MOUNTAIN WEST TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

General Procedure. All ties shall be broken in the order in which they occur, from top to bottom, in the standings. Tied teams in the higher position shall be considered as separate positions based upon their seeding (e.g., Team A and Team B are tied for first place in the standings. By using the established tie-breaking procedures, it is determined that Team B is the No. 1 seed and Team A is the No. 2 seed. Team C and Team D are tied for fifth in the standings. When using the tie-breaking formula to break the tie, Teams C and D are compared separately against Team B first, then Team A). When comparing tied teams against positions lower in the standings that are also tied, those lower-tied positions shall be considered a single position for the purposes of comparison.

When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal (i.e., 3-0 is better than 3-1). However, 2-0 is better than 1-0, and 0-1 is better than 0-2. Thus, if two tied teams have split their regular-season series, but Team A is 2-0 against the top seed and Team B is 1-0 against the top seed, Team A would gain the higher seed.

MOUNTAIN WEST TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES (CONT.)

Two-Way Tie. If two teams tie for a position, and one holds a win-loss advantage during regular season play, that team receives the higher seed. If the two teams split their games during the regular season, each tied team's record shall be compared against the team occupying the highest position in the standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains the advantage, thereby gaining the higher seed. If two teams remain tied after all other tie-breakers have been exhausted, the last tie-breaker to determine an advantage shall be team RPI, as determined by the most recent NCAA RPI available on Friday, March 6, 2015.

Three-Way Tie. If three or more teams tie for a position, the combined record of each of the tied teams against the other teams involved in the tie shall be compared. If one team gains the advantage, thereby gaining the higher seed, the process shall then revert to the two-way tie-breaking procedure between the remaining two teams, until the tie is broken. If all three teams remain tied following the initial comparison, each tied team's record shall be compared against the team occupying the highest position in the standings, continuing down through the standings until the tie is reduced to a two-team tie, at which time the procedure shall revert to the two-way tiebreaking procedure. If all three teams remain tied after all other tie-breakers have been exhausted, the last tie-breaker to determine an advantage shall be team RPI, as determined by the most recent NCAA RPI available on Friday, March 6, 2015.

Ties Between Four or More Teams. If four or more teams tie for a position, the combined record of each of the tied teams against the other teams involved in the tie shall be compared. If one team gains the advantage, thereby gaining the higher seed, the comparison process shall then be repeated among the remaining tied teams, until the tie is reduced to a two-team tie, at which time the procedure shall revert to the two-way tie-breaking procedure between the remaining two teams, until the tie is broken. If all teams remain tied following the initial comparison, each tied team's record shall be compared against the team occupying the highest position in the standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains the advantage, thereby gaining the higher seed. The entire tie-breaking procedure shall then be repeated from the beginning among the remaining tied teams, reverting to the three- and two-way tie-breaking procedures when appropriate. If four or more teams remain tied after all other tie-breakers have been exhausted, the last tie-breaker to determine an advantage shall be team RPI, as determined by the most recent NCAA RPI available on Friday, March 6, 2015.



AIR FORCE (7-6, 0-0 MW)

- Air Force opens Mountain West play on the road at Wyoming on Wednesday, Dec. 28. The Falcons have a 3-4 record when opening Conference play away from Clune Arena. The last road MW opener AF won was Jan. 14, 2012 at Boise State (74-59). Overall, AF has a 9-8 record in MW lid-lifters.
- AF is one of the deadliest 3-point shooting teams in the country, ranking ninth in 3-point field-goal percentage at 41.7 percent. The Falcons rank second in the Conference with a total of 118 made 3-pointers this season.
- The Falcons have hit seven or more 3-pointers in seven straight games and 12 of 13 overall this season.

COLORADO STATE (8-5, 0-0 MW)

- Colorado State looks to end a three-game losing streak when they host UNLV on Wednesday, Dec. 28. The Rams have compiled a 5-12 record in Mountain West openers, including a 4-6 mark at home. CSU has won five straight at home over the Rebels.
- Entering Tuesday, Rams forward **Emmanuel Omogbo** ranks 20th among all Division I players with a 10.5 rebounds per contest average. Omogbo's 137 total rebounds are tied for the 13th-most in the nation. He leads the MW in both categories.
- When CSU shoots at least 45 percent from the floor, the Rams are 55-6 (21-4 MW) under head coach **Larry Eustachy**.

NEVADA (11-2, 0-0 MW)

- Nevada enters league play with 11 wins for the first time since the 2011-12 season. It is one of 28 teams nationally with at least 11 wins this season. The Wolf Pack, who have won two of their four Mountain West openers, host San José State on Wednesday, Dec. 28.
- The Wolf Pack have won 10 straight home contests, including five this season. This streak is the longest in the Mountain West and ranks 33rd-best nationally.
- Sophomore forward **Cameron Oliver** ranks seventh nationally with 40 total blocks and ninth with a 3.08 blocks per game average. Oliver, who has 139 career swats, is the youngest player nationally with over 100 blocked shots. After 51 career games, Oliver is only 55 blocked shots away from fifth place in MW history.

SAN DIEGO STATE (8-4, 0-0 MW)

- After spending a week in Hawaii at the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic, the Aztecs will get Wednesday off. They'll return to the court on Sunday, Jan. 1 vs. New Mexico. SDSU has compiled a league-best 13-4 record in MW openers and has won nine straight.
- Entering the week, sophomore guard **Jeremy Hemsley** ranks second nationally with a 56.9 3-point field goal percentage (29-51). Hemsley is the Aztecs' leading scorer, pouring in 16.2 points per contest.
- SDSU has compiled a 163-21 home record since the start of the 2005-06 season, which is eighth-best nationally. Only 16 teams have won inside Viejas Arena in that time.

UNLV (7-6, 0-0 MW)

- UNLV opens up Mountain West action on the road at Colorado State on Wednesday, Dec. 28. The Rebels have compiled a 6-11 record in MW openers, including three road victories. UNLV has lost two straight Conference lid-lifters, with the last win coming on Jan. 4, 2014 at Fresno State (75-62).
- The Rebels have connected on at least one 3-pointer in 987 consecutive games, tied for the most in NCAA history with Kentucky. The last game UNLV did not make a 3-pointer was vs. Long Beach State on Jan. 25, 1986.
- In 13 games, the Rebels have had five different players lead the team in scoring and seven lead in rebounding.

WYOMING (10-3, 0-0 MW)

- Wyoming, which is 8-0 at home for the first time since starting 12-0 in 2014-15, hosts Air Force to begin Mountain West play. The Cowboys are 4-5 in home MW openers and 6-11 overall. Air Force has won six of the last eight meetings against the Cowboys.
- Wyoming is limiting opponents to a field-goal percentage of 37.9 percent, which ranks 23rd nationally and leads the Conference.
- Cowboys junior forward **Hayden Dalton** has recorded four straight double-doubles. He is the first Wyo player to accomplish this feat since Leonard Washington in 2012-13. In the last four contests, Dalton is averaging 19 points and 13.3 boards.

BOISE STATE (7-4, 0-0 MW)

- Boise State travels to Utah State for its Mountain West opener on Wednesday, Dec. 28. The Broncos have a 3-2 record in Conference openers, including 1-1 on the road. BSU's lone road victory in a MW lid-lifter came on Jan. 9, 2013 at Wyoming (63-61).
- Broncos guard **Chandler Hutchison** recorded nine double-figure scoring games in his first two seasons in Boise. Hutchison has already scored in double figures 10 times this season. The junior ranks third in the MW with a 17.5 points per game average.
- Under head coach **Leon Rice**, the Broncos have won 81 games when making at least eight 3-pointers. This season, BSU is averaging 7.4 made 3's per contest.

FRESNO STATE (8-4, 0-0 MW)

- Fresno State opens MW play at New Mexico on Wednesday, Dec. 28. The Bulldogs have won one of their four Conference openers (2015-16).
- When leading at halftime, the Bulldogs have won 37 of their last 39 games. Similarly, since the start of the 2011-12 season, Fresno State has won 18 games when trailing at half.
- Bulldogs junior guard **Jahmel Taylor** ranks sixth among all Division I players with a 3-point field goal percentage of 53.0 (35-66). Taylor has registered nine games with multiple made 3-pointers this season.

NEW MEXICO (7-5, 0-0 MW)

- New Mexico begins league play with a home contest vs. Fresno State on Wednesday, Dec. 28. The Lobos are 7-0 in MW openers played at The Pit and overall they've won five straight league lid-lifters.
- UNM ranks 13th nationally in free throws made (252) and 21st in free throws attempted (336). The Lobos' 75.0 percentage from the charity stripe ranks 37th in the nation and second in the Mountain West.
- Senior forward **Tim Williams** shot 60.4 percent from the field last year, which was eighth-best in UNM history. This season, Williams is shooting at a 60.9 percent clip, ranking 20th nationally.

SAN JOSÉ STATE (7-4, 0-0 MW)

- San José State concluded nonconference play with seven wins, the most entering league action since 2011-12 (8).
- The Spartans open MW play on the road at Nevada on Wednesday, Dec. 28. SJSU is 0-3 in Conference openers, including 0-1 on the road. Nevada has won 15 of the last 16 contests vs. San José State.
- San Jose State's next road win will give the program its first season of three road wins since 2013-14.

AZTECS PICKED TO WIN 2016-17 MW REGULAR-SEASON CROWN

For the fourth consecutive year, San Diego State is the preseason favorite to finish the 2016-17 regular season in first-place, according to a vote of the Conference media. The league's predicted order of finish was announced today by the Mountain West at Media Day, being held at the Renaissance Las Vegas Hotel.

The Aztecs received 23 of a possible 27 first-place votes and 293 points to garner the top spot in the poll. Nevada claimed the second spot, earning 234 points, while New Mexico received three first-place votes and 249 points to finish third. This is the highest predicted finish for the Wolf Pack since joining the Mountain West in 2012.

Fresno State, which received one first-place vote, collected 200 points for fourth place, followed by Boise State in fifth (164 points) and Utah State (153 points) in sixth. Rounding out the poll were Colorado State (146 points) in seventh, UNLV (120 points) in eighth, Air Force (90 points) in ninth, Wyoming (73 points) in 10th and San José State (41 points) in 11th.
