Nevada takes a five-game win streak into The Pit in Albuquerque, N.M. to face the Lobos of New Mexico at 12 p.m. PT ... The game will be streamed online at NevadaWolfPack.tv ... Doug Greenwald will have the call in Northern Nevada on NBC Sports Radio 94.1 FM and 1450 AM with a 15 minute pregame show prior to tipoff ... Nevada and New Mexico is a fairly short series at just 10 games, but the Lobos have won the last five contests ... The Wolf Pack earned a conference-opening win Thursday night against Fresno State, 90-73, and snapped a nine-game skid to the Bulldogs ... The Lobos on the other hand also opened with a win in league play, defeating Air Force 88-59 on the road ... While it is very early in the conference season, Saturday's matchup is already proving to be a battle of two of the top teams in the Mountain West this season ... Nevada head coach Amanda Levens earned the 50th win of her head coaching career with the victory over Fresno State ... Wolf Pack sophomore Camariah King has now scored in double figures in five straight games.

### **QUICK HITS**

- Nevada has won five consecutive games, its longest win streak since it also strung together five in a row in 2013-14.
- Senior T Moe needs 189 points to become Nevada's 13th 1,000-point scorer.
- The Wolf Pack begins conference play 1-0 for the first time in three years.
- Teige Zeller has posted four 20-point games this season and has led the Pack in scoring in six games.
- Saturday's game is an early battle of the league's top two teams.

### **SERIES HISTORY**

Nevada and New Mexico have a short history between them at just 10 games. The Lobos currently are ahead in the series, 7-3, and have won the last five contests. The last time Nevada beat UNM was on March 1, 2014 in Albuquerque, 60-55.

### **LAST TIME OUT (W, 90-73 vs. Fresno State)**

- Nevada led at halftime, 43-38, and is now 8-0 when leading at the half.
- The 90 points scored by the Wolf Pack are the second-most it has scored this season (95 vs. Sacramento State is the most).
- Teige Zeller recorded her third double-double of the year (20 pts, 12 rbs), and Terae Briggs posted her first (10 pts, 11 rbs).
- Nevada notched a 24-8 assist to turnover ratio, which tied a season high in assists and a season low in turnovers.
- Camariah King scored 11 points and has scored in double figures in five straight games.
- Nevada outscored the Bulldogs in the paint by a 52-22 margin.

### HONORS FOR ZELLER

Senior Teige Zeller was named the Mountain West Player of the Week on Dec. 18 for the first time in her career. She averaged a double-double with 13.0 points and 11.0 rebounds per game to help the Wolf Pack go 2-0 and end non-conference play on a four-game win streak. In the win over Stanislaus State she posted career numbers with 24 points and 19 rebounds. The 19 boards were tied for the most in a single game by a Mountain West player this season. It was the first weekly conference award given to a Nevada player since Mimi Mungedi earned the same honor in 2014.

### **HOME SWEET HOME**

Lawlor Events Center has been kind to the Wolf Pack over the years. Through eight home games this season Nevada sports a 6-2 record. Since the women's basketball team started playing in Lawlor in 1994, the Pack is 202-148 at home.

### **LEVENS MAKES HISTORY**

Nevada head coach Amanda Levens has made history already in her first season at the helm of the program. The Wolf Pack has secured a winning non-conference record, making Levens the first coach in program history to do so in their first season. Nevada ended non-conference action with a 7-4 record, the highest non-league record since the 2010-11 squad went 11-2.

### STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Nevada has 11 teams on its schedule this season who participated in postseason tournaments last year, including four who made the NCAA Tournament. Boise State, the favorite this year in the Mountain West, UConn, which enters the season ranked No. 1 in the nation, Oregon State and Montana State competed in the NCAA Tournament. Teams to have played in the Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT) include Utah, SMU, Seattle, Colorado State, UNLV and Wyoming. Utah State made an appearance in the WBI.

Additionally through Dec. 13, the Wolf Pack boasts the second-highest strength of schedule ranking in the Mountain West at 105. New Mexico leads the league in both strength of schedule (61) and RPI (10). Nevada also ranks highly in RPI at 112, also second-best in the MW.

Through the Wolf Pack's first 12 games of the season, the team has established itself as a top threat from beyond the arc. Last season, Nevada connected on just 30.8 percent of its shots from long range, but so far this year the Pack is hitting 35.4 percent. In 12 games Nevada has splashed down 69 threes. Nevada's three-point shooting percentage is second in the Mountain West and in the top 50 nationally. Senior Halie Bergman leads the Pack with 26 made three-pointers.



# HISTORICAL TEAM INFORMATION

The University of Nevada women's basketball program began in the year 1899, when the team, coached by Ada Edwards, earned its first win over a varsity opponent, Stanford. Since its inception in 1899, records of the program's history have not accurately been kept up to date. For the purposes of all records, wins and losses and other statistical information related to the Nevada women's basketball program, the 1981-82 season will be considered the first for the program, the first year women's basketball was recognized by the NCAA.

### **WOLF PACK ORIGIN**


In the 1921-22 athletic season, a local writer described the spirited play of a Nevada team as a 'pack of wolves'. The name stuck and soon almost every reference to the athletic teams was the Nevada Wolves. In 1923, the students officially designated 'Wolves' as the school's mascot.

Since all teams are a group of players, the word pack followed quickly. In 1928-29, the Nevada student handbook referred to the athletic teams as Wolf Pack and two school songs were adopted, entitled 'The Wolf Pack' and 'Here Comes the Wolf Pack'.
