## NEWS AND NOTES

### NEW MEXICO HEADS TO UT ARLINGTON INVITATIONAL TO CAP NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

The Lobos look to close out non-conference play on a high note as they head to the UT Arlington Invitational for four matches Friday and Saturday.

After splitting a pair of challenging matches its last time out at the Lobo Classic, New Mexico (6-3) has a chance to build some more momentum heading into Mountain West play.

Last week, the Lobos took down Arkansas for its second win over a Power Five school before falling to No. 1 Nebraska. Still New Mexico acquitted itself well in both matches, posting a game-turning comeback vs. the Razorbacks and matching the Cornhuskers point-for-point for the majority of two sets.

This week's slate provides a different trial for UNM. Although the Lobos have proven themselves in a couple of big matches, winning four matches in two days will test them.

But this week is the last time New Mexico will have to contend with multiple matches in a single day, and it's the last time UNM has to go

east for rest of the season.

Of the four schools, Houston Baptist has the best record at 8-4, followed by Samford at 6-5. But all four teams that UNM will face have struggled against Power Five/Group of Five schools.

Historically, New Mexico has done well against the teams in the tournament, winning 33 of their last 35 vs. UTEP, two straight against UTA and its only matchup vs. HBU. The Lobos and Samford have never faced off.

### NEW MEXICO FINISHES SECOND AT LOBO CLASSIC

New Mexico captured two victories as it hosted the Lobo Classic at WisePies Arena on Sept. 8-10. The Lobos opened with an exciting 3-1 triumph over Arkansas of the SEC, and followed with an exhibition win over Montreal.

UNM also battled No. 1 Nebraska in front of an announced crowd of 4,473, but fell 3-0.

Against Arkansas, **Julia Warren** notched her 1,000th career dig and was one of three pinhitters to notch double-digit kills.

### FIVE THINGS TO KNOW

The Lobos have seven native New Mexicans on its roster, including five probable starters.

UNM has collected 2 wins over Power Five teams this season, the same as the rest of the MW combined.

Julia Warren eclipsed 1,000 career digs in the Lobos' match vs. Arkansas on Sept. 8.

An announced crowd of 4,473 fans saw UNM take on No. 1 Nebraska in WisePies Arena, the fourth-best ever.

Cassie House & Julia Warren made the Lobo Classic All-Tournament Team, the second this year for both.

Senior outside hitters **Cassie House**, **Devanne Sours** and **Warren** powered New Mexico (6-2) past the Razorbacks (1-6), helping fuel a momentum-shifting 11-1 run in the third set that gave the Lobos a 2-1 lead in the match that they would not relinquish.

UNM followed that up with a solid team win over Montreal, overcoming a bit of a slow start before besting Montreal 27-25, 25-12, 25-14.

No. 1 Nebraska proved to be the toughest challenge. But bolstered by a supportive crowd announced at 4,473 fans — the fourth-best in program history — the Lobos pushed the defending NCAA champion Cornhuskers in the first two sets, eventually yielding in the third set.

## WARREN, HOUSE NAMED TO LOBO CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Senior outside hitters **Julia Warren** and **Cassie House** were both named to the Lobo Classic All-Tournament team after propelling UNM to a 2-1 record at the event at WisePies Arena.

It's the second such honor for both player after both were named to the UNM Invitational All-Tournament team.

Warren, from Albuquerque, N.M., registered 19 kills and 17 digs in the Lobos' two matches vs. NCAA teams. She notched eight digs in the Lobos' 3-1 win over Arkansas and nine digs in the Lobos' loss to top-ranked Nebraska.

She also posted 10 kills and a career high-tying three aces vs. Arkansas, with 9 kills vs. Nebraska.

House, from Rio Rancho, N.M., also performed well in UNM's matches vs. the Razorbacks and Cornhuskers. She finished with 23 kills on a .203 hitting percentage, adding nine digs and six total blocks.

She eclipsed double-digit kills in both matches to increase her team lead in kills to 94.

## WARREN SURPASSES 1000 CAREER DIGS, EYES TOP-10 MARK

With her seventh dig vs. Arkansas on September 8, **Julia Warren** broke the 1000-digs plateau as a Lobo.

She currently has 1,010 over her four-year career in Albuquerque, good for 11th in program history. The outside hitter from Albuquerque is just outside of the list of top-10 performers all-time at UNM. Paula Feathers (1995-98) sits 10th with 1,019.

She is the 37th player in Mountain West history to eclipse that mark.

At her current career rate of 2.91 digs/set, Warren has a chance to break into the top five in UNM history. With 23 matches remaining in the Lobos' season (and assuming the minimum of three sets per match), Warren

can notch about 200 more digs this season, which would put her fourth in program history.

## LOBOS VS. THE POWER FIVE

Through three weeks of the 2016 season, New Mexico has posted two wins over Power Five teams via their four-set victories over Arizona State (August 26) and Arkansas (September 8).

In the same span, the rest of the Mountain West has combined for exactly two.

The league has three more chances in the final week of non-conference play as Wyoming plays Oregon State on Sept. 16, Utah State duels Utah on Sept. 17 and Colorado State heads to No. 18 Colorado on Sept. 17,

## A MILE HIGH AND LOUDER THAN

WisePies Arena (aka The Pit) is New Mexico's world-famous basketball arena. On occasion, it's also hosted volleyball events, which was the case when Lobo Volleyball welcomed Arkansas, Montreal and No. 1 Nebraska to The Pit for the Lobo Classic.

And against the top-ranked Cornhuskers, The Pit's magic didn't disappoint, as an announced crowd of 4,473 fans watch New Mexico battle Nebraska.

It's the fourth-largest crowd in program history, and the most in 20 years, when 5,114 fans came out to see the Lobos play TCU in The Pit on October 5, 1996. It's the sixth match in program history with over 4,000 fans.

That number is also the 12th-best in Mountain West history. It's also just the second attendance figure in the top 20 not at Colorado State's Moby Arena or Utah's Smith Fieldhouse.

The other? When 4,112 fans came to watch No. 5 Nebraska play UNM at Johnson Center. (Maybe it's just the fans.)

## THE LOBOS TAKES TWO OF THREE AT USF INVITATIONAL

New Mexico won a pair of matches at the USF Invitational in Tampa, Florida, topping Stetson and Western Carolina. The Lobos also dropped a four-setter to tournament host South Florida.

The Lobos opened vs. Stetson, rallying for a 3-1 win behind a double-double from Julia Warren (16 kills and 11 digs), 12 kills from Cassie House and a career-high 24 digs from redshirt junior Ashley Kelsey,

However, the Lobos couldn't make it two straight, falling to South Florida 22-25, 25-23, 22-25, 17-25 despite three double-doubles and a career-high 14 kills from **Lauren Twitty**.

UNM did manage to cap the weekend with a win, parlaying strong performances across the board as it swept Western Carolina in straight sets.

## KELSEY MAKES IT 2-FOR-2 ON ALL-TOURNEY TEAMS. HEILBORN EARNS HER FIRST-EVER NOD

Ashley Kelsey and Carson Heilborn were both named to the USF Invitational All-Tournament Team as the pair helped New Mexico to a pair of wins during the event in Tampa, Florida.

Kelsey, a redshirt junior libero from Ewa Beach, Hawaii, made her second all-tournament team of the season as she provided strong defense for the Lobos.

Kelsey registered 57 digs on the weekend, including a career-high 24 digs vs. Stetson. She totaled only 1 reception errors in three matches. She added 10 assists and four aces, including a career-high 3 aces vs. Western Carolina (with all three coming in the third set)

Heilborn, a sophomore setter from Auburn, Washington, continued to pace the Lobos at setter. She led New Mexico with 102 assists (9.27/set) over the weekend, helping UNM to a team hitting percentage of .209. She also hit .538 with 14 kills.

She had a career night vs. South Florida, set career highs in kills (nine), assists (42) and digs (12) and finishing one kill short of New Mexico's first triple-double in six years vs. South Florida.

## NEW MEXICO GOES 3-1 AT HOME TOURNAMENT TO OPEN 2016

The Lobos opened their 2016 campaign with a solid showing at the UNM Invitational at Johnson Center in Albuquerque, winning three of their four matches on the weekend.

New Mexico started with an efficient sweep of Abilene Christian as four of its local players tallied at least five kills apiece. Behind a game-high 10 kills by **Cassie House**, the Lobos won 25-15, 25-19, 25-13.

UNM then turned around a picked up a thrilling four-set win over Arizona State, which was receiving votes in the AVCA's preseason poll. House again led the way with 17 kills, with **Julia Warren** (14 kills) and **Devanne Sours** (12) also contributing in the Lobos' 25-23, 21-25, 29-27, 25-20 win.

However, New Mexico's momentum was cut down vs. Idaho, as the Lobos fell in five, 27-25, 22-25, 21-25, 25-14, 11-15. House tallied 16 kills and Warren and **Mariessa Carrasco** notched 12 each, but numerous errors foiled UNM's bid to go 3-0.

The Lobos did close out the weekend on a high note, posting a dominant sweep of behind freshmen **Lauren Twitty** and **J'Kaylee Clark**. UNM won 25-14, 25-17, 25-17 as Twitty notched 10 kills and seven digs and Clark collected five kills and five blocks.

**Cassie House**, **Julia Warren** and **Ashley Kelsey** were named to the UNM Invitational All-Tournament Team after guiding the Lobos to a 3-1 performance at the event.

House, a senior from Rio Rancho, N.M., finished a team-high 47 kills on the weekend, including a match-high 17 in New Mexico's 3-1 win over Arizona State. Her 47 kills, which she recorded on a .241 hitting percentage, were good for second-most at the tournament.

Warren, an Albuquerque senior, tallied 37 kills, 42 digs and five aces for New Mexico. Her 37 kills were good for third-best at the tournament, with her 42 digs ranking fourth. Her five aces were tied for the most over the weekend.

Kelsey, UNM's libero, had a strong performance over the four matches, compiling 62 digs and 10 assists and four aces. The redshirt junior from Ewa Beach, Hawaii, led the tournament in digs and posted a career-best 23 receptions vs. Arizona State.

## LOBOS VS. TOP-5 TEAMS UNDER HC JEFF NELSON

New Mexico head coach **Jeff Nelson** has never shied away from playing the best teams in the nation. Every year, it's almost a guarantee the Lobos will be playing a top-ranked team in their pursuit of an NCAA bid.

The Lobos' showdown vs. No. 1 and defending NCAA champs Nebraska on September 10 was the seventh for New Mexico under Nelson, and the team's first against the nation's top-ranked squad since taking on Stanford on September 3, 2000 (a 3-0 Cardinal win).

Out of the six previous matches vs. No. 1 teams under Nelson, Nebraska was the opponent in two, once in Albuquerque at the No. 5 team (2011) and once in Lincoln, Nebraska, as the No. 2 team (2008).

UNM has also played No. 2 Texas at home in 2014, No. 4 Stanford at home in 2010, No. 4 Hawai'i in Honolulu in 2010, and No. 3 Hawai'i in the NCAA Championships in 2009.

New Mexico has yet to beat any of these top foes (in fact, UNM hasn't won a set in these matches).

The last time the Lobos beat a ranked opponent November 11, 2011, when UNM swept No. 13 Colorado State in Albuquerque.

## IT'S LIKE SHE FOUND A SHOVEL OUT THERE

After playing musical chairs with the libero position last year, the Lobos opened the season with redshirt junior **Ashley Kelsey** in the clash jersey.

So far in 2016, she has performed exceptionally well, leading the squad with 142 digs. She's registered over 20 digs three times this season, including a career-high 24 vs. Stetson on September 2.

The redshirt junior from Ewa Beach, Hawaii, has been named all-tournament at the first two tournaments of the season, the UNM Invitational and the USF Invitational.

Overall, Kelsey's 142 digs rank fifth in the Mountain West in total digs, while her 4.44 digs/set place her fourth overall in the league.

### OH, SO CLOSE

The last time a Lobo registered a triple-double (a performance in which a player accumulates a double-digit number total in three statistical categories), the oldest current player was sophomore in high school.

That performance — Jade Michaelsen's 11-kill, 44-assist, 11-dig effort vs. UC Santa Barbara on September 10, 2010 — was almost topped on September 2, 2016 when **Carson Heilborn** came exceptionally close to her own triple-double.

Heilborn finished just one kill short of a triple-double vs. South Florida on Sept. 2, finishing with nine kills, 42 assists and 12 digs. However, all those marks were career highs for the sophomore setter from Auburn, Washington, who currently ranks 10th in the Mountain West in assists.

### SHUTDOWN VOLLEYBALL

So far through three weekends of play, New Mexico has posted some strong defensive stats, including 69 total blocks and 473 digs.

But perhaps most impressive is the Lobos' opponent hitting percentage, which checks in at .160. UNM has managed to hold its foes to just 387 kills with 203 errors on 1151 attempts this season.

That stat line has New Mexico ranked second in the Mountain West in opponent hitting percentage through two weeks of play.

### DARN NEAR POINTLESS

New Mexico's shellacking of Western Carolina to cap the USF Invitational probably had something to do with the Lobos' numbers for opponent hitting percentage.

Against the Catamounts, UNM's defense was on point, holding WCU to a .021 hitting percentage.

Most noteworthy, however, was the Lobos' effort in the third set vs. Western Carolina, as the Catamounts finished with six points in the set.

That number is tied for the fewest points yielded by New Mexico in a set to 25 points, joining a six-point set by Air Force on October 30, 2010.

### HOUSE PARTY

**Cassie House** posted a strong debut over the Lobos' opening weekend, registering 47 kills over four matches.

She registered double-digit kills in three of the four matches, only missing going 4-for-4 after only playing a set in the Lobos' finale vs. Fairfield.

She did finish with a flawless .667 hitting percentage, with 4 kills on 6 attempts.

House also notched a match-high 17 kills in the Lobos' 3-1 win vs. Arizona State, including the winning kill in UNM's 29-27 win in set three.

She has continued her solid play through the third weekend of the year, and leads New Mexico with 94 kills over nine matches.

### THE BELEN BLOCKER

After sitting out the 2015 season due to thumb injuries, **Victoria Spragg** hadn't seen the court since November 21, 2014. When she finally made it back to action, the 6-foot-5 middle blocker from Belen, N.M., had a lot to catch up on.

She wasted no time, racking up 19 kills and 13 total blocks in three matches during the Lobos' opening weekend. Spragg posted a then-career best seven kills against Abilene Christian and Idaho, and led New Mexico with seven blocks against Arizona State.

She continued to shine at the USF Invitational on Sept. 2-3 in Tampa, Florida, notching another 12 blocks and 12 kills — including a career-high 8 vs. Western Carolina.

Overall, her 34 total blocks are tied for seventh in the Mountain West this year, while her 1.17 blocks/set average tabs her tied for fifth.

### CARSON HEILBORN DRIVING THE LOBOS' OFFENSE

With decorated starter Hannah Johnson graduated, the Lobos had some question marks regarding the setter position. **Carson Heilborn** and **Lise Rugland** were both initially in the running, splitting setting duties for the Lobos first few matches.

But Heilborn was given more opportunities by the New Mexico coaches, and finished the UNM Tournament with 103 assists and an assist/set average of 6.87.

She reached 30 assists twice, with 32 against Arizona State and 30 vs. Fairfield.

Heilborn continued to receive the starting

nod at the USF Invitational in Tampa, Florida, racking up 38 assists vs. Stetson and a career-high 42 vs. South Florida. She also flirted with a triple-double, finishing with career bests in kills (nine), digs (12) and assists.

Through three weeks of play, Heilborn has racked up 258 assists, good for 7.82 per set. She currently ranks 10th in the Mountain West in both categories.

## FANTASTIC FROSHIES

After falling in what head coach **Jeff Nelson** called "a classic letdown" vs. Idaho on August 27, the Lobos needed to bounce back when they played Fairfield later that day.

And behind some of their freshman, they certain did.

With newcomers **Lauren Twitty** and **J'Kaylee Clark** inserted in the starting lineup, the Lobos had little trouble with Fairfield, sweeping past the 2015 NCAA Tournament team.

Twitty finished with 10 kills on a .368 hitting percentage and seven digs and Clark added five kills and five blocks.

Twitty and Clark posted strong follow-up performances against South Florida, as Twitty logged a career-high 14 kills and Clark notched four kills on four attempts before injuring her left knee.

## LOBOS PICKED FOURTH IN MW PRESEASON COACHES' POLL

The Lobos were selected to finish fourth in the Mountain West this season, as voted by the league's 11 coaches in the MW Preseason Coaches' Poll released August 16.

Seven-time defending league champion Colorado State narrowly claimed the top spot in the coaches' poll over Boise State, earning six of the 11 first-place votes and 96 total points to Boise State's haul of four first-place votes and 92 total points.

Third-place Wyoming secured the final first-place vote and 80 total points, ahead of the Lobos' 66-point tally. UNLV and San Diego State tied for fifth place with 64 points.

Finishing seventh to 11th respectively were Nevada (47 points), Fresno State (35), Utah State (28), San José State (21) and Air Force (12).

This is the Lobos' ninth top-five selection in the preseason poll under Nelson. Last season, the Lobos were picked fifth.

## NELSON IN SEASON OPENERS

New Mexico has never lost a season opener during head coach **Jeff Nelson's** 10 seasons in Albuquerque. In fact, the Lobos have lost a

total of two sets in the eight season openers Nelson has coached (2007 vs. Florida Atlantic and 2011 vs. South Florida).

The Lobos UNM continued their success to open the 2016 season when it swept Abilene Christian to open the UNM Invitational.

Season-opening tournaments have also been successes during Nelson's tenure. Every year, the Lobos have won at least a majority of their matches.

However, New Mexico has posted at least one loss during its season-opening swing each of the last seven season (from 2010-16) after opening the Nelson era with three undefeated opening weekends (from 2007-09).

## WE ARE NEW MEXICO

Out of the 16 players on New Mexico's 2016 roster, seven hail from the Land of Enchantment. Three are senior outside hitters that all project to start in **Julia Warren** (Albuquerque), **Devanne Sours** (Tatum) and **Cassie House** (Rio Rancho). Expected starting middle blocker **Victoria Spragg** (Belen) is also from New Mexico, along with freshman middle **Jane Cisar** (New Mexico).

Defensive specialists **Mercedes Pacheco** (Albuquerque) and **Maddie Mayfield** (Albuquerque) round out the Lobos' contingent from New Mexico.

Overall, those seven native New Mexicans make up just under 44 percent of the Lobos' roster. When compared to the rest of the Mountain West, that's the third highest percentage of players competing at a school in their home state. Fresno State tops the list with nine California players out of 14 (64%), while San Diego State has 11 California players out of 20 (55%).

However, compared to every school in Division I, New Mexico ranks 31st in "home-state" players. When you discount all schools from the fertile recruiting states of Texas and California, UNM jumps all the way up to 13th in "home-state" players.

## WHO'S BACK

Although New Mexico loses three veteran starters in Hannah Johnson, Skye Gullatt and Simone Henderson, it does bring back a solid nucleus of players. 12 letterwinners from last year's 17-14 squad return, including three starters.

New Mexico returns all of its outside hitters, including **Devanne Sours**, **Cassie House**, **Julia Warren** and **Marisa Doran**. Also back are the two primary liberos from 2015 in **Ashley Kelsey** and **Mercedes Pacheco**.

Additionally, reserves from 2015 like middle blocker **Mariessa Carrasco** and setter **Carson Heilborn** are both primed to move into starting

or key roles for the Lobos in 2016. Service specialist **Allie Askew** also returns along with UNM's projected starting middle blocker **Victoria Spragg**, who redshirted last year after battling thumb injuries.

The Lobos also add back a couple of stalwarts from their beach volleyball program. **Lise Rugland** and **Maddie Mayfield** are both crossing over onto the hardwood for New Mexico and look to play important roles indoors.

## WHO'S NEW

Four freshman are making their debut at New Mexico in 2016. AVCA High School All-American **Lauren Twitty**, an outside hitter from Broadlands, Va., is one freshman looking to make an immediate impact for the Lobos deep offensive corp.

Middle blockers **J'Kaylee Clark** (Farmersville, Texas) and **Jane Cisar** (Albuquerque, N.M.) are also in contention for playing time at the net. Clark was a talented dual-sport athlete in Texas, while Cisar was named First-Team All-State in New Mexico.

The final newcomer is **Jessica Leo**, a setter from Phoenix. A daughter of one of head coach **Jeff Nelson's** players when Nelson was an assistant at Arizona State, Leo was selected to the Nike Tournament of Champions All-Tournament Team in 2014.

## ON THE 2016 SCHEDULE

The Lobos, who went 17-14 overall and 10-8 in Mountain West play in 2015, have put together a challenging 2016 schedule that provides a number of opportunities to build an NCAA-caliber résumé.

The schedule is highlighted by New Mexico's match vs. Nebraska on September 10, but the Lobos also have matches against 2015 NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona State, Fairfield, Rio Grande Rival New Mexico State and Mountain West foe Colorado State.

Fairfield (MAAC) and NM State (WAC) also won their respective conference championships last year.

New Mexico opens its season with the a five-team tournament on August 26-27 at Johnson Center. The Lobos welcome Abilene Christian and Arizona State for a pair of matches Friday, August 26, before turning around and playing Idaho and Fairfield on the following Saturday.

The Lobos then travel to Tampa, Florida, to play South Florida, Western Carolina and Stetson on September 2-3.

Nelson and company return to Albuquerque as they host the Lobo Classic at The Pit. New Mexico will take on Arkansas on September 8 before playing their marquee match vs. Nebraska on September 10.

New Mexico closes out tournament play with

a five-team affair in Arlington, Texas, as they travel to UT Arlington to play Houston Baptist and the Mavericks on September 16, and Samford and UTEP on September 17.

The Lobos round out their non-conference schedule with New Mexico State on October 16.

## ACES IN THE CLASSROOM

New Mexico shined academically in 2015 as Lobo volleyball collected a number of national- and conference-level awards.

The AVCA announced that 131 Division I teams earned the AVCA Team Academic Award for the 2015-16 season and New Mexico earned a spot on the list. The Lobos finished with a 3.32 cumulative GPA for the 2015-16 academic year.

It's the ninth straight semester — and the 27th semester in the last 28 — that the team posted at least a 3.0 GPA.

Overall, New Mexico has earned the honor eight times, previously being recognized by the AVCA in 2004, 2006, 2007, 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2015.

Five Lobos also made their way onto the Mountain West Scholar-Athlete list, including current student-athlete **Devanne Sours**, **Carson Heilborn** and **Marisa Doran**.

New Mexico also placed a number of players on the Mountain West All-Academic team, with **Allie Askew**, **Mariessa Carrasco**, **Cassie House**, **Sours** and **Doran** earning a spot.

## LOBOS HOST SUCCESSFUL ALUMNI MATCH IN PRESEASON TUNEUP

New Mexico hosted a successful Alumni Match Saturday, August 20, at Johnson Center, sweeping four straight sets against some former Lobo greats, 25-9, 25-11, 25-19, 25-21.

In the team's lone tuneup before the regular season, the Lobos received some strong performances across the board, which is exactly what head coach Jeff Nelson and his staff wanted to see.

UNM's seniors led the way, pacing the Lobos to a strong .364 hitting percentage (56 kills, 12 errors, 121 attempts).

Offensively, Cassie House registered a game-high 18 kills and Devanne Sours chipped in 10 kills and seven digs, while Julia Warren (five kills, nine digs and three aces) and Marisa Doran (five digs, four block assists) posted strong efforts defensively.

The Lobos' setters also shined as Carson Heilborn parlayed a starting effort into 28 assists (and six errorless kills), and Lise Rugland dished out 12 assists.

Victoria Spragg also had a strong night,

notching five kills and a pair of blocks assists.

Elsewhere, Mercedes Pacheco (10 digs) and Ashley Kelsey (three digs) successfully split the libero duties, while freshmen J'Kaylee Clark (four kills, 3 BA), Lauren Twitty (three kills) and Jane Cisar (two kills, 3 BA) posted productive Lobo debuts.

In fact, every player on the roster made an impact, with all 16 players recording at least a kill or a dig.

## SPRAGG, HEILBORN PLAY FOR MOUNTAIN WEST ALL-STARS

Sophomore **Carson Heilborn** and **Victoria Spragg**, competed with the 2016 Mountain West All-Star Women's Volleyball Team over the summer.

It's the third straight year the Lobos have been represented on the team. Last season, seniors **Julia Warren** and **Devanne Sours** competed with Nelson coaching the team, while in 2014, Warren, **Cassie House** and assistant coach **JJ Glavan** made the trip.

The year's team competed in the 2016 European Global Challenge in Pula, Croatia, from July 10-14, and faced off against junior national and club teams from throughout Europe.

The team finished third out of the 13-team field.

## THE LOBOS TAKE ON AUSTRALIA

The University of New Mexico volleyball team went Down Under to Australia on Saturday, May 21, for a two-week trip, where it spent 11 days touring and playing a number matches against national teams.

The Lobos, under head coach Jeff Nelson and assistants Pauline Manser and JJ Glavan, played two matches vs. club teams in Queensland before taking on national teams from Australia, New Zealand and Croatia in Melbourne.

UNM fared well in their competitions, sweeping a pair of club teams in the Queensland Club Team and the Queensland Pirate and topping the Australian and New Zealand national teams. Croatia was the only team that edged New Mexico.

The Lobos also learned about Australian culture and toured the country's beaches during their trip, which was organized in part by Manser, a former UNM All-American and a native Australian

It was New Mexico's first international trip since 2012, when the Lobos headed to Italy and Slovenia, as per NCAA rules that allow collegiate teams to take international trips once every four years.

## **HONG LENDS A HAND TO NEW MEXICO VOLLEYBALL**

After a successful professional career in his native South Korea, **Gitaik Hong** has made an early impact for the New Mexico volleyball team as a volunteer assistant coach, bringing a different perspective on the game.

Hong gives the program another defensive-minded coach who can assist the players.

His first experience in volleyball came in high school, where a volleyball coach noted his height. He put in a year playing with CheongSuk High School in South Korea, and made his first national team at age 18 in 1980.

While playing for the National Junior Men's Volleyball, Hong was part of the team that won first place in the Asia National Junior Championship.

He then went on to have a standout career as an outside hitter for Sung Kyun Kwan University, taking runner-up honors a number of times at the national championships and playing on the South Korean National University team in 1983 and 1985.

After graduating with his bachelor's degree in public administration, Hong then went on to play for the South Korean National Senior Men's Volleyball Team from 1985-87 and the LG Professional Volleyball Team from 1985-92.

Her was awarded MVP in 1985 and won third place for hitter and second place for blocker from 1984-89.

Hong then went on to coach the LG Professional Volleyball Team from 1995-99 before moving to New York.

Eventually, Hong made it to Albuquerque in 2011, when he started to coach with the Albuquerque Rebels Volleyball Club. Over the next few years, he also coached at Cibola High School, New Mexico Highlands University and with the New Mexico Juniors Volleyball Club.


