ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- New Mexico and Oral Roberts will face off Tuesday in WisePies Arena for the third time ever, in a series that dates back to December of 2008.
- In the first, and only, meeting between the two teams in WisePies Arena, the Lobos defeated the Golden Eagles, 66-63, on Dec. 17, 2008. Tony Danridge hit 20 points and Daniel Faris had 16 to lead New Mexico to its fourth straight win at the time.
- In the most recent meeting in Tulsa on Dec. 23, 2009, the Golden Eagles evened the score with a 75-66 victory. It was the first loss of the 2009-10 season after the Lobos started 12-0. The Lobos shot 37 percent from the floor and 26.8 percent from behind the line. The Golden Eagles shot 46.9 percent from the floor.
- The Lobos are 4-1 for the second time under head coach Craig Neal, most recently defeating the Nicholls State Colonels. The Lobos were led by an 18 point, nine rebound effort from Elijah Brown, who was New Mexico's leading scorer for the second time this season.
- The Golden Eagles are off to a hot start at 6-1. On Saturday, Oral Roberts took down Detroit at home, 100-95. The Golden Eagles have scored 100 points in back-to-back games, previously defeating Tabor, 112-80. Scott Sutton is in his 17th season as head coach of Oral Roberts. His 312 wins are the most in program history. Since the start of the 2001-02 season, Sutton's teams have finished either first or second in the Summit League nine times.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

The (-/RV) University of New Mexico men's basketball team (4-1) earned its fourth win in five games, taking down the Nicholls State Colonels (1-3), 75-63, at home on Nike N7 and American Indian Night. The Lobos were led by an 18 point, nine rebound effort from Elijah Brown, who was New Mexico's leading scorer for the second time this season. Brown also tied the game-high for assists at five. Tim Williams had a team-best 12 rebounds to go along with 10 points. Cullen Neal logged 12 point and tied Brown at five assists. In his last two games, Neal has logged nine assists to just two turnovers. The Lobos shot 41.3 percent (26-for-63), while Nicholls shot 32.8 percent (21-for-64). New Mexico won the rebounding battle, 45-39, with 10 offensive boards.

NIKE N7 & AMERICAN INDIAN NIGHT

The New Mexico men's basketball program is proud to collaborate with Nike N7 to celebrate Native American Heritage Month. Wednesday's game against Nicholls State was the program's Nike N7 and American Indian Night. The Lobos played in their custom turquoise jerseys, which represents harmony, friendship and fellowship in Native American Culture. The uniforms also compliment the Nike N7 Power of Perseverance Collection, recognizing the movement of sports on Native lands and driving awareness of Native American culture.

A jersey ceremony was held prior to tipoff. A jersey auction was also held Wednesday, which raised \$4,300 for the NB3 Foundation and the UNM American Indian Student Services Department.

POINT GUARD CENTURY MARK

Entering Tuesday's game against Oral Roberts, two of the Lobos' three point guards are approaching 100 assists for their careers. Tim Jacobs currently sits at 99 assists for his career, after logging 87 last year as a junior transfer from Cochise College. Starting point guard Cullen Neal is currently at 95 for his career. Neal has flourished as a distributor this year, with a team-best 19 assists and a 1.7 assist/turnover ratio. In the last two games, Jacobs and Neal have combined for 20 assists and just two turnovers.

TOYS FOR TOTS

On Tuesday, the University of New Mexico will hold its annual Toys for Tots game. Fans will receive a \$10 ticket in Bench Rows 1-25 while supplies last in exchange for an unused toy at time of purchase at the Lobo Ticket Office in WisePies Arena.

FURSTINGER'S STRONG PLAY

Joe Furstinger has never taken more than two field goal attempts in a game his entire career, but the young big man has found a variety of ways to make an impact on his team. In 15.2 minutes played per game, Furstinger is averaging 1.4 blocks and 1.0 steals per game. He is the only player on the team averaging at least one block and steal per game. Against Nicholls State, Furstinger logged a career-high 25 minutes and held the team's best +/- at +24, +15 better than anyone else on the team. For the season, Furstinger leads the Lobos at +19.15 per 40 minutes.

Head coach Neal on Furstinger after the win against Nicholls State... "I thought Joe was terrific. I also thought he was good at USC, and I should've played him more, but it was hard because Tim Williams had it going so well. Joe's given us great effort, he's got great confidence right now and he's playing at a high level. I was really happy the way he played. He's going to continue to get better because he wants to get better. It's the first time Joe's come in and watched a lot of tape and spent a lot of time in the gym, and when you do that you see rewards."

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

STRONG STARTS FOR NOODLES

Head coach Craig Neal has led his team to a 4-1 start for the second time in his three-year tenure. A win on Tuesday would give the Lobos five wins in their first six games for the sixth time since Neal joined the Lobos staff as an associate head coach in the fall of 2007. Prior to Neal coming to New Mexico, the last coach to open 5-1 or better in two of their first three seasons was Gary Colson, who joined the staff in 1981.

2016 WOODEN LEGACY

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team will participate in the 2016 DIRECTV Wooden Legacy, taking place Nov. 24-27 in Orange County, California, as announced by ESPN Events Friday. The first two days will be held on the campus of Cal-State Fullerton and the final day of competition will be at the Honda Center in Anaheim, California. Teams joining the Lobos in the field include Cal State-Northridge, Dayton, Nebraska, Portland, Texas A&M, UCLA and Virginia Tech.

TIM WILLIAMS STEPPING UP

Tim Williams had his break out game for New Mexico in the team's big win over Loyola-Chicago and has emerged as a force ever since. Against the Ramblers, he shot 71.4 percent and scored 22 points. He also led the team with four assists. At USC, he recorded 25 points with 15 rebounds, both highs at UNM. His second straight double-double came Wednesday against Nicholls State, with a team-best 12 rebounds to go along with 10 points. In the last three games, Williams is averaging 19 points per game and 11.3 rebounds. On the season, Williams ranks 34th in the nation with 3.8 rebounds per game. He has grabbed 16.1 percent of all available offensive rebounds.

OFFENSIVE REBOUND PERCENTAGE

The Lobos have worked hard on the glass this season, especially on the offensive end. New Mexico has grabbed a total of 61 offensive rebounds, averaging 12.2 per game. The Lobos have grabbed 37.2 percent of all available offensive rebounds, which ranks 43rd in the nation through games played on Nov. 28. The Lobos lead all Mountain West Conference teams in offensive rebound percentage, with Colorado State sitting second at 35.6 percent.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

The cherry and silver have continued last season's defense prowess. Last year, they held opponents to just 60.2 points per game, which was the second-best defensive scoring mark posted by a UNM team in the last three decades. The Lobos were the last team in the nation to concede 70 points in a game after allowing 70 points to Colorado State in their 24th game of the season. It was New Mexico's best defensive scoring start to a season since World War II.

So far this year, the Lobos are living up to their lofty defensive expectations. They are holding opponents to 38 percent shooting from the floor and 31.1 percent shooting from 3-point range. Their field goal defense mark ranks in the national top-50 through games played on Nov. 28. Despite a jump in total possessions, the Lobos are still holding opponents to 67 points per game, leading to a scoring margin of 13.2.

PACE OF PLAY

Head coach Craig Neal has made a point to play a more up tempo style in 2015-16. Last season, the Lobos averaged 62 points per game on an average of 62.5 possessions per game. This year, with the 30 second shot clock, the Lobos have improved to 80.2 points per game on an average of 70 possessions per game. Despite the increase from last season, the Lobos are just under the national average of 70.6. Against Nicholls State, the Lobos finished the game with 74 total possessions, a jump from the previous two games. During exhibition play, the Lobos averaged over 78 possessions per game against two Division II opponents.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

INJURIES

Injuries were a big part of the storyline in 2014-15, with five players missing a total of 52 games. Unfortunately, injuries have already taken out two players on the Lobo roster this season. JJ N'Ganga will miss the entire season due to injury. On Nov. 18, Craig Neal announced that Devon Williams has been advised to end his basketball career following a neck injury at New Mexico State. The Lobos dedicated their effort against Loyola-Chicago to Williams, with all of the players writing "DWill" on their shoes.

ELIJAH BROWN - FIRST MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

University of New Mexico men's basketball starting guard Elijah Brown was named the first Mountain West Conference Player of the Week of the 2015-16 season. In wins over Texas Southern and New Mexico State, both of whom were picked to win their conference, Brown averaged a conference-best 23.5 points per game on 54 percent shooting from the floor. He made timely buckets all week and reached the foul line consistently, converting on 15 of his 17 free throw attempts. Brown also helped create opportunities for his teammates and averaged a team-high four assists per game, earning an assist to turnover ratio of 2.7. He is currently second on the team with 4.5 rebounds per game.

Brown had a career night in an 83-74 win at New Mexico State and scored 31 points on 8-for-17 shooting. In the season-opener against Texas Southern, Brown scored 16 points on 6-for-9 shooting and recorded a team-best six assists. The sophomore became the first Lobo to earn the first MW Player of the Week honor of the season since Mark Walters in 2004.

RIO GRANDE RIVALRY

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team won its eighth straight game in Las Cruces, New Mexico, and 14 out of the last 16 meetings, against the New Mexico State Aggies on Nov. 15, 83-74. The Lobos were led by a career-night from sophomore Elijah Brown, who scored 31 points on 8-for-17 shooting. The guard scored 13 of his points at the line out of 14 attempts. It's the most points a Lobo has scored since Alex Kirk dropped in 32 on Nov. 22, 2013. He also tied the game-high of six rebounds. Fellow sophomore Cullen Neal scored 18 points with five rebounds.

The Lobos are now 1-0 this year in the Rio Grande Rivalry series, with the second game slated for Dec. 16 at home.

NATIONAL SIGNING DAY

Head coach Craig Neal's staff is bringing in two freshmen and one transfer player during the early signing period. Joining the Lobos will be transfer forward Connor MacDougall of South Mountain Community College and previously Arizona State University and Corona Del Sol HS. Also joining is Damien Jefferson of East Chicago Central HS and Aher Uguak of Harry Ainley HS in Edmonton, Canada.

GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

The NCAA recently released graduation success rates for all NCAA institutions, and it was great news for the Lobos. The men's basketball team posted an 80 percent graduation rate, a new best-mark on the program and a 14 percent increase from last year's mark, then the all-time high. The program posted a 3.02 team gpa in the Fall of 2014, which was the highest team gpa in a semester in program history. The team had posted a 2.94 gpa the spring before.
