NEW MEXICO NOTES

THE LAST TIME OUT

The Lobos are coming off a weekend in California where they lost to No. 21 Cal 2-0 on Friday for their second-consecutive loss to a ranked opponent to start the season (UNM lost to No. 16 Texas Tech 2-1 to open the season) before picking up their first win in emphatic fashion with a 5-2 victory over Pacific on Sunday. In the win over Pacific, the Lobos racked up four second-half goals - including three in the opening 10 minutes of the half. It's the most goals UNM has scored away from Albuquerque since 2009 and in a non-conference game since 2010.

A GOAL FOR YOU, A GOAL FOR YOU, A GOAL FOR YOU ...

In the Lobos' 5-2 victory over Pacific, UNM had four players score a goal apiece in Jennifer Muñoz, Jessie Hix, Gwen Maly and Claire Lynch while the other tally for the Lobos was an own goal. For the sophomore Muñoz and the freshmen Hix and Maly, it was each their first career collegiate goal.

LYNCH APPROACHING LOBO ALL-TIME TOP 10 IN GOALS

Claire Lynch's goal Sunday was the 10th of her career and has her approaching the program's all-time top-10 list for goals. She's two goals behind the No. 10 spot, occupied by Michelle Nowfel (1999-02), and three behind being tied for the No. 7 spot with a trio of former Lobos (Lindsey Guice, Zaneta Wyne and Dani Rangel).

LOBOS PLAY IN OGDEN FOR FIRST TIME

Friday's match against Weber State will be the first time the Lobos have played on the road against the Wildcats. UNM last played Weber State Sept. 7, 2014, at the Colorado College Invitational in Colorado Springs (a 2-1 loss). The only other time these schools have met is when the Lobos lost to the Wildcats 2-0 at home Oct. 4, 1998.

UNM LOOKS TO KEEP UNBLEMISHED RECORD VS. IDAHO ST.

The Lobos have played Idaho State twice in their history, both victories for UNM. The Lobos defeated the Bengals 4-1 last season at UNM Soccer Complex and also beat Idaho State 2-0 Aug. 21, 2009, in Albuquerque. This will be UNM's first trip to play in Pocatello.

LOCAL TALENT A STRONG INFLUENCE ON 2016 ROSTER

The 2016 Lobos will have plenty of home-grown talent on the roster as 14 players are from New Mexico. Ten of those players are from the Albuquerque area while two are from Farmington and one each are from Carlsbad and Tucumcari. It's not only the players that have New Mexico ties as head coach Heather Dyche is an Albuquerque Eldorado High School graduate and assistant coach Paul Maestas is a Lobo grad and a former high school, state-title winning coach at Eldorado High School.

LOBOS' MUÑOZ PLAYS FOR MEXICO U20 TEAM

UNM sophomore Jennifer Muñoz spent this past summer trying out, making and eventually starting for Mexico's U20 Women's National Team. Muñoz started 19 games last season for the Lobos, tallying one assist in 1,566 minutes of play.

CHAVEZ NAMED 2015-16 LOBO CLUB STUDENT-ATHLETE OF YEAR

Defender Emily Chavez earned the prestigious honor of being named the Lobo Club Student-Athlete of the Year for 2015-16. Chavez, who earned All-Mountain West honorable mention and Mountain West All-Academic honors last season, became the third player in MW history to win both an offensive and defensive player of the week honors in her career. The junior from La Cueva High School in Albuquerque has started 38 games in her two-plus years for the Lobos and has three goals and three assists.

LOBOS VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

UNM has dropped 13 straight matchups against ranked opponents, last beating a ranked team Oct. 16, 2010, when the Lobos defeated No. 8 BYU 1-0 in double overtime in Albuquerque. The Lobos' last win over a ranked opponent on the road came at No. 6 BYU on Oct. 6, 2005 (1-0). Since 2005, UNM is 3-21-5 against ranked teams.

LOOKING BACK AT 2015

The 2015 Lobos under first-year coach Heather Dyche won 10 games for the second consecutive season, going 10-8-2 and reaching the Mountain West Tournament semifinals (falling in penalty kicks). Of those eight losses, five were by one goal. New Mexico went 7-3-1 in the Mountain West to finish third in the conference.

ANOTHER STELLAR YEAR IN THE CLASSROOM

The University of New Mexico women's soccer program maintained a strong academic record during the 2015-16 school year, posting a spring GPA of 3.46. The program has posted an astounding 12 straight semesters of having a team GPA of 3.4 or higher. In the fall, the Lobos reached a GPA of 3.59. The high standard for the women's soccer program has been recognized over the years, with the 2015 season marking the 10th straight year in which the Lobos earned Academic All-District honors. In 2015, a pair of seniors, Cassie Ulrich from Rio Rancho, N.M. and Alyssa Coonrod from Albuquerque, N.M., were named to the 2015 CoSIDA/Academic All-District VII Team.

DYCHE ASSISTS U.S. SOCCER DURING OLYMPICS

Head coach Heather Dyche traveled to Brazil this summer to assist the U.S. Women's National team during the 2016 Summer Olympics. Dyche scouted and analyzed opponents for the USWNT. Dyche has a history of working with U.S. Soccer, helping with youth national teams, and is a national instructor on the U.S. Soccer educational staff.

UNM RACKS UP ANOTHER DOUBLE-DIGIT WIN SEASON

For the sixth time in seven years, UNM put together a 10-plus win season in 2015 by going 10-8-2. Also for the 10th time in 11 seasons, the Lobos finished above .500 on the season. In Mountain West play, UNM has had eight consecutive .500-or-better seasons and own a 40-16-10 mark over that stretch (.681).

HOME FIELD ADVANTAGE

The UNM Soccer Complex is a great home field advantage, and the records support that. New Mexico is 101-64-24 all-time in home matches, good for a .598 home winning percentage. A large factor is the Lobos' success at home is the dedicated crowds of Lobo fans at matches. New Mexico is the perennial leader in the Mountain West in attendance while consistently ranking in the top 25 nationally.

DYCHE MAKES HISTORY

Head coach Heather Dyche became the third women's soccer coach in Lobo history to win 10 games in her first season, joining Amy Allman (1993) and John Dewitt (1996).

THE SENIOR CLASS

The 2016 senior class is made up of eight Lobos. Katie Hinman, Savannah Viola, Ruth Bruciaga, Brooke Webster, Maddie Irwin, Olivia Ferrier and Annie Wheeler have spent all three years of their eligibility with UNM over the last four years while Victoria Archuleta transferred prior to her junior season.
