ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Tuesday's game coming off of a hard-fought matchup with No. 23 Arizona at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit.
- In Saturday's game, UNM found itself down by just seven with 3:56 left before Arizona closed on a 7-0 run for the victory.
- Rice is also coming off of a loss to a ranked opponent. The Owls fell at No. 24 Texas Tech on Saturday by a 20-point margin, 73-53.
- The Lobos lead the all-time series with Rice 4-2, but dropped the last contest against the Owls 90-89 in Albuquerque on Dec. 19, 2015.
- Prior to the loss in 2015, UNM had claimed four straight wins over the Owls from 1993-99.
- The Lobos are led by a trio of players averaging in double figures on the season including senior Sam Logwood (14.2), junior Chris McNeal (12.6) and junior Anthony Mathis (10.2).
- The Owls have two players scoring in double digits including Connor Cashaw (16.6), A.J. Lapray (11.1).

SCOUTING RICE

Rice enters Tuesday's game in a similar fashion to UNM with a 3-8 record having recently fallen to No. 24 Texas Tech on the road on Saturday. The Owls' three wins came against Northwestern State, St. Thomas and St. Edward's. Losses have come against teams like Eastern Kentucky, UNLV, Ole Miss, UT Arlington and Stephen F. Austin.

As a team, the Owls are posting 66.8 point per game while allowing 74.9 for a -8.1 scoring margin.

Individually, junior Connor Cashaw leads the Owls with 16.6 points per game and a team-high 7.2 rebounds. He also leads the team with 13 steals and is second on the team in assists with 26. He is followed by A.J. Lapray who has missed the last four games for Rice, playing seven and starting two on the season.

SERIES HISTORY

The history between Rice and UNM began on Dec. 22, 1958 when Rice earned an 81-69 win in Albuquerque. The Lobos went on a 4-0 streak from 1993-99 before falling against Rice in the teams' last meeting on Dec. 19, 2015 in Albuquerque.

The Lobos are 2-2 on their home turf including a 2-1 record in The Pit.

Last time the two teams played, Sam Logwood saw 31 minutes on the court while Joe Furstinger played 13 minutes, Dane Kuiper played four and Anthony Mathis played seven.

LOGWOOD RETURNS

After sitting out in the Lobos' game against rival New Mexico State on December 9, senior Sam Logwood has returned to the team after a brief leave of absence. The senior played 26 minutes against Arizona on Saturday while adding eight points to UNM's 73-point total. Logwood explained to media on Monday that his absence was unrelated to basketball and that he is happy to be back on the team.

KUIPER ON FIRE

Lobo fans have been waiting for Kuiper's shots to fall and they were not left disappointed on Saturday. Junior Dane Kuiper celebrated his 21st birthday on Saturday when the Lobos faced Arizona and went for a career-high 24 points on six 3-pointers and seven shots from the floor - both also career highs. He was 7-for-10 on the night from the floor and 6-of-8 from 3-point range while going a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line. Saturday night's game marked just the second time in his career that he led the Lobos in points in a game.

NEW MEXICO NOTES

3-POINT FRENZY

The Lobos are ranked 12th in the nation in 3-pointers per game and 13th in total made 3-pointers. In five of their 11 games this season, UNM has hit 10 or more threes.

LINEUP MIXUP

The Lobos have featured six different lineups this season over 11 games searching for that perfect starting-five combo. Just one player has started all 11 games for UNM - Joe Furstinger.

BIG GAMES - CONTROLLED TURNOVERS

The Lobos have committed less than 10 turnovers in some of their biggest games of the season this year including seven against Colorado and Arizona.

LOBOS IN THE NATION

The Lobos are performing well in many categories in comparison to the rest of the nation's teams. Here is a look at where the Lobos stack up nationally in key categories:

ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 Lobos have just five returning student-athletes from the 2016-17 squad and feature an outstanding nine newcomers. Under first-year head coach Paul Weir, the Lobos look to improve on their 17-14 overall record last season, 10-8 in Mountain West play.

Top returners for the Lobos include lone regular starter Sam Logwood who averaged 7.3 points per game for a .449 field goal percentage and a .671 percentage from the free throw line. All four other Lobos to return to UNM this season played in at least 10 games, including junior Dane Kuiper who started 13 games, averaging 6.0 points per game.

NEW COACH, NEW ERA

At the helm of the Lobos in the 2016-17 season will be head coach Paul Weir, officially named the 21st head coach in UNM men's basketball history on April 11, 2017. Weir spent the last season with New Mexico State where he finished 28-6 and led NMSU to a WAC Tournament Championship and an NCAA appearance. Weir is the first basket-

LOBO TRANSFERS

Of the nine fresh faces to the UNM squad, the Lobos welcome in six new transfers, four of which will be eligible to compete in the 2017-18 season. Those that are eligible and will don the Lobo Cherry & Silver this season include junior Chris McNeal (Indian Hills), senior Antino Jackson (Akron), junior Jachai Simmons (Midland College) and junior Troy Simons (Polk State). The pair of transfers that will not see action this season is JaQuan Lyle (Ohio State) and Vance Jackson (UCONN) due to NCAA transfer rules.

LOBOS ON TV

The 2017-18 schedule includes many national and regional broadcasts of New Mexico basketball. The Lobos are currently slated for TV 22 times, including 13 of 16 Mountain West games. UNM had 22 of 26 UNM and MW controlled games selected for TV while three non-conference road games, at New Mexico State, at UTEP and at Colorado are expected to be broadcast as well. The Lobos will be on ATT SportsNet/ROOT eight times, on CBS Sports Network five times, ESPN3 five times, and ESPNU and the Mountain West Network on Stadium once. Additionally, two games (at UNLV on January 17 and January 27 at home against Colorado State) are flex games that will be either on ESPNU or ESPN3.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

After two years as WisePies Arena - The Pit, the famous home of Lobo basketball has been given a new name. While it will still be referred to as "The Pit," this season will be the first that the Lobos will compete in "Dreamstyle Arena" as part of an exciting \$10 million agreement for naming rights by Dreamstyle Remodeling of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues. In addition to the official renaming of the Lobo basketball arena, the UNM football stadium, formerly referred to as "University Stadium" is now officially named "Dreamstyle Stadium."

In conjunction with the new name, The Pit was given a new floor this season, featuring both "New Mexico" and "The Pit" on the baselines, the new university interlocking UNM logo, fresh Mountain West logos customized in the Lobo cherry and silver, cherry free throw lines and dual Dreamstyle Arena logos on both sides of center court.

"The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except

Kuiper scores 24, Lobos battle but fall to #23 Arizona

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team battled No. 23 Arizona to an 89-73 loss at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on Saturday night in front of an enthusiastic, season-high crowd of 13,207. The Lobos rallied back from a 19-point deficit to trail by just seven with 3:56 remaining, but it wasn't enough to overcome the Wildcats, who shot 64.0 percent from the field.

"I thought the game was played and moving at the pace we wanted," head coach Paul Weir said. "There's another part of our energy level, defensively, that wasn't good enough. It has to get better."

"You do have to give Arizona some credit. They shot the heck out of the basketball tonight. I know those guys are skilled enough to shoot threes and they are special. They really showed how good of a team they are, made a lot of big shots - that is a good basketball team."

The Lobos (3-8) were unable to complete the comeback against the ranked Wildcats despite junior Dane Kuiper's career-best 24-point performance. Kuiper, who was celebrating his birthday, shot 70 percent (7-10) from the field and 75 percent (6-8) from behind the three-point arc, adding a perfect 4-4 from the free throw line. Troy Simons added 12 points on 40 percent (4-10) shooting. Senior Sam Logwood posted eight points in his first game back with the team after his brief leave of absence.

The Lobos shot 38.7 percent as a team, including 35.3 percent from behind the arc and 92.9 percent from the free throw line, but Arizona outscored New Mexico 42-20 in the paint and outrebounded the Lobos 35-23. UNM held the Wildcats to six offensive rebounds and seven second-chance points. In the second half, UNM matched Arizona, both notching 40 points.

After trailing by 15, 72-57, with 9:28 to go in the second half, the Lobos cut the Wildcat lead to eight at 74-66 on baskets from Simons, Logwood and Kuiper. It marked the first time since the 11:57 mark of the first half that the Lobos trailed by less than ten. Kuiper managed to cut the lead to seven twice, first on a three with 5:05 to go and then on a pair of free throws with 3:56 remaining, but the Lobos were unable to close the margin any further.

Arizona (8-3) widened the lead back to double digits and then continued with a commanding 12-point advantage with 1:05 to go, finishing the game on a 7-0 run en route to the 89-73 final.

The Lobos trailed 11-5 three minutes into the game but went on a 5-0 run behind a layup and a 3-point play from Simons to bring the game within one, 11-10. Arizona answered with an 11-3 run over the next two minutes to stretch its lead back to nine, 22-13, but freshman Makuach Maluach hit a three-pointer to cut the lead to six, 22-16.

After another 9-0 streak by the Wildcats, Kuiper added a layup and 3-pointer to keep the Lobos within ten, 31-21.

The Wildcats took their largest lead of the first half on four Allonzo Trier free throws with 18 seconds left as they made the score 49-31. Senior Antino Jackson hit a jumper as time expired to enter halftime trailing by 16, 49-33.

"We just couldn't get a break to go our way," Weir said. "When you're down 16 points, it's just hard to spot somebody that much."

The Lobos shot 41.4 percent from the field in the first half, including 35.7 percent from three. They added another four points from the free throw line, going a perfect 4-for-4 in the half.

UNM and Arizona opened the second half trading 3-point plays to make the score 52-36. Junior Chris McNeal hit his first three of the night off an offensive rebound to cut Arizona's lead to 13, 54-41, with 16:25 on the clock.

Junior Anthony Mathis, who is shooting 48.3 from behind the arc this season, drilled back-to-back threes with 12 minutes to go to make the score 66-54 and prevent Arizona from pulling away, setting up the UNM comeback attempt.

The game marked the first time since Jan. 16, 1999 that Arizona traveled to play in Albuquerque, when the Lobos beat the Wildcats 79-78. When the two teams met last year in Tucson, then-ranked No. 18 Arizona topped New Mexico 77-46. Saturday's contest also marks UNM's first ranked opponent of the season.

New Mexico will stay at home to face Rice in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit, continuing the Lobos' five-game home stand, on Tuesday, Dec. 19 at 7:30 p.m.

Lobos Drop First Home Game Against Rice

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. – The University of New Mexico men's basketball team (7-3) dropped a home game for the first time this season, falling to the Rice Owls (5-4), 90-89, in WisePies Arena Saturday.

The Lobos were led by Elijah Brown's fourth consecutive 20-point game, with 21 points on 5-for-13 shooting. He also tallied five rebounds and two assists. Tim Williams scored 18 points on 9-for-12 shooting and pulled down a team-best nine rebounds. Cullen Neal was the team's leading distributor, with seven assists to go with 16 points. Obij Aget was the team's fourth double-digit scorer, with 11 points, seven rebounds and a career-high five blocks.

"Give them credit, Rice played a heck of a game," said head coach Craig Neal. "They scored the ball, we had no answer for them. I thought our defense was not very good but this game's on me, it had nothing to do with our players. I didn't get them up to play and they just played with more energy and more effort."

The Lobos faced a tough test in the first half but eventually gained control of the game before the break. The Owls took advantage of a rough offensive stretch for New Mexico and worked their way quickly to a 12-point lead just seven minutes into the game.

New Mexico did not let the game get out of hand, and a 10-2 run put the Lobos on the Owls' heels. Timely 3-pointers helped Rice maintain the lead for nearly 13 minutes of the first half. However, the Lobos outscored Rice, 17-2, over the final five minutes of the first half to take a 44-38 lead into the break.

The Lobos looked to take control of the game in the second half, earning their first double digit lead within the first two minutes. With roughly 13 minutes remaining, Neal was fouled on a driving layup and earned three points the hard way, giving the Lobos their largest lead of the game at 66-49.

The big lead was short lived, as the Owls immediately answered with an 11-3 run to cut their deficit to single digits. Over the final seven minutes of the game, the Owls shot 11-for-17 and tied the game at 89-89 with 21 seconds remaining on a 3-pointer from Egor Koulechov.

The Lobos turned the ball over on the ensuing possession, but came up with the stop they needed on the other end to keep the game tied. However, with 0.1 second on the clock, the ref awarded Rice a technical free throw opportunity due to a Lobo calling a timeout the team did not have. Koulechov stepped up and scored his 32nd point of the game at the free throw line to win it for Rice.

Overall, the Lobos shot 50.8 percent (30-for-59) and 36.8 percent (7-for-19) from 3-point range. Rice shot 45.3 percent (29-for-64) and 40.7 percent (11-for-27) from deep. The Lobos won the rebounding battle, 40-31, but gave up more turnovers than Rice, 18-13.

Jordan Hunter and Joe Furstinger each scored five points off the bench, shooting 50 percent each. Furstinger also led the reserves with five rebounds, tying a season-high. Sam Logwood logged four points, three rebounds and two steals, and helped force a tough shot from Koulechov on the final stop of the game. Nikola Scekcic chipped in four points while Xavier Adams earned three points, rebounds and assists.

The loss snapped a streak of six consecutive wins at home for the Lobos, the longest unbeaten record to start a year at home since the 2012-13 season.

The Lobos will move on to the 2015 Hawaiian Airlines Diamondhead Classic in Honolulu, Hawaii, beginning Tuesday with Auburn at 12:30 p.m. MT.

Second Half Surge Sends Rice To Defeat At No. 24 Texas Tech

LUBBOCK, Texas -- No. 24 Texas Tech shot 63.3% in the second half in turning a four-point second half Rice lead into a 73-53 defeat, Saturday night at Lubbock Municipal Coliseum. Junior Connor Cashaw recorded his second straight double-double, recording game-highs of 21 points and 12 rebounds while setting a career-high with five three-pointers. Senior Bishop Mency scored nine points and Robert Martin added eight.

Rice began the game hot from the field. After Texas Tech opened the scoring, Rice scored nine of the next 11 points on three-pointers from Mency, Cashaw and Miles Lester. TTU then hit a pair of layups to make it a one-point game. However, a three from Cashaw followed by a three-point play by Martin gave Rice a 15-8 lead 6:22 into the game.

After trading baskets, Davide Morretti hit a three for Tech. But baskets by Cashaw and Najja Hunter gave the Owls their largest lead of the game, 21-13, with 11:01 to play in the half.

However, that's when Rice went cold. The Owls missed their final eight shots of the half while turning the ball over eight times, as the Red Raiders closed the half on a 16-4 run to lead 29-25 at the break.

"I'm proud of the guy's effort," said Rice head coach Scott Pera. "I thought they did a really good job of following the scouting report. They were focused on doing the right things. I thought at halftime we could have been winning or tied, but we missed two front ends of a one-and-one that really hurt us. But you would take a four-point game on the road against a Top-25 team."

Tech opened the scoring in the second half with a layup. Rice immediately answered, rattling off 10 straight points on three-pointers from Martin and a pair from Cashaw, giving Rice a 35-31 lead just 2:49 into the second stanza. However, the Red Raiders went on a 20-5 run over the next 6:34 to gain a 50-41 advantage midway through the second half.

Malik Osborne then hit a jumper and made a pair of free throws to pull Rice within seven points with 8:16 to play. The Owls had a chance to make it a five-point game when Cashaw went to the line for a one-and-one. But he missed the front end and Texas Tech went on a 15-4 run to put the game away.

Pera added, "I think we battled really hard for 33 minutes. We missed that front end coming out of the under eight media timeout that would have cut it to five. (Texas Tech's) length, athleticism and toughness at the end of the day was too much. They got some turnovers and easy baskets and our guys were wore out but I'm very proud of our effort."

Rice connected on just 38.6% (17-of-44) from the field and 40.0% (10-of-25) from three while shooting just 9-of-15 (60.0%) from the free throw line. Texas Tech shot 49.2% (31-of-63) from the floor and just 25.0% (4-of-16) from three while hitting just 7-of-21 (33.3%) from the charity stripe. However, the Red Raiders scored 34 points off of 26 Rice turnovers.

Rice stays on the road this coming Tuesday, Dec. 19 when it travels to Albuquerque, N.M., to face New Mexico. Tip-off is scheduled for 8:30 p.m. CT and will broadcast by AT&T Sportsnet.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

Lobos Break Records in Season Opener, Win 147-76

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team shocked a crowd of over 10,500 fans in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit in its first regular-season outing under first-year head coach Paul Weir on Saturday night. The Lobos shattered the UNM record for points scored in a game (136), claiming a 147-76 victory over Northern New Mexico.

The 71-point victory margin also ties the nearly 45-year-old record for largest victory margin, which occurred on December 29, 1972 against Dartmouth at The Pit.

Northern New Mexico is now 2-8 on the season while the Lobos start out 1-0 for the 15th straight season.

"I am extremely thankful to every fan that came through the door tonight and hopefully they'll continue to come out and support us as we try and earn their trust and their respect as a basketball program," Coach Weir said. "Obviously (this was) the kind of offensive game we've been looking for. Our last scrimmage was a very similar outcome, so we're thankful that we're shooting the ball the way we are."

The fiery Lobo offense dominated early and refused to let up. UNM got out to a 15-point lead less than five minutes into the first half, taking a 22-7 advantage with 15:38 still remaining in the first half. The Eagles went on an ensuing 7-0 run, testing the Lobo defense and cutting the home lead to eight, but UNM quickly pushed back ahead and extended the lead to 20 on a three from junior Troy Simmons with 9:43 left.

The Lobos concluded the first-half performance with a trio of back-to-back-to-back 3-pointers, two from junior Anthony Mathis and a third from junior transfer Chris McNeal. McNeal collected four threes in the first half alone and helped pace UNM to a 74-point first-half showing, just two points shy of the UNM record for most points in a single half. The record is 76, which occurred on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos shot 61 percent from the field in the first half (25-41) and 50 percent from 3-point range (10-20). Three players had reached double digits including McNeal (13), senior Sam Logwood (12) and freshman Makuach Maluach (11).

Junior Dane Kuiper opened the second half with a pair of free throws to put the Lobos up 40, 75-35.

Simons and freshman Vladimir Pinchuk shined in the second half, putting up 11 and 10 points, respectively en route to the victory.

McNeal burst on the scene in his first regular-season game as a Lobo with the first UNM double-double in points and assists since March 2, 2014. He posted a team-best 24 points on the night to go along with 10 assists.

Led by McNeal, eight of the 11 Lobos to hit the floor scored in double digits including Simons (19), Maluach (18), Kuiper (17), Mathis (16), Logwood (14), Pinchuk (12) and senior Antino Jackson (12).

As a team, the Lobos collected 40 assists and 22 steals, both ranking high in Lobo history. Forty assists ties the record for most in a game, which the Lobos had done twice previously, the first on December 16, 1978 against Central Florida and again on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington. Twenty-two steals is the second-most in a game in team history (25 is the record).

On the night, UNM shot 64.7 percent (55-85) from the floor including 46.2 percent from three and 86.4 percent from the free-throw line. The Lobos' 55 field goals is just four shy of the record for most in a game. The Lobos posted 59 in the November 23, 1990 game against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos also posted an outstanding 18 3-pointers on the night, just two short of the record 20 set on November 13, 2004 against Santa Clara, while defensively UNM posted six blocks and collected 32 defensive rebounds (45 overall). Senior Joe Furstinger led the way with three blocks.

Lobos Top Omaha with Second Straight 100+ Game

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team posted its first back-to-back 100+ point games since December 1998 on Tuesday night as the Lobos routed the visiting Omaha Mavericks 103-71 in their Nike N7 game, Junior transfer Troy Simmons paced the Lobos with 24 points that included six 3-pointers on the night.

The Nike N7 jersey auction in Dreamstyle Arena raised over \$2,500 for the NB3 Foundation and American Indian Student Services (AISS).

Four Lobos scored in double figures including Simons and seniors Antino Jackson (19), Sam Logwood (18) and Joe Furstinger (11). Furstinger's 11 points marks a new career-best for the senior, who has tallied a previous high of nine points twice in his career, including Saturday's game against Northern New Mexico. He also tied his career-best in free throws (5) and blocks (4).

Coach Weir earned his 30th career victory on the night as the Lobos improve to 2-0. Omaha falls to 0-3 on the season.

The Lobos opened the game with an 8-0 run over the first 2:30, half which came from Furstinger. Omaha followed with a 7-0 run as the Lobos struggled to find a consistent offensive flow, closing the gap to make it 19-16 UNM midway through the first half.

Alternating scoring droughts for both teams caused the score to remain close through the remainder of the first half, sending UNM into the locker room up by just one, 35-34. The Lobos shot an unimpressive 34.1 percent from the field and 20 percent from 3-point range compared to 37 percent from the floor and 35.7 percent from the arc for the Mavericks.

The second half was another story as the Lobos stormed past Omaha and didn't look back. In the second half, the Lobos shot 55.6 percent from the field and an outstanding 68.4 percent from 3-point range, hitting 13 triples en route to a 68-point second-half performance while limiting Omaha to just 37 points.

"I thought in the second half, we kept our defensive energy up and our offensive energy ended up coming around," head coach Paul Weir said. "I was much more pleased with our defensive energy in the second half."

"As far as our style of play, it's how we want to play and it went the way we wanted to. We were able to shoot the way we wanted to and hopefully we continue playing this way moving forward."

Simons's six 3-pointers combined with five from Jackson, three from junior Anthony Mathis, two from junior Chris McNeal and another from freshman Makuach Maluach - his first as a Lobo.

The UNM advantage was held within single digits until midway through the second half when the Lobos pulled away - fast. Sparked by a pair of Furstinger free throws and a three from McNeal, the Lobos took off on a 9-0 run in just one minute, taking a reachable 63-57 game to a 72-57 contest. McNeal's three was set up after he snagged a steal and, just 10 seconds later, Simons grabbed another steal in the Lobos' full-court press and posted the layup.

The 15-point lead was stretched to a 30-point blowout with four minutes left, 92-62 on a pair of Logwood free throws. Logwood went 10-for-11 from the stripe on the night, doubling his previous career-best five free throws in a single game.

It was a Jackson three that put the Lobos over 100 with 1:09 left. With seven seconds left on the clock, Omaha's Alex Alberry hit a three to cut the 35-point Lobo lead to 32 to close the game.

The Lobos are averaging 29.5 turnovers forced per game to start the season to go along with 44.5 field goals and 58.5 bench points. In the last two games, UNM has hit 35 3-pointers, at least 17 per game. Last season, it took nine games to reach that mark.

UNM out rebounded the Mavericks 48-37 including 19-9 offensive boards and forced 26 turnovers on the night.

Five score in double figures, Lobos claim 78-56 win

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- Paced by five Lobos in double figures, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team rebounded from a four-game losing skid on Wednesday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit, topping Evansville by a score of 78-59 while shooting 49 percent from the floor (30-61).

Senior Sam Logwood and junior Troy Simons led the Lobos (3-4) with 14 points each, with Logwood adding five rebounds. Junior Chris McNeal added 13 points while junior Anthony Mathis and freshman Makuach Maluach chipped in 10 points apiece. The Lobos also posted 23 assists on 30 made baskets, 10 of which came from senior Antino Jackson.

"Obviously it was really good to get a win," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought we played a lot better tonight. We had a little lull there in the middle of the second half... but you've got to give Evansville credit. I've coached against and scouted against a lot of teams, and Marty Simmons is as good of a basketball coach as I've ever had to scout against. He eats basketball for breakfast. The guy is just awesome."

Jackson's 10 assists marks the second time this season that a Lobo has posted 10 or more assists, despite scoring just two points on the night compared to his usual 9.3 average.

"We've talked about it all week: your shots can't dictate your effect on the game," Weir said. "Antino's ability to push the ball and transition in the second half really helped us win the game."

After entering Wednesday's game ranked fourth in the nation in forced turnovers (21.33) and eighth in turnover margin (6.5), New Mexico forced over 20 turnovers (21) for the fourth time this season while only committing 11, including just three in the second half.

Evansville (5-2) entered the matchup second in the country in three-point percentage (47.8) and the Lobos held the Purple Aces to just 3-of-13 from behind the arc, including 0-for-6 in the first half. Wednesday marked the first time this season that Evansville has been completely denied from the arc in a half.

In addition, the Purple Aces entered the game ranked eighth nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 58.2 points per game. Prior to the Lobos' 78 points, the most Evansville had allowed in a game this season was 63.

The Lobos got off to a quick start as Simons opened the game with an early three-pointer, and UNM followed with an 11-0 run four minutes into the game to take a 16-5 lead, highlighted by back-to-back threes from junior Dane Kuiper. Evansville answered with a 9-0 run to close the gap to 16-14 with six minutes left in the first half.

The Lobos extended the lead back to nine at 25-16 on a pair of Logwood free throws three minutes later, and held a similar margin the rest of the half to enter the break leading 35-27.

New Mexico shot 40 percent from the floor, including 6-of-15 from behind the arc and a perfect 5-for-5 from the charity stripe, compared to Evansville's 33.3 field goal percentage, no three-pointers and 77.8 from the free throw line.

The Lobos opened up a 52-40 lead eight minutes into the second half with threes from McNeal, Simons and Mathis to fire up the crowd and claim the momentum. Four minutes later, another three from Mathis extended the Lobo lead to 19, 62-43.

Senior Joe Furstinger followed with a dunk 30 seconds later and the Lobos continued to run away with the game. An eight-point run fueled by a pair of Logwood layups, a McNeal jumper and a swift jumper from freshman Vladimir Pinchuk increased the lead to 24 with 1:43 left before the final 78-59 score.

The Lobos were able to capitalize on Evansville turnovers, scoring 20 points, while also outscoring the Purple Aces 20-2 on the fast break.

"It feels great (to get the win)," Maluach said. "There's not a better feeling than winning in front of your home crowd. We're a resilient group and we like each other a lot. When we win, we win together, and when we lose, we lose together. Hopefully we win more games than we lose."

New Mexico travels to face UTEP in El Paso, Texas on Saturday, Dec. 2 at 7 p.m.

Logwood Scores 22, Lobos Falter at UTEP

EL PASO, TEXAS --- Senior Sam Logwood of The University of New Mexico men's basketball team led the Lobos with 22 points on Saturday night for his third game this season registering 20+, but it wasn't enough to earn UNM the win as the Lobos fell to UTEP 88-76 in Don Haskins Center.

Midway through the second half, the Lobos (3-5) got a 14-point Miner lead down to five (61-56) on a 13-4 run before UTEP (2-6) rallied back with an 8-0 run of its own to reclaim the double-digit lead, push it to 15 (71-56) and hold out for the win.

The Lobos knocked down a pair of 3-pointers from juniors Dane Kuiper and Anthony Mathis in the final 45 seconds to reduce the Miner lead to nine (84-75), but UNM was forced to foul and UTEP's free throws sealed the Lobos' fate.

After discussing the Lobos' lackluster play in the first half, head coach Paul Weir spoke about the second-half spark that led UNM to outscore the Miners 45-43 over the final 20 minutes.

"Unfortunately, it was a halftime speech that got us to where we needed to be," coach Weir said. "But just like the Maryland game, it was just too late to come back from 15 on the road, it just doesn't happen every time. We'd like it to, but it just doesn't."

"I don't think I'll think offense was the problem... I think our inability to play defense is getting very troubling. Tonight we just couldn't stop those guys, it's concerning and we just need to improve."

As a team, UNM shot 37.5 percent from the floor compared to 53.7 percent for the Miners however, despite the lopsided overall percentages both teams fired at nearly the same rate from three. UNM went 11-of-31 from behind the arc (35.5 percent) while UTEP was 9-of-24 (37.5 percent). UNM has registered at least 10 3-pointers in five of its seven games.

The Lobos entered the game ranked third in the nation in free throw percentage, but had their lowest performance of the season from the stripe, going 23-for-35 (65.7 percent).

Defensively, the Lobos outrebounced UTEP 37-33 and turned them over 14 times, while committing 14 turnovers of their own. The Miners tallied 16 points off of UNM's turnovers compared to 11 for the Lobos.

Not only did Logwood register his fifth game scoring in double figures this season, but Mathis tallied 13 points for his sixth double-digit game and senior Antino Jackson scored 10 points for his third.

Logwood also added seven rebounds to go along with junior Troy Simons' eight and freshman Vladimir Pinchuk's seven.

The Lobos will return to action on Wednesday, Dec. 6 when they travel to take on Colorado at 7 p.m. MT on the Pac-12 Network.

Lobos Defeated at Colorado in Second Half

BOULDER, COLO. --- Despite a strong first-half performance, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team suffered a 75-57 loss on the road at Colorado on Wednesday night, letting a two-point halftime margin slip away over the final 10 minutes of the game.

Junior Anthony Mathis led the Lobos (3-6) with 15 points, just one shy of his career-high, as the only Lobo to score in double figures. Mathis went for 5-for-9 from the field including 3-for-6 from three and 2-for-3 from the free throw line.

The Lobos started out strong, turning the Buffalos (7-1) over three times in just the first three minutes, exhibiting an outstanding defense that burst on the scene with arguably the most energy and intensity it has had all season. UNM held the Buffs scoreless for the first two minutes of the game and eventually forced 23 turnovers.

"I think defensively, it was a little bit of a step forward for us tonight, particularly the first 28-29, actually 31-32 minutes," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought our defensive energy was really good and man if we could just find a way to convert some layups and some free throws I really think it would put us over the top."

The Lobos struggled from the floor going 21-for-71 for a season-low 29.6 percent field-goal percentage while shooting 29.0 percent from three (9-31) on the night.

"We got a lot of really good looks I thought around the rim, (Colorado) just did a really good job of protecting the glass," Weir said. "When you get 20 more shots than your opponent, you usually feel really good about what you did, but we just weren't able to convert a lot of shots around the rim."

The Buffalos shot 50 percent from the floor (26-52) and 60 percent (9-15) from three, taking advantage of their opportunities. CU slowly gained an 11-point lead midway through the first half, but the resilient Lobos went on an 11-2 run to erase the advantage, cutting the Buffalo lead to one, 29-28 with 1:58 left in the first half. The run was capped by a Mathis three and a dunk by freshman Makuach Maluach.

A 3-pointer from junior Troy Simons tied it up at 33 apiece with 43 seconds on the clock and the Buffs put in one more to make it 35-33 at the half.

Lobos Fall to NMSU in Last-Minute Heartbreaker

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- With 6:40 to go in one of the biggest and most intense rivalries in The University of New Mexico history, the Lobos led the New Mexico State Aggies by eight, 56-48, on Saturday night in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit before dropping a heartbreaker by a final score of 65-62. The Lobos missed a tough, last-second three-pointer that would have tied the game.

The Lobos (3-7) outshot the Aggies (7-2) from 3-point range 28.6 percent to 20.0 percent and from the free throw line (70.6-50.0) in the outstanding defensive effort while scoring 14 points off of 17 NMSU turnovers.

UNM was led by senior Antino Jackson who compiled 14 points, his second-highest total of the season, including three from behind the arc. Junior Troy Simons posted 13 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

"I think this was just a newer team trying to find its way against a veteran team that's won a lot of games," head coach Paul Weir said. "I think that NMSU knows how to win those (close) games and has the experience to do it, and we're still trying to figure that out.

"These guys are fighting and I can't say anything negative about them ... they are giving it all they've got, we just have to find a way to improve and find a way to win games like this before the season is over."

Despite being down their leading scorer in arguably one of the biggest games of the year, the Lobos battled and went up on the Aggies, who reached the NCAA Tournament last season as the WAC Champions, by as much as nine points with 10 minutes left in the game. Nine points was the largest lead of the game by either team.

Freshman Makuach Maluach earned his first career start on the night. At the 10-minute mark, Maluach slammed a crowd-pleasing, one-handed dunk with unmatched enthusiasm from an excited Lobo crowd.

NMSU responded with three points from the game's leading scorer Zach Lofton, who tallied a game-high 22 points on the night, to cut the Lobo lead to six and eventually whittle UNM's advantage to three, 56-53 with 5:21 left.

The Aggies cut the deficit to one, 57-58 on a Lofton jumper and overtook the Lobos at the 2:34 mark on a Lofton layup, holding on for the win.

Lobo junior Anthony Mathis, who has been hot from behind the arc as of late, got a good look with the seconds winding down, but was forced to shoot from deep at the last second and missed. Mathis is 48.2 percent (27-56) on the season from three. Senior Joe Furstinger nearly got the putback before time expired.

As a team, UNM shot 39.9 percent compared to 42.6 percent for NMSU. The game marked just the second time this season that UNM committed more turnovers than it's opponent (19-17). NMSU outscored the Lobos in the paint, 36-20, but UNM collected more points on the fast break, 11-8. Both teams tallied 13 second-chance points on the night.

The Lobos will have seven days to recuperate from Saturday's game vs. NMSU before taking on Arizona on Saturday, Dec. 16 at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on CBS Sports Network at 6 p.m.

Kuiper scores 24, Lobos battle but fall to #23 Arizona

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team battled No. 23 Arizona to an 89-73 loss at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on Saturday night in front of an enthusiastic, season-high crowd of 13,207. The Lobos rallied back from a 19-point deficit to trail by just seven with 3:56 remaining, but it wasn't enough to overcome the Wildcats, who shot 64.0 percent from the field.

"I thought the game was played and moving at the pace we wanted," head coach Paul Weir said. "There's another part of our energy level, defensively, that wasn't good enough. It has to get better.

"You do have to give Arizona some credit. They shot the heck out of the basketball tonight. I know those guys are skilled enough to shoot threes and they are special. They really showed how good of a team they are, made a lot of big shots - that is a good basketball team."

The Lobos (3-8) were unable to complete the comeback against the ranked Wildcats despite junior Dane Kuiper's career-best 24-point performance. Kuiper, who was celebrating his birthday, shot 70 percent (7-10) from the field and 75 percent (6-8) from behind the three-point arc, adding a perfect 4-4 from the free throw line. Troy Simons added 12 points on 40 percent (4-10) shooting. Senior Sam Logwood posted eight points in his first game back with the team after his brief leave of absence.

The Lobos shot 38.7 percent as a team, including 35.3 percent from behind the arc and 92.9 percent from the free throw line, but Arizona outscored New Mexico 42-20 in the paint and outrebounded the Lobos 35-23. UNM held the Wildcats to six offensive rebounds and seven second-chance points. In the second half, UNM matched Arizona, both notching 40 points.

After trailing by 15, 72-57, with 9:28 to go in the second half, the Lobos cut the Wildcat lead to eight at 74-66 on baskets from Simons, Logwood and Kuiper. It marked the first time since the 11:57 mark of the first half that the Lobos trailed by less than ten. Kuiper managed to cut the lead to seven twice, first on a three with 5:05 to go and then on a pair of free throws with 3:56 remaining, but the Lobos were unable to close the margin any further.

Arizona (8-3) widened the lead back to double digits and then continued with a commanding 12-point advantage with 1:05 to go, finishing the game on a 7-0 run en route to the 89-73 final.

The Lobos trailed 11-5 three minutes into the game but went on a 5-0 run behind a layup and a 3-point play from Simons to bring the game within one, 11-10. Arizona answered with an 11-3 run over the next two minutes to stretch its lead back to nine, 22-13, but freshman Makuach Maluach hit a three-pointer to cut the lead to six, 22-16.

After another 9-0 streak by the Wildcats, Kuiper added a layup and 3-pointer to keep the Lobos within ten, 31-21.

The Wildcats took their largest lead of the first half on four Allonzo Trier free throws with 18 seconds left as they made the score 49-31. Senior Antino Jackson hit a jumper as time expired to enter halftime trailing by 16, 49-33.

"We just couldn't get a break to go our way," Weir said. "When you're down 16 points, it's just hard to spot somebody that much."

The Lobos shot 41.4 percent from the field in the first half, including 35.7 percent from three. They added another four points from the free throw line, going a perfect 4-for-4 in the half.

UNM and Arizona opened the second half trading 3-point plays to make the score 52-36. Junior Chris McNeal hit his first three of the night off an offensive rebound to cut Arizona's lead to 13, 54-41, with 16:25 on the clock.

Junior Anthony Mathis, who is shooting 48.3 from behind the arc this season, drilled back-to-back threes with 12 minutes to go to make the score 66-54 and prevent Arizona from pulling away, setting up the UNM comeback attempt.

The game marked the first time since Jan. 16, 1999 that Arizona traveled to play in Albuquerque, when the Lobos beat the Wildcats 79-78. When the two teams met last year in Tucson, then-ranked No. 18 Arizona topped New Mexico 77-46. Saturday's contest also marks UNM's first ranked opponent of the season.

New Mexico will stay at home to face Rice in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit, continuing the Lobos' five-game home stand, on Tuesday, Dec. 19 at 7:30 p.m.
