#### ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- New Mexico and New Mexico State will face off for the 215th time in the Lobos' oldest rivalry. UNM holds 118-96 advantage in the series, which began in the 1903-04 season. UNM has won 13 of the last 16 Rio Grande Rivalry meetings with Craig Neal on the sidelines (2007-08 to present).
- The game is part of a department-wide competition known as the "Rio Grande Rivalry". All of the two schools' athletic teams compete for points in the competition. The Lobos have claimed victory every year of the rivalry, which began during the 2007-08 academic year.
- Currently, the 2015-16 Rio Grande Rivalry is led by the Lobos, 6.0-3.0. The competition was tied prior the Lobos' 38-29 win in football on Oc. 3.
- The Lobos have won seven straight games in Las Cruces against the Aggies.
- New Mexico State was selected as the favorites to win the Western Athletic Conference by both the coaches and the media. Pascal Siakam was selected by the media as the Preseason Player of the Year, while Ian Baker was a unanimous pick for Preseason All-WAC First Team.
- Marvin Menzies enters his ninth year leading the Aggies. He has led his squad to four straight WAC Tournament titles and NCAA Tournament berths from 2012-2015.

## NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

### OPENING STRONG

Since the 1950-51 season, the New Mexico Lobos are 55-11 (.833) in season openers. That record includes a 47-5 (.904) mark in season openers in Albuquerque. That record is boosted by season-opening wins for the last 13 straight seasons. The last time the Lobos dropped a season-opener was against California on Nov. 23, 2002, 76-68. Despite the wide margin of victory Friday night for the Lobos, it was not close to the widest margin in a season opener during the 13-year stretch. In 2013, the Lobos defeated Alabama A&M 88-52 to open 2013-14. Two years prior, UNM defeated New Orleans 92-40.

### OPENING BIG

The Lobos' big win over SWAC preseason favorites, Texas Southern, marked multiple milestones that were never reached in the 2014-15 campaign. The Lobos scored a whopping 54 points in the first half, the first time the team scored 50 in a first half since Nov. 17, 2013 against Charleston Southern. The Lobos hit the 20 assist mark, the first time they had reached 20 in a game since Dec. 17, 2014 against Central Arkansas. The team's 86 points marked the first time the Lobos had crossed 80 since March 5, 2014, when the Lobos faced Air Force.

### GETTING DEFENSIVE

The cherry and silver will look to continue last season's defense prowess. They held opponents to just 60.2 points per game, which was the second-best defensive scoring mark posted by a UNM team in the last three decades. The Lobos were the last team in the nation to concede 70 points in a game after allowing 70 points to Colorado State in their 24th game of the season. It was New Mexico's best defensive scoring start to a season since World War II.

In the season opener against Texas Southern, the Lobos continued that defensive prominence. New Mexico held Texas Southern to 34.7 percent (17-for-49) shooting. The Lobos kept up their defensive intensity for a full 40 minutes, holding the Tigers to 34.6 percent in the first half and 34.8 percent in the second. Texas Southern was also held to 28.6 percent shooting from distance.

### HOT SHOOTING

The defense was on point Friday, but the offense hit its stride as well, especially early. The Sharks scored over 50 points in the first half and reached that mark by shooting 72.4 percent from the floor. Going into the second half, it was looking like a possible record night, with the Lobos getting to the basket to shoot from point-blank range with ease. However, a slump late in the game and a low-scoring second half presented any records from being broken. Going into the final minute, the Lobos were shooting over 60 percent for the game, but three-straight missed shots after multiple offensive rebounds dropped the Lobos to 59.3 percent shooting. It would have been the first game in which the Lobos shot over 60 percent since 2012. If they had stayed over 65 percent, it would have been the first time in over a decade.

### NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

Head coach Craig Neal's staff is bringing in two freshmen and one transfer player during the early signing period. Joining the Lobos will be transfer forward Connor MacDougall of South Mountain Community College and previously Arizona State University and Corona Del Sol HS. Also joining is Damien Jefferson of East Chicago Central HS and Aher Uguak of Harry Ainley HS in Edmonton, Canada.

# NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

## HEROES NIGHT

Coach Neal and the Lobos kicked off the 2015-16 season with "Heroes Night" in honor of the current and former men and women who have served our country in the armed services, as well as the first responders of our community. The Lobos dawned jerseys with camouflage lettering. An auction was held for the game-worn jerseys that netted \$3,200 that will be donated to the UNM Veterans Resource Center.

## PACE OF PLAY

Last season, the Lobos averaged 62 points per game and held opponents to 60.2 ppg. However, in the two exhibition wins, the Lobos averaged 88 ppg. That huge jump in points is linked to the average amount of possessions per game. Last year, the Lobos averaged just under 63 possessions per game, but in exhibition play, the Lobos averaged 78.1 possessions over two contests. The extra 15 possessions per game can be attributed to the new 30 second shot clock and Neal's desire to play an up tempo style. The trend carried over the regular season start Friday. The Lobos had over 70 possessions and earned an offensive rating of 120.7.

## WELCOME BACK CULLEN

Cullen Neal has not needed time to adjust back to playing at a high level, after serving as the Lobos' leading scorer in two exhibitions. He averaged 26.5 points per game this preseason, shooting 57 percent from the floor (17-for-30), 36 percent from 3-point range (5-for-14) and 88 percent from (14-for-16). He also had 11 assists, nearly twice as much as any other player (only Elijah Brown had more than 5).

In Friday's season-opener, Neal scored a game-best 22 points on 8-for-15 shooting. Neal also chipped in four assists and two steals. Neal scored 16 of his 22 points in the first period to help build New Mexico's lead.

## BROWN AND WILLIAMS DEBUT

Joining Neal as Lobos coming off a redshirt season are junior Tim Williams and sophomore Elijah Brown. Williams and Brown sat out last season after transferring from Samford University and Butler University respectively. Williams was a two-time All-SoCon selection at the forward position, and he averaged 17.6 points and 7.3 rebounds as a sophomore. The Illinois native also finished the 2013-14 season seventh in the nation in field goal percentage (.603). Brown was the Butler Bulldogs' fourth-leading scorer as a freshman in 2013-14. He tallied 19 points against then No. 11 Villanova. The redshirt sophomore is the son of veteran NBA coach Mike Brown.

In exhibition play, Williams averaged 14 points and six rebounds per game, both the second best marks on the team. He reached the foul line 18 times, a team-best, and shot nearly 70 percent from the floor. On Friday, Williams tallied 17 points on a near-perfect 7-for-8 shooting, along with five rebounds and two blocks.

Brown filled up the box score with efficiency in exhibition play, averaging 9.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, three assists and 2.5 steals per game. He was the team's best long range shooter at 42.9 percent shooting from 3-point range. Against Texas Southern, Brown scored 16 points on 6-for-9 shooting and recorded a team-best six assists.

## GETTING IN TIME

Head coach Craig Neal suited up 16 players for exhibition play and used all of his active players at some point. He made it clear in a press conference prior to Friday's game that no player wanted to take a red shirt for this season. Therefore, Neal was able to use 13 players in the blowout of Texas Southern. Everyone logged at least three minutes, with 10 players earning over 10 minutes. The final player to check in, to the excitement of the crowd, was freshman center Nikola Scekic.

### FRESHMEN IN EXHIBITION

All of the team's five freshmen appeared in the two preseason games. Below are the stats for the freshmen against the ThunderWolves and Hillcats:

 Anthony Mathis: 14.5 minutes per game. 13 points total, 3-for-8 from deep.  
 Nikola Scekic: Nine minutes played against RSU, two points and one rebound.

### KNOCKING ON WOOD

New Mexico has entered this season with 16 healthy Lobos after an injury-plagued 2014-15 season that saw five players combine to miss 52 games.

### YEAR THREE OF THE CRAIG NEAL ERA

Head coach Craig Neal became the second-fastest coach to 40 wins in UNM history. The Lobo head coach won 40 of his first 53 games as head coach during his first two seasons. Norm Ellenberger picked up his 40th win in his 52nd game as head coach during the 1970's.

### LOBOS IN THE PROS

Two former members of the New Mexico University men's basketball team, Tony Snell and Cameron Bairstow, opened the 2015-16 NBA season on the Chicago Bulls roster. Snell started opening night for the Eastern Conference contenders and scored 11 points with 2 rebounds. Alex Kirk, who played for the Cleveland Cavaliers in 2014-15, is now plying his trade in Italy.

The Rio Grande Rivalry with New Mexico State will continue with games in Albuquerque and Las Cruces.

### STU WALKER

The Pit will be missing a familiar voice this season after the loss of PA announcer Stu Walker. Walker had been the voice inside the Pit since November of 1995. He also served as the voice of the Lobos for several other sports, as well as for the Albuquerque Isotopes. A moment of silence was held prior to last Tuesday's exhibition game.

### 49 CONSECUTIVE SEASONS AND COUNTING...

UNM finished the season ranked 18th in the nation in attendance with an average home crowd of 14,571 inside WisePies Arena aka The Pit. That marked the 49th consecutive season that New Mexico has finished in the Top 25 in the NCAA in attendance.

### GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

The NCAA recently released graduation success rates for all NCAA institutions, and it was great news for the Lobos. The men's basketball team posted an 80 percent graduation rate, a new best-mark on the program and a 14 percent increase from last year's mark, then the all-time high. The program posted a 3.02 team gpa in the Fall of 2014, which was the highest team gpa in a semester in program history. The team had posted a 2.94 gpa the spring before.
