NO. 17/19 MARQUETTE OPENS 2017-18 SEASON ON ROAD AT NEW MEXICO

The 2017-18 slate begins on Monday for the No. 17/19 Marquette women's basketball team as the Golden Eagles open at New Mexico Nov. 13 at 8 p.m. Central time.

The season lidlifter will air live on the Mountain West Network from Dreamstyle Arena in Albuquerque.

Marquette is preseason ranked in both the AP and USA Today Coaches Poll for the first time in program history and earns its highest ranking since 2007. The Golden Eagles are the unanimous preseason favorites to win the BIG EAST Conference and return all five leading scorers, over 80% of their offense from last year's squad that won the league tournament and reached the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2011.

New Mexico (1-0) opened its campaign on Friday night with an 88-76 victory over Western Michigan. The Lobos were led by Mountain West Preseason Player of the Year Cherise Beynon with 24 points, while MWC Preseason Newcomer of the Year Tesha Buck tallied 22 points. New Mexico was picked to finish fourth in the Mountain West Conference.

Last season in Milwaukee, Marquette handed the Lobos a 62-52 loss at the Al McGuire Center as four Golden Eagles poured in double figures.

Following this contest MU will head home for its home opener at the Al McGuire Center. The Golden Eagles welcome Loyola Maryland on Sunday, Nov. 19 at 3 p.m. CT.

Season Lidlifter

Monday marks the official start of the 43rd season of Marquette Women's Basketball and the program is 643-559 overall.

Marquette is 26-16 all-time in season openers.

Series History

The Golden Eagles are 1-1 all-time against New Mexico. Their last match-up with the Lobos came last December and Marquette won 62-52 in its last non-conference game for the season. Hiedeman scored 13 points to go with seven rebounds and six assists in the contest and Danielle King scored 11 points and grabbed six boards. Davenport notched a double-double of 10 points and 13 rebounds.

Preseason Rankings

Marquette enters the season ranked 17th in the AP Poll and 19th in the USA Today Coaches Poll. This ranking marks the first time Marquette has been in the AP Poll since 2011. The Golden Eagles will have plenty of opportunities to climb the rankings, as they will face four preseason ranked teams. Marquette will battle No. 6 Notre Dame, No. 14 Tennessee, No. 24 Michigan and No. 25 DePaul. The Golden Eagles owned a 6-0 record against ranked teams last season.

MU Trio Recognized on Wath Lists

A trio of Marquette juniors landed on pre-season award watch lists. Allazia Blockton and Natisha Hiedeman are part of the 20-player Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List given to the nation's top point guard. Blockton has led the Golden Eagles in scoring each of her first two seasons and is on track to become the program's all-time leading scorer while Hiedeman is already climbing the ranks for her three-point shooting.

In the backcourt, Erika Davenport is on the Cheryl Miller Award Watch List given to the top small forward. The junior has been a double-double machine, leading the BIG EAST with 14 last season while averaging 13.4 ppg and 9.2 rpg last season. This season marks the first time these awards will be given out and the winner will be announced at the Final Four.

Golden Eagles Honored by BIG EAST

After last season's strong showings, three Golden Eagles earned preseason recognition from the BIG EAST. Junior guard Allazia Blockton is unanimous conference player of the year after making first team all-conference last season. Davenport and Hiedeman join their classmate on the awards list, as both made the All-BIG EAST Preseason team, highlighted by Davenport's unanimous selection.

Road Trip

The Golden Eagles open their regular season on the road for the first time since 2015-16 when they played at Green Bay. Marquette owns a 1-2 record in season openers under Carolyn Kieger.

Returning Players

Marquette brings back all but one starter from last year's BIG EAST Champions. Continuity will prove an advantage for the Golden Eagles as they return 86 percent of minutes and 89 percent of scoring. Kieger's strong first class of recruits headlined by Blockton, King, Davenport, Hiedeman and Wilborn enter their junior year together.

Freshmen Ready to Contribute

The Golden Eagles added two recruits in the offseason in Selena Lott and Myriama Smith Traore. Lott was a top-30 guard out of high school who was Troy Record girl's Basketball Player of the Year for her senior season. Smith Traore will add a strong defensive presence for the Golden Eagles, as she led Wisconsin in defensive rebounds (220) and blocks (120) in the 2015-16 season.

Marquette will also have redshirt freshman Lauren Van Kleunen who is ready to contribute after sitting out the 2017-18 season. Van Kleunen joins the Golden Eagles out of Ohio and was a two-time member of the District 15 All-Conference team in high school.

Blockton, Hiedeman Climbing Record Books

Members of Marquette's strong junior class are already putting themselves in team history after just two seasons. After leading the team in scoring for each of her first two years, Allazia Blockton is the 21st-highest

scorer in Marquette history with 1,126 career points. She is on-track to surpass the team record of 1,940 points held by Krystal Ellis and is just 151 shy of tying Kieger's mark of 1,277 career points.

Hiedeman is also on pace to break a Marquette record, as she has made 142 three-pointers, which is 10th all-time. She shoots the triple at a career 35.1 percentage and is only 20 threes away from cracking the top five in team history.

MU Will Be Challenged in Non-Conference Play

After setting a 9-2 mark in last season's non-conference slate, Marquette will face a tough schedule this season, with match-ups against three teams ranked in the preseason poll and all but four games on the road. The Golden Eagles face an early test in the Cancun Challenge, where they will take on No. 14/18 Tennessee in only the third game of the season. From there, Marquette will have a three-game stint in Wisconsin before heading back on the road to play last year's NIT Champions and No. 23/24 Michigan. Marquette wraps up non-conference play in one of the biggest games of its season when the team travels to South Bend to battle No.5/6 Notre Dame.

Last season's non-conference record was the best for the team since 2013-14 when the Golden Eagles also started the year 9-2.

Kieger's Leadership

In women's basketball history head coach Carolyn Kieger is the 36th to coach and play for a ranked team, and the 11th to do this at her alma mater.

MU Against the Top-25

Marquette went 6-0 when facing teams ranked in the top-25 last season, headlined by the BIG EAST title win over No. 17 DePaul. The Golden Eagles toppled then No. 18/16 Arizona State, then No. 22/15 Oregon State, 74-73 on the road. MU defeated a ranked DePaul team twice, and just knocked off No. 23 Creighton in the BIG EAST semifinals before besting DePaul in the finals. The

last time that Marquette defeated five top-25 teams in one season was 2010-11. That squad advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

Cleaning the Glass

Led by Erika Davenport's 9.2 boards a game, the Golden Eagles topped the BIG EAST with a +5.2 rebounding margin last season. Marquette also was second in the conference with a 34.8 rebounding defense and 40.1 rebounding offense.

Scoring Leads to Success

The Golden Eagles put up 78.8 points per game last season, good for second in the BIG EAST behind DePaul and 14th in the nation. Marquette also was second in scoring margin with a + 8.6 differential. The Golden Eagles scored 70-plus points in 26 contests last season, winning all but two of these games.

Protect the Ball

The Golden Eagles averaged 13.2 turnovers per game last season (12th in the NCAA) and notched a conference-high 1.4 assist to turnover ratio (ninth in the nation).

The Century Mark

Marquette reached 100 points in three games last season and owns a 3-0 record when this outburst occurs. MU topped St. Francis in the second game of the season, 104-91 and defeated DePaul 102-101 in overtime on Jan. 21. Most recently the squad rolled past Seton Hall 103-60 on Feb. 3.

The Triple-Double

Natisha Hiedeman recorded just the second triple-double in MU program history last season on Dec. 2 with 12 points, a career-best 18 rebounds and 10 assists. She is one of eight players in Division I this season to tally a triple-double and her 18 boards is the most by a BIG EAST player this season.

A Daily Double

Junior Erika Davenport recorded a BIG EAST-best 14 double-doubles in 33 games last season and finished just shy

of averaging one at 13.2 points and 9.2 rebounds. She has 22 career double-doubles after picking up eight as a freshman and ranked at 32nd in the NCAA with 14 tallied last year.

In-State Stretch

During non-conference play, Marquette will have its longest stint in Wisconsin to start December. The Golden Eagles host Loyola-Chicago, before playing at Green Bay and wrapping up the stretch versus Wisconsin. Marquette then hits the road to take on Michigan in Ann Arbor.

Three-Point Success

In the Carolyn Kieger era of Marquette women's basketball, the Golden Eagles have had success from beyond-the-arc, hitting a three-point basket in 62 consecutive games since going 0-for-6 at Villanova on Jan. 4, 2015. MU sank a season-best 11 treys at Georgetown, earning an 84-77 victory.

Gaining Experience

MU's head coach Carolyn Kieger enters her fourth year in the position. The Golden Eagles return all but one starter and are bolstered by the strong junior class.

It's Good to Play at Home

MU racked up a 15-3 home record last season, highlighted by three straight victories at the Al McGuire Center in the BIG EAST Tournament.

MU Picked First in BIG EAST Poll

Last season, the Golden Eagles were picked 3rd in the BIG EAST Preseason Poll, but following last season's tournament championship, Marquette was a unanimous selection for the top spot. No. 25 DePaul is ranked second while Villanova rounds out the top three.

Sizable Junior Class

Seven juniors are listed on the roster for MU, the largest class on the team. Shantelle Valentine represents the lone senior.

Lone Senior

Shantelle Valentine is the only senior on

the roster after McKayla Yentz represented the lone senior on last year's team. Valentine played in all 33 games last season, averaging 2.5 points and 2.2 rebounds in 11.8 minutes of action.

Marquette Adds Tori McCoy

The Golden Eagles added sophomore forward Tori McCoy from Ohio State during the offseason. The talented Illinois native will sit out the 2017-18 season due to NCAA transfer rules. McCoy averaged 8.1 points and 5.9 rebounds per game in her sole year as a Buckeye and led the team with 59 blocks. She was a member of the Big Ten All-Freshman team and was a consensus top-10 player out of high school while being named a McDonald's All-American.

Chloe Marotta Inks with MU

Carolyn Kieger and Marquette earned a commitment from Chloe Marotta as a member of the 2018 class. Marotta hails from Mequon, Wisconsin where she is a two-time first team all-conference selection and was named the No. 1 player in Wisconsin for 2018 by WisSports. At Homestead High School Marotta reached her 1,000th point as a junior, was Co-Player of the Year in the North Conference and earned First Team all-state accolades. She ranks No. 14 at her position and ESPNHoopGurlz listed her as one of 100 players to watch.

Marotta has Marquette ties, as her brother Cam is a member of the men's basketball team and her father Marc also played for the men's team in his time at Marquette. She will join the Golden Eagles in the summer of 2018.

Marquette on National Television

The Golden Eagles will play on national television for five BIG EAST games this season beginning, Dec. 28 when MU hosts St. John's at 7:30 p.m. CT on FS2. Marquette will be on FS1 two times and FS2 three times this season.

BEDN to Air Conference Games

The BIG EAST Digital Network will provide coverage of 73 additional women's basketball conference games. BEDN, launched in September 2014, is its own dedicated section within FOX Sports GO, the mobile app that provides live streaming video of FOX Sports content at home or on-the-go. FOX Sports GO is currently available for iOS, Android, Kindle Fire tablets and Fire phones, select Windows devices, and on desktops through FOXSportsGO.com. Streaming on FOX Sports GO is also now available on several connected devices, including Apple TV, Roku and Chromecast. notoriety around the BIG EAST.

Kieger's offensive style of run-and-gun showed yet again as the Golden Eagles finished the season ranked 14th in NCAA Division I averaging 78.8 points per game. Marquette also finished the year a perfect 6-0 against teams ranked in the top-25.

Kieger made her collegiate head coaching debut on Nov. 15, 2014 when Marquette hosted Green Bay in the 2014-15 season opener and she earned her first career victory on Nov. 17, 2014 when Marquette defeated Loyola Chicago, 86-71, at the Al McGuire Center. She completed her first year with a 9-22 overall record, but saw three student-athletes earn individual accolades in the BIG EAST with three all-conference selections.

In her second year at the helm of the Golden Eagles Kieger had the youngest program in NCAA Division I with eight freshmen on the roster. She took the program to a 14-16 overall record and improved her BIG EAST record to 9-9 and earned the league's No. 6 seed in the BIG EAST Tournament.

Kieger coached Allazia Blockton to become the BIG EAST Freshman of the Year, a program-first for Marquette, and saw junior McKayla Yentz named BIG EAST Most Improved Player after tripling her scoring output in 2015-16.

Kieger spent six seasons as the assistant coach at the University of Miami. She was the Director of Operations for the Golden Eagles during the 2007-08 season and spent a year at Miami as

coordinator of basketball operations from 2006-07.

As a player at Marquette, Kieger was a four-year starter, three-year captain and is MU's all-time assists leader. She is the only player in program history with at least 1,200 career points, 400 career rebounds and 600 assists. For her career, Kieger averaged 10.3 points per game and was a second team All-BIG EAST selection for the 2005-06 season, as well as, a second team All-Conference USA selection for the 2003-04 and 2004-05 seasons. During her senior campaign, she was a finalist for the Nancy Lieberman Award, given to the nation's top point guard.

In addition to her athletic accomplishments, Kieger received the BIG EAST Conference's Sportsmanship award as a senior.

A native of Roseville, Minn., Kieger graduated Cum Laude from Marquette University with a bachelor's degree in broadcasting and electronic communications in 2006. In 2007, she received the McCahill Award given to a graduated MU senior student-athlete who demonstrated the highest performance in scholarship, leadership and athletics.

Former Marquette University women's basketball standout Carolyn Kieger became the program's fifth head coach on May 1, 2014 and begins her fourth year at the helm of the Golden Eagles in 2017-18.

After just three seasons, Kieger has taken the Golden Eagles to new heights after a widely successful 2016-17 campaign that saw Marquette earn the BIG EAST Tournament title on its home floor for the first time in program history, while also earning a program-best fifth seed in the NCAA Tournament, as MU returned to the Big Dance for the first time since 2011 and the 10th time in team history. Kieger's record stands above .500 at 48-46 after she led Marquette to a 25-8 record last season, the first 20+ win season for the Golden Eagles since 2013-14, while coaching Allazia Blockton to a WBCA All-American honorable mention honor. Blockton earned unanimous All-BIG EAST first team honors as a sophomore and became the youngest player in program history to surpass the 1,000-point plateau and Marquette's 25th all-time. Fellow classmate Erika Davenport was a second-team all-conference selection and Natisha Hiedeman earned honorable mention accolades as the Golden Eagles earned


