SCOUTING THE LOBOS

The first repeat Mountain West competitor of the season for the Aggies, New Mexico makes the trip to Logan matching Utah State with a 9-9 record. Thus far, the Lobos have gone 5-3 in conference action. Last week, New Mexico fell to undefeated Wyoming, 68-52, in Laramie.

New Mexico returns seven letterwinners to the floor this season after going 17-15 overall and 9-9 in conference play a year ago. The Lobos finished tied for fifth in the Mountain West, falling to Colorado State in the semifinal round of the conference tournament. Junior guard Cherise Beynon leads New Mexico in scoring, averaging 15.7 points per game. Senior center Richelle van der Keijl is tops defensively, averaging 9.8 rebounds per game. As a team, New Mexico is shooting 38.2 percent (448-of-1172) from the field, 27.6 percent (120-of-434) from the 3-point line and 61.3 percent (212-of-346) from the free throw line. The Lobos are averaging 68.3 points per game, while allowing an average of 63.6 points from the opposing teams. Mike Bradbury is in his first season at the helm of the New Mexico program and his 10th overall as a head coach.

New Mexico leads the all-time series between the two teams, 14-6, dating back to the 1974-75 season. The Aggies and Lobos have played 10 games in the Spectrum, splitting the series, 5-5. Last season, the teams split the pair of conference games, with each team winning in its home arena. Utah State and New Mexico played in Albuquerque on January 4, with the Lobos taking the win, 78-67.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

Utah State makes the trip to Fresno for the teams' sole match-up this season. The Bulldogs are one of two Mountain West teams the Aggies will face just once. Fresno State welcomes the Aggies with an 11-8 record, going 4-4 in conference play. Last week, the team defeated Nevada at home, 68-54. The Bulldogs have their first bye on Wednesday.

Fresno State returns seven letterwinners from last year's team that went 22-12 overall and 15-3 in league action. The Bulldogs advanced to the championship game of the Mountain West Tournament, where they fell to Colorado State, 55-54. Fresno State made a postseason appearance in the WNIT, defeating Santa Clara before falling to Oregon in the second round. Junior center Bego Faz Davalos is the all-around leader for the Bulldogs, averaging 14.4 points and 11.4 rebounds per game. As a team, Fresno State is shooting 40.9 percent (451-of-1104) from the field, 30.2 percent (103-of-341) from the 3-point line and 63.9 percent (188-of-294) from the free throw line. The Bulldogs are averaging 62.8 points per game, while allowing an average of 61.5 points per game. Jaime White is in her third season as the head coach at Fresno State, where she has an overall record of 66-30.

Sharing time in both the Western Athletic Conference and the Mountain West, Utah State and Fresno State have an extensive history over just a 10-year span. Ultimately, Fresno State has dominated the series, leading, 20-2. The Bulldogs have won the last 16 meetings, with Utah State's last victory coming on Feb. 24, 2008. Last season, the teams met three times over 17 days. The Bulldogs claimed a 67-61 win in Logan, followed by a 66-62 victory in Fresno. The teams then met in the quarterfinals of the Mountain West Tournament, where Fresno State topped the Aggies, 55-47.

THAT FLASHBACK FEELING

Despite not being able to defeat Fresno State in any of the three meetings a year ago, Utah State has played well against the Bulldogs. In last year's matchups, sophomore guard **Katie Toole** averaged 9.7 points and 6.0 rebounds, while shooting 40.7 percent (11-of-27) from the floor. Sophomore guard **Rachel Brewster** averaged 9.3 points and 4.7 rebounds, while sophomore center **Deja Mason** had 7.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game.

SOPHOMORE BLOCK PARTY

Sophomore center **Deja Mason** continues to dominate the Aggie defense by blocking out the opposing players. Mason leads the team with 36 blocks this season, averaging 2.0 per game. With just two more blocks, Mason will match her total from last season, which ranks 10th in a single season. Though just a sophomore, she is currently tied for seventh on the Utah State career blocks list. Additionally, Mason is tied for the USU single-game record for blocks, as she had eight against Boise State last season.

THE HOME STRETCH

Utah State returns to its two-game schedule this week, after playing just one with a scheduled bye a week ago. The Aggies will now play 11-straight games without a break to close out the 2016-17 regular season. Utah State's second by of conference

play will come on the final day of the year leading into the conference tournament. The Aggies will close the year at home against UNLV on Tuesday, Feb. 28.

SEEING DOUBLE

Freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** recorded her third double-double of the season in the team's loss to Wyoming. She led the team with 12 points and a career-high 16 rebounds. Since the reinstatement of the USU women's basketball program, Dufficy is the only freshman to record multiple double-doubles in a season. Her three double-doubles are the most by a USU player in a season since **Jennifer Schlott** had five during the 2013-14 campaign. Dufficy is one of three Utah State players to combine for five double-double performances this season.

THE FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

Utah State freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** is having a standout freshman season. Averaging 9.0 points and 9.3 rebounds per game, she is leading all freshmen in the Mountain West. Overall, she currently ranks 28th in scoring and third in rebounding.

A REBOUNDING LEADER

With her success on the glass this season, freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** is leading the Aggies with an average of 9.1 rebounds per game. She is splitting her rebounds well with 89 defensive and 56 offensive, both of which rank her in the top-10 among Mountain West players. Dufficy is the first Aggie to average more than nine boards over the season since the reinstatement of the program, topping **Ashlee Brown's** lead of 8.9 rebounds in the 2011-12 season. **Sharon Epps** holds the single-season rebounding average record, snagging 12.5 per game in the 1982-83 season.

MIXING IT UP

In trying to find the perfect combination of players, Utah State has utilized six different starting lineups this season. The group including freshman guard **Eliza West**, sophomore guard **Rachel Brewster**, freshman guard **Jessie Geer**, freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** and sophomore center **Deja Mason** has seen the most starts, opening seven games together. West and Brewster are the only two players to start all 18 games this season. Freshman forward **Hailey Bassett** started three games in Mason's stead, giving the Aggies the youngest starting lineup among NCAA teams.

BETTER THAN THE REST

Utah State is out-performing its opponents in almost every major category so far this season. The Aggies have a better shooting percentage in all three areas. Additionally, Utah State has out-rebounded the other teams, 706-674, while tallying more assists (246-229) and blocks (106-50). As of Saturday's game at Colorado State, the Aggies are being out-scored on the year, 1,070-1065.

SHOOTING HIGH

Utah State has had several strong shooting performances this season. The Aggies' best performance from the field came against Incarnate Word in the Lady Griz Classic, where USU shot a season-high 53.7 percent (29-of-54) from the floor. USU's best 3-point percentage came against Idaho State, when the Aggies went 7-of-12 (58.3 percent) In all, Utah State has had five games shooting above 40 percent from the floor and seven instances of shooting above 40 percent from behind the arc.

THE PERFECT RANGE

Utah State is 5-1 this season when scoring between 60 and 69 points. Additionally, the Aggies are 2-0 when scoring in the 70-79 point range. Defensively, USU is 5-0 when holding its opponents to fewer than 50 points. The Aggies are 0-5 when allowing the other team to score 70 points or more.

SPLITTING THE STATS

Throughout the season, the Aggie starters and bench players have stayed statistically consistent. When looking at points, rebounds and minutes played, the starting lineup has recorded 65 percent of statistics, while the bench has 35 percent. When in the starting lineup, USU players have scored 659 points and recorded 421 rebounds while playing 2,234 total minutes. The bench players have 363 total points to go with 255 rebounds in 1,191 minutes on the court.

UP NEXT

Utah State has back-to-back road games, as the Aggies open next week at Nevada (7-11, 1-6 MW) on Wednesday, Feb. 1, at 7:30 p.m. (MT). The team will then return to the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum to host Boise State (14-4, 4-3 MW) on Saturday, Feb. 4, at 2 p.m.

With the loss, Utah State falls to 9-9 overall and 2-5 in Mountain West play. Colorado State improves to 14-5 on the year with a 6-1 league ledger.

Brewster led the Aggies from the very beginning, as she scored eight of the team's 13 first-quarter points. She put Utah State on the board from behind the arc before going on to add another trey and layup before the media stop. Brewster gave the Aggies their first lead of the game prior to the stop, but the Aggies would not score for another four minutes. Freshman forward **Hailey Bassett** ended the skid for Utah State, but the Rams held an 18-13 lead at the end of the quarter.

The Rams opened the second quarter on a 6-0 run, forcing an early timeout from the Aggie staff. Bassett pulled the Aggies out of their rough patch with an offensive rebound and putback off a shot from freshman guard **Jessie Geer**. However, Colorado State followed that with three-straight 3-pointers, holding the Aggies scoreless for the last 7:26 of the half. To the success behind the arc, the Rams added another six points to end the quarter up, 39-15.

The second half got off to a slow start on both ends of the court, but West was first to score for either team, ending the Aggies' long drought. West continued her strong third-quarter performance, scoring 12 points in the period. Utah State found more of an offensive groove in the third, but the Rams had an answer for every Aggie run. A free throw from freshman forward **Dee Moore** and a 3-point shot from freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** gave USU the final say on the quarter, but CSU held the 57-33 advantage.

Utah State's struggles from the floor continued in the fourth quarter, as the Aggies were held to mostly free throws for several minutes. In the meantime, Colorado State again found success from the 3-point line, adding four treys in the fourth. Sophomore guard Katie Toole ended Utah State's five-minute scoring skid in the final two minutes, while Brewster made the final layup of the day on either end.

Overall, Utah State shot 31.4 percent (16-of-51) from the field, including 26.1 percent (6-of-23) from the 3-point line, and was 71.4 percent (5-of-7) from the free throw line. Colorado State shot 56.6 percent (30-of-53) from the field, the best of any USU opponent this season. The Rams shot 41.7 percent (10-of-24) from behind the arc and 66.7 percent (4-of-6) from the free throw line.

In its sole game of the week, Utah State women's basketball dropped a road decision to Colorado State Saturday, falling to the Rams, 74-43.

Utah State was led by freshman guard **Eliza West** and sophomore guard **Rachel Brewster** who each tallied 12 points on the day. West was also the leading rebounder for the Aggies with six, matching her career-high. Colorado state had three players in double figures, including two with 20 or more points. Elin Gustafsson led the Rams with 22 points and 12 rebounds, her second double-double of the season.

Utah State women's basketball got back in the win column Saturday, as the Aggies defeated San Diego State, 53-47, in the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum.

Sophomore guard **Rachel Brewster** was the all-around leader for the Aggies Saturday, ending the game with 18 points and nine rebounds. She was joined in double figures by senior forward **Antoina Robinson**, who added 12 points. Freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** added another eight rebounds, contributing to the team's 43-38 rebound advantage over the Aztecs.

Back in the starting lineup for the first time since Dec. 3, Robinson started the day on a high note, scoring the first two field goals for the Aggies. After a bit of back-and-forth from both teams to start the quarter, the Utah State defense held the Aztecs out of the media timeout. San Diego State missed nine-straight field goal attempts over a five-minute stretch, while the Aggies went on a 9-0 run. The Aztecs ended their skid in the final minute of the quarter, but USU led, 19-9 after one.

Utah State maintained its control through the early minutes of the second quarter, but the Aztecs quickly started to gain some traction. The SDSU defense held the Aggies scoreless for nearly five minutes before freshman guard **Eliza West** ended the skid. In the meantime, the Aztecs chipped away at USU's lead, pulling within three points two different times. With a long pass from Dufficy, Brewster threw up a last-second shot from behind the arc, draining the 3 and giving Utah State a 28-22 lead at the halftime break.

Returning to the court, Brewster picked up where she had left off, scoring the first field goal of the half in the early seconds. She and Robinson each added another layup, the final points on either end for nearly three minutes. A single free throw for San Diego State ended the offensive skid, but the Aggies maintained their lead. Brewster then ended the Aggies' struggle, hitting the first field goal in the team's last eight attempts. It wasn't until the 3:05 mark of the third quarter that the Aggies made their first trip to the free throw line, where Brewster went 2-of-3. USU was again held scoreless for the final three minutes of the quarter, while the Aztecs added seven-straight points, down 38-34 at the end of the third.

Robinson snapped USU's skid on the first possession of the fourth quarter. Layups from freshman guard **Jessie Geer** and Brewster followed, rebuilding the Aggies' lead to double figures. With a layup from Dufficy, Utah State led by 12, matching its biggest advantage of the game. The Aztecs didn't score their first points of the quarter until the 4:53 mark, with a breakaway layup on a steal, also drawing the and-1. Robinson reached double figures for the second time this season after the media timeout, but SDSU answered with back-to-back 3-point shots to cut the Aggies' lead to three. As the final minute counted down, the Aztecs added two free throws to come within one possession. After timeouts from both benches, the Aggies drew a pair of fouls off San Diego State, where Robinson and Brewster combined for four free throws in the last 20 seconds of the game. The Aztecs had the final possession of the day, but were unable to capitalize on it to secure the win for USU.

Overall, Utah State shot 39.3 percent (22-of-56) from the field, including 25.0 percent (2-of-8) from the 3-point line, and was 70.0 percent (7-of-10) from the free throw line. San Diego State shot 28.8 percent (17-of-59) from the field, 22.7 percent (5-of-22) from behind the arc and 66.7 percent (8-of-12) from the free throw line.

Struggling through a late run by the opponent, Utah State women's basketball opened its week of road competition in a 78-67 loss at New Mexico Wednesday.

The Aggies were led by freshman guard **Olivia West** who scored a career-best 19 points on the night, as she went 6-of-10 from the field, including 5-for-8 from the 3-point line. Freshman forward **Hailey Bassett** joined her in double figures with 11 points. New Mexico had two players with 20-point games, while another added 18. Freshman forward **Shannon Dufficy** led Utah State with nine rebounds on the night, but the Lobos out-rebounded the Aggies overall, 40-36.

With the loss, Utah State falls to 8-6 on the year and 1-2 against league opponents. New Mexico improves to 7-6 overall and remains perfect in conference play at 3-0 with the win.

From the start, the game was very even-paced and back-and-forth. Four minutes in, the Aggies saw their first lead of the night on a 3-pointer from freshman guard **Jessie Geer**. After a bit of back-and-forth action, Utah State continued to benefit from the performance behind the arc, when West drilled back-to-back 3s to put the Aggies on top once again. Her strong shooting held through the quarter, as she hit shots from the 3-point line to beat a shot clock and again at the final buzzer of the quarter. After one, Utah State led, 21-16.

The Lobos started the second quarter with a bit of a run, but the Aggies answered with one of their own. Utah State was held to just free throws for a three-minute stretch, but managed to hang onto their lead. Bassett and West controlled the Aggie offense for the majority of the second quarter, combining to score 12-straight points and 12 of the team's 16 total points. West scored the final basket of the half for the Aggies to reach a new career-high. Heading into the break, USU remained ahead, up 37-32.

The back-and-forth action of the early minutes of the game returned at the start of the second half. New Mexico dominated the first minutes of the third quarter, taking the lead back for the first time since the first quarter. By the media timeout of the third, the teams had seen five lead changes and four ties, as both teams capitalized on the other's mistakes. The later minutes of the quarter went in New Mexico's favor, as the Lobos closed the period on a 7-1 run in the final minute to lead, 62-54.

Utah State tried to chip away at New Mexico's advantage through the fourth quarter, getting as close as four points. The battle continued down the final stretch of the game, as the teams alternated shots. With just over five minutes to play, sophomore guard **Katie Toole** drew a charge off New Mexico and followed it up with the team's ninth 3-pointer of the night. Going on a 7-0 run, the Lobos built their lead back to double figures over the final five minutes of the game. West attempted one final trey for the Aggies, but the Lobos had the final possession to secure the win.

Overall, Utah State shot 41.0 percent (25-of-61) from the field, including 40.9 percent (9-of-22) from the 3-point line, and was 66.7 percent (8-of-12) from the free throw line. New Mexico shot 40.3 percent (25-of-62) from the field, 33.3 percent (8-of-24) from behind the arc and 76.9 percent (20-of-26) from the free throw line.

Last Logan Meeting – Jan. 9, 2016 Utah State 72, New Mexico 56

Utah State women's basketball picked up its second conference win of the season Saturday, topping New Mexico, 72-56, at home.

With her 14th double-figure game of the season, sophomore guard **Funda Nakkasoglu** led the Aggies with 17 points on the day. Joining her in double digits were freshman guard **Rachel Brewster** with 12 points and senior forward **Julianne Anchling** with 10. Brewster and senior forward **Tijana Djukic** were tops in rebounding with six boards apiece. Cherise Beynon led New Mexico and all scorers with 21 points.

The Aggies utilized their seventh different starting lineup in Saturday's game as sophomore center Hannah Hutchins made her first start of the season. This was the first game of the year that all 15 players on the USU roster were dressed and ready to play, as several have dealt with minor injuries throughout the season.

Despite a slow start for both teams, the Aggies were first on the board Saturday on a layup from Hutchins two minutes into the game. The teams traded baskets back-and-forth, but the Aggies had the lead early on at the first media timeout. Out of the stop, the Lobos went on an 8-0 run, but the Aggies answered with a run of their own. The USU defense scored 11-straight points to end the quarter, with the Lobos' last field goal coming at the 4:05 mark.

With a 20-13 lead at the end of the first, the Aggies continued their run into the second quarter. The 16-0 run was snapped by a jumper from Jaisa Nunn, the first New Mexico points in more than seven minutes. During the scoring streak, Nakkasoglu went 1-for-2 from the free throw line, her first miss since the Dec. 22 game against Utah, making 28-straight in that period. Back-to-back 3-pointers from Brewster started another 14-0 run for the Aggies, while a jump shot from freshman guard Katie Toole gave the Aggies a 20-point lead. With the offensive surge, the USU defense held New Mexico to 2-of-10 over the final minutes, giving the Aggies a 45-23 lead at the break.

The Aggies slowed down through the second half, while the Lobos fought to cut into the deficit. By the media timeout, New Mexico had already scored more points than in either previous quarter. A pair of free throws from Brewster were the first points for either team in 2:44. The Aggies committed six turnovers in the final five minutes of the quarter, but stayed on top, 57-39 heading into the final period.

New Mexico continued to chip away at Utah State's lead in the fourth quarter, but was never able to find quite the groove needed to get back ahead. The Lobos called their final timeout of the day with 3:06 remaining in the game. The final two minutes of action belonged to Anchling, scoring five straight points as the clock ran out and gave the Aggies the win.

Battling through the third game in 18 days against the same opponent, seventh-seeded Utah State women's basketball's run through the 2016 Mountain West Championship came to an end Tuesday night, in a 55-47 loss to No. 2 Fresno State.

Sophomore guard Funda Nakkasoglu led the Aggies with 16 points on the night, the only USU player to reach double figures. Freshman guard Katie Toole had a team-best 10 rebounds, adding four points. Redshirt sophomore Bego Faz Davalos was tops for the Bulldogs with her 13th double-double of the season, tallying 23 points and 12 rebounds.

Nakkasoglu was first on either team to score Tuesday, but the Bulldogs responded with seven straight points. Despite four blocks from freshman center Deja Mason, the Aggies were unable to capitalize on the defensive opportunities and were held scoreless for more than three minutes. A pair of free throws from Mason ended the scoring skid for USU, but the advantage was in Fresno State's favor, up 13-9 at the end of the quarter.

As the second quarter got underway, senior forward Julianne Anchling drained a perfect 3-point shot to cut the lead to one, followed by another trey from freshman guard Rachel Brewster to take the lead. The teams went on to battle back-and-forth through the remainder of the half, trading shots as well as turnovers. Fresno State found a shooting streak as it made six straight field goal attempts, taking the lead back at the media timeout. A shot from senior forward Tijana Djukic tied the score once again, but the Bulldogs responded with a 3-point shot, taking the 28-25 lead into the locker room.

The Aggies came out hot in the second half, netting back-to-back baskets from Mason to take the lead once again. A trey from Nakkasoglu extend USU's lead, as the Aggie defense held the Bulldogs without a bucket for the first 5:24 of the half. Over the first half of the quarter, Utah State went on a 13-4 scoring run, but roles reversed in the final minutes, when the team's only point came from a single free throw from sophomore center Hannah Hutchins. Despite the slump, the Aggies held on to the lead to end the quarter up, 39-38.

The back-and-forth of the game only picked up in the fourth quarter, as both teams fought through the final minutes. Fresno State took the lead back at the 5:47 mark on an old fashioned 3-point play. Scoring then slowed down drastically, as neither team scored for nearly four minutes. Turnovers plagued the Aggies' possession, but the Bulldogs weren't able to capitalize on the miscues. As Mason fouled out, Faz Davalos ended the scoring skid for Fresno State, going 1-of-2 at the line. With less than a minute to go, Hutchins hit one free throw, the first USU points since the 7:17 mark of the quarter. The last minute was all about free throws on both ends, but Fresno State secured the win.

Overall, Utah State shot 30.2 percent (16-of-53) from the field, 26.7 percent (4-of-15) from the 3-point line and 78.6 percent (11-of-14) from the free throw line. Fresno State shot 31.7 percent (20-of-63) from the field, 15.4 percent (2-of-13) from behind the arc and 56.5 percent (13-of-23) from the free throw line.

Fresno State 66, Utah State 62

Utah State women's basketball wrapped up the regular season at Fresno State Friday night, falling to the Bulldogs, 66-62.

Freshman guard **Katie Toole** led the Aggies with 21 points on the night, her second 20-point game of the season. Freshman guard **Rachel Brewster** added 12 points, while sophomore center **Hannah Hutchins** had 10. Freshman center **Deja Mason** was tops defensively with seven rebounds. Alex Furr led Fresno State with 15 points, while three other players added 12 apiece.

With the loss, Utah State concludes the regular season at 13-16 overall and 8-10 in Mountain West play. Fresno State finishes with a 19-10 overall record, going 15-3 in league action.

Fresno State jumped out early Friday night, keeping Utah State off the board for the first four minutes of action. A 3-pointer from Brewster gave the Aggies their first points of the night, lighting an offensive spark. In the final minutes of the quarter, Utah State committed several turnovers, but managed to hold the Bulldogs scoreless to end the quarter down, 14-11.

The Aggies continued to fight into the second quarter, as the teams battled back-and-forth. Toole was the first USU player to hit double figures on the night, reaching the mark on a jumper midway through the quarter. In the final two minutes of the half, the Utah State defense held Fresno State to just three points, scoring 11 of its own in the same time. On a last-chance shot from behind the arc at the buzzer, sophomore guard **Funda Nakkasoglu** tied the score at 35 at the halftime break.

Coming out of the locker rooms, Fresno State opened the second half on a 7-0 run, forcing three early turnovers by the Aggies. Toole snapped the USU skid, but the Bulldogs went on to build their lead, getting up by 11, the largest advantage of the night. Utah State had its lowest scoring quarter of the game in the third, as Fresno State led, 56-45.

As the fourth quarter started, the Aggies continued to chip away at the Bulldogs' lead. Toole scored nine straight points for USU, getting the team's deficit back to six points. As Nakkasoglu was fouled, she hit her 40th and 41st consecutive free throws, putting Utah State within two. Back-to-back field goals from Brewster gave the Bulldogs just a one-point advantage with 1:12 remaining. In the final 30 seconds, Fresno State drew an offensive foul off the Aggies and were able to force another turnover.

Jerry Finkbeiner is in his fifth season as the head women's basketball coach at Utah State.

Finkbeiner (pronounced Fink-by-ner) was named the ninth head coach in USU program history on April 26, 2012. He is the second male coach in Utah State history, joining Bob Corbin, who was the Aggies' coach from 1984-86. Finkbeiner is only the second USU coach since the reinstatement of the program in 2003 when Raegan Pebley took over.

Overall, Finkbeiner has a 529-312 (.629) record in 27 years as a collegiate head coach, including his time at Utah State, Oral Roberts (1996-2013) and Southern Nazarene (1991-96). He also ranks 24th in the nation among active coaches with his 529 career wins.

Finkbeiner coached the 2015-16 squad to a 14-17 record, including an 8-10 Mountain West ledger. The Aggies finished seventh in the league, advancing to the second round of the conference tournament. Guard Funda Nakkasoglu earned first-team all-Mountain West honors, while guard Rachel Brewster was named to the all-Freshman team.

Off the court, seven Aggies earned academic all-Mountain West honors with another six being named Mountain West Scholar-Athletes.

In 2014-15, Finkbeiner coached the Aggies to an 8-23 record, going 5-13 in Mountain West play. That year, Finkbeiner led guard Funda Nakkasoglu to the Mountain West Freshman of the Year award. Additionally, Nakkasoglu earned honorable mention all-conference accolades. At the conclusion of the season, senior forward Franny Vaaulu became the second of Finkbeiner's players to sign a professional contract, playing for the Wolfpack in Wolfenbüttel, Germany.

In the classroom, four players earned academic all-Mountain West honors, while three were named Mountain West Scholar-Athletes.

During the summer of 2015, Finkbeiner took the Aggie women on an eight-day trip to the Yucatán Peninsula of Mexico. On the trip, the team played against local club and university teams, hosted coaches and children's clinics

and toured the sights.

In the 2013-14 season, Finkbeiner led the Aggies to a 15-16 overall record, while going 8-10 in league play in their first year in the Mountain West. The team advanced to the quarterfinals of the Mountain West Championships, falling to Colorado State.

That year, Finkbeiner coached guard Jennifer Schlott to several accolades and records. Schlott finished the year third in the nation in scoring with 26.2 points per game. She was named the Mountain West Player of the Year and became USU's first-ever AP All-American, earning honorable mention accolades. She became the all-time leading scorer at Utah State, ending her career with 1,556 points. Schlott was invited to a WNBA training camp with the Indiana Fever, before signing a professional contract to play for Tapiolan Honka in Finland.

Off the court, the 2013-14 Aggies also succeeded academically. Six student-athletes received academic all-Mountain West honors, while two were named Mountain West Scholar-Athletes.

In Finkbeiner's debut season in 2012-13, the Aggies achieved an 18-14 record. USU finished second in the Western Athletic Conference standings for the second-straight season with a 14-4 mark. Under the direction of Finkbeiner, Utah State advanced to the postseason for the third-straight season, as the Aggies played in the Women's Basketball Invitational. USU finished the season second in the nation in free throw percentage with a school and WAC record 80.1 percent. Three players were honored by the WAC as Devyn Christensen earned first-team honors, while Jennifer Schlott and Jenna Johnson earned second and third-team honors, respectively.

The Aggies also found success in the classroom under Finkbeiner as five players earned academic all-WAC honors.

Finkbeiner came to Utah State from Oral Roberts in Tulsa, Okla., where he spent 16 years as head coach. During his tenure at ORU, the Golden Eagles averaged 17 wins per season and advanced to postseason play eight times with five trips to the NCAA Tournament and

three appearances in the WNIT.

As the head coach at Oral Roberts, Finkbeiner led the Golden Eagles to seven Summit League regular season and tournament titles and six 20-win seasons. At ORU, Finkbeiner coached five All-Americans, eight conference players of the year, five conference newcomers of the year and 26 all-conference selections. He was named conference coach of the year twice during his ORU tenure.

In his six years prior to ORU, Finkbeiner led Southern Nazarene to three-straight NAIA national titles and a combined 99-4 record from 1994 to 1996. Finkbeiner posted a 186-20 record in six seasons at SNU. During his career at Southern Nazarene, Finkbeiner coached nine NAIA All-Americans and a two-time NAIA Player of the Year, while five of his players went on to play professional basketball overseas.

During his tenure at Southern Nazarene, Finkbeiner's coaching achievements did not go unnoticed, as he was named the NAIA National Coach of the Year in 1994, 1995 and 1996. He was also named as the College Sports Magazine and Converse National Coach of the Year in 1995. Finkbeiner was named the NAIA District 9 Coach of the Year in 1993 and the Sooner Athletic Conference Coach of the Year from 1992 to 1996.

Finkbeiner, a native of Southern California, attended Southern Nazarene in Oklahoma City, Okla. from 1975-80, where he was a four-year letterwinner. In that time, he was selected as a Christian Collegiate All-American in 1978. Finkbeiner graduated with a bachelor's of science degree in physical education and completed his master's degree in physical education at Northwest Missouri State University. Along with coaching at SNU, Finkbeiner also worked as a professor in the kinesiology and sports management department.

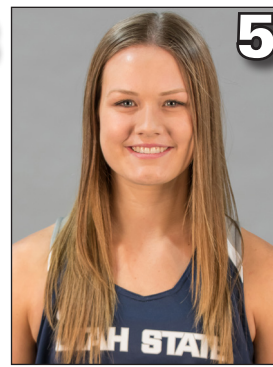

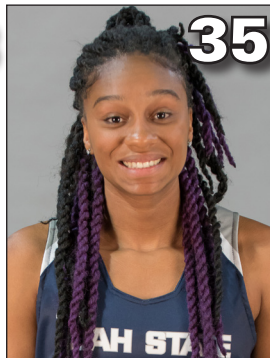
