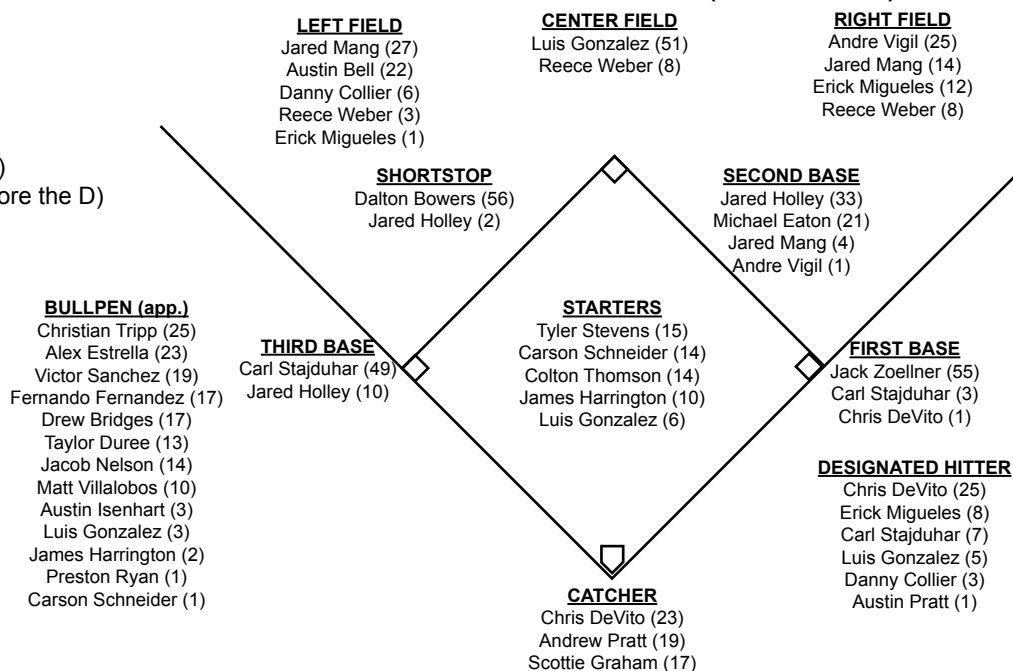

- Birmingham coached the Lobos to their first two MW Tournament Championships in 2011 and 2012. The Lobos also shared the regular-season crown in both 2012 and 2014, and won the league by a record seven games in 2013.
- Attained highest RPI in UNM history (No. 19) in 2010 and its highest ranking ever (No. 13 by *Baseball America*) in 2013.
- Earned his 1,000th collegiate victory with a 19-5 victory at Air Force on April 6, 2013.
- Coached his 1,500th collegiate game on Thursday, May 23, 2013, in the Mountain West Tournament against Nevada.
- The NMJC Thunderbirds won the 2005 NJCAA National Championship and were the national runners-up in 2007.
- Birmingham set the foundations for the programs at College of the Southwest (1988-89) and NMJC (1990-2007).
- Birmingham began his coaching career at Las Cruces Mayfield High School where the Trojans won the 4A championship in 1981 and had three No. 1 rankings through 1983.

HOME, SWEET HOME

On March 24, 2013, the UNM baseball team moved into its new old home. After spending most of the previous nine seasons at Isotopes Park, the Lobos returned to a newly renovated Santa Ana Star Field with astounding success. After losing two of their first five games in their new home park, the Lobos finished the season with 11 straight wins at home to post a 14-2 record at Santa Ana Star Field.

LAST TIME OUT FOR UNM ... The University of New Mexico Lobos (38-21) are the 2016 Mountain West Conference Baseball Tournament Champions and have earned an automatic bid to the NCAA Regional Tournament. The Lobos clinched the title with a 14-4 victory over the Nevada Wolf Pack Saturday.

The championship is the seventh MW title for the program and the sixth since 2011. Head Coach Ray Birmingham has now won six championships in his nine years with the university. This was also the first MW Championship won at the host site since 2008.

"I really wanted to win this in front of the home crowd, I wanted the people of New Mexico to see us win another championship," said Birmingham. "This is going to be our 10th number on the wall out there (in centerfield) in nine years and that's a big deal. I told our kids, our fans are going to come out in folds and pack that park. And that makes them play better. They play harder in front of that crowd."

"There are a lot of neighborhood kids on this team, and that's what's cool. Everyone knows a bunch of these kids. Albuquerque is a big little town, and we are family. I wanted them to win this for their family."

For Saturday's game, the Lobos left nothing to chance. After strong pitching dominated the week for New Mexico, the bats came alive Saturday to clinch the title. The Lobos hung 14 runs on the Wolf Pack in the first seven innings, ending the game early on the 10-run rule instituted for the tournament.

The offense erupted in the middle innings, as the Lobos scored 12 runs from the third inning through the fifth. During that span, four Lobos hit home runs, starting with a three-run bomb in the third inning from Carl Stajduhar that gave the Lobos a 3-2 lead.

The Wolf Pack scored three runs in the fourth inning to retake the lead, but another blast put the road squad away for good. Albuquerque native and freshman Andrew Pratt hit his second home run of the tournament straight over the centerfield fence, securing three runs. Dalton Bowers also scored in the fourth to give the Lobos a 7-4 lead.

The biggest inning of work came in the fifth, when DeVito sent a solo shot out of the park to leadoff the side. Three batters later, with one runner on, Reece Weber hit his first home run of the season to put the Lobos in double digits.

Gonzalez and Michael Eaton each capped off the side with RBI singles.

The Lobos needed two runs in the seventh to walk off and went to work immediately. Bowers and Gonzalez both reached base to lead off the side with a walk and double, respectively. After one out was posted, Tony Gwynn Player of the Year Stajduhar ended the game on a single to left field, clinching the title and calling on the dog pile.

On the mound, Carson Schneider (8-3) became the third straight starter to earn the victory for the Lobos. He held a red-hot Nevada team to three earned runs over six innings without a walk. Christian Tripp closed the game with a perfect seventh inning.

COACH BIRMINGHAM IN MOUNTAIN WEST PLAY... Head coach Ray Birmingham has finished his ninth regular season competing in the Mountain West Conference with the Lobos. He now holds a 155-82 record in league play and a .654 winning percentage.

Birmingham ended regular season conference action ranked fourth all-time in MW wins, but climbing on the lead. He will enter next season 31 conference wins short of the all-time leader in BYU's Vance Law. He will also be 10 wins shy of passing TCU's Jim Schlossnagle for 3rd and 14 shy of Tony Gwynn in second.

Carl Stajduhar was named MW Player of the Year after a stellar year in conference. During MW play, the third basemen earned the league's version of the triple crown with a MW-best .421 batting average, 39 RBI and nine home runs.

Stajduhar also leads the MW in league play in slugging percentage at .746 and total bases at 94.

Jared Holley has also had a standout season in MW play, with a league-best 38 runs scored and a .492 on base percentage, beating out Stajduhar by .002.

TRIPP'S BIG YEAR... The Lobos have reached the NCAA Regionals in large part due to great play of their underclassmen. The Lobos' Player of the Year winner, Carl Stajduhar, is just a sophomore. On top of that, coach Birmingham has regular put as much as 7 freshmen on the field.

One of the biggest standouts is Christian Tripp, who has emerged as a rock on the mound. After two appearances in the MW Tournament, he set a new record for appearances by a freshman in a season at New Mexico at 25. The previous record holder was teammate Carson Schneider.

All-MW Tournament... The Lobos came away highly recognized on the All Mountain West-Tournament Team last week. Pitcher Colton Thomson and centerfielder Luis Gonzalez were each named Co-MW Championship Most Valuable Players. They were joined

on the All-Tournament team by pitcher Tyler Stevens and designated hitter Chris DeVito.

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE?... The Lobos were fortunate to play the MW Tournament in Albuquerque, where they played in front of 1000-1100 fans every night. Although some may say that gave the Lobos a big advantage, history says otherwise. The Lobos are the first team to win the MW Championship on their field since TCU in 2008. They will also be the last to do so in the current format, as the league will move to a four-team tournament next season.

BASH BROTHERS... The Lobos have routinely had one of the best offenses in the country every year. However, what Chris DeVito and Carl Stajduhar are doing on the field stands out. They each rank in the national top 10 in total bases, making New Mexico one of two teams with two players in the top 10. The last Lobo duo to both finish in the top 10 were DJ Peterson and Mitch Garver back in 2012.

EAST AND WEST... The Lobos will be playing in the western most regional in the country in Lubbock, Texas. Although the Lobos will be west of all other teams playing, it will be the most EAST regional the team has ever played in. The Lobos have previously played in regionals taken place in: Greeley, Colorado; Fullerton, California; Tempe, Arizona; and Los Angeles, California.

WELL RESTED BULLPEN... If the Lobo bullpen is called upon in the Lubbock Regional, they will have been well rested for the moment. During the three-game Mountain West Tournament, the Lobos only used four pitchers. All three starters earned victories last week, while two were dominant enough to earn All-Tournament honors. Christian Tripp was used twice out of the pen, giving the rest of the arms much needed rest going into NCAA Regionals.

A STEP AHEAD... At least for last week, the Lobos looked like far and away the best baseball team in the Mountain West. The Lobos started the tournament with a shutout of Nevada, one of the hottest teams in the conference. Nevada followed their shutout by eliminating San Diego State, top seeded Fresno State and Air Force, with the last two coming on run rules by a combined 30 runs. When Nevada faced the Lobos, they were run ruled themselves, 14-4.

Although the numbers prove tournament dominance, it could have been even greater. The Lobos allowed eight runs over the course of the tournament, all of which came with two outs on the board. Also, half of the Lobos' runs allowed were unearned.

DUREE-ABLE... Taylor Duree made two appearances against Arizona State, giving him a program-record of career appearances as a Lobo. He is the second pitcher to reach 70 appearances at New Mexico and has passed Joe Coleman for the school record.
