Post-game Notes:

- UNM finished with six players in double figures including: redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg (16), redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (14), redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (13), senior Anthony Mathis (12), sophomore Makuach Maluach (11) and senior Dane Kuiper (10).
 - Saturday's game marked the first game this season the Lobos had six scorers in double figures. The last time the Lobos had six scorers in double figures was Feb. 20, 2018 at Wyoming.
- Bragg led the team in scoring with 16 points, tying his career high.
 - It was the first time this season that Bragg was the true leading scorer, as the other time he was the leading scorer, he was tied with two other Lobos (13 points vs. Penn).
 - He also set a season high in blocks with three.
- Jackson finished with 13 points and 10 rebounds, registering his fourth double-double of the season and his second in the last three games.
- McGee ended the game with a season-high 14 points, going 3-for-4 from beyond the arc, which tied his season high for made threes.
- Saturday's game marked Kuiper's third straight scoring in double figures, his eighth of the season.
 - Kuiper tied his career high in steals with four.
 - Kuiper's dunk with 46 seconds left in the first half gave the senior four dunks on the season, which is the most he has had in a single season in his career.
- The Lobos are now 6-0 when scoring between 80-89 points in a game.
- The Lobos are now 3-0 in conference play when leading for 95% of the game or more.
- The Lobos registered 20 assists, setting a new season high against NCAA Division I opponents.
 - The previous season high against NCAA Division I opponents was 19, which came against Iona on Nov. 13, 2018.
- The Lobos' defense forced 18 turnovers, surpassing their previous season high of 17 against NCAA Division I opponents, set against North Texas (12/18) and UTEP (11/24).
 - The Lobo defense held the Cowboys to 53 points, tying Wyoming's season low for points scored.
- UNM tied its season-high nine steals which came on Jan. 2 at Air Force.
