LOBOS ANNOUNCE 18 SIGNEES ON NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — University of New Mexico head coach Bob Davie, who will enter his eighth year with the program in 2019, has announced 18 signees for the 2019 football campaign. Of the 18 signees, 13 are junior college signees, with five coming from the high school ranks.

The signees represent 11 states and five time zones (Atlantic, Central, Mountain, Pacific and Hawaiian). Davie picked up 10 new players on defense, a side of the ball hit hard by graduation as UNM will return just one starter, Aaron Blackwell, although two would-be starters will return from injury in Trent Sellers and Alex Hart. On the defensive side, UNM picked up five defensive backs, four linebackers and one lineman.

On offense, UNM added eight new players, three linemen, two receivers, and one quarterback, one running back and one tight end. UNM returns almost it's whole offensive line, and overall the offense only lost four starters.

The December 19-21 signing period is the first of two for football for the 2019 season, as the traditional National Signing Day for the spring semester will be on February 6, which is the first Wednesday in the month of February.

JUNIOR COLLEGE

- Lettered at Fort Scott Community College for coach Kale Pick.
- Saw action in eight of 10 games.
- Served in the U.S. Army National Guard.
- Is married, and he and his wife Anna have a son, Lio.
- Has only been playing football for one year.



CHAD ALEXANDER

RB | 5-6 | 164 | Fr | HS

New Orleans, La. | Landry-Walker HS

HIGH SCHOOL

- Lettered in football at Landry-Walker High School for coach Emanuel Powell, and also lettered in track.
- Rushed for 1,084 yards on 118 carries with 17 rushing touchdowns as a senior for Landry-Walker.
- Also had a 70-yard kickoff return for a touchdown.
- Scored double-digit touchdowns as a junior.
- Helped win a 5A state title as a sophomore in 2016.



CADE BRIGGS

OL | 6-3 | 275 | Fr | HS

Las Vegas, Nev. | Bishop Gorman HS

HIGH SCHOOL

- Lettered in football at Bishop Gorman HS for coach Kenny Sanchez.
- Named second team All-Southwest League as a guard in 2018.
- Won a state title in all four seasons, including 2018, ending the season on a 10-game winning streak.
- Helped Bishop Gorman rush for 523 yards on 52 carries in the state title game, scoring eight rushing touchdowns.



ERIC CUFFEE

JUNIOR COLLEGE/TEXAS

- Originally played for the Texas Longhorns from 2016-17, redshirting in 2016.
- Lettered one season at Trinity Valley for coach Sherard Poteete.
- Saw action in 10 games with 13 tackles and a pass breakups.

HIGH SCHOOL

- Lettered in football at Waco HS for coach Marty Herbst.
- Named all-state as a senior, and he was a three-time all-district selection.
- Participated in the 2016 Under Armour All-America game.
- Was rated among the top 125 defensive backs out of high school by ESPN.
- Also competed in the 100m, 200m, 4x100m and 4x200m at Waco High School.

JUNIOR COLLEGE

- Lettered in football at Highland Community College for coach Aaron Arnold.
- Named Honorable Mention NJCAA All-America as a sophomore linebacker as well as First Team All-KJCCC honors.
- As a sophomore recorded 90 tackles, 16 for loss, 7.5 sacks, two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries, one interception (returned 100 yards for a touchdown), six hurries and three breakups.
- In his two-year career he had 153 tackles, 29.5 for loss, 13 sacks, two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries, six hurries, seven breakups and two interceptions.

HIGH SCHOOL

- Lettered in football at Randolph County High School for coach Pat Prestridge.
- As a senior he recorded 102 tackles, five sacks, five interceptions, 11 breakups, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery while also rushing for 2,008 yards on 199 carries with 31 TDs along with 13 catches for 353 yards.

- Named all MACJC South First Team.
- As a freshman recorded 33 tackles, one for loss and a forced fumble.

HIGH SCHOOL

- Lettered in football at Clinton High School for coach Judd Boswell.
- Helped Clinton to a 6A state championship as a senior, recording 123 tackles, 20 for loss, seven sacks, four passes defended, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.

QB | 6-2 | 226 | Jr | JC

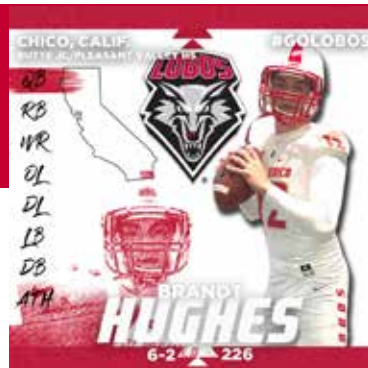
Chico, Calif. | Butte JC/Pleasant Valley HS

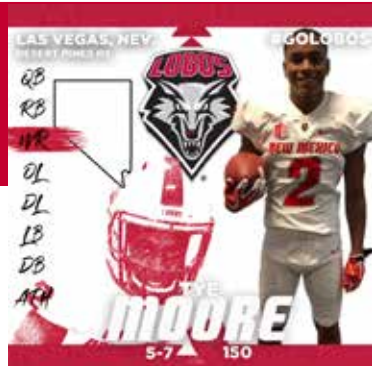

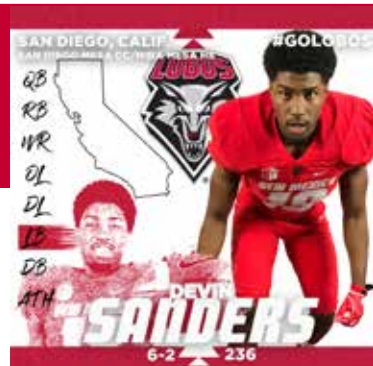
San Diego, Calif. | San Diego Mesa CC/Mira Mesa HS
