The Counting Crows had a hit song in 1996 by the title of A Long December and it will seem like that this month for the UNI men's basketball team.

UNI will embark on its third road game of a seven-game road trip this Saturday in Albuquerque, N.M., against the New Mexico Lobos. The

The Panthers and Lobos will tangle at 8 p.m. (CT) Saturday in The Pit.

SCOUTING NEW MEXICO

The New Mexico Lobos are 5-2 on the year, which includes a perfect 4-0 mark on their home floor.

The Lobos have scored wins over Texas Southern (86-57), at New Mexico State (83-74), Loyola (75-51), Nicholls State (75-63) and Oral Roberts (91-75). New Mexico's two losses have come at USC (90-82) and at Purdue (70-58).

Elijah Brown leads the Lobos in scoring at 17.9 ppg. Cullen Neal averaged 16.9 ppg. Tim Williams is scoring 16.1 ppg and leads the squad in rebounding at 8.9 rpg.

New Mexico is led by second-year head coach Craig "Noodles" Neal. He led New Mexico to a 27-7 mark and a berth into the 2015 NCAA Tournament. Neal served as an assistant to Steve Alford at both New Mexico and the University of Iowa.

ALL-TIME SERIES

Saturday will mark the first meeting between UNI and New Mexico.

Both squads are competing in the 2015 Diamond Head Classic in Honolulu Dec. 22-25.

CARING FOR THE BASKETBALL

UNI committed a season-low four turnovers in its 73-65 win at George Mason (Dec. 8).

It was the fewest turnovers for UNI since last season's MVC Tournament title win over Illinois State when the Panthers made only three turnovers.

THREE-POINT PRODUCTION

UNI leads the Missouri Valley Conference in three-point field goal

percentage (.429).

UNI has made the most three-pointers in the MVC with 78 made triples through eight games.

UNI has made at least seven three-pointers in every game this season.

The Panthers canned 10 three-pointers against George Mason - marking the fifth time this season that UNI has made 10 or more three-pointers.

PLENTY OF PANTHER POINTS

UNI is scoring 79.0 points per game in 2015-16, which ranks as the second-highest single-season average in the last 46 years of Panther basketball.

UNI averaged 85.1 points per game in the 1988-89 season.

UPPERCLASS SCORING

UNI's junior and senior classes are scoring 76 percent (59.8 ppg) of the teams points this season through the first eight games.

Seniors Matt Bohannon (13.8 ppg), Paul Jespersion (12.4 ppg) and Wes Washpun (15.9 ppg) are accounting for 42.0 points per game.

Juniors Jeremy Morgan (11.6 ppg) and Aarias Austin (6.1 ppg) are contributing 17.8 points per contest.

DON'T FORGET THE DEFENSE

It's not all about scoring this year, as UNI can also play some defense.

UNI is allowing 67.8 points per game.

In UNI's six wins, the Panthers have limited the opposition to 67 points or less.

UNI'S 3-POINT STREAK

UNI has made at least one 3-pointer in 503 straight games - the longest active streak in the Missouri Valley Conference.

The last time UNI failed to make a 3-point basket came Feb. 3, 2000, vs. Southern Illinois in a 72-58 Panther victory in the UNI-Dome. UNI went 0-for-4 from 3-point land vs. the Salukis in that contest.

the University of Virginia before transferring to UNI. Jespersion returned to Virginia this past week with the Panthers playing at Richmond and at George Mason.

Jespersion performed well in his return to Virginia by notching his first career double-double at George Mason with 19 points and 12 rebounds in UNI's 73-65 triumph.

Both his 19 points and 12 rebound were career-highs for Jespersion.

PAULIE IS MONEY AT THE LINE

Paul Jespersion salted away the UNI victory at George Mason (12/8) by making all six free throws in the final 1:09 of the second half.

He is 20-of-21 this season and has made 23 of his last 24 free throws dating back to 2014-15.

Jespersion has made 39-of-43 career free throws at UNI for a 90.7 percent clip.

DISHING AT A RECORD PACE

Senior guard Wes Washpun is handing out assists at a record-pace this season at 6.1 assists per game, which is also tops in the Missouri Valley Conference and ranks No. 21 in the country.

Jay Imhoff (1979-80) and Brooks

McKowen (2006-07) hold the UNI single-season assist record at 5.8 assists per game.

BO KEEPS KNOCKING 'EM IN

Senior guard Matt Bohannon has made a team-best 24 three-pointers through the first eight games.

He has made at least one 3-pointer in 18 straight games - dating back to last season.

MORGAN IS MAKING PLAYS

Junior guard Jeremy Morgan has shown he can do it all this season from scoring and rebounding to defending.

Morgan ranks fourth in scoring (11.6 ppg), second in rebounding (5.5 rpg), second in free throws made (27) and first in steals (14).

Morgan's steal of Joel Berry II's pass with :08 left and ensuing free throw helped clinch UNI's 71-67 victory over No. 1 North Carolina (Nov. 21).

FOR STARTERS

UNI's starting five consists of Matt Bohannon, Paul Jespersen, Bennett Koch, Jeremy Morgan and Wes Washpun.

Bohannon and Morgan are the two returning starters from last year's 31-4 Panther squad.

Jespersen started 33 career games at the University of Virginia before transferring to UNI. Prior to this season, Jespersen's last start came at Virginia on March 27, 2013 vs. Iowa in the NIT.

Washpun started 29 games as a sophomore for the Panthers. His last start previous the pair this season came March 7, 2014, in the MVC Tournament vs. Southern Illinois.

Koch came off the bench in all 28 games he played as a redshirt freshman.

HEAD COACH BEN JACOBSON

10th Year at UNI

UNI head coach Ben Jacobson is in his 10th season at the helm of the Panther men's basketball program and is the program's all-time wins leader with 203.

In his tenure at UNI, Jacobson has posted an overall record of 203-107 (.655 winning percentage). Jacobson has averaged 21.9 wins per season at UNI.

Jacobson guided UNI to a 31-4 record in the 2014-15 season, which included a school-record 16-game winning streak, an MVC Tournament title and the school's first-ever top-10 national ranking. UNI finished the season ranked No. 14 in the final Coaches Top 25 poll. The 2014-15 season also saw UNI's Seth Tuttle earned consensus second-team All-America honors.

For the third time in nine seasons, Jacobson was awarded the Missouri Valley Conference's Coach of the Year Award.

Jacobson has guided the Panthers to postseason play in six of his nine seasons as head coach, including three trips to the NCAA Tournament (2009, 2010 and 2015). UNI reached the Sweet 16 in 2010 following wins over UNLV and No. 1-ranked Kansas. The Panthers scored a 71-54 win over Wyoming in the 2015 NCAA Tournament to secure the program's fourth all-time tournament victory.

A native of Mayville, N.D., Jacobson graduated from Mayville-Portland High School in 1989 as valedictorian. He received his bachelor's degree in physical education from the University of North Dakota in 1994.

Following last season, Jacobson signed a 10-year deal through 2024-25.

Jacobson and his wife, Dawn, have two children, Hunter (12) and Tanner (10).

WINNING WAYS AT MCLEOD

The McLeod Center will celebrate its 10th anniversary this season and the Panthers have made winning a priority in their home venue.

UNI has posted an all-time mark of 117-29 (.801) in games played in the McLeod Center.

UNI secured a school-record 16 home wins in the 2012-13 season. The previous mark of 15 home wins was set in the 1989-90 season.

UNI has posted a trio of perfect home seasons since moving to NCAA Division I. UNI was a perfect 14-0 in both the 1983-84 and 2009-10 seasons and then UNI notched a 15-0 mark at home last season.

UNI set its home-court win streak of 21 consecutive victories between the 2008-09 and 2010-11 seasons.

The McLeod Center opened in November 2006.

SPIDERS SNAP UNI'S 5-GAME WIN STREAK

The Richmond Spiders snapped UNI's five-game winning streak on Dec. 5.

The Spiders drained 13 three-pointers and shot 53.6 percent from the field.

UNI was led in scoring by Matt Bohannon with 14 points. Bohannon and Paul Jespersen each drained three 3-pointers against the Spiders.

BACK-TO-BACK 90-POINT GAMES

For the first time since the 1993-94 season, UNI has tallied back-to-back 90-point scoring games with its 97-51 win at North Dakota and its 93-70 victory over North Texas.

The last time it happened, UNI notched a 92-72 win over Bradley on Feb. 7, 1994, and then followed it up with a 102-79 victory at Drake on Feb. 12, 1994.

7TH-LARGEST VICTORY IN SCHOOL HISTORY

UNI's 97-51 win at North Dakota resulted in a 46-point margin of victory - the seventh-largest margin of victory in school history.

It was UNI's largest margin of victory since a 53-point win over Wartburg (Nov. 12, 2012).

PAUL IS MAKING HIS MARK

Senior guard Paul Jespersen knocked in a career-high 18 points on the strength of 4-of-5 shooting from three-point land in UNI's 97-51 victory at North Dakota (Nov. 28).

DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR MORGAN

Junior guard Jeremy Morgan recorded his first career double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds in UNI's 83-63 triumph over Dubuque.

WASPUN GOES BACK-TO-BACK WITH 20-POINT SCORING GAMES

Senior guard Wes Washpun has

recorded back-to-back 20-point scoring games for the first time in his collegiate career.

WASPUN NAMED MVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior guard Wes Washpun has been recognized by the Missouri Valley Conference as its men's basketball player of the week (Nov. 23) for his play in a pair of Panther victories.

Washpun averaged 17.5 points, 5.5 assists, 4.0 rebounds and shot 63.6 percent from the field in leading UNI to wins over Stephen F. Austin and No. 1-ranked North Carolina.

Washpun began the week with a 14-point, five-rebound, three-assist effort in a 70-60 win over Stephen F. Austin. Washpun made 5-of-7 field goals against the Lumberjacks.

Washpun dropped in 21 points and handed out eight assists in a 71-67 triumph over No. 1 North Carolina. Washpun drained a 57-foot shot at the first-half buzzer. He then added 12 points and five assists in the second half to lead UNI back from a 16-point deficit. Washpun made 9-of-15 shots from the field, grabbed three rebounds and notched two steals vs. the Tar Heels.

It is the first MVC player of the week award in Washpun's collegiate career.

8TH CAREER TECHNICAL FOR JAKE

UNI head coach Ben Jacobson picked up his eighth technical foul

of his coaching career in UNI's 71-67 victory over No. 1-ranked North Carolina (Nov. 21).

UNI TAKES DOWN NO. 1

For the second time under head coach Ben Jacobson, the UNI Panthers have toppled the nation's No. 1-ranked team.

UNI recorded a 71-67 win over No. 1-ranked North Carolina on Nov. 21 in the McLeod Center.

Jacobson also led UNI to a 69-67 win over No. 1-ranked Kansas in the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

UNI has recorded 15 wins over ranked NCAA Division I opponents. UNI is 12-6 at home against ranked opponents. UNI has won four of its last five home games against ranked foes.

UNI TOPPLES NO. 1 CAROLINA

UNI's 71-67 win against No. 1 North Carolina marked the first time in the MVC's 109-year history that a non-conference No. 1 team lost to an MVC team in a true road game.

The league now has eight wins against No. 1 teams (the AP poll began in 1949-50.). The other seven were on neutral courts; which includes three "No. 1 wins" in the past seven seasons. 2010 (UNI vs. Kansas), 2013 (Wichita State vs. Gonzaga) and Nov. 21, 2015 when UNI knocked off North Carolina.

PANTHERS VS. THE ACC

UNI earned the program's third win over an Atlantic Coast Conference school with its triumph over North Carolina and second in as many seasons vs. an ACC opponent.

UNI knocked off Virginia Tech last season by the count 73-54 in the Cancun Challenge. UNI also defeated Boston College on Nov. 23, 2009,

at the Paradise Jam, 83-69.

UNI is now 3-3 all-time vs. the ACC (L, 63-60 vs. Clemson in 1991-92; L, 65-60 vs. Georgia Tech in 2004 NCAA Tournament; L, 80-66 vs. Maryland in 2013-14).

UNI VS. RANKED TEAMS

Since the 1979-80 season, UNI has compiled a mark of 15-34 vs. ranked opponents.

UNI is 12-6 at home against ranked opponents. The Panthers have won four of their last five home games against ranked foes. Ben Jacobson joined the UNI coaching staff in 2001-02, since then the Panthers have posted 12 victories over ranked opponents.

UNI is 2-0 all-time against No. 1-ranked opponents. UNI secured a 71-67 win over North Carolina in the McLeod Center on Nov. 21, 2015. The Panthers also recorded a 69-67 win over No. 1 Kansas in the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

The APR provides a real-time look at a team's academic success each semester by tracking the academic progress of each student-athlete on scholarship. The APR accounts for eligibility, retention and graduation and provides a measure of each team's academic performance.


