ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- New Mexico and Northern Iowa will be playing in the second ever game between the two programs.
- The only meeting between the two teams came on Dec. 23, 2010, in which Northern Iowa won, 66-60, in the Las Vegas Classic.
- A.J. Hardeman had 16 points and Dairese Gary 14 for the Lobos (10-2), whose eight-game winning streak ended. Gary scored New Mexico's last eight points, helping cut the deficit to 61-60 with a minute left.
- The Lobos are 1-0 this season against the Missouri Valley Conference. The Lobos played in the Mountain West/Missouri Valley Challenge earlier this season and defeated Loyola-Chicago, 75-51. Loyola-Chicago was slated fifth in the MVC preseason poll, while UNI was third.
- The Lobos are 5-2 on the season, with back-to-back home wins against Nicholls State, 75-63, and Oral Roberts, 91-75. The Lobos are 4-0 at home this year.
- UNI is 6-2 on the season. Five of six wins came in a row and included a victory over then-No. 1 ranked North Carolina, 71-67. Wins also include Stephen F. Austin, North Dakota and North Texas. UNI is led by Ben Jacobson, who is in year 10 at UNI and is the all-time wins leader with 203 victories.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team (5-2) gave a strong fight to the No. 11 Purdue Boilermakers (8-0), leading the undefeated team in the second half, but went down on the road Saturday, 70-58. The Lobos were led by Elijah Brown, who scored a game-high 21 points on 6-for-12 shooting with four rebounds and three assists. Cullen Neal poured in 16 points and tallied a team-best five assists. Tim Williams pulled down seven rebounds to go with eight points and two blocks. The Boilermakers entered the game leading the nation with a defensive field goal mark of 32.4 percent, but the Lobos matched their defensive intensity, holding the undefeated Boilermakers to 37.1 percent shooting (23-for-62). The Lobos were the first team this season to hold Purdue to under 40 percent.

POST PURDUE BUZZ

Although the Lobos came up short on the road, they grabbed the attention of folks at a national level by giving a NCAA title contender a great test on the road. The Lobos are up to 32nd in the NCAA's RPI as of Dec. 11. The Lobos are first among Mountain West teams and ahead of second-place UNLV at 75th. No other team from the Mountain West ranks in the top-50.

Both coaches were highly complementary of the other's team after the game. Matt Painter was quoted postgame as saying, "There's probably only one place in the country where we were winning this game today ... fortunate it got played here." In Wednesday's observations column, Jon Rothstein of CBS Sports wrote, "New Mexico is going to be a real factor at the top of the Mountain West and can make some statements nationally when it plays in the Diamond Head Classic in Hawaii in a few weeks."

GETTING DEFENSIVE

The cherry and silver have continued last season's defense prowess. Last year, they held opponents to just 60.2 points per game, which was the second-best defensive scoring mark posted by a UNM team in the last three decades. So far this year, the Lobos are living up to their lofty defensive expectations. The Lobos are holding teams to 38.2 percent shooting, ranking 40th in the nation. The Lobos rank 35th in 3-point field goal defense, holding teams to 28.7 percent shooting. The Lobos rank second to Nevada only in the Mountain West Conference in 3-point field goal defense. If you take out the Lobos' game at USC, they are holding teams to 25 percent shooting from deep this season.

PROTECTING THE PIT

The Lobos are 4-0 in WisePies Arena this year, with wins over Texas Southern, Loyola-Chicago, Nicholls State and Oral Roberts. The home nonconference slate gets tough to close the calendar year, with the Lobos hosting Northern Iowa, New Mexico State and Rice. If the Lobos defeat NIU Saturday, it will give head coach Craig Neal his first 5-0 home record as a head coach. In Neal's nine seasons on the staff, the Lobos have reached 10-0 at home twice. Reaching 5-0 at home this season would mark the first time they've reached it since the 2012-13 season, in which the Lobos won both the regular season and tournament Mountain West championships. That season, the Lobos started 7-0 at home, a record that could be matched by this year's team over the next three games.

Neal stated in a recent press conference that he would like to see his team finish 2015-16 undefeated in The Pit. It's a feat that has only been done twice since the construction of WisePies Arena, with the last undefeated home record coming in 1996-97.

YOUTH DAY AND MASCOT MANIA

The New Mexico athletic department will hold its annual Youth Day and Mascot Mania event for Saturday's game against Northern Iowa. All youth single game purchasers between the ages of 2-18 will receive a \$10 ticket in bench Rows 1-10, while supplies last. The department will also have mascot mania at halftime of the men's game.

SEASON OF GIVING

Prior to leaving for West Lafayette, Indiana, the University of New Mexico men's basketball team participated in another community engagement activity, stuffing 30 stockings full of gifts for the Heart Gallery Foundation of New Mexico. The Heart Gallery Foundation was created to raise and manage funds to support at-risk foster children, and to educate the public and raise awareness of the need for adoptive and foster care families for New Mexico's foster children.

ALL-TIME ASSIST/TURNOVER RATIO

Starting point guard Cullen Neal is currently holding an assist/turnover ratio of 1.58 on the season. In four home games, Neal has amassed 20 assist to just 11 turnovers. If he can maintain his mark throughout this season, and improve as a junior and fifth-year senior, Neal has a chance to end his career as one of the most efficient Lobo court general.

All-time, only 12 Lobos have ever finished their career with at least 300 assists and an assist/turnover ratio better than 1.58. Two of the top three players played under head coach Craig Neal, a prolific point guard during his playing days. Below is the all-time top-10:

FIRST HALF AGAINST GOLDEN EAGLES

The first half effort by the Lobos against Oral Roberts was arguably the team's most complete performance of the season. The Lobos shot 58.8 percent in the period and 72.7 percent (8-for-11) from deep, the best mark in any half this season. On the opposite end, the Lobos held the visitors, fresh off back-to-back 100 points games, to 10-for-32 shooting. The Golden Eagles were also 2-for-11 from deep. Elijah Brown finished the night with 15 points, but scored 14 in the opening period on 5-for-8 shooting, 4-for-6 from 3-point range. The Lobos also committed just four turnovers before halftime.

TOYS FOR TOTS

On Tuesday, the University of New Mexico will held its annual Toys for Tots game. Fans received a \$10 ticket in Bench Rows 1-25 while supplies last in exchange for an unused toy at time of purchase at the Lobo Ticket Office in WisePies Arena. Although many fans took advantage of the promotion, Toys for Tots was a great success thanks to the overwhelming response from our loyal Lobo season ticket holders. Several season-ticket holders brought in toys to donate towards the cause, which were delivered early on Thursday morning. Prior to the men's game at 7 p.m. Saturday, the women's basketball team will hold its Toys for Tots game at 2 p.m. against Pepperdine.

PREMIER GUARDS

After seven strong outings this season, the Lobos' starting back court of Cullen Neal and Elijah Brown has built a strong reputation nationally. Both guards have a rich basketball backgrounds, as Neal is the son of Lobo head coach Craig Neal and Brown the son of former Cleveland Cavaliers and Los Angeles Lakers head coach Mike Brown. The duo is combining for 35.8 points per game this season and 7.9 assists per game. The Lobos are the only team in the Mountain West to have two guards averaging 16.9 points per game or more. Brown, the team's leading scorer at 17.9, currently ranks fourth in the league in scoring. Neal, seventh in scoring, is tied for fourth in the league with 4.4 assists per game.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

STRONG STARTS FOR NOODLES

Head coach Craig Neal has led his team to five wins in their first six games for the second time in his three-year tenure. The victory over Oral Roberts Tuesday pushed the Lobos to that mark for the sixth time since Neal joined the Lobos staff as an associate head coach in the fall of 2007. Prior to Neal coming to New Mexico, the last coach to open 5-1 or better in two of their first three seasons was Gary Colson, who joined the staff in 1981. Neal's winning percentage as a head coach is .653, which puts him in the top five all-time at New Mexico among coaches with at least 50 games. He currently sits .010 under the great Bob King. A strong season would put him in range of catching Norm Ellenberger, who finished his tenure at New Mexico with a .684 winning percentage. If he catches Ellenberger, Neal would have the distinction of coaching on two (his staff and Steve Alford's) of the top three winningest staff's in program history.

PACE OF PLAY

Head coach Craig Neal has made a point to play a more up tempo style in 2015-16. Last season, the Lobos averaged 62 points per game on an average of 62.5 possessions per game. This year, with the 30 second shot clock, the Lobos have improved to 78.6 points per game on an average of 72.5 possessions per game. That puts the quick Lobos above the national average of 70.3. While the national average is trending slower, the Lobos have picked up the tempo as the season has progressed. The Lobos' possession mark has gone up over the last two games, with the Lobos logging 81 against Oral Roberts and 79 against Purdue.

RIO GRANDE RIVALRY

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team won its eighth straight game in Las Cruces, New Mexico, and 14 out of the last 16 meetings, against the New Mexico State Aggies on Nov. 15, 83-74. The Lobos were led by a career-night from sophomore Elijah Brown, who scored 31 points on 8-for-17 shooting. The guard scored 13 of his points at the line out of 14 attempts. It's the most points a Lobo has scored since Alex Kirk dropped in 32 on Nov. 22, 2013. He also tied the game-high of six rebounds. Fellow sophomore Cullen Neal scored 18 points with five rebounds.

The Lobos are now 1-0 this year in the Rio Grande Rivalry series, with the second game slated for Dec. 16 at home.

DECEMBER IN PARADISE

Head coach Craig Neal and the University of New Mexico men's basketball program will be spending the holiday in Hawai'i this year. The Lobos are one of eight teams participating in the 2015 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic on December 22, 23 and 25 in Honolulu at the Stan Sheriff Center. The Lobos will face Auburn in the opening contest of the tournament.

2016 WOODEN LEGACY

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team will participate in the 2016 DIRECTV Wooden Legacy, taking place Nov. 24-27 in Orange County, California, as announced by ESPN Events Friday. The first two days will be held on the campus of Cal-State Fullerton and the final day of competition will be at the Honda Center in Anaheim, California. Teams joining the Lobos in the field include Cal State-Northridge, Dayton, Nebraska, Portland, Texas A&M, UCLA and Virginia Tech.

GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

This past week, New Mexico student-athletes took their final exams to wrap up the fall semester. The men's basketball program puts a priority behind the student portion of student-athlete, and in turn, gave the Lobos a few days off to concentrate on their studies. In the last NCAA report, the men's basketball team posted an 80 percent graduation rate, a new best-mark on the program and a 14 percent increase from last year's mark, then the all-time high. The program posted a 3.02 team gpa in the Fall of 2014, which was the highest team gpa in a semester in program history. The team had posted a 2.94 gpa the spring before.
