SCOUTING THE LOBOS

New Mexico welcomes the Aggies to the Pit with a 6-6 overall record, including a 5-3 home record. The Lobos opened conference play with wins at Fresno State (80-54) and against San Diego State (85-42).

New Mexico returns seven letterwinners to the floor this season after going 17-15 overall and 9-9 in conference play a year ago. The Lobos finished tied for fifth in the Mountain West, falling to Colorado State in the semifinal round of the conference tournament. Junior guard Cherise Beynon leads New Mexico in scoring, averaging 15.4 points per game. Senior center Richelle van der Keijl is tops defensively, averaging 9.8 rebounds per game. As a team, New Mexico is shooting 40.3 percent (315-of-782) from the field, 29.3 percent (86-of-294) from the 3-point line and 56.8 percent (133-of-234) from the free throw line. The Broncos are averaging 70.9 points per game, while allowing an average of 62.1 points from the opposing teams. Mike Bradbury is in his first season at the helm of the New Mexico program and his 10th overall as a head coach.

New Mexico leads the all-time series between the two teams, 13-6, dating back to the 1974-75 season. The Lobos hold a 7-1 advantage in games played in Albuquerque. Last season, the Aggies and Lobos split the pair of conference games, with each team winning in its home arena.

SCOUTING THE LADY REBELS

UNLV enters the week with a 9-5 record. The Lady Rebels opened conference play with an 0-2 record, falling to Colorado State (57-37) at home and at Wyoming (79-57).

UNLV returned three starters and eight total letterwinners from last year's squad. The team went 18-14 overall a year ago, while going 9-9 in conference play to tie with New Mexico for fifth place. The Lady Rebels advanced to the semifinals of the Mountain West Tournament, where they fell to Fresno State. As a team, UNLV is shooting 37.5 percent (312-of-832) from the field, 30.8 percent (82-of-266) from the 3-point line and 64.2 percent (174-of-271) from the free throw line. The Lady Rebels are averaging 62.9 points per game, while allowing an average of 58.8 points from their opponents. Cathy Olivier is in her ninth season as the head coach at UNLV, where she has an overall record of 126-140.

UNLV leads the all-time series against the Aggies, 18-3, going back to the 1974-75 campaign. In 12 prior meetings, Utah State has never beaten the Lady Rebels in games played in Las Vegas. Utah State and UNLV met just once last season, where the Lady Rebels claimed the 46-38 win in Las Vegas.

FRESH FACES

New Mexico is one of five teams the Aggies will face this year that is under the direction of a first-year head coach. Mike Bradbury took over the helm of the Lobo program this season, replacing Yvonne Sanchez who was the head coach for the previous five seasons. Bradbury is one of five head coaches in the first season at their current school, joining Tamara Inoue (UC Irvine), Christy Smith (Incarnate Word), Shannon Schweyen (Montana) and Adia Barnes (Arizona). Additionally there are another six schools on this year's schedule who have had their current head coach for five years or less.

DOUBLE DUTY

After several performances nearing double-double status, Utah State has had three double-doubles in its last four games. Sophomore center **Deja Mason** recorded the first double-double of any Aggie player this season the team's loss to BYU. Mason was second on the team in scoring that day, matching her career-high with 11 points and adding a career-best 11 rebounds. That was the second double-double of Mason's career. Freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** recorded back-to-back double-doubles in the games at Arizona and Boise State. Against the Wildcats, she led the team with a career-high 21 points and 11 rebounds. She followed with a repeat performance in the next game, recording 13 points and 12 boards. Last season, five Utah State players combined for seven double-double performances.

A REBOUNDING MACHINE

Freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** continues to anchor the Aggie defense. In the Dec. 15 game against Utah Valley, Dufficy recorded a team high 14 rebounds for the third time this season. She first had 14 boards against Montana State (Nov. 14), which is the most rebounds recorded by an Aggie freshman since the reinstatement of the program in the 2003-04 season. With her 14-rebound performances at Montana (Nov. 27) and against UVU, Dufficy became the first player to have multiple games of 14 or more rebounds in a season since the reinstatement.

THE DUFFICY DEFENSE

While leading the Aggies defensively, freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** is highly ranked conference-wide. Overall, she ranks third in rebounding, averaging 9.5 per game. She leads the league in offensive rebounds, averaging 4.0 per game. Among all Mountain West players, she is one of two players to have five or more 10-rebound games, joining Fresno State junior center Bego Faz Davalos. She is one of just three players, and the only freshman, to have multiple games with 14 or more rebounds.

THE FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

Utah State freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** is having a standout freshman season. Averaging 9.9 points and 9.5 rebounds per game, she is leading all freshmen in the Mountain West. She currently ranks 20th in scoring and third in rebounding.

SULTANS OF SWAT

Continuing the dominant defensive performance, the Aggies lead the Mountain West in blocks, averaging 6.8 per game as a team. Individually, three USU players are ranked in the top-10 among conference players. Sophomore center **Deja Mason** ranks second, averaging 2.5 per game. Behind her, senior forward **Antoina Robinson** is ranked seventh (1.4 bpg), while freshman forward **Dee Moore** is tied for ninth (1.0 bpg).

BLOCKING OUT THE COMPETITION

While leading the Mountain West in blocking, the Aggies have had several strong single-game performances. In the loss to BYU, the USU team tied the program single-game blocks record, combining for 14. That matches the record set by the team in 2011 in a game against Boise State. Among those 14 blocks against the Cougars, Mason led the team with five, tying her season-high, while Robinson tied her career-best with four. Those 14 blocks are the most in a game by a Mountain West team this season. The Aggies also had 13 blocks against UC Irvine.

WEST SIDE STORY

After struggling to score over the final four non-conference games, freshman guard **Olivia West** got back on track in the first weekend of Mountain West action. In the first league home game against Air Force, West had a perfect shooting game, as she went 3-for-3 from the field, including 2-of-2 from the 3-point line, and was 4-of-4 from the free throw line.

UTAH STATE'S BEST

So far this season, the women's basketball team has had three players earn USU America First Credit Union Student-Athlete of the Week honors. Freshman guard **Eliza West** picked up the first accolade for the week ending Nov. 28, while sophomore guard **Rachel Brewster** followed the next week. Most recently, sophomore forward **Shannon Dufficy** picked up her first AFCU Student-Athlete of the Week honor after the Boise State and Air Force games. Last season, women's basketball earned the award four times, all of which were given to **Funda Nakkasoglu**. This is the first time three different women's basketball players have been named the USU Student-Athlete of the Week since the 2012-13 season, when **Devyn Christensen**, **Jenna Johnson** and **Jennifer Schlott** each earned the honor at least once.

THE PERFECT RANGE

This season, Utah State is 7-0 when scoring 60 points or more. The Aggies are 5-0 when scoring 60-69 points and 2-0 when scoring 70-79 points in a game. Conversely, Utah State is 1-5 when allowing its opponents to score in the same range. The Aggies are 6-0 on the year when holding their opponent to fewer than 60 points.

START 'EM YOUNG

With three freshmen and two sophomores in the current starting five, Utah State currently has the youngest starting lineup in the country. USU is one of four NCAA teams that has three freshmen in its starting corps right now, joining Air Force, Maine and UAB. Joining the freshmen, UAB starts one sophomore and a junior, Maine has a sophomore and a senior and Air Force adds two juniors. This is the second season in a row that the Utah State has utilized its youth, starting two freshmen, two sophomores and a senior for the majority of its games in the 2015-16 season.

UP NEXT

After two-straight road games, the Aggies return to the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum next week for back-to-back home games. Utah State will host Wyoming on Wednesday, Jan. 11, at 7 p.m. The week will conclude in a game against San Diego State on Saturday, Jan. 14, at 2 p.m. The Aggies will then have their first bye of the conference season, returning to action on Saturday, Jan. 21, at Colorado State.

Made her collegiate debut and first-career start against Westminster (Nov. 11)... Named MVP of the Lady Griz Classic... Scored a career-best 18 points against Montana (Nov. 27)... FRESHMAN FORWARD SHANNON DUFFICY – Leads the team in rebounding, averaging 9.5 boards per game... Averaging 12.3 points and 1.0 rebounds over her last four games... Made her collegiate debut and first-career start against Westminster (Nov. 11)... Has scored in double-digits five times this year... Scored a career-high 21 points at Arizona (Dec. 21)... Has two double-doubles on the year at Arizona (21-11) and at Boise State (13-12)... Has recorded a career-high 14 rebounds in three games... Was named to the all-tournament team at the Lady Griz Classic... Averaging 9.9 points and 9.5 rebounds per game... Shooting 42.6 percent (43-of-101) from the field, 42.9 percent (6-of-14) from the 3-point line and 60.7 percent (17-of-28) from the free throw line.

SOPHOMORE CENTER DEJA MASON – Leads the team in blocks with 29 on the season, averaging 2.9 per game... Recorded season-high five blocks in back-to-back games against

Utah State women's basketball opened the Mountain West portion of its season on the road Thursday, falling to Boise State, 76-56.

Utah State was led by freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** who recorded her second double-double of the season with 13 points and 12 rebounds. She was joined in double figures by freshman guard **Eliza West** who ended the night with a team-high 14 points. The Broncos were led by a double-double from Shalen Shaw who had 19 points and 10 rebounds. The Aggies out-rebounded Boise State, 39-38.

With the loss, Utah State falls to 7-5 overall and 0-1 in Mountain West action. Boise State moves to 11-1 on the year and 1-0 in league play.

The Broncos won the tip Thursday night, but were unable to score on their first possession. Utah State nearly turned the ball over, but Eliza West hung on to earn the first points of the night. Boise State ran through the next minutes of play though, holding the Aggies to just a pair of free throws over a five-minute stretch. Eliza West ended the skid, snapping an 8-0 Bronco run. Behind Shaw's dominating performance, the Broncos ended the first quarter with a 26-10 lead.

Utah State was first to score in the second quarter behind a 3-point shot from freshman guard **Jessie Geer**. Through the next minutes, Dufficy was the only Aggie to score, adding a pair of shots in the paint over two-and-a-half minutes. Utah State gained a little bit of traction after the media timeout, but the Broncos were able to answer each Aggie shot. Utah State had the final possession of the half, but a layup from Eliza West hit the rim and bounced out. The teams headed into the locker rooms with Boise State leading, 46-23.

Starting the second half with the ball, Dufficy's first shot of the quarter was blocked. She responded with a block of her own on the other end of the court. Geer fouled a Bronco player on the offensive rebound, but she missed the free throws to keep the second half scoreless. Boise State was first to score in the third quarter, but the teams traded buckets back-and-forth for the early minutes of play. The Aggies were held to just free throws for the final five minutes of the quarter until freshman guard/forward **Hailey Bassett** scored with 10 seconds on the clock. After three quarters, Boise State led, 66-42.

The Aggies started strong in the fourth quarter, holding the Broncos scoreless for the first two minutes. With two quick fouls in 20 seconds, freshman guard **Olivia West** fouled out. She ended the night with three points, her first in five games. Over the final five minutes of the night, both teams were held mostly the free throws. The Aggie defense slowed the Broncos down as Boise State did not hit a field goal for nearly four minutes. With less than two minutes to play, Boise State ended its scoring skid in the final bucket of the night.

Overall, Utah State shot 33.9 percent (19-of-56) from the field, including 37.5 percent (3-of-8) from the 3-point line, and was 75.0 percent (15-of-20) from the free throw line. Boise State shot 46.2 percent (30-of-65) from the field, 33.3 percent (8-of-24) from behind the arc and 61.5 percent (8-of-13) from the free throw line.

Becoming the youngest player in Utah State women's basketball history to score 1,000 career points, **Funda Nakkasoglu** led the Aggie women's basketball team in a 73-70 loss at New Mexico Wednesday night.

N a k k a s o g l u scored 28 points on the night, as she became the ninth player in program history to reach the 1,000-point benchmark. The sophomore guard shot 42.1 percent (8-of-19) from the field, including 66.7 percent (4-of-6) from the 3-point line. She also shot perfectly from the free throw line for the

second straight game, going 8-of-8 on the night. Joining Nakkasoglu in double figures were freshman guard **Katie Toole** with 14 and senior forward **Julianne Anchling** with 12. Freshman guard Rachel Brewster was the top rebounder against the Lobos, tallying 10. New Mexico was led by 24 points from Cherise Beynon, while two others added double-figure points.

The Lobos were first on the board Wednesday night, but the teams traded baskets over the first few minutes of action, going into the first media timeout with New Mexico leading, 11-8. Toole scored the first four points for the Aggies, while Nakkasoglu earned her first four at the free throw line. After five minutes without a field goal, a deep 3-pointer from Nakkasoglu got the Aggies back in it, followed by shots from freshman center **Deja Mason** and senior forward **Tijana Djukic**. A layup from sophomore center Hannah Hutchins put the lead back in USU's favor, while sophomore guard Baylee Peck scored her first points of the year at the buzzer, putting the Aggies up 19-16 at the quarter break.

As the second quarter started, the Lobos capitalized on several costly Utah State turnovers, going on a 7-1 run. Out of the USU-called timeout, the Aggies answered with five straight points, once again evening the score. The offensive success switched teams again, as New Mexico went on another 9-0 run. After four scoreless minutes for the Aggies, Nakkasoglu drained another trey, while Djukic got the final shot in for the half. The Lobos held the advantage at the midpoint of the game, leading 35-30.

All-around play cleaned up in the second half, as the teams committed a combined five turnovers in the third quarter. The Aggies and Lobos battled back-and-forth throughout the quarter, but New Mexico maintained the lead. The Utah State offense found a spark, however, ending the quarter on an 8-0 run and keeping the Lobos without a point for the final 2:34. A layup from Nakkasoglu put the lead back in the Aggies' favor, as the third quarter ended at 50-49.

Though the Lobos scored a quick five points to start the fourth quarter, the Aggies responded with a 6-0 run, building up their lead. During that run, Nakkasoglu reached 23 points on the night, putting her at 1,001 career points. Three straight turnovers by Utah State put New Mexico back into scoring mode, scoring seven straight points, while Beynon tied the score at 62 with a 3-pointer. Making up a bit for the slump, USU made five of its next seven baskets. With under a minute to play, New Mexico made a pair of free throws to tie the game, while a layup gave the Lobos the lead heading into the final seconds. As the teams fouled back-and-forth, the last minute was full of free throws. Mason got the final point of the night, but it wasn't enough as the Lobos took the victory.

Overall, Utah State shot 42.9 percent (24-of-56) from the field, 35.7 percent (5-of-14) from the 3-point line and 81.0 percent (17-of-21) from the free throw line. New Mexico shot 32.4 percent (23-of-71) from the field, 33.3 percent (9-of-27) from behind the arc and 75.0 percent (18-of-24) from the free throw line.

AGAINST THE COMPETITION – NEW MEXICO

Last Logan Meeting – Jan. 9, 2016 Utah State 72, New Mexico 56

Utah State women's basketball picked up its second conference win of the season Saturday, topping New Mexico, 72-56, at home.

With her 14th double-figure game of the season, sophomore guard **Funda Nakkasoglu** led the Aggies with 17 points on the day. Joining her in double digits were freshman guard **Rachel Brewster** with 12 points and senior forward **Julianne Anchling** with 10. Brewster and senior forward **Tijana Djukic** were tops in rebounding with six boards apiece. Cherise Beynon led New Mexico and all scorers with 21 points.

The Aggies utilized their seventh different starting lineup in Saturday's game as sophomore center Hannah Hutchins made her first start of the season. This was the first game of the year that all 15 players on the USU roster were dressed and ready to play, as several have dealt with minor injuries throughout the season.

Despite a slow start for both teams, the Aggies were first on the board Saturday on a layup from Hutchins two minutes into the game. The teams traded baskets back-and-forth, but the Aggies had the lead early on at the first media timeout. Out of the stop, the Lobos went on an 8-0 run, but the Aggies answered with a run of their own. The USU defense scored 11-straight points to end the quarter, with the Lobos' last field goal coming at the 4:05 mark.

With a 20-13 lead at the end of the first, the Aggies continued their run into the second quarter. The 16-0 run was snapped by a jumper from Jaisa Nunn, the first New Mexico points in more than seven minutes. During the scoring streak, Nakkasoglu went 1-for-2 from the free throw line, her first miss since the Dec. 22 game against Utah, making 28-straight in that period. Back-to-back 3-pointers from Brewster started another 14-0 run for the Aggies, while a jump shot from freshman guard Katie Toole gave the Aggies a 20-point lead. With the offensive surge, the USU defense held New Mexico to 2-of-10 over the final minutes, giving the Aggies a 45-23 lead at the break.

The Aggies slowed down through the second half, while the Lobos fought to cut into the deficit. By the media timeout, New Mexico had already scored more points than in either previous quarter. A pair of free throws from Brewster were the first points for either team in 2:44. The Aggies committed six turnovers in the final five minutes of the quarter, but stayed on top, 57-39 heading into the final period.

In a low-scoring game on both ends of the court, Utah State women's basketball fell to UNLV on the road in a 46-38 game Wednesday.

Sophomore guard **Funda Nakkasoglu** was the leading scorer for the Aggies with 10 points on the night. Just behind her was freshman guard **Katie Toole** with eight points, making her first start since the Idaho State game. Junior forward **Antoina Robinson** was the leading rebounder for the Aggies, tallying 10 boards. **Dakota Gonzalez** led UNLV with 19 points, while **Nikki Wheatley** added 11.

Wednesday's game was the lowest-scoring game for the Aggies since Dec. 15, 2007, when the team scored 38 points in a loss at Utah. Utah State has now scored 38 points of fewer just eight times in program history. Utah State and UNLV combined for 84 points on the night, the lowest combined score since the Aggies defeated Fresno State, 44-40, on Feb. 24, 2008. Wednesday was just the third time in program history, that both teams scored fewer than 50 points in a Utah State game.

It took three minutes for anyone to score Wednesday night, as the Lady Rebels were finally first on the board with a pair of free throws. Back-to-back 3-pointers from UNLV followed, pushing USU to call the first timeout, down 8-0. Out of the timeout, the Aggies found a spark, scoring seven straight and holding the Lady Rebels to an 0-for-7 stretch. Another UNLV trey ended the drought, but the Aggies got the final points of the quarter with a set of free throws from Nakkasoglu. Despite the slow start, Utah State ended the first quarter with just a one-point deficit, down 10-9.

The slow pace returned at the start of the second quarter, as the Aggies went almost minutes of action without a score. Another pair of free throws ended the skid, while the Lady Rebels also struggled. By the media timeout, UNLV still led, up 13-11. After no one on either team scored for nearly four minutes, a layup from senior forward **Tijana Djukic** tied the game, heading into the final minute of the half. The Lady Rebels got one basket in before the buzzer, heading into the locker room with the 15-13 advantage. The Aggies shot just 23.5 percent (4-of-17) in the first half, but held the Lady Rebels to 14.3 percent (5-of-35) from the floor.

It took the Aggies just 10 seconds to get the first bucket of the second half, as Toole tied the game. Fouled in the process, Toole missed the and-one, unable to take the lead. Just minutes later, freshman guard **Rachel Brewster** was fouled on a 3-point attempt. She made 2-of-3 free throws, giving the Aggie their first lead of the night. UNLV took that lead right back, however, going on a 13-2 run and gaining the momentum of the game. With the biggest lead of the night, the Lady Rebels ended the third quarter with a 30-21 advantage.

UNLV got the first shot of the final quarter in, but the Aggies answered with an 8-0 run. The Lady Rebels cut in with a 3-pointer, calling a timeout right after. Nakkasoglu narrowly missed a layup, but was fouled in the process and she capitalized on the free throw attempts to tie the game once again. UNLV got on another run as the quarter wound down, when a free throw from senior forward **Julianne Anchling** cut into the 8-0 surge. With 18 seconds left, Anchling's free throw was the final basket for the game.

On the night, Utah State shot a season-low 26.1 percent (12-of-46) from the field, 7.1 percent (1-of-14) from the 3-point line and 81.3 percent (13-of-16) from the free throw line. UNLV shot 21.2 percent (14-of-66) from the field, 26.9 percent (7-of-26) from behind the arc and 73.3 percent (11-of-15) from the free throw line.

Last Logan Meeting – Jan. 24, 2015 Utah State 85, UNLV 72

Three players with double-digit points, including a double-double from senior forward **Ingrida Strikas** led the Utah State women's basketball team to an 85-72 win over UNLV Saturday, the team's third-straight victory.

Freshman guard **Funda Nakkasoglu** and senior guard/forward **Jasmine Porter** led the team in scoring with 17 points apiece. Strikas added 16 to the total score, the team's most since scoring 92 at Sacramento State. Strikas was also tops defensively, with a season-best 10 rebounds. Danielle Miller was the top scorer for UNLV, with 20 points. The Aggies had 21 assists on 29 made field goals Saturday. Nakkasoglu also led in that category, tallying eight to match her season-best.

With the win, Utah State improves to 6-13 overall with a 3-4 Mountain West record. The Rebels fall to 6-12 on the year and 3-4 in league play. The game opened heavily in UNLV's favor, as the Rebels jumped out on an 11-3 run, securing a double-digit lead in the first five minutes of action. As the half went on, the Aggies would chip away at each Rebel lead, but were never able to quite get the advantage.

With just three minutes left in the first half, a flawless jumpshot from freshman guard **Tilar Clark** tied the game for the first time. A pair of free throws from Strikas after the next play gave the Aggies their first lead of the afternoon. USU stayed ahead for the remainder of the half, but two free throws from Aley Rohde knotted the score at 36 to send the teams into the locker rooms.

The second half proved to be an eventful and physical one for both teams. The Rebels had a strong opening stretch, similar to their performance in the first half. Senior forward Franny Vaalu finally got the score tied again, followed by a trey from Porter to get the lead back in the Aggies' favor.

USU held UNLV to just one point over a five-minute stretch through the midpoint of the half. In a last-ditch attempt to beat the shot clock, Miller lobbed the ball from the half-court mark, draining the shot and ending the Rebels' drought. That shot shifted the momentum back to the UNLV side of the floor for the next stretch of action, as the cut into the Aggies lead. A layup from Rohde momentarily gave the Rebels another lead, but free throws from Nakkasoglu gave the advantage back to USU. The Aggies would maintain the lead for the remainder of the game.

Heading into the final stretch, Strikas and junior forward **Tijana Djukic** both fouled out of the game. Strikas had one technical, joining Porter

in the same call. Overall, Utah State had 21 fouls and 24 turnovers, while UNLV had 25 and 19, respectively.

With less than a minute left on the clock, Utah State found its first double-digit lead of the day. The final seconds of the game were all about Utah State, as a layup from Nakkasoglu and free throw from Porter finished out the day and secured the 13-point victory.

Overall, Utah State shot 53.7 percent (29-of-54) from the field, 33.3 percent (4-of-12) from three and 82.1 percent (23-of-28) from the free throw line. UNLV shot 34.9 percent (22-of-63) from the field, 31.3 percent (5-of-16) from three and 71.9 percent (23-of-32) from the free throw line. For the third-straight game, the Aggies out-rebounded the opponent, taking a 39-34 advantage.

Jerry Finkbeiner is in his fifth season as the head women's basketball coach at Utah State.

Finkbeiner (pronounced Fink-by-ner) was named the ninth head coach in USU program history on April 26, 2012. He is the second male coach in Utah State history, joining Bob Corbin, who was the Aggies' coach from 1984-86. Finkbeiner is only the second USU coach since the reinstatement of the program in 2003 when Raegan Pebley took over.

Overall, Finkbeiner has a 529-312 (.629) record in 27 years as a collegiate head coach, including his time at Utah State, Oral Roberts (1996-2013) and Southern Nazarene (1991-96). He also ranks 24th in the nation among active coaches with his 529 career wins.

Finkbeiner coached the 2015-16 squad to a 14-17 record, including an 8-10 Mountain West ledger. The Aggies finished seventh in the league, advancing to the second round of the conference tournament. Guard Funda Nakkasoglu earned first-team all-Mountain West honors, while guard Rachel Brewster was named to the all-Freshman team.

Off the court, seven Aggies earned academic all-Mountain West honors with another six being named Mountain West Scholar-Athletes.

In 2014-15, Finkbeiner coached the Aggies to an 8-23 record, going 5-13 in Mountain West play. That year, Finkbeiner led guard Funda Nakkasoglu to the Mountain West Freshman of the Year award. Additionally, Nakkasoglu earned honorable mention all-conference accolades. At the conclusion of the season, senior forward Franny Vaalu became the second of Finkbeiner's players to sign a professional contract, playing for the Wolfpack in Wolfenbüttel, Germany.

In the classroom, four players earned academic all-Mountain West honors, while three were named Mountain West Scholar-Athletes.

During the summer of 2015, Finkbeiner took the Aggie women on an eight-day trip to the Yucatán Peninsula of Mexico. On the trip, the team played against local club and university teams, hosted coaches and children's clinics

and toured the sights.

In the 2013-14 season, Finkbeiner led the Aggies to a 15-16 overall record, while going 8-10 in league play in their first year in the Mountain West. The team advanced to the quarterfinals of the Mountain West Championships, falling to Colorado State.

That year, Finkbeiner coached guard Jennifer Schlott to several accolades and records. Schlott finished the year third in the nation in scoring with 26.2 points per game. She was named the Mountain West Player of the Year and became USU's first-ever AP All-American, earning honorable mention accolades. She became the all-time leading scorer at Utah State, ending her career with 1,556 points. Schlott was invited to a WNBA training camp with the Indiana Fever, before signing a professional contract to play for Tapiolan Honka in Finland.

Off the court, the 2013-14 Aggies also succeeded academically. Six student-athletes received academic all-Mountain West honors, while two were named Mountain West Scholar-Athletes.

In Finkbeiner's debut season in 2012-13, the Aggies achieved an 18-14 record. USU finished second in the Western Athletic Conference standings for the second-straight season with a 14-4 mark. Under the direction of Finkbeiner, Utah State advanced to the postseason for the third-straight season, as the Aggies played in the Women's Basketball Invitational. USU finished the season second in the nation in free throw percentage with a school and WAC record 80.1 percent. Three players were honored by the WAC as Devyn Christensen earned first-team honors, while Jennifer Schlott and Jenna Johnson earned second and third-team honors, respectively.

The Aggies also found success in the classroom under Finkbeiner as five players earned academic all-WAC honors.

Finkbeiner came to Utah State from Oral Roberts in Tulsa, Okla., where he spent 16 years as head coach. During his tenure at ORU, the Golden Eagles averaged 17 wins per season and advanced to postseason play eight times with five trips to the NCAA Tournament and

three appearances in the WNIT.

As the head coach at Oral Roberts, Finkbeiner led the Golden Eagles to seven Summit League regular season and tournament titles and six 20-win seasons. At ORU, Finkbeiner coached five All-Americans, eight conference players of the year, five conference newcomers of the year and 26 all-conference selections. He was named conference coach of the year twice during his ORU tenure.

In his six years prior to ORU, Finkbeiner led Southern Nazarene to three-straight NAIA national titles and a combined 99-4 record from 1994 to 1996. Finkbeiner posted a 186-20 record in six seasons at SNU. During his career at Southern Nazarene, Finkbeiner coached nine NAIA All-Americans and a two-time NAIA Player of the Year, while five of his players went on to play professional basketball overseas.

During his tenure at Southern Nazarene, Finkbeiner's coaching achievements did not go unnoticed, as he was named the NAIA National Coach of the Year in 1994, 1995 and 1996. He was also named as the College Sports Magazine and Converse National Coach of the Year in 1995. Finkbeiner was named the NAIA District 9 Coach of the Year in 1993 and the Sooner Athletic Conference Coach of the Year from 1992 to 1996.

Finkbeiner, a native of Southern California, attended Southern Nazarene in Oklahoma City, Okla. from 1975-80, where he was a four-year letterwinner. In that time, he was selected as a Christian Collegiate All-American in 1978. Finkbeiner graduated with a bachelor's of science degree in physical education and completed his master's degree in physical education at Northwest Missouri State University. Along with coaching at SNU, Finkbeiner also worked as a professor in the kinesiology and sports management department.

Finkbeiner and his wife, Reva, have five children and two daughters-in-law, Isaac (Angela), Ben (Alycia), Corban (Nathan), Micha (Tommy) and Bethany. His son, Ben, is an assistant coach for the Aggies.
