#### **In-Game Notes**

- Lobos are now 17-13 on the year and 10-8 in the Mountain West.
- Lobos finished fifth in the MW regular season and will play the No. 4 seed Fresno State Bulldogs in the quarterfinals of the Mountain West Tournament Thursday.
- This was the 84<sup>th</sup> all-time meeting between the two squads.
- UNM improves to 46-38 all-time against the Aztecs.
- The Lobos tallied their first sweep of the Aztecs since 2005.
- UNM improves to 11-4 when leading at the half this season.
- When shooting less than 50.0% UNM improves to 10-12 on the year.
- Inside WisePies Arena The Pit the Lobos finished the season at 11-4.
- When scoring between 60-70 points, UNM is 3-4.
- The last time that UNM shot less than 30% 3FG was at WYO on 2/25/16 (3-20, 15.0%).
- UNM held SDSU to 31.5% shooting tonight, it was the first time that the Lobos held their opponents to less than 35% shooting since facing SJSU on 2/13/16 (30.4%).
- UNM held SDSU to 19.0% 3FG tonight, it was the first time that the Lobos held their opponents to less than 20% 3FG% since holding SDSU to 14.8% on 2/6/16.

## **RS-Junior Elijah Brown**

- Notched his 28<sup>th</sup> double-digit scoring effort this season and 59<sup>th</sup> of his career (31-28).
