SCENE SETTER

■ THE GAME:

As part of this year's Mountain West/Missouri Valley Conference Challenge Series, Illinois State hosts New Mexico Saturday at 7 p.m. on Doug Collins Court at Redbird Arena. The Redbirds are aiming to remain undefeated at home after winning two straight games and three of the last four. The Lobos are facing their first true road test.

■ THE SERIES:

Saturday's game marks the first-ever meeting between Illinois State and New Mexico. The Redbirds are 1-3 in the MW/MVC Challenge Series. ISU won its first game in the series at Utah (Dec. 19, 2009), but has dropped three-straight since then, including last year's 71-60 loss at San Diego State (Nov. 13, 2015). New Mexico beat Loyola at home, 75-51, in last season's Challenge Series (Nov. 18, 2015). The Lobos are 5-0 in the Challenge Series.

■ THE COACHES:

Illinois State: Dan Muller (Illinois State, 1998) is in his fifth season as the head coach at Illinois State. Muller is the first-ever ISU coach to beat four Top-25 teams in his first four years. He led ISU to the 2015 NIT.

New Mexico: Craig Neal (Georgia Tech, 1988) is in his fourth season as the head coach at New Mexico. He became the first rookie head coach in program history to lead New Mexico to the NCAA Tournament (in 2013-14).

■ ILLINOIS STATE:

Was picked to finish second (out of 10 teams) in the Missouri Valley Conference ... Was the only team to feature two players (out of five) on the Preseason All-MVC First Team (**Paris Lee** and **MiKYLE McIntosh**) ... Returns four of five starters and seven of 11 letterwinners from last year's team, which tied for second place in the MVC with a 12-6 record, signifying ISU's highest league finish and most conference wins since the 2007-08 season.

■ NEW MEXICO:

Was picked to finish third (out of 11 teams) in the Mountain West ... Returns four starters and nine letterwinners from last year's 17-15 team which finished fourth with a 10-8 record in the MW regular-season standings ... Was the only team to feature two players (out of five) on the Preseason All-MW First Team, Elijah Brown and Tim Williams, and Brown was also the MW Preseason Player of the Year (averaged a team-best 21.7 ppg in 2016-17).

COACHING STAFF

**DAN MULLER | HEAD COACH | FIFTH SEASON**

Dan Muller knows what it takes to lead the Illinois State men's basketball team to the NCAA Tournament. He was the leader on the floor when the Redbirds qualified for the Big Dance in 1998, and he is striving to repeat that accomplishment, this time from the sidelines, as ISU's head coach. Muller was named the 19th men's basketball coach in school history May 8, 2012. Throughout his first four seasons, Muller led the Redbirds to a 76-58 record, including four triumphs over Top-25 programs. Before becoming ISU's leader, Muller spent 12 years as an assistant coach at Vanderbilt. As a player, Muller guided ISU to two regular-season and MVC Tournament championships.

**LUKE YAKLICH | ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH | FOURTH SEASON**

An Illinois State alum with invaluable Illinois high school and AAU ties, along with more than a decade of head coaching experience, Luke Yaklich (pronounced YOCK-lich) has served as an assistant coach for the ISU men's basketball team since the 2013-14 season. He was promoted to associate head coach ahead of the 2016-17 campaign. Yaklich was previously the head boy's basketball coach at Joliet Township High School in Joliet, Illinois, for six seasons, and also as a coach for the Joliet Pride and Illinois Wolves AAU teams. In total, Yaklich worked as a high school head coach and teacher for 14 years. Yaklich served as the ISU men's basketball team's manager/student assistant from 1996-98.

**DEAN OLIVER | ASSISTANT COACH | THIRD SEASON**

Dean Oliver has continuously proven his leadership ability as an NBA player and an NCAA Division I assistant coach and student-athlete. He is now sharing his vast experience with the Illinois State men's basketball program since joining ISU as an assistant coach prior to the 2014-15 season. A Mason City, Iowa, native who was born in Quincy, Illinois, Oliver spent three seasons as an assistant coach at North Dakota (2011-14), in Grand Forks, North Dakota, before coming to ISU. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Oliver prospered as a professional basketball player for nearly a decade, including a two-year stint in the NBA with the Golden State Warriors following a college career at Iowa.

**BRIAN REESE | ASSISTANT COACH | FIRST SEASON**

Brian Reese, who won a national championship as a player with North Carolina and was the head coach at Division II Georgian Court University last season, was hired as an assistant coach at Illinois State ahead of the 2016-17 season. Prior to his head coaching stint, Reese served as a collegiate assistant for six years. Before coaching at Georgian Court, Reese was an assistant at Monmouth University for four seasons (2011-15). Prior to joining Monmouth, Reese served as an assistant coach at High Point (2010-11) after a two-year stint with Wingate (2008-10). As a player, Reese helped North Carolina win the 1992-93 national championship by averaging 11.4 points and 3.6 rebounds per game.

NORMAL, Ill. – Five Redbirds recorded double-digit scoring efforts to lead a balanced offensive attack in Illinois State's 77-63 win over IUPUI Wednesday night on Doug Collins Court at Redbird Arena. ISU (3-2) shot 30-for-60 (50.0 percent) from the field and held IUPUI (2-5) to 21-for-54 (38.9 percent). The Redbirds also outrebounded the Jaguars, 42-31. **Paris Lee** led all scorers with 18 points. In the first half, the Redbirds forced 11 IUPUI turnovers compared to four of their own en route to a 44-29 halftime advantage. IUPUI pulled to within 67-57 with 5:04 remaining. However, Illinois State outscored IUPUI 10-6 in the final four minutes to secure the non-conference victory.

TEAM NOTES

CHALLENGING THE WEST

The revived Mountain West/Missouri Valley Challenge Series resumed last season and features head-to-head competition between 10 Mountain West and 10 Missouri Valley teams annually, with each conference hosting five games apiece each season. Annual matchups for teams in the Challenge Series are based upon factors including the previous year's achievements, records and RPI rankings, as well as projected rankings/strength of teams in the upcoming season, based on composite sources. Each season will be considered separately in terms of matchups, therefore, games from the previous year may not be returned.

RENEWING THE RIVALRY

The original Mountain West/Missouri Valley Challenge Series ran from the 2009-10 through the 2012-13 seasons, with Illinois State earning a 1-2 record (2009-10: at Utah, W 73-63; 2010-11: vs. UNLV, L 82-51; 2011-12: No opponent; 2012-13: vs. Wyoming, L 81-67). Last season, Illinois State lost at San Diego State, 71-60 (Nov. 13, 2015). So, ISU hold a 1-3 overall record in the Challenge Series, and New Mexico is 5-0.

TOP FIVE

Senior forward **Deontae Hawkins** is the only Missouri Valley Conference player to rank in the top five in both league scoring (fifth, 16.0 points per game) and rebounding (second, 7.6 rebounds per game).

APPROACHING 200

By forcing two steals in Illinois State's win over IUPUI, senior guard **Paris Lee** increased his career-steals total to 194, putting him six steals away from becoming just the second Redbird ever to force 200 or more career steals. Lee is currently second on the career-steals list behind **Ron Jones** (222).

TAKING THE ROCK

As a team, Illinois State ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference and 24th nationally with 9.2 steals averaged per game. Senior guard **Paris Lee** ranks third in the league with 2.2 steals per contest.

HELPING HAND

Senior guard **Paris Lee** leads the Missouri Valley Conference and ranks 44th nationally with 5.6 assists averaged per game. As a team, the Redbirds rank third in the league with 16.4 assists per contest.

BALANCED ATTACK

For the second time this season, five Redbirds scored in double figures, as Illinois State used a balanced offensive attack to beat IUPUI (Nov. 30): **Paris Lee** (18), **MiKyle McIntosh** (14), **Deontae Hawkins** (13), **DJ Clayton** (12) and **Phil Fayne** (11). The same five players also reached double figures in the win over Fort Wayne (Nov. 16). The IUPUI game marked the first time since 2013-14 that the Redbirds have featured five players in double figures in two or more games (they achieved this feat five times that year).

A TALE OF TWO HALVES

In all five games this season, the Redbirds have both scored first and held a halftime advantage. ISU holds a +9.0 scoring margin in the first half of games this year contrasted with a -2.2 scoring margin in the second half. Illinois State also has a +4.2 turnover margin in the first half compared to a -2.6 second-half turnover margin. Additionally, ISU has shot 49.3 percent in the first half and 42.8 percent in the second half.

TRENDING

So far this season, Illinois State is 3-1 when: Leading with five minutes left in regulation; ISU starters outscore opponent's; Outrebounding opponent. ISU is 3-0 when outshooting its opponent. In Redbird victories, **Deontae Hawkins** has averaged a team-best 19.3 points per game compared to 11.0 in losses.

CLOSING IN ON 80

Fifth-year head coach **Dan Muller** is one victory away from his 80th win. With a current record of 79-60, Muller will become just the eighth Redbird head coach (out of 19) to achieve 80 victories at Illinois State.

DJ IS A HIT

Junior transfer guard **DJ Clayton** has consistently contributed in his first five games as a Redbird. After scoring six points in the season opener, Clayton has reached double figures in four-straight contests, most recently netting 12 points with a game-high eight rebounds in the win over IUPUI (Nov. 30).

HOT SHOT

In Illinois State's 81-67 victory over Ferris State (Nov. 27), the Redbirds recorded their highest point total since scoring 81 in an 84-81 overtime loss at Missouri State Jan. 30, 2016. It also marked the most points scored by ISU in a victory since an 82-72 home-court win over Bradley Jan. 17, 2015. Illinois State's 31 made-field goals were the most since totaling 39 in a 99-57 win over Quincy Dec. 29, 2014.

INTENSE DEFENSE

The Redbirds combined for 15 steals in the win against Ferris State (Nov. 27), signifying ISU's most steals since also forcing 15 versus UAB (Nov. 23, 2012). Illinois State's 15 steals tied for seventh on the program's single-game steals list. Additionally, the Redbirds forced 22 turnovers against Ferris State, which was the most since forcing 24 versus Indiana State (Dec. 31, 2014). Senior forward **Deontae Hawkins** contributed a career-best four steals, surpassing his previous high of three.

FAYNE'S GAME

Sophomore transfer **Phil Fayne** scored a career-high 22 points on 9-for-16 (56.3 percent) shooting from the field in Illinois State's win over Ferris State (Nov. 27), marking the most points scored by a Redbird newcomer since then-junior transfer **DeVaughn Akoon-Purcell** netted 24 points versus Southern Illinois Feb. 25, 2015. Akoon-Purcell – who netted 20 or more points three times as a junior – went on to earn 2015 Missouri Valley Conference Newcomer of the Year accolades. Fayne is averaging 11.8 points.

MIKYLE STYLE

Junior forward **MiKyle McIntosh** – a Preseason All-Missouri Valley Conference selection – picked up where he left off by recording season highs in points (20) and rebounds (nine) at TCU (Nov. 21).

CAREER NIGHT

Senior forward **Deontae Hawkins** netted a career-high 24 points in Illinois State's home-opening victory over Fort Wayne (Nov. 16). Hawkins surpassed his previous high of 18 points versus Youngstown State (Nov. 29, 2014). The Dayton, Ohio, native, made a career-best nine field goals (on 15 attempts), topping his previous mark of seven-made field goals against Southern Illinois Feb. 24, 2016.

HAWK SKIES FOR BOARDS

In Illinois State's season opener at Murray State (Nov. 11), senior forward **Deontae Hawkins** matched a career best with 15 rebounds. Hawkins recorded 15 boards for the third time in his career. And, with 14 points, Hawkins earned his third-career double-double.

IT'S A STEAL

Senior guard **Paris Lee** ranks No. 2 among active NCAA players for career steals. He needs three to crack into the MVC all-time Top 10 for steals.

As the Missouri Valley Conference's active career leader in steals and assists, senior guard **Paris Lee** will undoubtedly leave his mark in the Illinois State record book. Lee ranks second in career steals (194) behind **Ron Jones** (222 from 1976-80). Lee also ranks 11th in career assists (347). Additionally, Lee began the 2016-17 season with 813 points, just 187 away from becoming the 42nd member of the 1,000-point club. Lee scored 355 points last season and has never scored fewer than 227.

REDBIRDS TO PLAY IN 2017 PUERTO RICO TIP-OFF

The Illinois State men's basketball team is one of eight programs slated to play in the 2017 Tire Pros Puerto Rico Tip-Off, scheduled for Thursday, Friday and Sunday, Nov. 16, 17 and 19 in San Juan, Puerto Rico, at the Coliseo Roberto Clemente. ISU is making its first-ever appearance in the tournament which is managed by ESPN Events.

"Another year and another terrific high-level tournament for Illinois State basketball," head coach Dan Muller said. "I want to thank ESPN for giving us a great opportunity to play in the Puerto Rico Tip-Off with an outstanding field of teams. I am looking forward to our team getting a chance to experience a new culture and play in a great tournament next year."

The Tire Pros Puerto Rico Tip-Off will feature a pair of schools with previous appearances in the San Juan event – Florida State of the Atlantic Coast Conference (2013) and Western Michigan of the Mid-American Conference (2011) – along with seven teams that posted winning records during the 2015-16 season, including Illinois State. The field also includes 2016 NCAA participants Iowa State of the Big 12 Conference and Tulsa of the American Athletic Conference.

Other schools competing in the 2017 Puerto Rico Tip-Off will be Boise State of the Mountain West Conference, South Carolina of the Southeastern Conference and UTEP of Conference USA.

Iowa State posted a 23-12 record during its 2015-16 campaign and advanced to the NCAA Championship Sweet 16 before losing to Virginia. Tulsa compiled a 20-12 mark last season and dropped a First Four game to Michigan. Tulsa coach Frank Haith led Miami to the 2007 Tire Pros Puerto Rico Tip-Off.

Boise State (20-12), Florida State (20-14), Iowa State (23-12), South Carolina (25-9) and Tulsa (20-12) won more than 20 games last season, with Illinois State (18-14) and UTEP (19-14) also posting winning records during the 2015-16 campaign. Overall, the eight schools scheduled to compete in the 2017 Puerto Rico Tip-Off posted a 59.8 winning percentage (158-106). Both Florida State and South Carolina competed in the 2016 NIT.

GOOD WORKS

Junior forward **MiKyle McIntosh** is one of 111 NCAA Division I men's basketball student-athletes nominated for the 2017 Allstate Good Works Team. A panel will select the final 10-member team (unveiled in February). McIntosh is a two-time AFNI Honor Roll member and has volunteered for more than 15 hours.

HIGH EXPECTATIONS

Illinois State is picked to finish second in the league, according to the 2016-17 MVC Preseason Poll, as compiled from votes by MVC sports information directors, media and coaches. Illinois State's predicted second-place finish marks ISU's highest pick since also being tabbed second in the 2012-13 preseason poll. The Redbirds have now been selected to finish second or higher six times in program history (1993-94: first; 1996-97: first; 1997-98: first; 2001-02: first; 2012-13: second; 2016-17: second). ISU received 356 total points and four first-place votes. Wichita State is the favorite to win the MVC men's basketball title.

The Redbirds landed two on the five-player preseason roster for the first time since **Rico Hill** and current head coach **Dan Muller** represented ISU as preseason first-team selections in 1997-98. Hill and Muller led Illinois State to the NCAA Tournament that year after winning MVC regular-season and tournament titles. The 2016-17 Redbirds were the only team to earn two first-team honors.

DAN MULLER

HEAD COACH • FIFTH SEASON • 79-60 ISU AND CAREER RECORD

Dan Muller knows what it takes to lead the Illinois State men's basketball team to the NCAA Tournament. He was the leader on the floor when the Redbirds qualified for the Big Dance in 1998, and he is striving to repeat that accomplishment, this time from the sidelines, as ISU's head coach. Muller was named the 19th men's basketball coach in school history May 8, 2012.

Throughout his first four seasons, Muller led the Redbirds to a 76-58 record, including four triumphs over Top-25 programs, two postseason appearances (2015 National Invitation Tournament and 2014 College Basketball Invitational), three postseason wins, and victories against the Big Ten, the BIG EAST and the Southeastern Conference (SEC). Muller is the first coach in Illinois State basketball history to beat four Top-25 teams in his first four seasons, and his four Top-25 victories are also tied for the most ever recorded by a Redbird head coach.

Muller has guided ISU student-athletes to eight All-Missouri Valley Conference selections (one first team, four second team and three honorable mention), four MVC All-Defensive accolades, three MVC All-Newcomer honors and one MVC All-Freshman accolade. Additionally, three Redbirds have garnered All-MVC Scholar-Athlete recognition under Muller's tutelage.

As a fourth-year coach (2015-16), Muller and the Redbirds faced one of the toughest non-conference schedules in program history, ranked No. 7 nationally at the end of the regular season, according to the Collegiate Basketball News Report. The Redbirds finished the 2015-16 campaign with an 18-14 overall record and tied for second place with a 12-6 mark in the MVC, signifying ISU's highest league finish and most conference wins since 2007-08. Illinois State's upset victory over No. 21 Wichita State (Feb. 6) on Doug Collins Court at Redbird Arena marked Muller's fourth Top-25 win in as many seasons. In the classroom, Muller's Redbirds established a cumulative team grade-point (GPA) record by teaming up to earn a 2.82 GPA during the 2015-16 academic year.

In his third season (2014-15), Muller guided ISU to a 22-13 overall record, marking the Redbirds' most victories since

2009-10. Illinois State tied for third place in the league with an 11-7 mark. As the MVC Tournament's fourth seed, ISU upset No. 8 Wichita State in the semifinals. After falling to No. 11 Northern Iowa in the tournament championship game, the Redbirds earned an at-large bid to the NIT and advanced to the second round by beating Green Bay at home (March 18). The Redbirds also established a team grade-point average record in the fall of 2014 with a 2.99 GPA.

During his second season (2013-14), Muller was charged with leading the most inexperienced team in NCAA Division I basketball. With just two-and-a-half years of returning experience, Muller guided ISU to an 18-win season, including victories over a Top-25 program (vs. No. 25 Dayton, Dec. 7), a Big Ten team (at Northwestern, Nov. 17), a BIG EAST opponent (vs. DePaul, Dec. 22) and an SEC foe (vs. Texas A&M, March 24).

In his first year at Illinois State (2012-13), Muller led the Redbirds to an 18-win campaign, with at least one victory against eight of the MVC's nine opponents, including a win at No. 16 Creighton.

Before becoming Illinois State's leader, Muller spent 12 years as an assistant coach at Vanderbilt. Under former Illinois State head coach Kevin Stallings, Muller was regarded as one of the top assistant coaches in the country. As Vanderbilt's recruiting coordinator, Muller spearheaded the program's recruiting efforts beginning in 2006, which were the highest rated recruiting classes in the history of the program.

As a player, Muller guided Illinois State to two regular-season and MVC Tournament championships and four postseason appearances, including trips to the NCAA Tournament in his final two seasons (1997 and 1998).

Muller ranks 11th in career scoring with



1,445 points, while leading the Redbirds to a 91-37 overall record, and he still owns the school record with 128-consecutive starts (every game of his career). Muller was also a two-time MVC Defensive Player of the Year and was named the MVP of the MVC Tournament as a senior. In 2009, he was inducted into the Illinois State Athletics Percy Family Hall of Fame.

Off the court, Muller was a two-time GTE Academic All-American and a recipient of the NCAA's Post-Graduate Scholarship. He also was named a Bone Scholar, the highest academic honor at ISU, and he is the only men's basketball student-athlete to earn the award.

The Lafayette, Indiana, native spent two years playing professionally, including a stint with the NBA's Vancouver Grizzlies.

Muller is a 1998 graduate of Illinois State and graduated cum laude with a bachelor's degree in organizational leadership. He later earned his master's in business administration from Florida in 2003. He is married to Melissa Muller and has one stepson, Sib.
