

Coach Weir:

"I think CU did a really good job over the course of the game of just continuing to get the ball inside and getting some buckets around there ... They did a really good job protecting the rim."

"We got a lot of really good looks I thought around the rim, they just did a really good job of protecting the glass. When you get 20 more shots than your opponent, you usually feel really good about what you did, but we just weren't able to convert a lot of shots around the rim."

"I think defensively, it was a little bit of a step forward for us tonight, particularly the first 28-29, actually 31-32 minutes ... I thought our defensive energy was really good and man if we could just find a way to convert some layups and some free throws I really think it would put us over the top."

"We watch and talk a lot about our shot selection. I thought our shot selection tonight was actually pretty good, we just miss a lot of shots around the rim still and that's something we're going to continue to practice and hopefully get better at because I don't want to just shoot 3-point shots all game. We'd like to have some balance to our offense and right now, I think we have balance in our shot selection but we don't have balance in our field goal percentage."

Anthony Mathis

"I think we played with a lot of energy in both halves, I just think it was a matter of shots going in (in the first half) and then shots not going in (in the second half). Overall I think we played really hard, we're taking steps, it's just one step at a time."

"We gave up a lot of corner threes and they did a great job capitalizing on those open shots and when you give a great team open shots like that, they're going to knock them down and that's what they did."

"I just felt like every time we would get right there, close to cutting (the lead) down or getting the lead, we just gave up a drive and kick three and they made them."
