ABOUT THE MATCHUP: New Mexico will face Southern Utah in the first game of the UNM Thanksgiving Tournament Friday. This will be the first meeting between the two teams under coach Yvonne Sanchez but the sixth meeting overall for the program. The Lobos lead 3-2. The last time the two teams met was on Dec. 14, 1996. The Lobos beat the Thunderbirds 62-54. The Lobos will be looking for their first tourney title since the 2008 season. Southern Utah comes into the game with a 0-4 record, suffering losses to MW foe UNLV, Utah Valley, UC Irvine and New Mexico State. The Lobos are coming off a 83-43 win over Nicholls State earlier this week and will look to continue the WisePies Arena streak.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

SCOUTING SOUTHERN UTAH

The Thunderbirds are off to a rough start in the 2015-16 season, suffering four losses in as many games. They are shooting just 31 percent from the field, 28 percent from free throw range and 61 percent from the free throw line. They are averaging 46 rebounds per game to go along with 55 ppg. Southern Utah is led by junior forward Jessica Richardson. She leads the team with 14.3 ppg and 10.5 rpg. She is shooting 46 percent from the field.

UNM THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT

The Lobos will look to claim the annual UNM Thanksgiving Tournament championship which hasn't been won by UNM since the 2008-09 season. In 2008, the Lobos claimed a 68-51 win over William & Mary before claiming the title over Nebraska 62-51.

THE WISEPIES ARENA STREAK CONTINUES

The WisePies Arena streak extends to 15 straight wins in the arena after the 83-43 win over Nicholls State Tuesday, Nov. 24. The streak dates back to Dec. 18, 2014 when the Lobos beat Cal Poly 84-68.

TIME CHANGE FOR THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT

The game times for the annual UNM Thanksgiving Tournament have changed and moved up. The neutral game on Nov. 27 will be at 3 p.m. and the Lobo game will be at 5 p.m. For Saturday, Nov. 28, the neutral game will be at 2 p.m. with the Lobo game following at 4 p.m.

LOBOS WIN TWO STRAIGHT

After suffering a tough loss to New Mexico State on Nov. 17, the Lobos have bounced back with two strong wins, including its first 40-point win since the Lobos beat Air Force 84-41 on March 10, 2009.

OWENS SHOWS LEADERSHIP

Senior Bryce Owens helped the Lobos to their last two wins, collecting 15 points against Sac State and Nicholls State. At the point guard position, she has recorded 14 assists and currently leads the team with 11 ppg.

LINES FOR THREE

Freshman Emily Lines has shown what she can do behind the arc. Before Tuesday, Lines was 4-for-4 from beyond the arch. She went 2-for-3 against Nicholls State. Three of her first four came in the final minutes of New Mexico State.

SHUMPERT RECORDS FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Senior Khadijah Shumpert led the Lobos in the 84-71 win over Sacramento State. She recorded her first double-double of the season as well as the Lobos first double-double. She put together 21 points and brought down 10 rebounds. She was 9-for-13 from the field and 3-for-4 from the free throw line to go along with three assists and one steal.

PLAYING UNSELFISH

The Lobos played very unselfish in the last two games, collecting a total of 45 assists with 24 coming against Sac State on Nov. 21 and 21 assists Tuesday against Nicholls State. Cherise Beynon recorded a career-high nine assists against Sac State. Freshman Jannon Otto led the team in the assist category against Nicholls State with four.

KELLER COMES ONE STEP CLOSER

Kianna Keller is known for her size and blocking skills. Before the season she was ninth on the all-time list in career blocks with 79. But her six blocks in the first three games moves her up to seventh on the all-time list, passing Abby Garchek (1995-98) and Jessica Kielinski (2007-11). After collecting two against Nicholls State, she now has 87 in her career which is six away from being tied for sixth all time with Val Kast (2006-10). The all-time leader is Jordan Adams (2000-03) with 344.

NLI SHOW ON ROOT SPORTS

ROOT Sports featured the women's basketball NLI show. That took place during the 30-minute break between the men's and women's games Friday Nov. 13. Coach Sanchez and Lobo play-by-play announcer Josh Suchon talked about the four signees and previewed the 2015-16 season. The Lobos welcome in Brittany Panetti from Katy, Texas, Hannah Sjerven from Rogers, Minn., Mykiel Bureson from Pflugerville, Texas and Sammie Woodward from Racine, Wisc. This recruiting class was ranked the top class in the Mountain West, which is the second year in a row the Lobos have earned that ranking.

LOBOS START STRONG WITH TWO EXHIBITION WINS

The Lobos started off preseason with two dominating exhibition wins. The Lobos put together a 78-41 win over Western New Mexico and a 80-39 win over New Mexico Highlands last week.

ABOUT THE 2015-16 LOBOS

The 2015-16 edition of the New Mexico women's basketball team is an experienced group that adds three exciting freshmen to the mix. The Lobos return 11 letterwinners to the squad which includes the return of Whitney Johnson, who has been away from the team on a Mormon Mission in Mexico. With the loss of Antiesha Brown, the Lobos will look to four returning starters with the leadership of three seniors, Alexa Chavez, Bryce Owens and Khadijah Shumpert.

The Lobos have a nonconference schedule that starts out with seven of their first eight games at home. The nonconference schedule is highlighted by games with SMU, Minnesota, Nicholls State, Sacramento State, UTEP, Pepperdine, Houston Baptist and our home Thanksgiving tournament, welcoming in North Carolina A&T, Southern Utah and Duquesne.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

ONE FOR THE BOOKS

Last year's season was one for the books, as the 2014-15 Lobos finished with a school-record 14 conference wins, winning 13 straight at home for the first time since 2004-05 and went undefeated at home in conference play for the first time since 2005-06. Sanchez earned Mountain West Coach of the Year honors. The Lobos advanced to the finals of the Mountain West Tournament for the second time in four years and hosted two games in the WBI, the team's first postseason appearance since 2009-10.

ADDITION BY ADDITION

The Lobos welcome three freshmen — all coming from experienced backgrounds of basketball. The three freshmen gave the Lobos their BlueStar Top 50 recruiting class honorable mention, making them the only program in the Mountain West to earn that distinction.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

Last year, "The Pit" went under construction with the name of the arena. It is still identified as "The Pit" but has a few more letters added to it, as the name of the arena is now WisePies Arena aka The Pit. "The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years.

ALBUQUERQUE'S OWN

When head coach Yvonne Sanchez calls Albuquerque her home, she really means it. Sanchez enters her fifth season at the helm of the Lobo program after spending the previous 11 seasons as an assistant on staff under coach Don Flanagan. However, Yvonne Sanchez and basketball in Albuquerque go back over a quarter of a century. Sanchez was a prep stand-out for Flanagan at Eldorado High School in Albuquerque in the 1980s. Sanchez earned Mountain West Coach of the Year after finishing second in the MW with a 14-4 record.

STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico

women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For six of the last eight seasons, and eight of the last 11 seasons, UNM has finished in the WBCA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

MOUNTAIN WEST MEDIA POLL

The Lobos were picked to finish second in the 11-team Mountain West preseason poll released in October. 2014-15 regular-season champion Colorado State grabbed the top spot in the poll, which is listed below:

Khadijah Shumpert made the preseason All-Mountain West team while newcomer Jannon Otto garnered MW Freshman of the Year honors. Shumpert earned College Sports Madness preseason first-team all-conference recognition.

RIO GRANDE RIVALRY

The Rio Grande rivalry is a series between UNM and NMSU that encompasses athletic teams for both programs. It began with the 2007-08 school year. The teams' will match up this season on November 17 in La Cruces and December 20 in Albuquerque.

STAFF OF ENCHANTMENT

In addition to coach Yvonne Sanchez's New Mexico roots, the UNM staff has several other connections to the Land of Enchantment.

Assistant coach Amy Beggin is a 2010 graduate of UNM and just one of 17 Lobo players to score 1,000 points during her collegiate career. She became the program's video coordinator in 2011 and worked her way up to director of operations and now assistant coach, where she is in her second season.

Jourdan Erskine replaced Beggin as the team's director of operations. Erskine played for the Lobos from 2009-13 and was a team captain her senior year. Erskine was the team's video coordinator before she was promoted to director of operations.

Vera Jo Bustos took over the video coordinator position, who was a standout New Mexico prep player at West Las Vegas High School. She is the school's all-time leader in points, rebounds,

assists, steals and games started.

Former All-America and Olympic athlete Carla Garrett became the program's strength coach in the summer of 2015. She is originally from Santa Fe, New Mexico and played high school basketball against head coach Yvonne Sanchez.
