the Lobos battled and went up on the Aggies, who reached the NCAA Tournament last season as the WAC Champions, by as much as nine points with 10 minutes left in the game. Nine points was the largest lead of the game by either team.

Freshman Makuach Maluach earned his first career start on the night. At the 10-minute mark, Maluach slammed a crowd-pleasing, one-handed dunk with unmatched enthusiasm from an excited Lobo crowd.

NMSU responded with three points from the game's leading scorer Zach Lofton, who tallied a game-high 22 points on the night, to cut the Lobo lead to six and eventually whittle UNM's advantage to three, 56-53 with 5:21 left.

The Aggies cut the deficit to one, 57-58 on a Lofton jumper and overtook the Lobos at the 2:34 mark on a Lofton layup, holding on for the win.

Lobo junior Anthony Mathis, who has been hot from behind the arc as of late, got a good look with the seconds winding down, but was forced to shoot from deep at the last second and missed. Mathis is 48.2 percent (27-56) on the season from three. Senior Joe Furstinger nearly got the putback before time expired.

As a team, UNM shot 39.9 percent compared to 42.6 percent for NMSU. The game marked just the second time this season that UNM committed more turnovers than it's opponent (19-17). NMUS outscored the Lobos in the paint, 36-20, but UNM collected more points on the fast break, 11-8. Both teams tallied 13 second-chance points on the night.

The Lobos will have seven days to recuperate from Saturday's game vs. NMSU before taking on Arizona on Saturday, Dec. 16 at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on CBS Sports Network at 6 p.m.
