SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos are 8-1 all-time against San Jose State, including winning last season's lone meeting with the Spartans on the road, 82-72. UNM is 4-1 all-time on the road against the Spartans. UNM's lone loss to San Jose State came Feb. 13, 2016, in San Jose - a 59-58 defeat.

HEADING INTO THE MATCHUP

The Lobos won a battle of the two unbeaten teams in Mountain West play on Wednesday night - using a 17-5 run to end the game to defeat Boise State 100-83 at Dreamstyle Arena.

UNM had five players finish in double figures - led by Alex Lapeyrolerie's career-high 23 points (5-for-10 from 3-point range). Cherise Beynon had 18 points and tied her own UNM record with 15 assists to go along with four rebounds and four steals. Jaisa Nunn had 19 points, seven rebounds and two blocks, Tesha Buck had 15 points, eight rebounds, five assists and three steals and freshman Antonia Anderson scored a career-high 13 points to go along with two steals.

The Lobos shot 52.3 percent from the field (34-for-65) and 38.5 percent from 3-point range (10-for-26), but the big difference was the Lobos went 22-for-24 from the free-throw line (91.7 percent).

San Jose State has dropped its last two games, falling on the road to UNLV 79-60 on Wednesday night and at Colorado State 63-48 on Dec. 30.

In the loss to UNLV, the Spartans struggled from the field (18-for-60, 30 percent), including from beyond the arc (5-for-30, 16.7 percent). San Jose State was outrebounded by the Rebels 55-30 with UNLV grabbing 18 offensive rebounds.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES**SCOUTING SAN JOSE STATE**

San Jose State enters Saturday's contest third in the Mountain West in scoring (70.6 points per game), but is last in the conference in points allowed per game at 84.1. The Spartans are third in the conference in 3-point percentage (34 percent) and are only behind the Lobos (161) with 119 3-pointers made.

Taylor Turney leads the Spartans in scoring this season at 13.7 points per game as well as in assists (58). Myzhanique Ladd is the only other player averaging more than 6.6 points per contest as she is averaging 12.1 per game and also leads the team in rebounding at 7.0 per contest. Analyss Benally is the team's top 3-point threat as 28 of her 30 field goals made this season are 3-pointers and is shooting 32 percent (28-for-87) from beyond the arc.

LAPEYROLERIE ON A ROLL

UNM senior Alex Lapeyrolerie has been on a roll as of late as the guard has scored 14 or more points in six consecutive games - culminating in Lapeyrolerie scoring a career-high 23 points against Boise State on Wednesday night. She has increased her scoring average from 9.8 points to 12.4 during this stretch.

LOBOS IN RPI TOP 30, RECEIVING VOTES IN AP, USA TODAY POLLS

The Lobos' strong start to the season has led to being in the top 30 in RPI and receiving votes in both the AP Media Top 25 and USA Today Coaches Polls (see polls on page four). The Lobos are at No. 26 in the RPI as of the last rankings released by the NCAA following games on Jan.

NO TEAM HAS STARTED BETTER IN UNM HISTORY

The Lobos with their 90-56 win over Texas Tech on Dec. 6, set a new record for most wins to start the season at 10, bettering the 1996-97 team that started 9-0 (that team finished 18-10).

The 94-87 overtime victory over Navy on Dec. 10 tied another Lobo record as it tied the program's mark for most consecutive victories at 11 - something it did in the 2003-04 and the 1977-78 season. With UNM's 90-58 victory over Lamar on Dec. 20, it also set the Lobo record for best start to a season with only one loss at 12-1 - breaking the record of 11-1 set during the 2008-09 season.

LOBOS LIGHTING UP SCOREBOARD

UNM is 16 games into the season and hasn't slowed down in putting up big numbers offensively as the Lobos are 13th in the nation and lead the Mountain West in scoring at 86.4 points per game. UNM also has three of the top seven and four of the top 15 scorers in the conference in Tesha Buck (15.9 - third), Cherise Beynon (15.2 - fifth), Jaisa Nunn (14.9 - seventh) and Alex Lapeyrolerie (12.4 - 13th).

BEYNON CLIMBING CAREER UNM CHARTS IN ... ALMOST EVERYTHING

Cherise Beynon's first three seasons as a Lobo have been spectacular to say the least and the do-it-all guard will continue to climb the Lobo all-time lists this season. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native is in the career top 10 in points (1,415 - eighth), field goals made

(532 - seventh), field goals attempted (1,492 - second), 3-pointers made (157 - fifth), 3-pointers attempted (528 - second), assists (488 - second), steals (219 - second) and rebounding (649 - 10th). She's also nearing the top 10 in minutes played (3,287 - No. 10 is at 3,406). She can also become the second UNM basketball player - male or female - to reach the 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 500-assist mark (Mandi Moore finished with 1,057 points, 603 rebounds and 651 assists for the Lobos from 2002-05).

A DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

UNM's Jaisa Nunn with her 16 points and 12 rebounds against Navy on Dec. 10 racked up her seventh double-double - ranking 22nd in the NCAA (she just missed another against Air Force). On the season Nunn is averaging a double-double with 14.9 points and 10.4 rebounds (tops in the Mountain West).

THREE-SHA BUCK LIGHTING IT UP FROM LONG RANGE

Lobo senior transfer Tesha Buck has made an immediate impact in several facets, but particularly from 3-point range as the Minnesota native ranks in the NCAA top 20 in 3-pointers made (55 - sixth), 3-pointers per game (3.4 - 12th), and 3-point percentage (47.4 - 13th). Her 55 3-pointers this season is tied for 10th on the Lobos' single-season list.

BUCK HUNTS DOWN UNM SCORING, MW 3-PT RECORDS VS. LAMAR

Tesha Buck had a performance for the ages against Lamar on Dec. 20 as she set a UNM record with 40 points to go along with UNM and Mountain West records for 3-pointers made with 10. She's just the seventh player in Mountain West history (started 1999-2000) to reach the 40-point mark in a game while she's the first to reach 10 3-pointers in a game. It's the 58th time a player has hit 10 3-pointers in a game in NCAA Division I women's basketball history. Overall, Buck went 15-for-21 from the field and 10-for-16 from 3-point range - including hitting her first five 3-pointers (all in the first quarter as she had 17 points in the opening period).

FIRST OT WIN IN A LONG TIME

The Lobos' 94-87 victory over Navy in overtime on Dec. 10 was the program's first victory in overtime since beating Air Force on March 5, 2011 - but it was a stretch of only two overtime losses during that time. UNM lost to Pepperdine in OT on Nov. 26, 2011.

and to Fresno State on Jan. 2, 2016. It's the Lobos' first overtime win at home since beating California in double overtime on Nov. 11, 2010.

UNM WRAPS UP UNDEFEATED NOVEMBER

UNM wrapped up a perfect opening month of the season after defeating UTEP in its first road of the season, 59-35, on Nov. 30. The Lobos finished the month outscoring their opponents by an average of 19.3 points per game (85.5-66.2) and had a turnover margin of plus 7.0 per game for the month. They also and twice as good a turnover-to-assist ratio as their opponents (1.6 to 0.8).

LOBOS WIN UNM THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT, BUCK NAMED MVP

For the first time since 2008, the Lobos won their own Thanksgiving Tournament by beating Wichita State, UC Irvine and Illinois - winning each game by double figures and two of the games by 20-plus. Tesha Buck was named the tournament's MVP while she was joined on the all-tournament team with Jaisa Nunn and Alex Lapeyrolerie.

BRADBURY GETS WIN NO. 200

UNM coach Mike Bradbury has had a successful 10-plus seasons as a head coach and now he's hit win No. 200 in just his 11th season when the Lobos defeated Illinois 97-68 on Nov. 26. The second-year Lobo coach averaged 19.3 victories per season in his first 10 years as a head coach.

LOBOS MAKE IT 3-FOR-3, BUCK NAMED MW PLAYER OF WEEK

For the third week in a row with a third different player, the University of New Mexico women's basketball program has earned the Mountain West Player of the Week honor as Tesha Buck's stellar and steady performance while guiding the Lobos to the UNM Thanksgiving Tournament title was honored Monday by the conference. Buck averaged 17.3 points, 5.7 assists, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game in helping the Lobos to three convincing victories. Along with her averages, the senior shot 50 percent (12-for-24) from 3-point range during the tournament.

Buck joins Cherise Beynon (first week) and Jaisa Nunn (second week) in earning Mountain West Player of the Week honors this season, marking the first time since the 2008-09 season the Mountain West

has awarded the same school three straight weeks (was also to three different players). It's the first time the Lobos have ever won the award three straight weeks and is the first time since the 2010-11 season the program has had three honors in the same season as well as three different players win the award in the same season.

NUNN NAMED MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

A near flawless – and Lobo-record – performance by Jaisha Nunn that helped The University of New Mexico women's basketball team defeat a ranked opponent highlighted a week that saw the junior average 17.7 points and 10.7 rebounds and be selected the Mountain West Player of the Week for the week of Nov. 20. Nunn broke a 35-year-old New Mexico scoring record by piling up 39 points (the old record was 35 set by Yvonne McKinnon in 1979) and adding 13 rebounds in the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette on Nov. 13 at Dreamstyle Arena – including converting on a three-point play with 1.8 seconds remaining to give UNM the victory. The Kirkland, Wash., native was 14-for-15 from the field and 11-for-12 from the free-throw line while committing no turnovers in 34 minutes of play.

RECORD SCORING NIGHT FOR THE LOBOS

The Lobos broke a 38-year-old scoring record Wednesday, Nov. 15, when they defeated Northern New Mexico 107-66 - breaking the old record set March 3, 1979, when UNM defeated Northern Arizona 106-81. It's the first time the Lobos have reached 100 points in a game since beating Morgan State 101-22 on Jan. 4, 2005.

WASHINGTON NEARLY SETS RECORD OFF BENCH VS. NNMC

UNM freshman Madi Washington came off the bench against Northern New Mexico and scored 27 points during the Lobos' win Wednesday, Nov. 15 - tied for the second-most points off the bench and tied for the sixth-most points for a freshman in UNM history. The UNM record for points off the bench is Jordan Adams who scored 30 against Utah Feb. 3, 2000. The Lobo record for points by a freshman was the previous UNM overall scoring record set by Yvonne McKinnon with 35 points against Adams State on Feb. 19, 1982.

FIRST WIN OVER A RANKED TEAM SINCE 2010

In the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette, it marked the first Lobo win over a ranked team since beating No. 25 SMU March 17, 2010 - a stretch of eight consecutive losses to ranked teams. It's the highest-ranked opponent the Lobos have defeated since UNM beat No. 16 BYU March 4, 2006.

BEYNON NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For the first time in her decorated career, senior Cherise Beynon was named Mountain West Player of the Week on Monday, Nov. 13, after nearly putting up a triple-double in the Lobos' season-opening win over Western Michigan. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native had 24 points, nine assists and eight rebounds in the victory. It's just the second time a Lobo has earned the honor in the previous three seasons.

LOBOS PICKED FOURTH IN MOUNTAIN WEST

The Lobos has been selected to finish in the top third of the Mountain West Conference by the coaches and media as UNM was picked to finish fourth in the conference. The Lobos collected four first-place votes (there were 25 votes total) and 186 points – only behind Boise State (221 points, seven first-place votes), Wyoming (216 points, six first-place votes) and Colorado State (211 points, six first-place votes).

UNM SWEEPS PRESEASON CONFERENCE AWARDS

The Lobos swept the three preseason Mountain West individual awards with Cherise Beynon named the MW Preseason Player of the Year (as well as to the All-MW Preseason Team), Tesha Buck selected the MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year and N'Dea Flye voted the MW Preseason Freshman of the Year.
