#### Opening Tip

- Colorado State wraps up two straight televised Mountain West games, taking on rival New Mexico, Jan. 14.
- Tip off between the Rams and Falcons is set for 12 p.m. MT at Moby Arena, with the game televised on ROOT Sports. Drew Goodman is on the play-by-play, Joe Cravens is the analyst and Ryan Spilborghs is on the sidelines.
- It will also air across the Colorado State Sports Network, including flagship KARS 102.9 FM, with Brian Roth on the play-by-play and Adam Nigon handling the analysis.
- The game will have live audio on CSURams.com and live stats on GameTracker.

#### 2016-17 Rams Quick Hits

- The 2016-17 season marks the 115th in the history of the Colorado State men's basketball program. The Rams are 1,227-1,225 (.501) in 2,452 games all-time.
- Colorado State is under the direction of coaching veteran Larry Eustachy, who is in his fifth season at the helm of the Rams' program and his 26th as a Division I head coach in 2015-16. Eustachy reached the 500-win plateau in his coaching career with the 85-58 victory over Air Force, Jan. 7.
- Colorado State men's basketball concluded the 2015-16 season in the Mountain West Tournament Semifinals and finished the year with an 18-16 overall record, including 8-10 in MW play.
- Colorado State basketball declined postseason invitations last year after much consideration of the events as well as the status of the team after the season. The program earned its sixth invitation for postseason play in the last seven years.
- CSU lost four of its five starters, including leading scorers Antwan Scott, a Second Team All-Mountain West selection, and Joe De Ciman, who was the only player from Larry Eustachy's first CSU team to play all four years.

**The Coaches**

- Colorado State Head Coach **Larry Eustachy** (Long Beach State, '79) starts his fifth season at the helm of the Rams and holds a 98-54 (.645) record at CSU and 500-312 (.616) overall coaching record in his 26th season. Last season, CSU posted an 18-16 mark, including 8-10 in Mountain West play, and advanced to the MW Championship semifinals.
- New Mexico Head Coach **Craig Neal** (Georgia Tech, '88) is in his fourth season as leader of the Lobos and as a head coach overall with a 68-46 mark.

**All-Time Against Today's Opponent**

- This will be the 120th meeting ever between the two schools, with New Mexico having a decisive 74-54 advantage, but CSU holds the lead at 33-24 at home. Last year, the two teams played just once, with CSU earning an 86-69 victory on Feb. 23
- CSU head coach Larry Eustachy is just 2-6 all-time against New Mexico, including 2-2 at Moby Arena. Eustachy has coached CSU to victories in the last two meetings
- Against all current teams from the Mountain West Conference, CSU is 350-399 and 219-137 at home. Head coach Larry Eustachy is 76-62 overall in his career against the MW, including 45-14 on home floors.

**A Win Over New Mexico Will...**

- Improve CSU to 46-74 in the overall series against New Mexico, including 34-24 at home.
- Move head coach Larry Eustachy to 3-6 against the Lobos in his career
- Give Larry Eustachy his 99th win in five seasons at CSU and the 501st of his 26-year career.
- Guarantee CSU a winning record at home for the fifth

straight season under Eustachy and eighth consecutive year for the program overall.

- Give Larry Eustachy his 99th win in five seasons at CSU and the 501st of his 26-year career.
- Put the Rams at 4-1 in Mountain West play, the best program record through five games in MW action and tie the best in all league starts.

**Scouting New Mexico**

- The Lobos are 9-8 on the season and 2-3 in MW play.
- Picked to finish in third in the Mountain West preseason coaches' poll, Air Force returned four starters and nine letterwinners from last season.
- This season, the Lobos are led by redshirt-senior forward Tim Williams, who paces the team in points (18.5 ppg), rebounds (7.1 rpg) and minutes (33.3 mpg). Redshirt-junior guard Elijah Brown is the top Lobo in three pointers (32) and steals (24) while senior center Obij Aget is the top UNM player in blocks (21) and field goal percentage (.609).

**Mountain West Openers**

- Since the formation of the Mountain West conference in 1999-2000, the CSU men's basketball team is 5-13 in Mountain West openers and 4-7 at home in those games.

**Mountain West Record**

- Colorado State - a charter member of the Mountain West - is now 109-155 (.413) in regular-season action against MW foes since the formation of the league in 1999-2000.
- Head coach Larry Eustachy is 42-32 (.568) in MW regular-season action in his time at Colorado State and 45-36 including tournament games..

**Eustachy Among the Elite**

- CSU head coach Larry Eustachy has ranked among the best coaches in his sport for nearly two and a half decades, now in his 26th season as a mentor at the NCAA Division I level and just got his 500th career win, becoming the 62nd Division I head coach (all wins at Division I level) to reach that milestone ever.
- His 500 wins ranks 18th among active NCAA Division I coaches (same standard) and he is two back of Billy Donovan (Marshall, Florida) for No. 61.
- The four others that could reach the 500-win level this year, within reason, are Eustachy, Leonard Hamilton (Florida State - 494), John Beilein (Michigan - 493), Jay Wright (Villanova - 492) and Mark Few (Gonzaga - 481).
- In his first season at the helm of the Rams' program, Eustachy became the only head coach in NCAA Division I history to lead five different programs - CSU, Southern Miss, Iowa State, Utah State and Idaho - to 24 or more wins in a season.
- With a career record of 500-312 (.616), Eustachy ranks as one of just 75 head coaches (out of 351 Division I programs) to have a .600 or better win percentage with a minimum of five years experience. He entered the season tied for 57th on the list, and is one of just 33 coaches in the ranking with at least 20 years of Division I experience.

**Moving Up the CSU Coaching Ranks**

- CSU head coach Larry Eustachy continues to move up the record chart for the Rams in victories.
- Already starting the season with the highest winning percentage among coaches with at least four years at the school, Eustachy moved from seventh to fourth in career wins over the course of the season, passing Boyd Grant (1988-91) with his 82nd win on Feb. 6, 2016 vs. Nevada.

- In a rare Tuesday night Mountain West contest, the Colorado State men's basketball team put together its most complete game of the conference season with a 86-69 victory over visiting New Mexico, Feb. 23... - For the season, CSU is 74.1 percent from the charity line, ranking 10th nationally in free throws made and 17th in free throws attempted.

- The Rams have also made 326 free throws while their opponents have combined for just 317 total attempts.
- In the win at Colorado Nov. 30, the Rams made their first 18 free throws in a row, a key reason that CSU won the road game.
- However in their recent loss at Long Beach State Dec. 22, the Rams shot a season-low 40.0 percent (8-of-20) from the free throw line.
- Last year, Colorado State did its job overall at the free throw line in its 34 games, connecting on 71.8 percent (618-of-861) of its attempts. The Rams were a touch lower at 70.2 percent (308-of-439) from the line in conference action.
- The Rams made 618 free throw attempts in 2015-16, while their opponents had just 703 total attempts from the line. CSU ranked 19th nationally in free throws made and 18th in free throw attempts.

### Road Struggles

- CSU picked up its first MW road win at San Jose State, Jan. 4, and is now 2-3 on the road this year.
- Under head coach Larry Eustachy, CSU is 21-32 (.396) on the road, above the national average of 32.4 percent.
- Last season, the Rams were 6-11 in games away from Moby Arena, snapping a five-game skid with the win over San Jose State in the neutral-site game.

### Double-Double, Omogbo's Trouble

- Senior forward Emmanuel Omogbo has been a load for opposing teams since late last season, overcoming the family tragedy in January 2015.
- Omogbo currently leads the Mountain West and ranks 16th nationally at 10.6 rebounds a game to go with his 12.8 points a contest and league-high eight double-doubles (20th in NCAA Division I).
- Against Fort Lewis (11/16), Omogbo recorded his ninth career double-double with a career-high 20 points and 15 rebounds (third most in his career). He then had 11 points and 10 rebounds against Maryland Eastern Shore (11/23) for his 10th career double-double.
- Omogbo added his third double-double of the season against Southeastern Louisiana with 18 points and a season-best 16 boards. He led CSU in the win over Alcorn State with 15 points and 15 rebounds.
- He had 13 points and 11 boards against Kansas State at the Pepsi Center in Denver, Dec. 17, before his recent double-double of 13 points and 13 rebounds against UNLV, Dec. 28.
- Recently, he just missed a double-double with a career-high 22 points and game-high nine rebounds at Boise State, Dec. 31. However he followed it up with 13 points and 11 rebounds in the win at San Jose State, Jan. 4
- For his CSU career, Omogbo now has 16 double-doubles.

### Clavell Can Fill It

- Redshirt-senior guard Gian Clavell is having a strong return to the Rams' lineup in his final collegiate season after receiving a medical redshirt for last season.
- He returned to the lineup Dec. 10 against Northern Colorado after sitting out the first nine contests due to a suspension for a violation of CSU's Student-Athlete Code of Conduct. He scored 15 points off the bench in the Rams' victory. He then followed it up with 16 points versus Kansas State at the Pepsi Center in Denver, Dec. 17.
- Recently, he had his first double-double of the year with 21 points and a career-high 11 rebounds in the win over UNLV, Dec. 28. He followed it up with 22 points at Boise State, Dec. 31.
- In his last outing, Clavell scored a season-high 28 points, including a team season-best five three-pointers, in the win over Air Force, Jan. 7. The 28 points were the most he has scored in his career in a 40-minute game.
- Clavell currently leads the team in scoring at 16.5 points per game, having scored in double figures in six of his seven appearances this season. He also is shooting 45.8 percent from the floor, 40.0 percent from the three-point line and grabbing 5.4 rebounds a contest.
- He still needs 358 points this season to reach 1,000 CSU points.
- The 6-4 native of Puerto Rico was second in the Mountain West and 23rd nationally at 20.8 points per game in 2015-16 while ranking 11th in the nation at a staggering 36:54 per contest when he broke his hand prior to the Kansas

State game. At the time of his injury, he led the team with 27 made three pointers, ranked second in rebounding at 6.9 per contest and had a career-high 35 points in a double-overtime loss to UTEP early last season.

### Nixon Does It All

- Sophomore Prentiss Nixon has become an integral part of the CSU lineup this season.
- The guard has averaged 12.5 points per game this year, scoring in double figures in 10 games, including the last four straight (all MW contests).
- He scored a career-high 30 points against Kansas State and surpassed his season high from last year four times.
- Nixon has also been stellar on the defensive end of the floor, drawing a team-high 17 charges/offensive fouls this season and creating 16 steals, tied for second on the team.

### Paige Wheeling & Dealing

- Redshirt-sophomore J.D. (or as Coach Eustachy calls him Jeremiah) Paige has been adjusting well to his new role within CSU's offense.
- Paige leads CSU assists (2.8 apg) and steals (1.2 spg) and is fourth in scoring (8.9 ppg) and second in blocks (0.9 bpg).
- The Denver, Colo., native had a solid outing against Alcorn State (11/23), recording career bests of 23 points and six assists in the home victory.

### Carvacho Growing On the Floor

- Redshirt-freshman center Nico Carvacho is showing his increased comfort level on the floor for the Rams.
- Carvacho had a breakout game at Colorado, Nov. 30, scoring 14 points on 5-of-7 shooting and grabbing 9 rebounds.
- Against Northern Colorado Dec. 10, he posted his first collegiate double-double of 13 points (5-of-6 FG) and 11 boards.
- He leads the Rams at 55.2 percent (32-of-58) from the field and is fourth in rebounding at 4.2 per game.

### Young Guards Stepping Up Scoring

- Redshirt-sophomore J.D. Paige and sophomore Prentiss Nixon are both showing what a year of college basketball can do for confidence and skills.
- Last season, Paige averaged 4.9 points a game and shot just 33.8 percent from the field, while Nixon was 4.8 points and 38.9 percent from the floor.
- This year, the duo has increased their scoring averages by more than double combined, as Nixon is at 12.8 points per game while Paige is currently at 8.9 points per contest.

### #TeamTogether Is Real

- Head coach Larry Eustachy preaches the Team Together concept and it is showing on the floor.
- CSU has had six different players lead the team in scoring in its first 10 games.
- Also, all 10 players are averaging at least 12 minutes a game so far this season, showing that they can all be counted on to contribute at various times. However, the roster will be reduced by three players following today's game, due to academic issues.

### Colorado State Policy on Injury Reports

Due to circumstances surrounding the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA), Colorado State University has developed a policy regarding the release of injury information.

CSU student-athletes have the right to hold all injury information, except body part and playing status, confidential and private. As a standard operating procedure, coaches, athletic communications staff, and other athletic department personnel should refrain from sharing specific injury information with the media. However, in certain occasions, injury information could be released at the discretion of the athletic communications department after authorization is obtained from the student-athlete.

It is the policy of the CSU athletic training staff to not address the media unless it is absolutely necessary. Therefore, inquiries by the media regarding medical situations should be addressed to the Athletic Communications office.

It's TV Time For the Rams

- All of Colorado State's home conference games will be available via network broadcasts, with all 18 MW handled by major partners. In total for the year, Colorado State has a combined 23 games selected for broadcast on CBS Sports Network (seven), ROOT Sports (seven), ESPN networks (five) and Mountain West Network on Campus Insiders (two) along with a pair of Pac-12 Network road games.

Stacking of the Classes

- CSU finally has the stack of classes that head coach Larry Eustachy has desired since taking over the program, though it won't take effect until next season. Because of four experienced Division I transfers sitting out, next year's roster is scheduled to have three seniors, five juniors and four sophomores with college playing experience along with one JUCO transfer.

Eustachy's Contract Extended

- Colorado State Director of Athletics Joe Parker announced a one-year extension to the contract of head men's basketball coach Larry Eustachy. This guarantees that Eustachy will remain at the helm of the Rams through the 2020-21 season.

Omogbo MW Player of the Week

- Colorado State senior forward Emmanuel Omogbo was named the Mountain West Men's Basketball Player of the Week, the league announced Nov. 28. This was the first time that Omogbo has earned the honor. The leading rebounder in the conference, Omogbo continued to assert himself in all phases, recording a double-double in each of the three games this week, leading the Rams to victories in all three. He averaged 14.7 points and 13.7 rebounds for the week while shooting 48.4 percent from the field and 73.7 percent from the free throw line.

Coaches' Shows Are Back

- The Coors Light Basketball Coaches Show, featuring men's head coach Larry Eustachy and women's head coach Ryun Williams are back on Monday nights at 6 p.m. at Lucky Joe's in Old Town Fort Collins. All fans are invited to join the coaches and get the update on both programs through the first weeks of the season. The remaining Monday dates for the Basketball Coaches' Shows are: Jan. 16, 23 & 30, and Feb. 6, 13, 20 & 27.

Looking Ahead

- Colorado State will head back on the road for the next two Mountain West games, traveling to California to take on defending league champion Fresno State, Jan. 18. Tip off at Save Mart Center is set for 9 p.m. MT as the game will be televised nationally on CBS Sports Network. It will also air across the Colorado State Sports Network, including flagship KARS 102.9 FM, with Brian Roth on the play-by-play and Adam Nigon handling the analysis.

Long Beach State, 1979 • Fifth Year at Colorado State  
26th Year as Head Coach

Larry Eustachy, the 2000 Associated Press and U.S. Basketball Writers Association National Coach of the Year, enters his fifth season as head coach of the Colorado State men's basketball program in 2016-17. He was introduced as the 19th head coach in the history of the CSU basketball on April 12, 2012.

One of the most decorated active coaches in NCAA basketball, Eustachy enters his 26th season as a head coach as the only head coach in Division I history to lead five different programs - CSU, Southern Miss, Iowa State, Utah State and Idaho - to 24 or more wins in a season. With a career record of 500-312 (.616), Eustachy ranks as one of just 75

head coaches (out of 351 Division I programs) to have a .600 or better win percentage with a minimum of five years experience. He entered the season just 11 victories from the 500-win mark in his career and is 28th on the active career wins list. He is also one of just 33 coaches in the ranking with at least 20 years of Division I experience.

At Colorado State, he has put together the most wins in a four-year span of the program with 87, surpassing Boyd Grant's 81 victories (1988-91). He began his fifth season with the highest winning percentage among coaches with at least three years at the school at .644 and started 13 wins away from 100 and 17 wins from taking over third on the CSU coaching chart. His teams have also won

more than 80 percent of their games at CSU's Moby Arena in his four years of leadership.

In his first year at the helm, Eustachy led the Rams to arguably the best season in school history, guiding the squad to a then-program-best 26-9 record, and an NCAA Tournament victory over the Missouri Tigers before bowing out against eventual national champion Louisville. The Rams also cracked the Associated Press top 25 for first time since 1954.

Eustachy continued to rewrite the Rams' record books in his third season in 2014-15, leading the Rams to a school-record 14-0 start before once again notching a program-best season record at 27-7. The Rams' advanced to the postseason (NIT) for the second time in three years under his watch, and ranked for two weeks in the AP Top-25 and three weeks in the USA Today Coaches poll.

A veteran mentor with more than 35 seasons of coaching experience - including 25 seasons as a head coach - Eustachy has amassed an impressive 499-312 record in stops at Idaho (1990-93), Utah State (1993-98), Iowa State (1998-03) and Southern Miss (2004-12) and CSU (2012-present), leading his squads to 11 campaigns of 20 or more victories, nine postseason berths (including five NCAA tournament appearances), and six conference championships.

Eustachy, a native of Alameda, Calif., and a 1979 graduate of Long Beach State University, has garnered numerous coaching honors throughout his illustrious career. In addition to his two National Coach of the Year nods in 2000, he was also the 2001 runner-up for the AP's top coaching honor.

He was twice named the Big West and Big 12 Coach of the Year during stints at Utah State (1995 and 1998) and Iowa State (2000 and 2001), respectively, and joins the Rams after leading his Southern Miss Golden Eagles' squad to 25 wins in 2011-12 to earn the

2012 Conference USA Coach of the Year award. Eustachy was also the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 11 Coach of the Year in 2012.

Eustachy's coaching career began at the age of 22 as an assistant coach at Citrus (Calif.) College, where he played two seasons after a standout prep career at Arcadia High School. From 1981-90, Eustachy honed his skills as an assistant at Division I schools Mississippi State (1981-86), Idaho (1986-87), Utah (1987-89) and Ball State (1989-90) before taking his first head coaching job at Idaho (1990-93).

Following his stint at Idaho, Eustachy spent five seasons (1993-98) as the head coach at Utah State (1993-98). He then took over for close friend Tim Floyd at Iowa State, spending five seasons in Ames, Iowa, and leading the Cyclones to the Elite Eight in the 2000 NCAA tournament.

Eustachy spent the previous eight seasons at Southern Miss, where he resurrected the Golden Eagles program and led USM to four 20 win seasons, including each of his last three campaigns in Hattiesburg.

Eustachy is a native of Alameda, Calif. He and his wife Lana live in Fort Collins. Eustachy has two sons, Hayden and Evan.

## The Eustachy Philosophy

Eustachy's philosophy is a unique mixture of several coaches who had great influence on him during his years as a player and as an assistant coach. Eustachy's teams put a premium on defending and rebounding, combining that with peak physical conditioning and strength, all the while incorporating an offense that best utilizes the talents of the respective members of the team.

It's a philosophy that contains the contribution of a number of coaches, including his influential junior college coach Neil Edwards, former USC and Mississippi State Coach Bob Boyd - Eustachy's mentor - former NBA and current UTEP Head Coach Tim Floyd, whose own philosophy had bits of Don Haskins and his father, Lee Floyd, a former coach during the 1950s and '60s at Southern Miss.

Eustachy not only instills physical toughness in his players, but he also strives to make his players value the mental part of the game, an aspect that is created through stressful practice. It's during those practices that Eustachy knows he and his staff need to be at their best, for that is where the battles on the court are often times won and lost.
