WHAT'S HAPPENING

- **The Game:** Boise State (13-6, 6-2 MW) winner of five straight will travel to face the New Mexico Lobos (11-7, 4-3 MW) Saturday afternoon in Albuquerque, tip is at 2 p.m. in WisePies Arena.
- **Big Game:** This will be the second-consecutive game for the Broncos in which they face the team directly behind them in the MW standings in a third versus fourth encounter with the Lobos ... a win for Boise State would put it two games up on the teams behind the Broncos.
- **Next Up:** The Broncos will hit the road for Logan, Utah, for a Wednesday night encounter with the Utah State Aggies (9-10, 4-4 MW), tip is scheduled for 7 p.m. in the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum.
- **Radio:** KTIK (AM 1350) will carry all of the women's games this season. Chris Lewis returns for his third season as the voice of the Broncos.
- **Internet Broadcast:** You can also listen to the radio broadcast on the internet at BroncoSports.com.

GAME PREVIEW

New Mexico | Saturday, Jan. 30 | Albuquerque, N.M.

New Mexico Scouting Report

- **Record:** The Lobos possess a 11-7 overall record and 4-3 league mark, fourth place ... they have won two in a row 71-57 over San Jose State at home and a 63-33 win at Air Force Wednesday night.
- **Preseason Poll:** The Lobos were picked to place second out of 11 teams in the MW preseason coaches'/media poll.
- **UNM Leaders:** On the year Khadijah Shumpert leads UNM averaging 14.1 points (6th MW) and 6.5 rebounds (6th MW) per game, both team highs ... Cherise Beynon adds 12.1 points (14th MW), 5.6 rebounds (14th MW) and team-high 3.5 assists (6th MW) per game.
- **UNM as a Team:** On the year, the Lobos are averaging 64.2 points (7th MW) per game and allow 58.7 (3rd MW) ... UNM is shooting 38.8 percent (7th MW) from the floor, 29.5 percent (6th MW) from 3-point range and 64.4 percent (8th MW) from the free-throw line ... defensively the UNM holds opponents to 35.9 percent (2nd MW) from the floor and 29.8 percent (6th MW) from beyond the arc.

Boise State Scouting Report

- **Record:** The Broncos enter the game at 13-6 overall and 6-2 in MW play, third place ... they have won five straight, most recently the Broncos beat Wyoming 58-49 (Jan. 23) and UNLV 75-56 (Jan. 27) in Boise.
- **Bronco Leaders:** Boise State is led by Brooke Pahukoa averaging 15.9 points (4th MW) and 5.5 rebounds (16th MW) per game ... Shalen Shaw is next at 13.4 points (9th MW) and team-high 8.9 rebounds (2nd MW) per game, she leads the MW in league contests averaging 11.4 rebounds per game ... Miquelle Askew, the reigning MW Player of the Week, adds 13.2 points (10th MW) and 5.5 rebounds (15th MW) per game.
- **As a Team:** Boise State averages 70.5 points (2nd MW) per game on the year and is shooting 43.2 percent (1st MW / 49th NCAA) from the floor, 34 percent (1st MW) from





the 3-point arc and 76.2 percent (1st MW / 15th NCAA) from the free-throw line ... defensively, the Broncos are holding teams to 61.7 points per game (6th MW) on 38.7 percent (6th MW) shooting from the floor and 28.4 percent (3rd MW) from beyond the arc.

- **Preseason Poll:** Boise State who went 22-11 overall and 11-7 (4th) in the Mountain West Conference during 2014-15 was picked to place third out of 11 teams in this year's MW preseason poll.
- **MW Champs:** Boise State won the 2015 MW Tournament and advanced to the NCAA first round where the Broncos fell 72-61 at Tennessee.

The Series

- **Record:** This is the 12th meeting all-time between the two programs ... the Broncos hold a 7-4 advantage overall and a 5-3 lead in the MW regular-season series.
- **In Boise:** The Boise State leads 4-1 in the series for games played at Boise.
- **In Albuquerque:** The series is tied 2-2 in games played at UNM.
- **Last Year:** The two squads met three times last year with Boise State winning twice 86-65 in Boise and 66-60 in the MW Tournament Championship game, while the Lobos won 63-50 in Albuquerque.
- **Boise State vs. Mountain West:** The Broncos are 120-90 all-time versus the current membership of the Mountain West Conference.

LAST TIME OUT

- **BOISE, Idaho (1/27/2016):** Brooke Pahukoa scored 20 points to lead Boise State to a 75-56 victory over UNLV Wednesday night at Taco Bell Arena ... Pahukoa was one of four Broncos in double-digit points as Boise State pulled away in the second half to win convincingly ... Boise State never trailed in the game, won all four quarters and took a five-point 35-30 lead into halftime ... the Broncos out scored the Lady Rebels 25-15 in the third period and took a commanding 15-point 60-45 advantage into the fourth, eventually winning it by 19 points

... Yaiza Rodriguez dished out a career-high 11 assists in the win, tied for the third most all-time in program history.

HEARTBREAKERS

- Boise State has lost six games this season, all by five points or less and by a combined total of 21 points ... twice by two points, once by three, once by four and twice by five.
- In the pair of two point losses the Broncos had chances to tie or win with last second shots.
- The Broncos are 2-6 this year in games decided by five points or less.

PAHUKOA SIXTH NATIONALLY FROM THE ARC

- Brooke Pahukoa leads the MW in 3-point percentage hitting 45.5 percent (46-of-101), sixth nationally.
- She has been rank as high as second (Jan. 17) when she was hitting 49.4 percent.
- She is in range to potentially break the school season record of 46.9 percent set by Missy Dallas (38-of-81) during the 1987-88 season.
- The MW record is 50.4 percent (69-of-137) by Julie Larsen of Utah in 2005-06.

PAHUKOA AMONG THE BEST FROM FREE-THROW LINE

- Boise State junior Brooke Pahukoa is among the best free throw shooters all-time at Boise State shooting 83.3 percent (140-166) which would be a new school record if her career was over ... current record is .823 by Nadia Begay (2003-07).
- This year she is shooting 82 percent (50-61) third in MW ... in league games she leads the MW at .882 (30-34).
- Last year she had a streak of 30 straight from the line, second longest all-time two short of tying record.
- This year she saw a streak of 23 consecutive free throws dating back to the last eight made at Eastern Washington (Dec. 21) end at Fresno State (Jan. 9).

BRONCOS ARE 15TH IN NCAA

- As a team the Broncos lead the MW and

are ranked 15th in the nation for free throw percentage at 76.2 percent.

- If the season was over today that would be a new Boise State record, the current high is 74.2 percent in 2011-12.

COACH PRESNELL

- Presnell Sets Record:** Head coach Gordy Presnell in his 11th season at Boise State set the school record for most wins by a coach at Portland on Dec. 6 with his 180th victory ... he is currently 189-144.

- Career Record:** Coach Presnell is currently 585-271 (.683) overall in his 29th season as a collegiate head coach.
- National Standing:** Coach Presnell entered 2015-16 as the 32nd winningest active coach in the NCAA (all divisions) with 572 wins (now 585), 19th among active NCAA Division I coaches ... he was also ranked 33rd for best win percentage among current division I coaches at .684.
- Most Conference Wins:** Coach Presnell set the program record for wins in conference games last year when the Broncos defeated Colorado State (Dec. 31, 2014) giving him 74 ... the record now stands at 90.
- Most Games Coached:** Coach Presnell set the school record for games coached at Boise State when the Broncos tipped at San Diego State (Feb. 7, 2015) in his 302 game ... the record is now at 333.

ASKEW HITS 1,000 POINTS

- Senior center Miquelle Askew hit the 1,000-point milestone on Dec. 13 at home against Concordia (Ore.) when she scored 23 points to give her 1,002 ... she currently has 1,151, 11th overall.
- Askew is the 17th Bronco to hit 1,000 career points.

BOISE STATE TENURE (2005-present)

Eleven years ago Gordy Presnell returned to his home state to become the sixth head coach in Boise State University's women's basketball program history. He brought with him a mild and laid back demeanor, 18 years of head coaching experience and a long record of success. Presnell currently ranks second in Bronco history for victories by a coach with a record of 176-138 (.561) overall. The 2015-16 season will mark his 29th as a collegiate head coach with a career record of 572-265 (.683).

This past year of 2014-15 he led the Broncos to their third NCAA Tournament berth in program history and their second-ever conference tournament championship defeating New Mexico 66-60 for the Mountain West title. Boise State finished with its sixth 20-plus win season all-time at 22-11 and the fourth under coach Presnell.

Since his arrival in the spring of 2005 Presnell has turned the Broncos around and has them competing for conference championships. His teams have won two regular season titles in 2007 and 2008, as well as recording the program's first ever conference tournament titles in 2007 and 2015 to advance to the NCAA Tournament.

In the first 10 years under his direction, the Broncos have recorded six winning seasons and one at .500. After going 15-15 in his first year (2005-06) the Broncos recorded four consecutive-winning seasons, including a school-record 24 wins in both the 2006-07 (24-9) and 2007-08 (24-8) campaigns. Presnell's teams have gone 84-78 in conference games and an impressive 107-44 (.709) at home in Boise, including a perfect 14-0 in 2007-08.

Presnell's teams have advanced to national postseason play four times and have recorded the only postseason victories in program history reaching the second round of the 2008 Women's National Invitation Tournament and 2014 Women's Basketball Invitational.

Over the course of his tenure Presnell's Broncos have pushed the tempo of the game. His teams are routinely ranked among the top scoring and rebounding teams in the conference and have set numerous school records along the way. Presnell coached teams have set the school record for points in a season three times in 2006-07 (2,275), 2007-08 (2,330) and 2014-15 (2,331), in addition to recording six of the top 10 season totals all-time (45 years). In rebounding the Broncos have turned in the top six totals all-time and have set the record three times in 2005-06 (1,252), 2006-07 (1,330) and most recently 2007-08 (1,335).

They have five of the top 10 scoring averages in program history including the fourth-best mark of 72.8 points per game in 2007-08 and the fifth-most at 70.6 in 2014-15. Presnell's Broncos have six of the top 10 season marks for field goals made, seven of the top 10 in field goal attempts, eight of the top 10 in 3-point field goals made and the top 10 marks for 3-point field goal attempts. His 2011-12 squad set the school record for free-throw percentage in a season hitting .742, while the 2012-13 team is right behind them in second at 73.4 percent.

In 2007, Presnell led the team to new heights with a 24-9 overall record, they won the league regular-season crown and WAC Tournament title advancing to the NCAA Tournament, the program's first postseason national tournament since the 1998 WNIT. For his coaching performance he was named the WAC and WBCA Division I Regional Coach of the Year.

Program honors during his tenure at Boise State include: winning back-to-back Western Athletic Conference regular-season crowns in 2007 and 2008; the 2007 WAC Tournament

title; 2015 Mountain West Tournament title; two NCAA Tournament appearances in 2007 and 2015; advanced to the second round in both the 2008 Women's National Invitation Tournament and the 2014 Women's Basketball Invitational; one WBCA All-Region and one Honorable Mention All-American honors; nine postseason all-conference honors, seven conference all-freshmen team members, two conference newcomers of the year, one freshman of the year, three conference all-defensive team honors, five conference all-tournament team honors with two tournament MVP; and a combined 57 academic all-conference honors by 24 individuals.

PRIOR TO BOISE STATE

Prior to taking over at Boise State, Presnell coached for 18 successful years at Seattle Pacific University in Washington. At SPU, he inherited a program that had not recorded a winning season in the previous nine years. He built the Falcons into a NCAA Division II national power, accumulating an overall record of 396 victories with 127 defeats (.757). Along the way his teams amassed an average of 22 wins per season while claiming seven conference championships, including four of his last five seasons. In addition, his teams were an impressive 221-29 (.884) at home in Broughman Pavilion, including five unbeaten home seasons.

On the national scene under Presnell, the Falcons advanced to nine-straight (1997-2005) and 10 of 11 NCAA Division II tournaments while he was in Seattle. Overall, Seattle Pacific made postseason appearances in 13 of his 18 years, 10 NCAA and three NAIA. Presnell's teams reached three NCAA Division II Elite Eights and advanced to the 2005 national title game.

At the time of his departure from Seattle Pacific in the summer of 2005, Presnell was ranked tied for 10th-place nationally among NCAA Division II coaches for win percentage (.757) and 21st for total victories.

COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

In 28 years as a collegiate head coach Presnell has experienced 24 winning seasons and one at .500. His teams have won a combined nine regular-season titles, seven at SPU and two at Boise State. In addition, he has guided 17 of his 28 squads into postseason national tournaments.

During his career he has been named conference coach of the year eight times, WBCA Regional Coach of the Year five times (four at NCAA Division II level and one at Division I), and the WBCA NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year twice. His coach of the year honors now total 15 in 28 years. In 2007 during the NCAA's 25th anniversary celebration for women's sports, coach Presnell was listed as one of the top coaches all-time in their publication "Women's Basketball Finest."

His student-athletes have accumulated numerous honors along the way: one All-American; seven individuals have earned 10 honorable mention All-American awards; five league players of the year; 10 freshman/newcomers of the year; 31 players have combined for 50 all-conference honors; seven conference all-freshmen team members; three all-defensive team members; 38 individuals have combined for 97 academic all-conference honors; 10 combined for 12 national academic honors including two academic All-Americans.

PERSONAL

Presnell, a Lapwai, Idaho, native graduated from Northwest Nazarene University in Nampa, Idaho, in 1983 with a B.A. in physical education. He continued his studies in physical education at Seattle Pacific University, where he earned a master's degree in 1989. He and his wife, former SPU gymnast Susan Nolte, live in Meridian, Idaho. They have two children, a daughter, Jacquelyn (24), and a son, Ryder (20).
