SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos are 3-15 all-time against Texas Tech, including losing to the Red Raiders in Lubbock 69-58 last season. This will be the first time the Red Raiders have played in Albuquerque since Nov. 15, 2012 - a game the Lobos won 65-61. UNM is 3-5 at home all-time against Texas Tech.

HEADING INTO THE MATCHUP

UNM improved its record to 9-0 after sweeping a road trip at UTEP (59-35) Thursday and at New Mexico State (101-93) on Saturday to tie the best start in program history with the 1996-97 team.

The Lobos won their first road game of the season against UTEP thanks to a strong defensive effort as the 35 points allowed is the fewest by a UNM team since holding Air Force to 33 points in the 2015-16 season. UNM, which didn't allow more than nine points in a quarter over the final three quarters, was led by Tesha Buck's 19 points as the senior - last week's Mountain West Player of the Week - went 5-for-12 from 3-point range.

The Lobos followed it up by winning a game in the exact opposite fashion, beating NMSU in a high-scoring affair. The Lobos went 15-for-22 from 3-point range and were led by Cherise Beynon's 30 points while N'Dea Flye had a career-high 25 points.

The Red Raiders have dropped three in a row, including losing last week to LSU at home 48-40 Thursday and dropping its first road game of the season at Houston 79-75 Sunday afternoon.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES**SCOUTING TEXAS TECH**

The Red Raiders head into Wednesday's matchup with four players averaging double figures, led by 6-foot-5 Brittany Brewer at 14.1 points per game. She's also averaging 6.7 rebounds per contest. Jada Terry is averaging 11.4 points, Brielle Blaire 11.3 points and Reece' Caldwell 11.1 points to round out the players averaging double figures.

Caldwell also is pacing the Red Raiders in assists at 6.7 per game while Brewer and Dayo Olabode lead the team in rebounding at 6.7 per contest.

The Red Raiders don't have a player that has nobody with more than 10 3-pointers on the season with no one shooting better than 34.6 percent. As a team, Texas Tech is shooting 26.1 percent from 3-point range. The Red Raiders have dominated the glass this season, outrebounding opponents by 10.3 boards per game, however, are turning it over 5.1 more times per game than their opponent.

UNM HOT FROM BEYOND THE ARC

The Lobos in their last three games have been scorching from 3-point range as since Nov. 26 have gone 45-for-91 (49.5 percent) from 3-point range. The Lobos went 18-for-33 against Illinois on Nov. 26, 12-for-36 against UTEP and 15-for-22 against New Mexico State. On the season, the Lobos are shooting 40.9 percent from 3-point range.

UNM WRAPS UP UNDEFEATED NOVEMBER

UNM wrapped up a perfect opening month of the season after defeating UTEP in its first road of the season, 59-35, on Nov. 30. The Lobos finished the month outscoring their opponents by an average of 19.3 points per game (85.5-66.2) and had a turnover margin of plus 7.0 per game for the month. They also and twice as good a turnover-to-assist ratio as their opponents (1.6 to 0.8).

LOBOS WIN UNM THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT, BUCK NAMED MVP

For the first time since 2008, the Lobos won their own Thanksgiving Tournament by beating Wichita State, UC Irvine and Illinois - winning each game by double figures and two of the games by 20-plus. Tesha Buck was named the tournament's MVP while she was joined on the all-tournament team with Jaisa Nunn and Alex Lapeyrolerie.

BRADBURY GETS WIN NO. 200

UNM coach Mike Bradbury has had a successful 10-plus seasons as a head coach and now he's hit win No. 200 in just his 11th season when the Lobos defeated Illinois 97-68 on Nov. 26. The second-year Lobo coach averaged 19.3 victories per season in his first 10 years as a head coach.

LOBOS MAKE IT 3-FOR-3, BUCK NAMED MW PLAYER OF WEEK

For the third week in a row with a third different player, the University of New Mexico women's basketball program has earned the Mountain West Player of the Week honor as Tesha Buck's stellar and steady performance while guiding the Lobos to the UNM Thanksgiving Tournament title was honored Monday by the conference. Buck averaged 17.3 points, 5.7 assists, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game in helping the Lobos to three convincing victories. Along with her averages, the senior shot 50 percent (12-for-

24) from 3-point range during the tournament.

Buck joins Cherise Beynon (first week) and Jaisa Nunn (second week) in earning Mountain West Player of the Week honors this season, marking the first time since the 2008-09 season the Mountain West has awarded the same school three straight weeks (was also to three different players). It's the first time the Lobos have ever won the award three straight weeks and is the first time since the 2010-11 season the program has had three honors in the same season as well as three different players win the award in the same season.

LOBOS RECEIVING VOTES IN AP TOP 25, USA TODAY POLLS

The Lobos with their 9-0 start received 26 points in this week's AP Top 25 poll (See page 4 of these notes for the full AP Top 25) and are sitting two spots outside the top 25. Also, the Lobos received votes this week in the USA Today women's basketball coaches poll.

NUNN NAMED MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

A near flawless – and Lobo-record – performance by Jaisa Nunn that helped The University of New Mexico women's basketball team defeat a ranked opponent highlighted a week that saw the junior average 17.7 points and 10.7 rebounds and be selected the Mountain West Player of the Week for the week of Nov. 20. Nunn broke a 35-year-old New Mexico scoring record by piling up 39 points (the old record was 35 set by Yvonne McKinnon in 1979) and adding 13 rebounds in the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette on Nov. 13 at Dreamstyle Arena – including converting on a three-point play with 1.8 seconds remaining to give UNM the victory. The Kirkland, Wash., native was 14-for-15 from the field and 11-for-12 from the free-throw line while committing no turnovers in 34 minutes of play.

RECORD SCORING NIGHT FOR THE LOBOS

The Lobos broke a 38-year-old scoring record Wednesday, Nov. 15, when they defeated Northern New Mexico 107-66 - breaking the old record set March 3, 1979, when UNM defeated Northern Arizona 106-81. It's the first time the Lobos have reached 100 points in a game since beating Morgan State 101-22 on Jan. 4, 2005.

WASHINGTON NEARLY SETS RECORD OFF BENCH VS. NMJC

UNM freshman Madi Washington came off the bench against Northern New Mexico and scored 27 points during the Lobos' win Wednesday, Nov. 15 - tied for the second-most points off the bench and tied for the sixth-most points for a freshman in UNM history. The UNM record for points off the bench is Jordan Adams who scored 30 against Utah Feb. 3, 2000. The Lobo record for points by a freshman was the previous UNM overall scoring record set by Yvonne McKinnon with 35 points against Adams State on Feb. 19, 1982.

NUNN BETTER AGAINST NO. 16 MARQUETTE

Junior post Jaisa Nunn had a night for the ages during the Lobos' 88-87 win over Marquette on Monday, Nov. 13. She set a school-record with 39 points (besting the previous record of 35 by Yvonne McKinnon in 1982) on 14-for-15 shooting from the field (new career high in field goals made) and going 11-for-12 from the free-throw line (New career high in free throw makes and attempts). She also grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds.

FIRST WIN OVER A RANKED TEAM SINCE 2010

In the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette, it marked the first Lobo win over a ranked team since beating No. 25 SMU March 17, 2010 - a stretch of eight consecutive losses to ranked teams. It's the highest-ranked opponent the Lobos have defeated since UNM beat No. 16 BYU March 4, 2006.

BEYNON NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For the first time in her decorated career, senior Cherise Beynon was named Mountain West Player of the Week on Monday, Nov. 13, after nearly putting up a triple-double in the Lobos' season-opening win over Western Michigan. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native had 24 points, nine assists and eight rebounds in the victory. It's just the second time a Lobo has earned the honor in the previous three seasons.

NICE DEBUT BY BUCK

Senior transfer shined her Lobo debut during an 88-76 win over Western Michigan on Friday, Nov. 10. The Wisconsin-Green Bay transfer racked up 22 points and added five assists in the victory. She was, not surprisingly, deadly accurate from beyond the arc -

LOBOS PICKED FOURTH IN MOUNTAIN WEST

The Lobos has been selected to finish in the top third of the Mountain West Conference by the coaches and media as UNM was picked to finish fourth in the conference. The Lobos collected four first-place votes (there were 25 votes total) and 186 points – only behind Boise State (221 points, seven first-place votes), Wyoming (216 points, six first-place votes) and Colorado State (211 points, six first-place votes).

UNM SWEEPS PRESEASON CONFERENCE AWARDS

The Lobos swept the three preseason Mountain West individual awards with Cherise Beynon named the MW Preseason Player of the Year (as well as to the All-MW Preseason Team), Tesha Buck selected the MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year and N'Dea Flye voted the MW Preseason Freshman of the Year.

BEYNON CLIMBING CAREER UNM CHARTS IN ... ALMOST EVERYTHING

Cherise Beynon's first three seasons as a Lobo have been spectacular to say the least and the do-it-all guard will continue to climb the Lobo all-time lists this season. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native is in the career top 15 in points (1,325 - 8th), field goals made (498 - seventh), field goals attempted (1,392 - fifth), 3-pointers made (150 - fifth), 3-pointers attempted (495 - fourth), assists (429 - fourth), steals (198 - third) and rebounding (622 - 12th). She's also nearing the top 10 in minutes played (3,057 - No. 10 is at 3,406). She can also become the second UNM basketball player - male or female - to reach the 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 500-assist mark (Mandi Moore finished with 1,057 points, 603 rebounds and 651 assists for the Lobos from 2002-05).

BEYNON 2016-17 ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

Cherise Beynon was named the second Academic All-American in program history last season as she is one of just five players in the nation to make the CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team list.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 University of New Mexico women's basketball team returns key pieces from head coach Mike Bradbury's first season and the additions of several others have the Lobos in a position to play the up-tempo style Bradbury hopes for and improve from their 15-15 campaign in 2016-17.

UNM returns All-Mountain West and Mountain West All-Defensive Team member Cherise Beynon as well as fellow starters Alex Lapeyrolerie and All-Mountain West Freshman team member Mykiel Burleson. UNM also returns Jaisa Nunn in the post and guards Laneah Bryan and Emily Lines. Add to it with two talented transfers and five freshmen that all will likely see action and UNM is excited to see what 2017-18 has in store.

Lobos come up short at Texas Tech

LUBBOCK, TEXAS --- Despite an extraordinary defensive effort by the Lobos, The University of New Mexico women's basketball team (2-1) came up short against the Texas Tech Lady Raiders (2-1) on Sunday, falling by a score of 69-58 at the United Supermarkets Arena. The Lobos were led by freshman Mykiel Burleson who netted a career-high 22 points to lead all players.

Burleson was one of two Lobos to register double digits on the afternoon. Sophomore Jaisa Nunn registered 14 points and nine rebounds in a near double-double.

"I think we played hard, defensively we were really good, but we just couldn't find a way to get enough rebounds," UNM coach Mike Bradbury said. "That was really the difference in the game. We shot 37 uncontested, wide open (three-point) shots and made eight, so we have to make more shots and we have to get more rebounds."

Despite the 11-point final margin, the Lobos and the Lady Raiders were in a tight race all game that included seven lead changes. The game was also tied 10 times.

The Lobos' largest lead in the contest was six, which occurred twice at 28-22 and 40-34 in the second and third quarters, respectively. The Lady Raiders' lead was never more than five until there was just 4:06 left on the clock in the fourth. With the Lobos up 53-51 with 6:05 left to play, Texas Tech went on a 16-7 run in the final minutes for the win.

Defensively, UNM did exceptional work in limiting the Lady Raiders' leading scorer of the season, Reece Caldwell (33.0 points per game) to zero points throughout the first three quarters. Caldwell heated up in the fourth however as the Lobos ran out of steam, scoring all 12 of her points in the final 5:30 of the game.

The Lobos got on the board first in the first quarter in which the squads traded baskets. Nunn nailed her second three-pointer of her career in the frame to tie it 10-10 7:40 into the match. She hit her first career three in the Lobos' last match against NMSU.

The teams kept the score close until midway through the second quarter when Burleson tied the game at 22-22 on a jump shot. Burleson was fouled on the shot and missed the free throw, but Nunn collected the rebound and put it back up to spark a Lobo run. UNM scored eight straight points over a span of 1:02 to take a 28-22 lead. Texas Tech responded with a 6-0 run of their own to go up 31-30 and after senior Kianna Keller netted a three, the teams went into the locker rooms with the Lobos leading 34-32.

Keller went 2-for-2 from behind the arc Sunday marking the first time in her career that she has scored more than one three in a game. In fact, Keller had registered just one three-pointer in her career, in her freshman season, prior to Sunday's contest.

The third quarter showed much of the same, balanced effort and the Lady Raiders led 47-45 heading into the fourth quarter before Caldwell went off for 12 points to put the game away.

Overall, the Lobos shot 34.9 percent (29-of-83) from the field while Texas Tech was just 28.8 percent (23-of-80). Neither team shot above 25% from three-point range as UNM went 8-for-37 behind the arc (21.6 percent) and the Lady Raiders went 4-for-17 (23.5 percent). The Lobos also failed to shoot above 50 percent from the free throw line, going just 4-for-10 compared to 7-of-10 for Texas Tech.

UNM has limited all three of its regular-season opponents to less than 30 percent shooting this season.

The Lobos finished with an edge in turnovers, committing just six to the Lady Raiders' 13.
